SEPT. 10
2005 - In a 7-5 win at Miller Park in Milwaukee, Craig Biggio hits his 600th career double, becoming just the 13th player in MLB history to reach that milestone.
1980 - Jose Cruz is the hero with a 12-inning walkoff solo HR off Rick Sutcliffe to defeat the Dodgers in the Dome, 6-5.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Phillies will play the rubber match of this series this afternoon at Citizens Bank Park...**RHP Cristian Javier** will start for the Astros vs. Phils **RHP Zack Wheeler** (12-5).

REMATCH: **RHP Cristian Javier** faced off against **RHP Zack Wheeler** in his only career regular season start/app. vs. PHI, which came on April 29, 2023 in Houston...he took the loss in a 6-1 Astros defeat.

ASTROS-PHILS: The Astros have won 5 of their last 6 games vs. the Phillies...in those 6 games, Astros starters have combined for a 1.67 ERA (7ER/37.2IP)...3 of those 5 wins came via a shut-out...HOU swept a 3-game series vs. PHI at Daikin Park in the last meeting between the 2 clubs, June 24-26 of 2025...in those 3 games, Astros pitchers allowed just 1 run in 27.0 IP...**Last Visit to CPB:** The Phils took 2 of 3 from HOU in the last series here in Philly, Aug. 26-28 of 2024...in the final game of that series, **Yordan Alvarez** went 4x4 with 3 HR in a 10-0 Astros win...**Postseason History:** The Astros and Phils have met twice in the postseason, with PHI taking the 1980 NLCS and the Astros winning the 2022 World Series.

MR. CRISTIAN: **RHP Cristian Javier** is making his 10th start and 15th appearance of the season this afternoon...he pitched well in his last start on Sept. 4 vs. ARI, allowing just 1 run and 1 hit in 5.0 IP with 8 strikeouts in a 3-1 Astros win...**Racking Up The K's:** In his last 4 starts, Javier has tallied 25 strikeouts in 17.1 innings of work...**Made History:** In his last start at Citizens Bank Park, Javier was a part of just the 2nd no-hitter in World Series history, hurling 6.0 no-hit innings in the Astros 5-0 win in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series (11/2/22)...Javier tallied 9 K's in that outing...6 current members of the Phillies started in that no-hitter...the night before the no-hitter, Phillies hitters combined for 5 HR in a 7-0 win in Game 3 of that WS.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros were topped by the Phillies in a slugfest last night, 11-7...the 2 clubs combined for 18 runs on 24 hits, including 4 HR...**RHP Hunter Brown** had ND as the Astros starter (5 IP, 4 ER)...**Isaac Paredes** had a big night, going 2x4 with a HR and 3 RBI...**Cam Smith** homered for the 2nd cons. night.

ROAD WARRIORS: Today is the 3rd game (1-1 thus far) of a 6-game road trip for the Astros...after today's game, they will fly to Florida for a 3-game set over the weekend vs. TB at Tropicana Field...since going 1-9 on the first road trip of the 2026 season, **the Astros have gone 36-25 (.590) on the road since April 14**, which ranks third in the Majors in that span...more recently, they are 20-13 (.606) on their last 6 road trips combined (includes current trip).

LEAD PROTECTORS: Monday night's win improved the Astros record to 64-0 when leading after 8.0 innings...they are 1 of 4 clubs that have not lost a game when leading after 8.0 innings...the others are TB (77-0), ARI (66-0), TEX (62-0).

BIG WES: With Tuesday night's win, **RHP Hayden Wesneski** is now 3-0 in his last 4 starts with a 1.57 ERA (4ER/23IP)...for the season, he is 5-1 with a 3.35 ERA in 8 starts (Astros are 7-1 in his starts).

THE HIT MAN: **Jose Altuve** collected his 2,500th career hit last night, becoming the 103rd player in ML history to reach this milestone...**Freddie Freeman** was the last player to reach 2,500 hits, which took place on June 9 of this year at PNC Park vs. PIT...Freeman (2,587) and Altuve (2,500) are the 2 active hits leaders in the Majors...Altuve ranks 2nd in franchise history in hits to **Craig Biggio** (3,060)...**Another Record:** Altuve's 3-hit game on Sunday vs. ARI was the 225th of his career, which ties Biggio for the most in franchise history.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the AL in SLG (.410), rank 2nd in HR (192), T-3rd in OPS (.725) and 5th in runs scored (660).

SLOW AND STEADY RECOVERY: Since starting the season with a 20-31 record after 51 games, the Astros are 54-41 (.568) in their last 95 games (since May 22)...that is the second-best record in the AL in that span, behind only the Red Sox.

WINNING THE WEST: The Astros currently hold a 2.0-game lead in the AL West over the 2nd-place Rangers...HOU finished at 9-4 vs. TEX, so they hold the tiebreaker vs. them.

STARTING STRONG: In the last 9 games, Astros starters have combined for a 2.94 ERA (16ER/49IP) ...the Astros are 5-4 in that span...additionally, the Astros are 9-6 in their last 15 games, during which the starters have posted a combined 3.30 ERA (28ER/76.1IP).

