THE TWINS: Finished their final homestand of 2025 with a record of 3-7, going 1-2 vs. Arizona, 1-2 vs. New York-AL and 1-3 vs. Cleveland...tonight, they will begin their final roadtrip of the season with six games, starting with three against the Rangers at Globe Life Field tonight through Thursday and followed by three against the Phillies at Citizens Bank Park this weekend.

TWINS GUARDED FROM THE SWEEP: The Twins beat the Guardians Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-2, avoiding the four-game sweep...Simeon Woods Richardson (7-4) started but did not factor into the game's decision, allowing two runs, both in the first inning, on three hits (1 HR), two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...Kody Funderburk (W, 1.0 IP), Pierson Ohl (1.0 IP), Cole Sands (1.0 IP) and Travis Adams (1.0 IP) combined for 4.0 one-hit innings of relief, with no walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits, two apiece from Kody Clemens, Brooks Lee and Jhonny Pereda...Lee hit his 16th home run of the year and, Royce Lewis hit his 13th and the first of his career as a pinch-hitter.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins yesterday returned catcher Christian Vázquez from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...additionally, they optioned postgame Sunday outfielder DaShawn Keirseý Jr. to Triple-A St. Paul.

✦ Vázquez, who missed the last 43 games with a left shoulder infection, played in four games with Triple-A St. Paul on rehab assignment, going 2-for-15 with one home run, four RBI, three walks and three runs scored.

✦ Keirseý Jr. appeared in one game during his most recent stint with the Twins, playing one inning in leftfield on Saturday in game two of the doubleheader vs. the Cleveland Guardians and grounding out in his only plate appearance.

LONE STAR STATS: Twins and Rangers are playing each other or the fourth, fifth and sixth times in 2025...these two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from June 10-12, as the Twins won game two...Twins and Rangers will first meet in 2026 for a four-day, three-game series at Globe Life Field from June 15-18.

✦ The Twins are 9-3 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023 and 3-0 in 2024...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 19-7 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 13-3 in their last 16.

✦ Trevor Larnach is hitting .290 (9-for-31) with two doubles, two home runs and a .920 OPS in 10 career games against Texas.

✦ Byron Buxton is hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, three walks, a stolen base and a 1.276 OPS in his last five games against Texas, including two three-hit performances earlier this season (3-for-4 on 6/10, 3-for-3 on 6/11).

✦ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 13-4 all-time in Arlington, going 4-0 at Globe Life Park and 9-4 at Globe Life Field...his .700 win percentage in this city is his best; Washington D.C. (2-1, .667) and Toronto (14-7, .667) are next.

HOT WHEELS: The Twins have stolen 22 bases in their last 14 games...in 33 games since August 17, they have stolen 47 bases in 54 attempts, the most stolen bases in any 33-game span in Twins history (1961-)...their 107 stolen bases so far this season are tied for the 14th-most in team history (also 1988, 1991) and the most since 2012, when they swiped 135 bags.

✦ The Twins have stolen 52 bases since August 1, the third-most in baseball behind New York-AL (57) and New York-NL (53).

THE LEFTORIUM: Notable individuals vs. lefties this season:

✦ Byron Buxton is hitting .307 (31-for-101) with nine home runs, a .673 slugging percentage and a 1.053 OPS against left-handed pitching on the season — his highest OPS vs. lefties in his career...Buck's .673 slugging percentage ranks third-best in baseball this season, trailing Aaron Judge (.744) and Cal Raleigh (.683).

✦ Austin Martin is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with a .908 OPS against lefties this season.

✦ Brooks Lee is hitting .296 (29-for-98) with two doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and an .809 OPS in his last 56 games against lefties.

✦ Royce Lewis is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with five RBI and an .844 OPS over his last 19 games against lefties.

AUSTIN POWER: Austin Martin went 1-for-4 on Sunday afternoon, recording his 100th career hit...he hit safely in nine of 10 games on the Twins' recent homestand, batting .300 (12-for-40) with four doubles, four RBI, five runs scored and four stolen bases in those 10.

✦ Over his last 24 games, Martin is hitting .338 (27-for-80) with seven doubles, four RBI, 14 runs scored, 13 walks, just 16 strikeouts, a .436 on-base percentage and an .861 OPS.

✦ Martin has posted a .405 on-base percentage in 19 games this month, seventh-best in the AL and 19th-best in baseball.

SHERRY ROBERTSON AND JIM RANTZ AWARD WINNERS: The Twins announced today that infielder Kaelen Culppepper has been named the 2025 Sherry Robertson Award winner as the Twins minor league Player of the Year and left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp has been named the 2025 Jim Rantz Award winner as the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year.

✦ Culppepper, 22, split the 2025 minor league season between High-A Cedar Rapids and Double-A Wichita, hitting a combined .289 (131-for-454) with 16 doubles, three triples, 20 home runs, 64 RBI, 50 walks, 25 stolen bases, 77 runs scored and an .844 OPS in 113 games during his second professional campaign...the 6-foot, 185-pound infielder was second among all Twins farmhands in hits and tied for third in runs scored, while ranking fourth in total bases (213), fifth in doubles and eighth in RBI...he was a two-time Twins minor league Player of the Week and represented the Twins at the 2025 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Truist Park in Atlanta...he is currently ranked as the No. 3 prospect in the Twins organization and the No. 72 overall prospect in baseball, per MLB.com.

✦ Prielipp, 24, went 1-9 with a 4.03 ERA (82.2 IP, 37 ER), 31 walks, 98 strikeouts and a 1.51 WHIP in 24 games (23 starts) between Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul in the 2025 minor league season, his first full professional campaign...the 6-foot-2, 210-pound southpaw ranked second among all Twins pitchers in starts and was tied for seventh in strikeouts, despite missing time on the 7-day Injured List from June 9-21 with a blister...he was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on May 11 after tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with just three hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts on May 8 for the Wind Surge...he is currently ranked as the No. 10 prospect in the Twins organization and fourth-best pitcher, per MLB.com.
