THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

AUG. 11

2025 - IF **Carlos Correa** plays his first game at Daikin Park after being re-acquired by the Astros from the Twins ahead of the 2025 trade deadline...Correa went 1x4 with an RBI, as the Astros defeated the Red Sox, 7-6...the night also marked the first time IF **Alex Bregman** played at Daikin Park as an opposing player and he went 2x4 with a homer and two RBI...lastly, **RHP Cristian Javier** (2ER/5IP) made his first start in his return from Tommy John surgery and earned the winning decision.

2023 - RHP **Justin Verlander** picks up the win in what is his 500th career start, defeating the Angels at Daikin Park, 11-3...Verlander tallies seven strikeouts with no walks in the win, which also was his first start at home after being re-acquired from the Mets at the 2023 trade deadline.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros continue their six-game road trip tonight and will hand the ball to **RHP Hunter Brown** (3-1) for game two of their three-game set at Oracle Park...the Giants will counter with **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** (2-3), who will be making his 6th start of the season.

THE TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 41-28 since May 22, which is the second-best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the AL in SLG (.414), and OPS (.735), while ranking second in home runs (162), OBP (.320) and hits (991)...in the Majors, the Astros rank third in homers, trailing only the Nationals (171) and Yankees (167).

DIESEL POWER: **RHP Hunter Brown** will make his 12th start of the season and his ninth since returning from a lengthy stint on the IL with a right shoulder strain...the 2025 All-Star has begun to round into form over his last three starts, including two quality starts, going 2-0 with a 2.41 ERA (5ER/18.2IP) with 20 strikeouts, a .169 opponent batting average (11x65) and a 0.80 WHIP...Brown is set to make his 1st appearance at Oracle Park and his 2nd appearance vs. the Giants (also, May 2, 2023, at Daikin Park).

AYA IN ACTION: The Astros Nike RBI Softball Team recorded a 2-1 win over Roberto Clemente Nike RBI Softball Team in day two of the 2026 Nike RBI Softball World Series in Vero Beach, FL...the team's next game will be at 8 a.m. CT tomorrow vs. the US Virgin Islands Nike RBI Team, with the winner advancing to the Nike RBI Softball World Series Championship...the Astros Nike RBI Softball Team, which has won five Nike RBI World Series Softball Championships, is making its 12th appearance in the Nike RBI Softball World Series.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros continue a six-game West Coast road-trip with the second game of a three-game series tonight at Oracle Park, the club's first trip to the venue since a three-game series from June 10-12, 2024...Houston has gone 24-15 (.615) on their last five road trips and are 30-21 (.588) on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the season...Houston is 31-30 overall on the road in 2026.

YESTERDAY'S GAME: Down to their final strike, the Astros rallied for a 6-3 win in 10 innings last night at Oracle Park...**RF Cam Smith**, who also hit a solo homer in the 7th inning, drove in the game-tying run with a two-out single in the 9th inning...**SS Jeremy Peña** (RBI single) and **3B Isaac Paredes** (two-run double) put the Astros out in front in extras and **LHP Josh Hader** tossed 2.0 perfect innings to finish out the win, marking his longest appearance of the season...**RHP Hayden Wesneski** got the start and matched his career high by tossing 7.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts...the Astros have won all three of Wesneski's starts this season.

ROSTER MOVES: **OF Nelson Velázquez** reported to the Major League team today (wearing No. 30)...to make room for Velázquez on the active roster, the Astros optioned **OF Jake Meyers** to Triple A Sugar Land following last night's game...Velázquez, 27, has played in 34 games for the Cardinals this season and 228 career games at the Major League level, also appearing with the Cubs (2022-23) and Royals (2023-24)... Velázquez owns a career .739 OPS vs. left-handed pitching in the Majors.

VS. THE GIANTS: The Astros have a long history with the Giants, having played them 742 times, their second-most against a single opponent, trailing only the Reds (860g)...this series marks the Astros' first trip to Oracle Park since June 10-12, 2024 (Giants went 2-1)...the Astros have a pair of players who spent portions of their Major League careers with the Giants in **LHP Steven Okert** (2016-18) and **OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (2021-25).

