**TODAY'S GAME:** Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 3-game series vs **Erica George's Nationals** and the finale (2-3) of a 7-day/6-game homestand that includes a weekend series victory vs the **Astros** (2-1).

- Following today's game vs **Wsh**, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **Cle** (Fri-Sun) and **Phi** (Mon-Wed).
- Cin is coming off a 0-7 road trip at **Pit** (0-3) and **Chc** (0-4).

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds today seek to avoid their first losing home sweep since dropping all 3 games to the **Royals** at **Great American Ball Park** from 8/16-8/18, 2024, a run of 38 consecutive series in **Cincinnati** without being swept.

- This current 38 sweepless series streak at home is the team's longest since avoiding the broom in a franchise-record 52 straight home series from 9/19/11-9/25/13.
- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**... the only other Cin teams to run the home schedule without being swept were the clubs of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012.
- The **Nationals** last swept the Reds at **GABP** in 2023 (8/4-8/6).

**ELLYTRICITY:** In last night's 10-inning, 8-7 loss vs **Wsh**, **SS Elly De La Cruz** went 2-for-5 with a double and a run scored...it was his career-high fifth consecutive multi-hit game...it's the longest such streak by a Red since **Noelvi Marte** had multiple hits in 5 straight games from 8/16-8/20, 2025.

- Elly** has 12 hits over his last 24 at-bats to lift his batting average to a season-high .295.
- Among all Major League shortstops this season, ranks with the leaders in TB (90, 1st), runs (31, 1st), avg exit velocity (94.3, 1st), XBH (19, T1st), homers (10, 2nd), SLG (.520, 2nd), RBI (29, T2nd), games (43, T2nd), OPS (.876, 3rd), hits (51, 3rd), and stolen bases (9, T3rd).
- Half of his 10 HR have come off left-handed pitching (49 PA)...hit 5 HR off lefties last year (210 PA).
- Is 2 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 123 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark since 1900 (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).
- Is also 2 stolen bases shy of ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to reach 400 hits, 200 RBI, and 150 stolen bases for his career.
- Is on pace for 37 HR and 33 SB...would become the fourth Red in franchise history to join the "30-30 club"...(**Brandon Phillips** in 2007, **Barry Larkin** in 1996, **Eric Davis** in 1987).

**EL CABALLO DE HIERRO:** **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 261 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fourth-longest streak of consecutive games played by a Red since 1970.

**APRIL FLOWERS, MAY SHOWERS:** The Reds have dropped 10 of their first 12 games to begin the month of May after going 20-11 (.645) to open the season.

- Entered this month a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the National League Central Division (+1.0).

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds went 2-4 in 2025 vs **Wsh**, dropping both 3-game series (1-2, 5/2-5/4 in **Cincy** & 1-2, 7/21-7/23 in **D.C.**).

- Cin is 22-40 vs **Wsh** since 2016 with a -63 run margin (293-356).
- The Redlegs have dropped 21 of the last 29 games vs **Wsh** here at **Great American Ball Park** since 2017.
- Cin has won 9 of its last 16 games at **Nationals Park** dating back to 5/25/21, but is just 12-18 there since the beginning of 2016.
- Wsh** last swept the Reds in 2024 in **D.C.** (3g, 7/19-7/21).

**KEEPIN' IT CLEAN:** **2b Matt McLain** has produced a career-high 77 consecutive errorless games at second base, beginning 8/11/25.

- McLain's** last error at the keystone came on 8/10/25 at **Pit** (throwing error in the 8th inning).

**MINIMIZING MISCUES:** The Reds rank third in the majors with a .990 fielding percentage (**SD** .993, **Ath** .992)...Cin's 15 errors rank T3rd...only the **Padres** (10), and **A's** (11) have fewer errors so far this season.

**3-4-5:** Reds' 3,4,5 batters have combined to slash .270/.349/.494 in the first 43 games of the 2026 season (134-for-496, 28hr, 87rbi, 196 times on base).

- The rest of the Cin lineup has combined for a .193/.284/.318 slash line with the fewest hits in the majors (181).
- Cin 3-4-5 hitters lead their ML counterparts in home runs (28).

