BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude their penultimate homestand of the season today (1-2 vs. BAL, 1-1 vs. PIT) with the series rubber game in this three-game divisional series against the Pittsburgh Pirates...the Cardinals fell to 2-3 on the current homestand with a 6-2 loss yesterday after posting a 4-1 win on Friday...following today's game with the Pirates, and an off-day tomorrow, the Cardinals will begin a three-city trip (at LAD-3, at COL-3, at SF-3) on Tuesday night at Chavez Ravine against the defending World Series Champion Los Angeles Dodgers...including today's game, the Cardinals have 25 regular season games remaining with 10 at home & 15 on the road.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 17.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee; 2.0 games ahead of 4th place Pittsburgh and 4.5 games out of the final National League Wild Card position...the Cardinals are 3-7 in their last 10 games, 10-10 in last 20 and 15-15 in last 30...they are 35-38 vs. teams that are currently .500 or better and 33-31 vs. the sub .500 teams.

WETHERHOLT ON INJURED LIST/PRIETO RECALLED: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals placed rookie INF **JJ Wetherholt** (right wrist tendinitis) on the 10-Day Injured List and recalled INF **César Prieto** from Memphis...Prieto (#31) will be making his 3rd stint with St. Louis this season, having appeared in 9 games...Wetherholt has appeared in 130 games in his rookie campaign, batting .242 with 17 HR, 48 RBI & 14 SB's while playing Gold Glove caliber defense at 2nd base.

(INJURY) BUG BITES: Since August 18, the Cardinals have placed seven players on the Injured List with RHP **Andre Pallante** (right elbow), RHP **Hunter Dobbins** (right forearm), SS **Masyn Winn** (left thumb), OF **Everson Pereira** (left hand), RHP **Peter Strzelecki** (right forearm), INF **Blaze Jordan** (left ankle) and INF **JJ Wetherholt** (right wrist) all currently out with injuries.

REDBIRD ROOKIES: Not including pitchers or the designated hitter, the Cardinals position player rookies have totaled a combined 360 games started this season...Cardinals rookies combined for 161 starts all of last season and in 1906 had 657 rookie starts, a team high dating to 1900...**JJ Wetherholt's** 115 starts at 2nd base are the most among Cardinals rookies at 2B since 1960 when Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** started 119 and **Blaze Jordan's** 44 starts at the Hot Corner are the most by a Cardinals rookie since **Daniel Descalso** (61) in 2011...Cardinals rookie pitchers have appeared in 40 games, led by **Luis Gastelum's** 21 relief outings...**Quinn Mathews** is the only rookie pitcher to start this season, doing so four times.

POWER PLAY: The Cardinals homered for a 12th consecutive game yesterday, their longest long ball streak since a 13-gamer in 2022...the Cardinals 143 HR's this season are just six shy of their 148 round-trippers in 2025...Cardinals rookies have belted 44 HR's this season, 2nd only to the Chicago White Sox (60) among all MLB teams, and just three back of their franchise record 47 rookie HR's in 2017 when they were led by **Paul DeJong's** 25 rookie season homers.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY HUNTER & WAINO: Cardinals pitcher **Hunter Dobbins** is celebrating his 27th birthday today, while Cardinals great **Adam Wainwright** turns 45 today.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Justin Bruihl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Asst. to President of Baseball Ops. **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made MLB debuts vs. Pittsburgh.

Caleb Ferguson pitched in 45 games for the Pirates in 2025 before traded to Seattle for RHP Jeter Martinez (July 30, 2025).

Peter Strzelecki pitched in 16 games (1 start) for Indianapolis (AAA-Pirates) in 2025.

Nathan Church (2018) & **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA.

Nick Yorke made his MLB debut at St.x Louis on Sept. 16, 2024.