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** leads the AL in all three Triple Crown categories, ranking first in batting average (.323), HR (35), and RBI (86)...additionally, he leads MLB in OPS (1.059), OBP (.435), SLG (.624), and TB (269)...in the AL, he ranks first in hits (139), extra-base hits (60), and runs (80), and tied for second in walks (82)...AL leaders below:

HADERADE: **LHP Josh Hader** has been stellar since returning from injury in early June, going 4-1 with a 1.00 ERA (3ER/27IP), 38 strikeouts, a .110 opponent batting average (10x91) and a 0.74 WHIP, while also converting all 16 of his save opportunities...since being reinstated from the IL on June 3, he ranks second in opponent batting average (.110), third in SO/9 (12.67) and fifth in ERA among AL relievers (min. 25 IP).

CAM JAM: **RF Cam Smith** has homered three times and logged two three-hit games through his first three appearances of this current road trip, including his fourth career multi-homer game last Friday at SD...so far this road trip, Smith has batted .545 (6x11) with five runs, three homers, four RBI and a walk...he has also hit safely in eight of his last 10 games (since July 29 at LAA), batting .432 (16x37) with 10 runs, two doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI and a 1.246 OPS over that stretch.

THREES COMPANY: **2B Jose Altuve** enters tonight's game with 224 career games of 3+ hits, which is just one game of 3+ hits from tying Hall of Famer **Craig Biggio** (225) for the most in Astros franchise history...Altuve has multiple hits in six of his last 12 games (since July 28 at LAA), batting .319 (15x47) in that span.

BIG WES: **RHP Hayden Wesneski** parroted the first two successful outings of his season by matching his career high of 7.0 innings in last night's win, allowing three runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts...Wesneski has gone 2-0 with a 3.86 ERA (8ER/18.2IP) through his first three starts of the season after missing 14 months due to Tommy John surgery.

LAST START, AUGUST 5 vs. TOR: Allowed 3 runs on 3 hits and 2 walks with 8 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...marked his 5th quality start of the season...didn't factor into the decision as the Astros fell to the Blue Jays, 4-5 in 10 innings at Daikin Park.

THE DIESEL: The Astros 2026 Opening Day starter, Brown has been limited to just 11 Major League starts on the season due to a 2-plus month-long IL stint (April 5-June 16) due to a right shoulder strain...has gone 2-0 with a 2.41 ERA (5ER/18.2IP, 20 strikeouts, a .182 opponent batting average and a 0.80 WHIP over his last 3 starts after posting a 5.22 ERA (17ER/29.1IP) in his first 6 starts following his reinstatement from the IL.

VS. THE GIANTS: Has made 1 career start against the Giants in his career on May 2, 2023 at Daikin Park...in that start, he allowed 2 runs on 4 hits and 5 walks with 4 strikeouts in 4.1 innings...was handed the loss after the Astros lost to the Giants, 0-2.

WINDY CITY DELIGHT: Had his best start of the season on July 25 at CWS, tossing 7.0 scoreless innings with 7 strikeouts while allowing just 2 hits and no walks...marked his longest scoreless outing since he also tossed 7.0 scoreless innings on June 26, 2025 vs. PHI...was the 1st start of his career in which he tossed 7.0+ scoreless innings while allowing 2-or-fewer hits without issuing a walk...was the 1st such start by an Astro since **RHP José Urquidy** on Aug. 3, 2022 vs. BOS (7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 10 SO).

SAVANT SAYS: Among all Major League pitchers, he ranks in the 94th percentile in groundball percentage (55.1) 92nd percentile in xBA (.197) and 92nd percentile in average exit velocity (86.3).

FOUR SEAMS: Has held opponents to a .121 batting average (7x58) with his 4-seam fastball and has tossed the pitch at a 34.2-percent rate, the highest of all his pitches...ranks in the 86th percentile among all MLB pitchers in Fastball Run Value (9).

MINOR LEAGUE WORK: Made 4 rehab appearances this season on his way back from injury between Double A and Triple A...combined for a 1.88 ERA (3ER/14.1IP) with 21 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 0.77 WHIP and a .157 opponent average.