TRIPLE THREAT: **Yordan Alvarez**, who is a solid candidate for the AL MVP Award, currently ranks 1st or 2nd in the AL in all three **Triple Crown** categories...he enters today leading the AL in batting avg. (.312), while ranking 2nd in HR (38) and RBI (96)...Alvarez also leads the Majors in OPS (1.022) and leads the AL in SLG (.593) and OBP (.428)...**Rare Feat:** Since **Carl Yastrzemski** won the AL Triple Crown in 1967, there has been just one Triple Crown winner in the Majors, **Miguel Cabrera** in 2012 (AL).

CHALLENGING STRETCH: The Astros are 5-4 thus far while in the midst of a stretch of playing 4 cons. teams (CWS, ARI, PHI, TB) with winning records, 2 of which are leading their respective divisions (CWS, TB), one that would qualify for the playoffs as a WC (PHI) and another that is 0.5 game out of a WC spot (ARI)...in this stretch, HOU has gone 3-1 vs. CWS, 1-2 vs. ARI and 1-1 at PHI.

MEASURING UP: The Astros are 28-20 (.583) vs. teams currently at .500 or above...they own a winning record vs. several clubs that are in the AL postseason hunt: 5-1 vs. BOS, 5-2 vs. CWS, 4-2 vs. CLE, 2-1 vs. TB, 9-4 vs. TEX.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Single A Fayetteville is scheduled to play tonight at Fredericksburg in Game 2 of their Carolina League playoff series...they lead the series, 1-0.

LAST START, SEPT. 4 vs. ARI: Had a great start his last time out on Friday night vs. the D-backs, earning his 2nd win of the season...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing just 1 run on 1 hit and 3 walks on the night...tied his season high with 8 strikeouts...tossed just 79 pitches in the outing...the Astros won that game 3-1.

EL REPTIL: The Dominican hurler, who's in his 7th MLB season with the Astros, is making his 100th career start tonight (139th appearance)...the 2026 season is his first full season since missing parts of the 2024-25 seasons after undergoing Tommy John surgery...has pitched as both a starter (9g) and reliever (5g) this year, while pitching around a midseason, 3-month IL stint.

SINCE HIS RETURN: Is making his 8th start since being reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3...has posted a 4.46 ERA (20ER/40.1IP) with 46 strikeouts (13 walks) in his 11 total appearances since returning from the IL.

AS A STARTER: Began the season as the Astros' No. 3 starter and made 3 turns in the rotation before being placed on the IL with his right shoulder strain...has worked predominantly as a starter since the 2022 season, making 80 of his 90 total appearances in that span as a starter...has gone 35-25 with a 3.98 ERA (223ER/504.1IP), a .212 opponent batting average, and a 1.19 WHIP in his 99 career regular-season starts.

KEEP IT 100!: Will become the 34th pitcher in franchise history to make 100 career starts with the club...will be come just the 11th pitcher to do so for the franchise since 2000, the first year of Daikin Park.

A CUT ABOVE: Has begun to mix a cutter into his repertoire, tossing it at a single-game career-high 17.4-percent rate in his start on Aug. 9 at SD...had not thrown a tracked cutter in his MLB career prior to his appearance on July 27 at LAA...has held opponents to a .200 batting average (3x15) with his cutter this season.

VS. PHI: Will be back on the Citizens Bank Park mound tonight for the first time since Game 4 of the 2022 World Series...famously pitched the first 6.0 innings of the Astros combined no-hitter that night, fanning 9 hitters with 2 walks...the Astros won that game 5-0 to even the series at 2 games apiece...faced the Phillies once since this date, on April 29, 2023 in Houston (3ER/5.2IP).

IN RELIEF: Has posted a 2.70 ERA (4ER/13IP) with 17 strikeouts, a 1.20 WHIP and a .245 opponent batting average through 5 relief appearances this season...his relief appearance on July 4 vs. TB was his 1st regular-season relief outing since Aug. 26, 2022 vs. BAL.

WELCOME BACK: Was reinstated from the 60-day IL on July 3 after missing 76 games (April 9-July 1) due to a right shoulder strain...has battled a multitude of injuries the past few seasons, also missing most of the 2024 and '25 seasons due to Tommy John surgery (underwent the procedure in June 2024)...returned from Tommy John surgery on Aug. 11, 2025, going 2-4 with a 4.62 ERA (19ER/37IP) in eight starts to close out the season.

ABREU OF LATE: Has recorded 7 consecutive scoreless outings (7.1 IP since Aug. 28 at NYM), which is the longest active streak of scoreless apps. among Astros pitchers...has also been scoreless in 11 of his last 12 apps. (since Aug. 16 vs. SEA), posting a 0.69 ERA (1ER/13IP) with 15 strikeouts, a 1.15 WHIP and a .163 opponent batting average in that span.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 5-1-7 with a 1.89 ERA (10ER/47.2IP)...also has recorded 56 strikeouts, a 1.09 WHIP and a .169 opponent average during the stretch...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season...among AL relievers since May 3, he ranks 4th in opponent batting average, 7th in ERA and 9th in SO/9 (10.57).

VS.
