**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-1 through four games on their current seven-game homestand, winning two of three against Texas over the weekend, followed by a win over the Royals yesterday afternoon...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of four against Kansas City, then finish the series on Thursday afternoon...after this series, they will hit the road for a nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with games in Houston, New York and Pittsburgh.

☞ Minnesota has gone 22-11 in its last 33 games since April 22, tied with New York-AL for second-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (24-9) and ahead of Kansas City (21-12).

☞ The Twins are 14-12 at home this season, including a record of 12-6 in their last 18 here.

☞ Twins have won five of their last six games overall.

**RYAN RULES THE ROYALS AGAIN:** The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-5 at Target Field...Joe Ryan (4-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Ryan Jeffers and Edouard Julien...Jose Miranda hit a two-run homer, his fifth of the season, while Trevor Larnach hit a three-run homer, his fourth of the season.

**TWIN CITIES-KANSAS CITY:** The Twins and Royals are playing the fifth of 13 meetings in 2024.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 52-32 vs. Kansas City...51 wins are his most against any opponent.

☞ Minnesota has won five consecutive home games vs. the Royals, dating back to April 30, 2023...additionally, they have won 14 of their last 15 against KC in this ballpark.

☞ The Twins' 24 wins vs. KC since the start of '22 are their second-most wins vs. any opponent in that span, trailing Chicago-AL (26-13).

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .314 (55-for-175) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 25 walks, a .400 on-base percentage and an .886 OPS in 46 games against the Royals since '19.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .339 (43-for-127) with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI, 32 runs scored and a 1.042 OPS in his last 33 games against the Royals.

☞ In their last 13 home games against the Royals, Twins starters have gone 8-0, 1.75 ERA (77.0 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 95 strikeouts.

**BACK TO 26:** The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Diego Castillo from Triple-A St. Paul...Castillo, 30, has made 18 appearances for the Saints, posting a 2.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 5 ER) with five saves, six walks, 22 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average...the 6-foot-3, 268-pound right-hander signed a minor league contract with the Twins in late March...a native of Cabrera, Dominican Republic, Castillo has pitched in parts of six major league seasons with the Tampa Bay Rays (2018-21) and Seattle Mariners (2021-23), going 24-18, 3.22 ERA (268.1 IP, 96 ER), 35 saves (46 opps), 101 walks, 304 strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average in 258 games (17 starts)...Castillo takes the 26-man roster spot vacated by left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk, who was optioned to St. Paul...Funderburk appeared in 19 games for the Twins this season, going 1-0, 5.18 ERA (24.1 IP, 14 ER), 12 walks, 23 strikeouts and a .295 opponent batting average...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Justin Topa (left patellar tendinitis) to the 60-day Injured List.

**LEFT SIDE STORY:** Twins hitters are slashing .267/.314/.431 with a .745 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .219/.300/.384 with a .684 OPS vs. right-handed pitching...the .267 average vs. lefties ranks fourth among AL teams and sixth in all of baseball.

☞ Since April 24, the Twins are slashing .295/.333/.476 (.809 OPS) vs. lefties — the second-highest batting average in baseball since that date, trailing only Kansas City (.296).

☞ Willi Castro is hitting .415 (17-for-41) with a 1.064 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 16 games, he is 17-for-31 (.548) with a 1.369 OPS vs. lefties.

**RED HOT JOSE:** Over his last 25 games, dating back to April 25, Jose Miranda is hitting .310 (27-for-87) with seven doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, a .341 on-base percentage, a .529 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS...additionally, he has homered twice in his last five games vs. KC.

**'PEN ON POINT:** Over the last six games, the Twins bullpen has gone 2-0, 2.61 ERA (20.2 IP, 6 ER) with five walks, 19 strikeouts, a .173 opponent batting average, six holds and four saves in four opportunities...their .173 BAA ranks fourth in baseball in that span, while their .224 wOBA ranks third.

**ROYCE ON REHAB:** Royce Lewis is currently on rehab assignment today with Triple-A St. Paul as the Saints play a doubleheader in Rochester at 3:05 pm (CT)...through two games, Lewis is 3-for-9...Lewis was injured with a right quad strain on Opening Day, March 28 at Kansas City, while running the bases.