Luke Weaver was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (No. 27) of the 2014 MLB Draft...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2016-18) before packaged in a trade to Arizona for **Paul Goldschmidt** (Dec. 5, 2018)...2016 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKee**...grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Hunter Dobbins and **Mason Montgomery** were teammates at Texas Tech from 2019-20.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Bill Sherdel** made his MLB debut with St. Louis on April 22, 1918 vs. Pittsburgh.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 26-year-old Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his team-leading 27th start of the season. It marks his 147th career Major League appearance and his 80th career start.
- Enters today's start on a six-game losing skid, last earning a win on July 11 vs. Atlanta at Busch Stadium. The last left-handed Cardinals starting pitcher with a longer losing streak was **Jordan Montgomery** (7-game losing streak) from April 13-June 3, 2023.
- Leads St. Louis with a single-season career high 132 strikeouts, most by a Cardinals southpaw since **Jaime García** (150 in 2016).
- Ranks 21st among left-handers in franchise history with his 79 starts.
- Is one of five Cardinals who have induced double-digit GIDP this season (11).
- Tied for 3rd in the National League with four pick-offs, most by a Cardinal since **Lance Lynn** (4 in 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5 in 2005).
- Is the third Cardinals lefty with 21+ wins since 2000, joining **Jamie Garcia** (62-45) and **Mark Mulder** (22-18). His next win ties **Alex Jackson** (1966-67), **Jerry Reuss** (1969-71), **Ferdie Shupp** (1919-21), and **Mulder** (2005-08) for 34th all-time among Cardinals left-handed pitchers.
- Opponents are batting .185 (10-54) off his curveball this season. Boasts a 41.5% whiff rate and 53.4% K% (2nd in MLB) on his curve.
- The Cardinals are 18-19 in his 37 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 13-14 with a 4.57 ERA (187.0 IP) with 11 quality starts (all 11 starts with 6.0 IP or more).

LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, August 25 vs. Baltimore): L, 13-1: 4.0 IP, 8 H, 8 R, 8 ER, 1 BB, 7 SO - 91 pitches

- Suffered his 6th straight losing decision, last earning a win on July 11 vs. Atlanta at Busch Stadium.
- Yielded career high 8 runs, which included home runs to Pete Alonso and Christian Encarnacion-Strand.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

NOT MY DECISION: Did not factor in the decision, but the Cardinals won 5-1 at TOR (8/2) following 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball including striking out the first three batters of the game.

AND THE AWARD FOR BEST SUPPORTING CAST MEMBER ...?: Supported with 3 runs or fewer (9 total) in each of his seven starts since the All-Star Break.

JUST PEACHY: Fanned 9 batters, one shy of his career high, in a 5-3 win vs. ATL (6/30) at Truist Park to earn his 20th career win and the blanked the Braves over 6.0 IP two weeks later in a 4-1 win at Busch Stadium on 7/11.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: Had his deepest start (5.1 IP) since a 6.0 inning effort at SD (5/7) and led the Cardinals to a series win over the Cubs on NBC Sunday Night Baseball in his 5-1 win vs Chicago on 5/31.

K-CLUB: Libby notched single-game career highs for strikeouts in consecutive starts when he fanned 9 on 5/19 vs. PIT and then he bettered that with 10 K's on Memorial Day (5/25) at MIL; He and Brewers starter Jacob Misiorowski (12) combined for 22 strikeouts in the 5/25 game.

LIBBY vs. LEFTY: Recorded 38 strikeouts in May, the most by a Cardinals lefty in the month of May since Hall of Famer **Steve "Lefty" Carlton** fanned 52 in May, 1970.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that he was born. Became 1 of just 16 LHPs to make the Opening Day start for St. Louis since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Is a career 18-33 with a 5.07 ERA (382.0 IP) in his 79 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.

LIBERATORE vs. PIRATES:

- Is making his 8th career start (12th app) vs. the Pirates posting a 2-3 record with a 5.72 ERA (39.1 IP) with 39 strikeouts.
- He and Michael McGreevy were the only two pitchers who missed the Pirates during their four-game sweep at PNC Park in April.
- Fired 7.0 innings allowing one run in his May 6, 2025 start vs. the Pirates, a 2-1 win at Busch Stadium opposing **Paul Skenes** while striking out a season-high 8 batters.
- Made his Major League debut vs. Pittsburgh at PNC Park on May 21, 2022 and received a no decision in a game the Cardinals won 5-4 behind a four-hit night from **Paul Goldschmidt**.
- Has yet to win at PNC Park with an 0-3 record an 8.27 ERA over four starts and five app.
- Received 3 runs or support or less in his last six starts vs. PIT.

LAST START vs. PIRATES (May 19, 2026 at Busch Stadium): ND, W 9-6; 4.2 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 9 SO; 77 pitches)

- The Cardinals walked-off the Pirates in the 10th inning thanks to Ivan Herrera's three-run homer off Mason Montgomery.
- Allowed all four of his runs in the 5th inning as Pittsburgh sent nine batters to the plate.
