TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals open a three-game set tonight with the 17th of 19 meetings between the teams this season...The teams are set to finish their season series this weekend.

A With a win in any of these three games, the Braves will take the season set from the Nationals for the second consecutive season...Over the previous three years, the Braves went 18-39 (.316) against their National League East division rival.

A After opening the season series with three straight losses to Washington, the Braves have won nine of the last 13 games between the clubs despite outscoring Washington by just one run (71-70)...The Braves took three of four from the Nationals last weekend, September 5-8, at SunTrust Park.

A RHP Mike Soroka is 0-2 with a 3.86 ERA (9 ER/21.0 IP) in four career games, all starts, against the Nationals...All of the righty's starts against Washington have come this season, and the Braves have won both of the starts here at Nationals Park...In his last start, also against tonight's starter RHP Max Scherzer, Soroka allowed four runs, earned, over 6.0 innings to lose, 9-4.

A RHP Max Scherzer is 10-7 with a 3.66 ERA (55 ER/135.1 IP) in 23 career games, 21 starts, against Atlanta...The righty has faced Atlanta once this season, beating them 9-4 on September 8 in his last start...Since returning from the 10-day IL, he is 1-0 with a 3.54 ERA (8 ER/20.1 IP) in four starts.

SINCE THE BREAK: The Braves are 37-20 (.649) since the All-Star break, a half-game behind St. Louis for the best such record in the National League...Atlanta is one win away from tying their second-half win total from a year ago.

A The Braves have hit 91 home runs since the break (1.6 per game), tied for the third most in the National League.

A The Braves have hit triple-digit home runs following the All-Star break three times since the game's inception in 1933...They did it in 1956 and 1957, before hitting a franchise-record 114 following the 2006 All-Star Game.

MAGIC NUMBER: The Braves enter tonight with a magic number of eight to clinch the National League East, which would give the club their second consecutive division title...The Braves can also clinch a postseason berth as early as tomorrow, as their postseason magic number stands at four.

A The Braves are looking for their 19th division title in franchise history, and they are currently tied with New York (AL) for the most in MLB history.

A The Braves won a major league-record 14 consecutive division titles from 1991-2005, with the first three coming as N.L. West champs before moving into the N.L. East in the strike-shortened 1994 season...They also won the West in 1969 and 1982, and the East in 2013.

40-40?: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. homered and stole two bases yesterday moving him within one home run and four steals of becoming the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40-homer, 40-steal season.

A OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in 1988...Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996, while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

A Last night, Acuña Jr. became the 15th player in history to have 35 home runs and 35 stolen bases in a single season, and the youngest to accomplish the feat...The last player to reach those marks was Matt Kemp in 2011 with the Dodgers.

ACUÑA JR. HOME RUNS: Ronald Acuña Jr. hit his 39th home run of the season last night, and is now one homer away from becoming just the third player in baseball history to hit 40 homers in his age 21 season or younger.

A Former Brave and Hall-of-Famer Eddie Mathews hit 47 home runs as a 21-year-old in 1953, while 20-year-old Mel Ott had 42 for the New York Giants in 1929.

A The Dodger's Cody Bellinger also had 39 home runs a 21-year-old in 2017.

ROSTER MOVES: The Braves today recalled RHP Bryse Wilson, RHP Kyle Wright and RHP Touki Toussaint from Triple-A Gwinnett, while also reinstating OF Nick Markakis from the 10-day injured list...The club also placed UTIL Johan Camargo on 10-day injured list, retroactive to September 12, with a right shin fracture.

A Markakis missed 43 games with a fractured left wrist.

A The club now has 36 players on the active roster.

HOME RUNS: The Braves hit three home runs last night, giving them 234 this season, which is one shy of the franchise record first set in 2003.

A The Braves' home run total ranks fifth most in baseball and second most in the National League...Only the Dodgers have more with 259.

A The Braves are looking to become just the fourth team in baseball history to have three players reach 40 home runs in a season, OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (39), 1B Freddie Freeman (38) and 3B Josh Donaldson (37) are all on pace to reach the mark.

A The 1973 Atlanta team had Davey Johnson (43), Darrell Evans (41) and Hank Aaron (40) all reach the mark.

A The other two clubs were both Rockies teams, and they did it in consecutive years in 1996 and 1997.

A In 1996, Ellis Burks, Vinny Castilla and Andres Galarraga all hit at least 40, while in 1997, Larry Walker joined Castilla and Galarraga at the mark.

