**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers play the third game of a four-game weekend series at American Family Field nationally televised tonight on FOX ... The Cardinals visit Angel Stadium for the first time since 2016 for a three-game Interleague series with the Los Angeles Angels on Monday (May 13-15) ... The Redbirds are riding a modest two-game win streak in nationally-televised games (April 26-27 at New York Mets on AppleTV+ and FOX).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 8.0 games behind division-leading Milwaukee, and 4.5 games back in the NL Wild Card race ... St. Louis is trying to snap a season-high six-game losing streak (May 4-present), the longest active in MLB, and its longest skid since a eight-gamer last season (April 28-May 6, 2023).

**WELL, WELL, WELL, HOW THE TURNTABLES:** The Cardinals have lost 10 of their last 11 games and seven straight to the Brewers (Sept. 27, 2023-present), matching the club's longest skid to Milwaukee in franchise history (May 11-Aug. 26, 2008) ... St. Louis has dropped the first five games of the season series to the Brew Crew for the first time. **NORTHERN EXPOSURE:** Since St. Louis and Milwaukee began regular season play in 1997, the Cardinals own the most wins against the Brewers (239-194, .552) and boast the best road winning pct. (.123-.92, .572) of any visitor of Milwaukee since 1997 ... Their .575 win pct. (111-82) since American Family Field opened in 2001 is tops among teams who annually play in Milwaukee.

**CARPENTER RETURNS:** Prior to today's game, the Cardinals activated 1B/DH **Matt Carpenter** from the 10-Day Injured List and optioned INF **José Fermín** to Memphis (AAA) ... Carpenter, who missed the last 32 games with a right oblique strain, batted .211 (4-11) with two homers and four walks in six injury rehab games between Memphis (AAA) and Springfield (AA).

**GOLDENADO:** In 31 career plate appearances against **Freddy Peralta**, **Nolan Arenado** is slashing .357/.419/.786 (10-28) with four home runs & 10 RBI ... **Paul Goldschmidt** is batting .296/.367/.7667 (8-27) with two homers in 30 plate appearances ... No other opposing batter has more home runs and RBI off Peralta than Arenado.

**BE LIKE MIKE:** **Michael Siani** is riding a career high seven-game hitting streak (9-19, .474) since April 30, tied for the 4th-longest active hitting streak in Major League Baseball ... Siani is batting .444 (8-17) in month of May, 4th-highest in MLB.

**SIX SHOOTERS:** **Kyle Gibson** has thrown 6.0 or more innings in each of his first seven starts of the season, longest active streak in MLB this season and one of six MLB pitchers with seven starts of 6.0+ innings this season ... This is the first time in Gibson's 12-year career he has done this, and Gibson is the first Cardinal to achieve this since **Mike Leake** (11) and **Michael Wacha** (7) in 2017 ... **Bob Gibson** holds the franchise record for the Cardinals with 35 in 1969 (every start that season).

**ALL IN THE FAMILY:** The Cardinals have hit the most home runs (236) of all opposing teams at American Family Field since it opened in 2001 ... **Paul Goldschmidt** has gone yard 18 times at American Family Field, 6th among all visiting players and 2nd among active opponents to **Joey Votto** (24) ... Goldy enjoyed a three-homer game here on March 29, 2019 in his second career game as a Cardinal; his first homer that night was off **Freddy Peralta**.

**WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN:** Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn**, who sports MLB's 3rd-highest line drive percentage (35.4%) behind **Freddie Freeman** (37.0%) and **Gavin Sheets** (37.1%), co-leads Major League shortstops in defensive runs saved (8) with **Bobby Witt Jr.** - *Sports Info Solutions*

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 11, 1996):** **Red Schoendienst's** uniform number 2 is retired by the St. Louis Cardinals at Busch Stadium II, on Red Schoendienst Day.

#### MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

**Ryan Helsley** (April 16, 2019) and **Brandon Crawford** (May 27, 2011) made their MLB debuts at Milwaukee.

**Devin Williams** was born in Florissant, Mo... was 1st Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the Univ. of Missouri before drafted by Milwaukee in the 2nd round in 2013.

**Trevor Megill** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Cardinals AGM/Player Development **Gary LaRocque** was selected by Milwaukee in the 14th round of the 1975 MLB Draft.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** in exchange for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**.

**Willson Contreras'** younger brother, **William**, is also a catcher for the Brewers.

**Bryan Hudson** graduated from Alton (Ill.) High School, where he set school records for career wins (25) and strikeouts (324)...committed to the University of Missouri prior to being drafted by the Cubs in the 3rd round. of 2015.

**Joe Ross's** older brother **Tyson Ross**, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals in 2018.

**Turner Ward** played parts of three seasons (1994-96) with the Brewers.

**Chris Roycroft** pitched for the Joliet Slammers (2021-22) in the independent Frontier League.

**Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA) in the Brewers organization in 1990.

**Steve Dillard**, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & broadcaster **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** is a Marquette Univ. graduate... started in pro baseball as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991).

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** and **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-Green Bay women's basketball team.

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay... graduate of The University of Wisconsin-Madison.

- Making his eighth start of the season and as a member of the Cardinals (302nd career start). It's his 10th career start against Milwaukee and 7th at American Family Field.
- Became the 9th active pitcher with 300 or more games started at Detroit (April 30-G1). **Justin Verlander** leads the active list with 512.
- Has pitched four straight quality starts, tied with **Sonny Gray** for the longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Jordan Montgomery** ran off five straight (6/9-7/2/2023).
- Has thrown 6.0 or more innings in his first seven starts this season, tied for longest active streak in MLB this season and the first time in his 12-year career he has done this. He's the first Cardinals pitcher to achieve this since **Mike Leake** (11) and **Michael Wacha** (7) in 2017. **Bob Gibson** holds the franchise record for the Cardinals with 35 in 1969 (every start that season).
- Is one of nine pitchers this season with six starts of 6.0 or more innings.
- The last time a Cardinal pitched at least 6.0 innings in each of the first seven starts (in their first full year with the team) was **Brad Penny** (first seven starts in 2010).
- Posted his career-highs for innings pitched (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings are the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month, most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- Has posted a 3.24 ERA (25.0 IP) with **Willson Contreras** behind the plate, the 4th-lowest ERA of any of the 24 catchers he has pitched with in his career.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Joins his fifth Major League team Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Posted his 7th straight start of 6.0 innings or more. Allowed three runs (2 ER) on seven hits. Departed tied at 3-3 as the Cardinals scored three runs in the bottom of the 6th inning trailing 3-0.
- Became the first Cardinals pitcher since Michael Wacha (7) and Mike Leake (11) in 2017 to begin the season with seven straight starts of 6.0 innings or more.

CAREER

- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in ground into double plays (211). Has allowed 209 career home runs over that period for comparison.
- Has career marks of 106-102, one of 17 active pitchers with 100 or more wins. Ranks 11th among active pitchers with 106 wins, three behind **Carlos Carrasco** (109) for 9th and **Wade Miley** (108) for 10th.
- Durable starting pitcher, has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has posted eight 10-win seasons since his MLB debut in 2013, tied for 4th-most among over that period trailing only **Max Scherzer** (10), **Gerrit Cole** (9) & **Clayton Kershaw** (9).
- One of four pitchers since 2014 to record 100 or more strikeouts in 9-of-10 seasons with **Jacob deGrom**, **Clayton Kershaw** and **Max Scherzer**.

2024

- Posted his career-highs for innings (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- Had three straight starts pitching 6.0 or more innings with one run allowed (4/19-30). Longest streak by a Cardinals pitcher since **Steven Matz** reeled off three last year (7/25-8/3/23). The last Cardinals pitcher with four straight starts (6.0+ IP & 1 R or less) was **Adam Wainwright** (9/2-18/19).