ALL-STAR SEASON: A 2025 All-Star, Brown finished third in the AL in Cy Young voting last season after turning in the best year of his career with a 12-9 record, a 2.43 ERA (50ER/185.1IP) and posting a 1.03 WHIP...in 2025, Brown held opponents to a career-low .201 average and posted 206 strikeouts in 185.1 innings pitched...his 2.43 ERA ranked 10th all-time among Astros starters and was the second-lowest by an Astros starter in the last 20 seasons (since 2005)...among AL starters, he ranked first in opponent SLG (.318) and second in ERA (2.43)...lastly, by reaching 206 strikeouts, he became the 18th pitcher in club history to reach 200 strikeouts in a season.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU: By finishing third in the AL Cy Young voting in 2025, the Astros were granted a compensation pick immediately after the first round of the 2026 draft (No. 28 overall)...the Astros earned the pick through the Prospect Promotion Incentive (PPI), which was ratified into the latest CBA...the PPI rewards teams for promoting their best prospects to the big leagues at the start of the season, having them accrue one full year of service time and then having them factor into a major award that season or prior to qualifying for arbitration...the Astros used that selection on **RHP Jack Radel** out of Notre Dame.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/7 at SD): Earned his 4th win of the season after he walked 1 and struck out 2 in 1.1 scoreless innings on Fri. night at SD...also stranded both of his inherited runners.

SCORELESS STREAK: Is on an active 11-game scoreless streak (11.0 IP), recording a 0.00 ERA (0ER/11IP) with 15 strikeouts, 4 walks, a 0.64 WHIP and a .083 opponent batting average...it is the second-longest streak by an Astros pitcher this season, behind only LHP Steven Okert 14-game scoreless streak from May 23-June 24.

MILESTONE MARKERS: On Wednesday vs. TOR, he struck out RF Nathan Lukes to begin his scoreless 8th inning, recording his 500th career strikeout...became just the 4th reliever in franchise history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining LHP Billy Wagner (694), RHP Brad Lidge (557) and RHP Dave Smith (529)...logged his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history

HEAT OF THE SUMMER: Over his last 17 appearances (since June 20), he's posted a 1.02 ERA (2ER/17.2IP) with 22 strikeouts, a .121 opponent batting average and a 0.74 WHIP...ranks 4th among AL relievers in opponent batting average in that span (min. 15 IP).

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 4-1-6 with a 1.93 ERA (7ER/32.2IP)...has also recorded 39 strikeouts, a 1.01 WHIP and a .165 opponent batting average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season.

AT DAIKIN: Has made 179 career appearances at Daikin Park tying him with RHP Ryan Pressly for the 3rd-most in the venue's history...his 264 strikeouts at Daikin Park trail only RHP Brad Lidge (287) for the most by a reliever in the venue's history...also has 192.2 IP in his career at Daikin Park, recently surpassing Octavio Dotel (190.1) for the 3rd-most innings pitched by a reliever in the venue's history.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/9 at SD): Surrendered 1 run on 2 hits through 2.0 innings with 1 strikeout and no walks Sunday night at SD.

FIRST SAVE: Recorded his 1st career save after working a perfect 1.1 innings with 1 strikeout on Aug. 2 vs. TEX...also stranded both of his inherited runners and his 18.2% inherited runners scored rate this season ranks 12th in the AL (min. 50 IP).

TWO FOR BLU: Ranks 1st in the Majors with 23 appearances of 2.0+ innings, with COL RHP Zach Agnos (19) the next closest...are the most by an Astro since RHP Octavio Dotel logged 24 appearances of 2.0+ innings in 2001.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Leads MLB relievers with 72.1 IP...also ranks 1st in MLB with 28 multi-inning apps and ranks T-4th among AL relievers with 74 strikeouts.

FOUR SEAMS: Opponents are batting .203 (27x133) vs. his 4-seam fastball this season, which he's thrown at a 50.9-percent rate...has averaged 95.7 mph with his 4-seam fastball, up from 94.6 mph from his 2025 rookie season.

REVERSE SPLIT: Has held left-handed hitters to a .188 average (26x138) with 40 strikeouts this season...is the 8th-lowest opponent average vs. left-handed hitters by a right-handed pitcher in the AL (min. 100 BF).
