BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a six-game road trip tonight at Tropicana Field, having dropped two of three to the Nationals... Tonight marks the O's first game at Tropicana Field since August 11, 2024... Baltimore and Tampa Bay will meet six times in the next 10 days, with the Rays coming to Camden Yards from May 25-27.

⚾ Yesterday, Baltimore hit a season-high three home runs on the road, its most since hitting four at Petco Park against San Diego on September 3, 2025... The Birds have hit multiple home runs on the road in back-to-back games for the second time this season (also 4/21-22) and look to do so in three straight for the first time since a three-game run from June 5-7, 2025.

⚾ **Colton Cowser** recorded his first long ball of the season, snapping a career-long streak of 38 consecutive games without a home run (w/1+ PA)... The homer was hit at 113.3 mph, marking his hardest-hit ball of the season.

⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** tallied a season-high four hits, going 4-for-5 with a double, home run, and steal... He became the first Oriole with 4+ hits and 1+ steal in the same game since **Jordan Westburg** on May 11, 2024 vs. Arizona (4-for-5, 2B, 2 RBI, SB).

LOUD CONTACT: Despite falling in two of three games to the Nationals this past weekend, the Birds had 32 batted balls hit at least 100.0 mph... From Friday through Sunday, no club in the majors had more such batted balls, with the next closest club being the Nationals (27).

⚾ **Gunnar Henderson** led the team with seven batted balls hit 100.0+ mph, followed by **Jeremiah Jackson** (6) and **Pete Alonso/Coby Mayo** (both 4).

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .389/.421/.639 (14-for-36) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, eight runs, and seven RBI during his career-best 10 game hitting streak... The 10-game stretch is the longest by an Oriole this season and is tied with CIN's **Elly De La Cruz** for the longest active streak in the majors.

⚾ He has scored a run in a career-best five straight games, tied with five others for the second-longest active run in MLB behind CWS' **Miguel Vargas** (6 G).

⚾ In 21 games since April 20, Basallo is 28-for-73 (.384) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 runs, and 13 RBI.

SOUTHPAW STORY: The Orioles are 3-9 (.250) against left-handed starters, tied with the Mets (also 3-9) for the second-lowest winning percentage in MLB ahead of the Royals (2-10, .167).

⚾ **Samuel Basallo** is 7-for-14 (.500) off southpaws since April 24 after opening the season 1-for-12.

⚾ In four games since May 13, Baltimore is slashing .319/.365/.426 (15-for-47) with two doubles and one home run off left-handed pitching... In their previous eight games off southpaws from May 4-12, the Birds slashed .160/.259/.320 (12-for-75) with one double, one triple, and three home runs.

⚾ The Orioles faced a right-handed starter in a franchise-record 17 straight games to open the season, surpassing the previous record of 14 in 1975.

GUNNAR AND THE RAYS: In 39 career games against Tampa Bay, **Gunnar Henderson** is slashing .333/.385/.608 (51-for-153) with seven doubles, four triples, nine home runs, 28 runs, 22 RBI, 13 walks, and six steals.

⚾ His .992 career OPS opposite Tampa Bay is third highest among all active players (min. 150 PA), trailing LAA's **Mike Trout** (1.099) and PIT's **Marcell Ozuna** (1.012).

⚾ He has reached base safely in 12 of 13 career games at Tropicana Field, including hits in 11 of the games, batting .357 (20-for-56) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, and seven RBI.

⚾ He has three hits in back-to-back games at Tropicana Field (8/10-11/24), one of five Orioles in team history to accomplish the feat, joining **Adley Rutschman** (6/9-8/10/24), **Miguel Tejada** (7/21-22/06), **B.J. Surhoff** (8/31-9/1/04), and **Jeff Conine** (8/23/01-4/19/02)... Tonight, he looks to become the first to ever do so in three straight.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20.0 IP) with two hits, seven walks, and 24 strikeouts across 21 appearances to begin the season.

⚾ Garcia has faced 32 right-handed hitters, holding them hitless (0-for-29) with three walks... According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the 32 right-handed batters faced without a hit allowed is the longest season-opening streak in franchise history (since 1954), surpassing **Eddie Watt** (29 BF) in 1967.

⚾ Overall, his .033 (2-for-61) opponent average and 0.45 WHIP are the best among MLB relievers.

⚾ Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 21 outings of a season was eight, shared by **Andrew Miller** (2014), **Brian Matusz** (2013), **Armando Benítez** (1998), and **Jesse Orosco** (1997)... **Yennier Cano**, however, has surpassed each of them, having allowed only seven hits across his 21 outings in 2026.