Tonight's Game

- Set for his 27th start of the season and 32nd of his career.
- Ranks fourth in the majors with a 2.67 ERA (47 ER/158.2 IP)...Tonight's opposing starting pitcher, Max Scherzer, ranks second (2.56)
- Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu (2.45 ERA) and Houston's Justin Verlander (2.58 ERA) have been better.
- Soroka's current ERA is the second best by a Braves rookie in the live-ball era (since 1920)...Right-hander Jim Turner went 20-11 with a 2.38 ERA for the 1937 Boston Bees.
- Soroka's ERA is the lowest by any rookie in the majors since 2013, when Miami's José Fernández compiled a 2.19 mark over 28 starts.
- Makes his 15th start of the season on the road, and is 6-1 with a 1.44 ERA (14 ER/87.2 IP) over his first 14 starts.
- Soroka's 1.44 ERA on the road is best in the majors among qualified starters, and over a full point lower than the closest pitcher (Jacob deGrom, 2.53).
- Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only one qualified pitcher has had a better ERA on the road than Soroka's current mark...Greg Maddux did so twice, pitching to a 1.37 ERA in 1994 and a 1.12 mark in 1995.
- Makes his fifth career start against Washington, all of which have come this season... Is 0-2 with a 3.86 ERA (9 ER/21.0 IP) in his first four games.
- Atlanta has gone 2-2 in his starts against the Nationals this season.
- Pitched against the Nationals in his last turn, September 8, and faced the same opponent in consecutive starts for the second time in his career...Pitched against Toronto in back-to-back starts earlier this season, August 27 and September 2.
- Allowed two runs over 6.0 innings in his first start against the Blue Jays, before allowing three runs over 5.0 innings in the second.
- Allowed a career-most three home runs in his last start, September 8, and has allowed five home runs in his last 11.0 innings pitched.
- Yielded just nine home runs over his first 173.1 major league innings.
- Regardless of the outing, Soroka's 13 home runs allowed on the season are tied for the fewest in the majors among pitchers with as many innings.

2019 Recap

- A native of Calgary, Alberta, he beat the Blue Jays for the first time in his last start, 9/2 at SunTrust Park...Allowed three runs over 5.0 innings.
- Became the first Canadian-born Braves pitcher to ever beat Toronto, and the second to ever beat a Canadian franchise...Claude Raymond, a native of Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, Quebec, pitched 2.0 innings of relief to beat the Expos on 5/16/69.
- Lost at Toronto, 8/27, for his first career loss on the road...Allowed eight hits and two runs over 6.0 innings.
- The loss also marked the first time he lost consecutive decisions in his career, a streak that span eight total starts...Also lost on 7/20 vs. WSH...Went winless during the stretch despite a 2.81 ERA (16 ER/51.1 IP).
- Turned 22 years old, August 4...Went 12-3 with a 2.58 ERA (40 ER/139.2 IP) in 24 starts aged 21 or younger.
- Soroka's 24 starts before turning 22 are fourth-most in franchise history since 1908, and the most since Steve Avery made 56 such starts.
- He is one of 145 pitchers in the live-ball era (since 1920) to make at least 24 starts aged 21 or younger...Of those 145 pitchers, Soroka's 2.58 ERA was fifth lowest, trailing just José Fernández (2.25 in 36 starts), Dwight Gooden (2.28 in 99 starts), Mark Fidrych (2.34 in 29 starts) and Vida Blue (2.36 in 49 starts).
- Lost to Washington, 7/20 at SunTrust Park, to snap a 10-game winning streak that spanned 15 starts...Allowed nine hits and four runs over 6.0 innings.
- Became just the sixth Braves pitcher in the live-ball era (since 1920) with a double-digit win streak and the first since Greg Maddux also won 10 straight in 2001.
- Went 9-1 with a 2.42 ERA (24 ER/89.1 IP) over 15 starts to open the season, and became the youngest pitcher in franchise history to be named an All-Star.
- Made his All-Star Game debut with a scoreless sixth inning, July 9 at Progressive Field...Retired Whit Merrifield, Carlos Santana and Dan Vogelbach.
- Allowed a then season-high four runs, including three earned, 6/1 vs. DET...The outing snapped a streak of eight straight starts allowing one earned run or less to start the season.
- Was the third major league starter in the live-ball era to open his season with eight consecutive starts of one earned run or less, and the first Braves pitcher to do so...Edinson Vólquez (2008) and Mike Norris (1980) also did so.

Career Recap

- Selected by Atlanta with the 28th overall pick in the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.
- Is 23-20 with a 2.84 ERA (117 ER/370.2 IP) over 69 career minor league games, including 67 total starts.

- Is 1-0 with 3.86 ERA (12 ER/29.0 IP) in 39 games with Atlanta...Thirty-two of his 39 appearances have been scoreless, including 19 of his last 23.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 2.00 ERA (6 ER/27.0 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty-two of his 39 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .154 (8-for-52) average with 18 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-53 (.245).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignmnt by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

- Was returned from his major league rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 60-day injured list today...Was placed on the IL, 7/11, and missed 56 games with a fractured right great toe
- Is 0-0 with 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP) in 10 appearances with ATL this season...Has struck out 11.
- Went 0-1 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP) in 22 games with the Strippers this season, and fanned 41 batters while walking just four...In seven games with the Strippers during his rehab assignment, allowed six runs.
- In 2017 made his first Opening Day roster and appeared in 29 games out of the bullpen for Los Angeles (NL) before suffering a full tear of the ulnar collateral ligament in his left elbow that ended his season in August.

- Is 0-1 with a 4.19 ERA (9 ER/19.1 IP) in 21 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.20 ERA (14 ER/57.1 IP) in 59 games on the season...He has converted 23 of 28 save opportunities.
- Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless appearances on 9/7 vs. Washington...Held opponents to just four hits while striking out 14 through 13.0 innings during the streak...Logged his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 vs. WSH.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...At the time ranked fourth in the AL with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 27 yrs • #77

Saves/Opp: 18/25 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 64/42 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 23/11

- Is 8-2 with a 3.92 ERA (29 ER/66.2 IP) in 63 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since Oscar Villarreal also had eight in 2006.
- Left-handers have just 16 hits in 98 at-bats (.163) against him...Righties are hitting .333 (55-for-165).
- Has fanned 93 batters in 66.2 innings for a career-best 12.56 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
