**FIREWORKS & POSTGAME CONCERT:** Tonight, the D-backs feature their first Postgame Fireworks show of the season, presented by Budweiser...tomorrow, fans can enjoy a free (with a game ticket) postgame concert from The All-American Rejects...fans can upgrade to a field pass for on-field access at dbacks.com/aar.

**\$100 MILLION IN GIVING:** The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** In the last 7 meetings between the D-backs (38 R, 57 H, 30 XBH, 13 HR) and Braves (51 R, 69 H, 30 XBH, 11 HR), the teams have combined for a total of 89 runs (12.7 AVG R/G), 126 hits (18 AVG H/G), 60 extra-base hits (8.6 AVG XBH/G) and 24 homers (3.4 AVG HR/G).

- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 22 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout since March 27 @ Dodgers (third inning) is the Majors' longest active streak.
  - Last season, he rode a streak of 43 plate appearances without a strikeout from April 3 (fifth inning)-April 14, 2025, the longest by a D-back since Ender Inciarte (44 PA from Aug. 31-Sept. 11, 2015).
- **Corbin Carroll** has an extra base hit in 3 of his last 4 games and RBI in 4 of his last 5 games, hitting .375 (6-for-16)/1.387 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez**, in his last 3 starts vs. NL East opponents, is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (4 ER in 16.2 IP), opponent .227 AVG, 10 walks and 21 strikeouts.
  - Tossed 5.0 scoreless frames in his first start on March 28 @ Dodgers (ND; 0 ER in 5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 BB, 5 K).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 17-2 vs. Braves last night.

- **Jordan Lawlar** hit his first career home run in the third inning after 125 homerless plate appearances to start his career.
- **Jose Fernandez**, who replaced Perdomo at shortstop in the sixth, became the first D-back ever to play 3 different infield positions (1B, SS, 3B) within their first 3 career games and second D-back all-time to play 3 different positions overall (also: Daulton Varsho in 2020 - C/CF, LF) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
  - The last MLB player to play 3 different infield positions within their first 3 career games was Maximo Acosta/MIA in 2025 (2B, SS, 3B) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].
- **Geraldo Perdomo** went 1-for-1 with 1 double and 1 walk.
- **Nolan Arenado** went 1-for-2 and has hit safely in 3 straight games.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** went 2-for-2 with 1 double and 1 RBI...has hit safely in each of his 3 games (5 H in 9 PA, 1 2B, 1 HR, 2 RBI).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs reinstated C **Adrian Del Castillo** from the 10-day injured list (strained left calf) and optioned to Triple-A Reno following their game yesterday; recalled from Reno today, selected RHP **Taylor Rashi**, placed INF/OF **Jordan Lawlar** on the 10-day injured list (fractured right wrist) and designated RHP **Joe Ross** for assignment.

**DEFENSIVELY:** The D-backs 11 defensive runs saved (DRS) rank atop the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (10), Braves (8), Mariners (7) and Giants (7), while **Keitel Marte's** 3 DRS rank tied for the most among players with Cole Young /SEA.

- Their 3 DRS at second base rank tied for the most with the Mariners, 2 DRS at third base also rank tied for the most with the Red Sox and Astros and 2 DRS in LF rank tied for the most with the Rays and Mariners.

**TRENDING: Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 home games since Sept. 15, 2025, with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI and 8 walks.

- On Wednesday, he ended his on-base streak at 22 games...dated back to Sept. 9, 2025 and was the Majors' second longest active on-base streak...marked his longest on-base streak of his career (combined seasons).
- Has reached base in 23 of his last 24 games with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 11 RBI and 14 walks (12 K).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 29 home games since Aug. 6, 2025, batting .330 (35-for-106)/1.113 OPS with 9 doubles, 4 triples, 7 homers, 24 RBI, 18 walks and 12 stolen bases.
- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 home games since Sep. 19, 2025, batting .300 (12-for-40)/.839 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer and 5 RBI.

**VS. BRAVES:** The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 games (1 @ home, 3 on road).

- Among active NL players vs. Braves since 2024, **Keitel Marte** ranks in homers (T-2nd, 6), SLG (5th, .750) and OPS (8th, 1.150).
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely 2+ times in 4 of his last 5 games, hitting .333 (6-for-18)/1.399 OPS with 1 double, 2 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI and 3 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 5 straight games with 1 double, 4 RBI and 1 walk.

## NEXT STARTER: RHP MICHAEL SOROKA (1-0, 0.00)

- Earned the win in his D-backs debut on March 30 vs. Tigers after recording a career-high-tying 10 strikeouts over 5.0 scoreless innings, which included an immaculate fifth inning.
- His 10 strikeouts vs. Tigers surpassed Randy Johnson's 9 on April 5, 1999 @ Dodgers for the most by a pitcher in a D-backs debut.
- Fourth D-back all-time with an immaculate inning (second occurrence @ Chase Field), joining Randy Johnson (Aug. 23, 2001 @ Pirates, sixth inning), Byung-Hyun Kim (May 11, 2002 @ Phillies, eighth inning) and Wade Miley (Oct. 1, 2012 vs. Rockies, third inning).
- Pitched 4 seasons with the Braves from 2018-23, going 17-8 with a 3.32 ERA (91 ER in 246.1 IP), 67 walks and 200 strikeouts.
- Made his lone start on May 13, 2025 @ Braves while with the Nationals (ND; 2 ER in 4.0 IP, 4 H, 1 BB, 4 K).

- In 2025, hit .237 (95-for-401) with 18 doubles, 1 triple, 12 homers, 52 RBI and 28 walks in 107 games with the Cardinals.
- Has won a MLB-record 6 Platinum Glove Awards.
- Is 1 of 3 players in MLB history with 5+ Silver Sluggers and 10+ Gold Gloves with Iván Rodríguez and Ken Griffey Jr.

- In 93 games last season with Triple-A Reno, hit .294 (116-for-394)/.810 OPS with 29 doubles, 2 triples, 7 homers and 58 RBI.