**E-ROD AND CULPEPPER GET THEIR ROLL ON:** Double-A Wichita outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez has been named Texas League Player of the Week and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper has been named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Rodriguez, 21, played in five games for the Wind Surge, hitting .421 (8-for-19) with two doubles, two home runs, four RBI, four walks and a 1.364 OPS...he is ranked as the club's third-best prospect, per MLB.com.

☞ Culpepper, 22, made the start for theernels on Thursday at Peoria, pitching 6.0 perfect innings, with eight strikeouts, retiring all 18 batters he faced...he is ranked as the club's eighth-best prospect, per MLB.com — fourth among pitchers.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1994, St. Paul native Dave Winfield recorded his 3,054th career hit to surpass former Twin Rod Carew and move into 15th place (now 23rd place) on the all-time list.

**DOMINANT IN D.C.:** Last started May 22 in Washington, opposite Jake Irvin, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 win...threw 4.2 scoreless innings, allowing three hits and one walk with one strikeout...allowed just two runners to reach scoring position and stranded both...was pulled with two outs and nobody on in the fifth, one out shy of qualifying for the win.

- ☞ Induced four whiffs on 34 swings (11.8%)...ranks in MLB's seventh percentile with a 17.6 percent whiff rate.
- ☞ Allowed four hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...Washington went 1-for-4 on those swings...ranks in MLB's 34th percentile with a 40.7 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ Fourth start of career with zero extra-base hits allowed...opponents have slugged .328 with a .617 OPS vs. Woods Richardson this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started May 17 in Cleveland, opposite Triston McKenzie, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 loss...allowed one run on four hits in 5.1 innings with no walks and two strikeouts...all four hits were singles...was pulled with Andrés Giménez on third and one out in the sixth; Steven Okert entered and allowed a fielder's choice that retired Giménez, then a two-run home run to David Fry.

- ☞ Generated seven whiffs on 45 swings (15.6%).
- ☞ Allowed six hard-hit balls...Cleveland went 1-for-6 with three groundouts on those swings.
- ☞ First MLB appearance in which he didn't issue a walk.

**ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT:** Has never faced Kansas City or any of its active hitters in his MLB career...made six starts vs. Omaha, Kansas City's Triple-A affiliate, in 2022-23...has posted a 2.52 ERA (25.0 IP, 7 ER) in five career starts vs. American League Central opponents (DET, CWS x2, CLE).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Making third home start of the season...has gone 0-0 with a 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 14 strikeouts at home, compared to 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24.0 IP, 8 ER), five walks and 12 strikeouts in five road starts...has allowed a .200 (8-for-40) batting average, .296 BABIP (batting average on balls in play) and .458 OPS at home, compared to .264 (24-for-91) BAA, .282 BABIP and .687 OPS on the road.

**REVERSE SPLITS:** On May 22, Washington's left-handed hitters went 1-for-10 with a walk and a strikeout vs. Woods Richardson, while its righties went 2-for-5...through seven games vs. Woods Richardson, lefties have hit .179 (10-for-56) with a .466 OPS and 19.0 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .293 (22-for-75) with a .730 OPS and 17.5 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Kansas City ranks 10th in baseball with a .712 OPS vs. right-handed pitching this season.

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix in his seven MLB starts this season...here's his 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ranks in MLB's 96th percentile with a breaking ball run value of 6.

- ☞ Pitched in Twins spring training for first time in career and was optioned to Triple-A on March 11.
- ☞ Made two starts for St. Paul from April 9-15...was recalled by Minnesota on April 21 and made a relief appearance for Twins on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs in 4.2 innings pitched.
- ☞ Pitched a professional career-high 7.0 innings April 28 at Rochester, allowing two runs on three hits.
- ☞ Earned first win of the season on July 2 vs. Gwinnett, his first of four-straight winning decisions.
- ☞ Struck out a season-high seven batters July 8 at Iowa (5.0 IP).
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on September 10 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- ☞ Went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- ☞ Made 22 starts and three relief appearances for St. Paul...went 5-6 with a 5.21 ERA (103.2 IP, 60 ER) as a starter, and 2-0 with a 4.30 ERA (14.2 IP, 7 ER) as a reliever.
