YESTERDAY'S GAMES: The Brewers split a pair of games with the White Sox as they won, 3-2, in Glendale and lost, 8-2, in Phoenix.....RHP Freddy Peralta started in Phoenix and tossed 3.0 scoreless innings (2h. 4k).....RHP Tobias Myers started in Glendale and tossed 3.0 perfect innings (3k).....2B Andruw Monasterio belted a 2-run HR (#1) and walked twice.

THE ROSTER: The team currently has 62 players in Major League camp: 30 pitchers, 7 catchers, 14 infielders and 11 outfielders.....there are 22 non-roster invitees in camp: 8 pitchers, 4 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 outfielders.

THE NEW BREW: LHP Tyler Alexander (free agent), RHP Grant Anderson (trade with TEX), LHP Nestor Cortes (trade with NYY), INF Caleb Durbin (trade with NYY), LHP José Quintana (free agent), RHP Elvin Rodríguez (free agent), LHP Connor Thomas (Rule 5 Draft from STL) and LHP Grant Wolfram (free agent).

GONE FROM 2024: SS Willy Adames (SF), RHP Kevin Herget (NYM), LHP Wade Miley (CIN), LHP Hoby Milner (TEX), RHP Frankie Montas (NYM), RHP Colin Rea (CHC), RHP Joe Ross (PHI), C Gary Sánchez (BAL), RHP Devin Williams (NYY), RHP Bryse Wilson (CWS) and LHP Rob Zastryzny (CHC).

2024 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 93-69 and finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs....the team tied the Padres for the fourth-best record in baseball, trailing only the Dodgers (98-64), Phillies (95-67) and Yankees (94-68).....the Brewers lost to the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 666 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022

### TONIGHT'S STARTER: #93 - RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI (\* relief)

RHP Jacob Misiorowski, 22, enters the 2025 season as the third-best prospect in the organization according to Baseball America.....Misiorowski went 3-5 with a 3.33 ERA and 1 save in 33 games (21 starts) last season between Double-A Biloxi (19gs) and Triple-A Nashville (33g, 21gs)....he held opponents to a .167 batting average with 127 strikeouts in 97.1 innings (11.74 K/9IP)....he was selected in the second round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from Crowder (MO) College.....name is pronounced "miz-uh-RŎW-skee."

### ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Trevor Megill, 31, went 1-3 with a 2.72 ERA and 21 saves in 48 relief appearances with Milwaukee last season..... he held opponents to a .200 batting average with 50 strikeouts in 46.1 innings.....his 21 saves led the team (9th in NL).

**LHP Grant Wolfram**, 28, signed as a free agent on Dec. 11.....selected by Texas in the 18th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft from Davenport (MI) University, he spent seven seasons in the Rangers farm system....he went 4-1 with a 3.13 ERA and 6 saves in 46 relief appearances at Double-A Frisco (2g) and Triple-A Round Rock (44g) in 2024.

**LHP Jared Koenig**, 31, went 9-4 with a 2.47 ERA and 1 save in 55 games [6 starts] with Milwaukee last season.....he held opponents to a .229 batting average with 63 strikeouts in 62.0 innings.

RHP Craig Yoho, 25, is a non-roster invitee.....Yoho was named 2024 Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 4-2 with a 0.94 ERA and 10 saves in 48 relief appearances at Class-A Wisconsin (16g), Double-A Biloxi (18g) and Triple-A Nashville (14g).....he was selected in the eighth round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana University.....he converted from an infielder at the University of Houston to a pitcher at Indiana in 2023.