## CHASE BURNS RHP #26

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the 3-1 win on Sat, 5/9 vs Hou (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 3bb, 2k, 1hr, 87TP).

- Was his third straight quality start (fourth QS over his last 5 outings).
- Was his seventh start this season in which he allowed 2 runs or fewer.

**MAY 3 at PIT:** Did not factor in the decision in the 1-0 loss at Pit on Sun, 5/3 (7.0ip, 3h, 0r, 1bb, 7k, 94TP).

- Pitched a career-high 7.0 innings.
- Allowed just 4 of his 24 batters to reach.
- Was his third scoreless outing of the season and his second straight quality start (third QS over his last 4 outings).
- Retired 16 straight from the 1st inning to the 6th.

**APRIL 28 vs COL:** Earned the 7-2 win on Tue, 4/28 vs Col (6.0ip, 7h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 9k, 1hr, 97TP).

- His 1st-inning strikeout of TJ Ruffalo marked the 100th of his career...became the fourth-fastest Reds pitcher by innings (72.1ip) to reach the 100-strikeout mark since 1900 (Aroldis Chapman, Fernando Cruz, Alexis Díaz).
- Was his third quality start of the season, the fifth of his career.
- Produced a career-high 22 swings-and-misses.
- Matched his season high with 9 strikeouts.
- Left with a 4-2 lead.

**APRIL 22 at TB:** Earned the 12-6 win on Tue, 4/22 at TB (5.2ip, 4h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 8k, 1hr, 97TP).

- Marked his third Major League appearance in which he threw 97 or more pitches, his first this season.
- Threw 61 pitches through his first 3 innings and 36 through his final 2.2 innings.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 16 of his 23 batters.
- Allowed just 3 hard-hit balls.
- Held the Rays scoreless through his first 5 innings...allowed a leadoff single in the 6th (Junior Caminero) and a 2-run homer to his next batter (Jonathan Aranda)...go the next 2 batters out before turning it over to Sam Moll.

**APRIL 16 vs SF:** Did not factor in the decision in the 3-0 loss vs SF on Thu, 4/16 (6.0ip, 2h, 0r, 1bb, 4k, 87TP).

- The 6.0 scoreless innings marked the longest scoreless outing of his career.
- Was his second quality start of the season, the fourth of his career.
- Allowed just 3 base runners and no hard-hit balls.
- The Reds scored 6 total runs through his 4 starts and went 2-2 in those games.

**APRIL 10 vs LAA:** Suffered the 10-2 loss on Fri, 4/10 vs LAA (5.1ip, 7h, 5r/5er, 4bb, 2k, 2hr, 92TP).

- Allowed 21 batted balls in play, 9 hard-hit balls, 11 base runners, and 2 home runs - all career highs.
- Was ahead in the count to 13 of his 27 batters.
- For the third time in his 3 starts, the Reds plated just 2 runs.

**AS A STARTER:** His 105 strikeouts through his first 16 career starts rank third by any Reds pitcher in that span since 1900, behind only Gary Nolan (114k, 1967) and Nick Lodolo (113, 2022).

**2.11 ERA:** His 2.11 ERA (47ip, 11er) ranks fifth among all qualified NL pitchers.

**2 RUNS OR FEWER:** His 7 starts of 2 runs or fewer rank T3rd in the majors.

**WARMONGER:** His 2.1 bWAR ranks sixth among all Major League pitchers in 2026.

**SWING AND A MISS:** His 33.5% miss rate (miss# / swing#) is the fourth-highest among qualified Major League starters...has caused 118 swings-and-misses.

**THERE'S A FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING:** In the 2-0 win vs Pit on 3/30, RHP Chase Burns earned his first career win (5.0ip, 1h, 0r, 3bb, 7k, 78TP) and RHP Connor Phillips picked up his first career save (1.0ip, 0h, 2bb, 1k).  
• Burns and Phillips became the eighth pair of Reds teammates since saves became an official stat in 1969 to earn their first win and save, respectively, in the same game...the last duo to do it was RHP Julian Aguiar and RHP Casey Kelly on 8/24/24 at Pit.
