RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the second game of a three-game series with the division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates at Busch Stadium ... The Redbirds have gone 2-3 on their homestand vs. Colorado (2-2) and Pittsburgh (0-1) ... St. Louis went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position while stranding eight runners in its 2-1 defeat to the Pirates last night, alternating wins and losses for the season-high 7th straight game (L-W-L-W-L-W-L).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today a percentage point behind Chicago (32-35) and Cincinnati (32-35) in 5th place in the NL Central, 7.0 games behind Milwaukee, and are one of eight teams separated in the NL Wild Card standings by 1.5 games ... Since Mother's Day (May 12-present), the Cardinals sport MLB's 6th-best win pct. (.615, 16-10 record).

BURIED TREASURE: St. Louis has won the season series over Pittsburgh in 20 of the last 24 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013, 2023), and owns MLB's best overall win pct. vs. the Pirates (.569, 111-84) dating back to 2013 when the two teams squared off in the Division Series.

STORMIN' GORMAN: Nolan Gorman hit his team-leading 15th home of the season last night, tying Bryce Harper for 4th-most in the National League behind Marcell Ozuna (18) and the Dodgers duo of Teoscar Hernandez (17) and Shohei Ohtani (17).

- Last night David Bednar became the 51st different pitcher that Gorman has taken yard since his MLB debut on May 20, 2022 at Pittsburgh, surpassing Paul Goldschmidt (50) and Nolan Arenado (50) for most by a Cardinal over that timespan ... Since the beginning of 2023, Gorman has taken the most pitchers deep (39) among NL Central hitters (10th-most in the NL).

- Gorman's 15th homer this season matches Red Schoendienst (15 in 1953) for 7th-most among primary second baseman in franchise single season history (chart left).

- Gorman joins Rogers Hornsby (21 in 1925 & 17 in 1921) as the only Cards primary second basemen with 15+ HR in the teams first 65 games.

WINNING: Since May 10, rookie shortstop Masyn Winn is hitting .347 (33-95), 2nd-highest in MLB over that timespan to Aaron Judge (.414, 41-99) ... Overall this season, Winn's .305 (60-197) batting average leads Major League rookies, ranks 10th in Major League Baseball, and is 2nd to only Bobby Witt Jr. (.321) among primary shortstops.

- Since 2011, Winn (.300 in April & .309 in May) and 2017 American League Rookie of the Year Aaron Judge (.300 in April & .309 in May) are the only two Major League rookies with .300+ batting averages in both April and again in May (75+ PA each month) ... Winn is currently batting .297 (11-27) in June, while Judge batted .324 (33-102) in June 2017. - Olney/Elias

CLOSE CALLS: Forty-six of the Cardinals 65 games (70.8%) have been decided by three runs or fewer, 3rd-most in MLB behind the Mets (47) and Cubs (47) this season ... St. Louis is 9-9 in one-run games, 7-8 in two-run games, and 8-5 in three-run games.

- The Cardinals sport MLB's 2nd-lowest average margin of victory (2.55) ahead of only Tampa Bay (2.34).
- St. Louis 18-1 this season when the trio of JoJo Romero, Andrew Kittredge, and Ryan Helsley all pitch in the same game (lost May 4 vs. the Chicago White Sox) ... Helsley paces MLB in saves (21), while Romero shares the MLB lead in holds (19).

SAC SIANI: Michael Siani leads Major League Baseball in sacrifice bunts (8), most by Cardinals position player since Jon Jay (9 in 2013) and tied for 11th-most since 2000 ... Cardinals Bench Coach Daniel Descalso recorded 10 sacrifices in 2011.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (June 12, 1957): Stan Musial plays his 823rd consecutive game, breaking Gus Suhr's National League record ... The longest Iron Man streak in the Busch Stadium III era (2006-24) is held by Albert Pujols, who appeared in 167 consecutive games from July 27, 2006-August 03, 2007.

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Michael Siani's younger brother, **Sammy Siani**, was selected by Pittsburgh with the 37th overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft and is an outfielder for Altoona (AA) in the Pirates organization.

Nolan Arenado (2009) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (SS).

Marco Gonzales pitched parts of three seasons in St. Louis (2014-15, '17)...was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#19) of 2013 MLB Draft...2014 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year...traded to Seattle for **Tyler O'Neill** (July 21, 2017).

Willson Contreras (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Sonny Gray** (July 10, 2013 at PNC Park), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Drew Rom** (Aug. 21, 2023 at PNC Park) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

David Bednar was teammates of **Adam Wainwright**, **Miles Mikolas**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, and **Nolan Arenado** on Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale, Ill... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58).

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22)...traded to Pittsburgh with **Malcom Nunez** for **José Quintana** and **Chris Stratton** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956... played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

TONIGHT'S GAME

NL Ranks: Wins (7, T-6th), Decisions (11, T-1st), SO/9 IP (11.97, 1st), SO/BF (.328, 2nd), SO/BB (4.32, 8th).

- Makes his 12th start of the season tonight, 10th start (11th app.) against the Pirates and his first as a member of the Cardinals.
- Is 4-2 overall this season at home. Has a 1.60 Home ERA and .161 Opp. BA with just one HR allowed this year.
- His 1.60 Home ERA ranks 4th among N.L. pitchers (min. 5 starts) & .161 Opp. BA ranks 2nd.
- Only **Jaime Garica** (0.46 in 2011) had a lower Home ERA over his 1st five home starts to begin a season at Busch Stadium III than Gray (0.93). Garcia had 0.81 ERA thru his 1st six home starts
- Opened the season on the Injured List and made his first start on April 9 at Philadelphia, 12 games into the season. Since April 9, ranks among National League leaders in starts (11, T-1st), wins (7, T-2nd) and strikeouts (82, 2nd).
- Has allowed six home runs this season in 61.2 innings pitched after an MLB-low eight homers allowed over 184.0 innings pitched (among 2023 qualifiers).
- Has 61.4 K% on Sweeper pitch, fanning 43 in 70 plate appearances, ranking 1st in MLB.
- Leads the Cardinals and ranks T-4th in the National League with seven wins. Has recorded decisions in all 10 starts, with two of his losses coming against Milwaukee.
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); Has 16 career double-digit strikeout games, two this year.
- Ranks 13th among active pitchers with 105 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (138, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (108, T-10th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn** & **Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

- His teams won five straight games against the Pirates from May 27, 2019-Aug. 5, 2021 (4-0, 3.58 ERA, 27.2 IP, 32 K), 10

- His 3.44 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,598 strikeouts rank 16th.
- Has made 11 career starts at Busch Stadium, with six of those being Quality Starts. He is 5-4, 2.24 ERA career at Busch (64.1 IP/16 ER).

- Has struck out 77 batters over his first 10 starts for the Cardinals, most in franchise history through first 10 starts as a Cardinal, and his 7 wins are T-3rd (also Lance Lynn) for most in first 10 starts with the club.
- Surpassed 1,600 career innings vs. CWS (5/3), firing 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in a 3-0 win, his 7th career win vs. the Pale Hose, the opponent he has his 3rd-most wins against.