⚾ Garcia's 40.6 percent whiff rate is second highest in the majors (min. 20.0 IP) behind SD's **Mason Miller** (57.3%).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (T-1st, 44), times on base (T-2nd, 88), doubles (T-2nd, 14), and on-base percentage (3rd, .419).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ His 88 times on base are the third most in a players' first 46 games to begin his time with the Orioles, trailing **Roberto Alomar** (101 in 1996) and **Frank Robinson** (92 in 1966).

⚾ Ward has seen 950 total pitches this season, most in the majors ahead of WSH's **James Wood** (924) and ATH's **Nick Kurtz** (900)... An MLB-best 358 of those pitches have come in a 3-2 count.

'PEN PALS: Baltimore has a 17.2 percent inherited runners scored rate (10 IRS/58 IR), second best in the majors behind Seattle (14.6%; 7 IRS/48 IR)... The Orioles posted a 27.6 percent rate last season, ranking eighth in MLB.

⚾ **Rico Garcia** has stranded all 12 of his runners, the best mark in MLB ahead of LAA's **Sam Bachman** and TOR's **Louis Varland** (both 7.1%, 1-for-14).

⚾ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland... It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season and 110th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth consecutive loss on May 12 vs. New York-AL after allowing six runs on six hits (2 HR) and three walks with three strikeouts across 4.0 innings...Threw 73 pitches, 46 strikeouts.

⚡ Permitted a leadoff home run to Paul Goldschmidt and allowed a three-run homer to Trent Grisham with two outs in the third frame.

⚡ Prior to the Grisham long ball, Rogers had gone 42 consecutive starts without allowing a home run to a left-handed batter, with JJ Bleday last taking him deep on May 4, 2024 at Oakland...Of the 53 career home runs Rogers has allowed, only four have been hit by lefties (CJ Abrams, 4/29/24 & Pavin Smith, 5/3/22).

TROP TALK: Rogers has made four career starts opposite the Rays, going 1-0 with a 3.98 ERA (9 ER/20.1 IP)...In two starts last season at Steinbrenner Field, he went 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER/8.1 IP).

⚡ His lone career start at Tropicana Field came as a Marlin on September 6, 2020... He did not factor into the decision after throwing 6.0 innings of three-run ball, allowing four hits (3 HR) and one walk with 10 strikeouts.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .404/.456/.538 (21-for-52) with four doubles, one home run, and 13 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

⚡ His .995 opponent OPS with two outs is sixth highest in MLB (min. 50 BF) ahead of AZ's Merrill Kelly (1.099), TB's Jesse Scholtens (1.074), CIN's Brady Singer (1.066), SEA's Luis Castillo (1.029), and WSH's Zack Littell (1.019).

UNDER THE HOOD: Rogers' hard-hit rate is down 14.8 percent from 2025, going from 48.4 percent to 33.6...The 14.8 percent decrease is the largest year-over-year decrease among all qualified MLB starters, and seventh overall behind SD's Mason Miller (-23.8%), TB's Bryan Baker (-19.1%), LAD's Tanner Scott (-15.6%), PHI's Orion Kerkering (-15.1%), BOS' Brennan Bernardino (-15.0%), and MIN's Taylor Rogers (-14.9%).

⚡ Opponents are 16-for-54 (.296) with four doubles and three home runs off his four-seamer after going 22-for-139 (.158) with two doubles, one triple, and three homers off the offering in 2025.

BEST OF THE BEST: Since making his 2025 season debut on May 24 (G2) at Boston, Rogers' 2.75 ERA (44 ER/144.0 IP) is fourth lowest in MLB (min. 140.0 IP), trailing PIT's Paul Skenes (2.02), DET's Tarik Skubal (2.11), and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (2.16).

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on May 13 vs. New York-AL after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering one hit and three walks with seven strikeouts...Marked his third career start working 6.0+ innings and allowing one or zero hits, joining June 8, 2024 at Tampa Bay (6.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K) and May 26, 2024 at Chicago-AL (7.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 11 K).

vs. TAMPA BAY: Is scheduled to make his eighth career start against the Rays, having gone 2-3 with a 5.94 ERA (24 ER/36.1 IP)...In his three starts at Tropicana Field, Bradish is 2-1 with a 2.12 ERA (4 ER/17.0 IP) and 22 strikeouts against three walks.
