The Brewers enter today's game as one of two teams (Toronto) in the Major Leagues without a home run this season.....the team scored 9 runs yesterday in its victory over the Cubs, marking the first time since a 10-2 win last season on 6/15 at New York-NL that the Brewers scored as many as 9 runs without the benefit of a homer.. the Brewers recorded 3 sacrifice flies in yesterday's win, tying a franchise record, now done 25 times

Brice Turang reached base safely in 4 of his 5 plate appearances yesterday against the Cubs. going 2-for-3 with a pair of walks....he lined out to center in his final plate appearance in his bid to reach for a fifth time

Can't Hardly Wade

Wade Miley makes his season debut tomorrow night seeking the 100th win of his Major League career....he has gone 99-94 with a 4.13 ERA in 292 games/285 starts.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell - the longest-tenured active manager in the National League and third in the majors - is in his ninth season as Brewers manager (617-556) and eighth full season.....he has the most wins of any manager in franchise history.....his 1,173 games managed are second to Phil Garner (1,180).....Counsell was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....he is signed through the 2023 season.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (3rd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (2nd season), bullpen coach Jim Henderson (2nd season), pitching coach Chris Hook (5th season), third base coach Jason Lane (8th season, 3rd as 3B coach), associate pitching, catching and strategy coach Walker McKinven (4th season), bench coach Pat Murphy (8th season) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (2nd season) all returned from the 2022 staff.....Néstor Corredor, who had previously been bullpen catcher (2021-22), is now a coach.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 86-76 last season, missing the postseason for the first time since 2017.....the team was eliminated from NL Central contention on September 27 and eliminated from postseason contention on October 3, snapping their franchise-record four consecutive years of making the playoffs.....the team won at least 86 games for the fifth consecutive full season (since 2017), joining the Dodgers (since 2012), Astros (since 2017) and Yankees (since 2017) as the only teams to accomplish the feat during this stretch (does not include 2020).

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made one replay challenge this season, going O-1.....the challenge came on Opening Day at Chicago-NL as a safe call at first base (Dansby Swanson) on a pickoff attempt stood.

TODAY'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (18g, 17gs, 4-4, 3.58 in 2022)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 26, went 4-4 with a 3.58 ERA in 18 games/17 starts last season.....he held opponents to a .190 batting average with 86 strikeouts in 78.0 innings pitched.....the team went 8-9 in his starts.....he produced 4 quality starts.....he was on the injured list twice last season: 5/23-8/2 (right posterior shoulder strain) and 9/9-9/24 (right shoulder inflammation).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

BABY ON BOARD: Peralta is making his first start since he and his wife, Maritza, welcomed their second child into the world.....Freddy Jr. was born last Wednesday night in Milwaukee.....he weighed 9 lbs and 9 ounces.....the couple also has a daughter named Norah.

CAREER: Is 30-17 with a 3.82 ERA in 116 games/67 starts [415ip. 176er]....is in his sixth Major League season, all with the Brewers [2018-23]....is 22-15 with a 3.81 ERA as a starter (331ip, 140er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er)....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 18-10 with a 3.34 ERA in 62 games/34 starts (223.2ip, 83er).....went 3-4 with a 4.34 ERA in 11 games/10 starts last season (45.2ip, 22er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-7 with a 4.37 ERA in 54 games/33 starts (191.1ip, 93er).....went 1-0 with a 2.51 ERA in 7 starts last season (32.1ip, 9er).

CAREER vs. METS: His only outing against the Flusing, New York Metropolitans came in an 8-4 win on 9/26/21 at American Family Field (5.1ip, 5h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 1hbp).
