RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a season-long, 10-game, 10-day homestand against the Nationals (2-1), Royals (0-2, two to play), and Diamondbacks (three to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...are 2-3 on a stretch of 23 games in 24 days leading into the All-Star break (June 19–July 12), with the lone off day coming on June 29...they are an MLB-worst 9-18 since May 24 after producing an MLB-best 22-4 record between April 22–May 23...have lost 8.5 games on the AL East-leading Yankees during that timeframe, whom they now trail by 3.0 games for the division lead...had the best record in the AL for 35 straight days between May 9–June 12, which included eight consecutive days atop the majors from May 18-25...have spent 41 days in first place in the AL East, 36 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

★ The Rays dropped the game two of the four-game set with the Royals last night, 12-5...marked the fourth time they have dropped back-to-back games at home since returning to Tropicana Field...they have only lost three straight once: a three-game sweep from June 1-3 vs. DET.

★ **Shane McClanahan** delivered a quality start in the losing effort...paired with **Drew Rasmussen's** quality start on Monday, it marked the first time the Rays have lost back-to-back games while throwing a pair of quality starts since Sept. 15-16, 2025...the last time they lost three or more consecutive games with quality starts was a franchise-record-tying four games between July 22-26, 2016 (also: July 6-12, 2002).

★ McClanahan (529) surpassed **Tyler Glasnow** (526) for eighth most strikeouts in team history and is 41 strikeouts being **Alex Cobb** (570) for seventh most...his 529 SO are the most by a Rays pitcher within their first four majors league seasons since **Blake Snell** (585) from 2016-19.

★ The Royals 12 runs tied the most they have scored against the Rays in team history (also: July 8, 2007 at KC).

★ With the defeat last night, the Rays have lost or split each of their last 13 four-game series dating back to June 7, 2024 (0-6-6).

★ Their 7-13 (.350) record in June is on pace to be their worst winning pct. during the month since 2005 (8-18/.308) and their worst in any calendar month since July 2025 (7-18/.280) and the worst in a month since July 2025 (7-18/.280)...see more in "June Gloom" note below.

★ Each of the last nine meetings (July 4, 2024–pres.) between the Rays and Royals have been taken by the visiting team...per Stats Perform, it is the longest such streak against any opponent in franchise history...see more in "Real Royalty" note below.

JUNE GLOOM—The Rays .350 (7-13) winning pct. in June is on pace to be the in any month since 2008, ahead of only July 2025 (7-18) and July 2023 (8-16)...since the calendar flipped to June, their 15 home runs are the fewest in the majors and their .358 slugging pct. is the third lowest in MLB ahead of the Braves (.358, by pct. points) and Diamondbacks (.353)...they are on pace to launch 20 home runs in June, which would be their fewest in a month since May 2024 (20HR)...the Rays were second in the Junior Circuit with a .280 average with runners in scoring position across their first 56 games (Opening Day–May 31), compared to .253 (6th in AL) since June began...the bullpen's 4.40 ERA in June is the third highest in the AL (ATH, 6.35; MIN, 6.98).

★ The club entered June with a 9-1 record in one-run games and has gone 2-8 in one-run affairs this month...the last time it dropped nine one-run contests or more in a month was May 2023 (9).

★ Rays pitchers have limited opposing hitters to 48 walks in June, tied for the fewest in the majors with the Red Sox, who have played one fewer game...at the same time, while hitting they have walked 71 times, the third most in the AL (ATH, 74; KC, 72).

ARANDA & ARAÑITA—Through the team's first 76 games this season, **Yandy Díaz** has reached base safely 131 times and **Jonathan Aranda** has reached base 125 times...Díaz's 131 TOB are the most in team history through this point of the season, while Aranda's 125 TOB are fifth most (see table on the right)...the duo have combined for 102 RBI (Aranda, 52 & Díaz, 50), the first Rays pairing to reach that mark through 76 team games since Logan Morrison (54) and Steven Souza Jr. (48) in 2017...(Morrison/Souza Jr. in 2017, **Evan Longoria/Carlos Peña** in 2010 & 2009, **Fred McGriff/Gerald Williams** in 2000, **Jose Canseco/McGriff** in 1999).

★ Díaz (446) tied **Brandon Lowe** Monday night for seventh-most RBI in franchise history...he is one shy of **B.J. Upton** (447) and three shy of **Aubrey Huff** (449) for fifth most.

★ After going 0-for-11 in the series against the Tigers between June 1-3, Aranda has recorded a hit in 13 of 16 games (June 5–pres.) with five multi-hit contests and has reached base safely in 15 of them.

DOME SWEET DOME—Despite losing six of their last 11 at Tropicana Field, the Rays are tied for the best home record (26-12/.684) in MLB with the White Sox (also 26-12)...it is tied for the second-best start at home in franchise history (also: 2008) behind 2023 (30-8)...since May 13, the Rays are 12-8 at home (3rd in AL/T8th in MLB) compared to 3-12 in road affairs (30th in MLB)...on the year, the 237-point discrepancy between their home (26-12/.684) and road (17-21/.447) winning percentages is the third largest in MLB behind the White Sox (.309) and Tigers (.264)...the Rays are in a stretch of 19 home games within a 28-game span from May 29–June 28, going 10-13 thus far (7-7 at home)...they have several notable active home streaks:

★ The Rays are 12-0 against the AL East at Tropicana Field, MLB's longest season-opening, home winning streak over division rivals since the 2009 Dodgers won their first 12 home games vs. the NL West...among AL clubs, only the 2003 Royals (13-0) have had a longer streak in the divisional era (since 1969)...they are 14-11 against all other opponents at home.

★ **Yandy Díaz** has reached base safely in 21 straight home games (May 5–pres.), tied with **SD Fernando Tatis Jr.** for the longest active streak in the majors...he is slashing .397/.478/.744 (31-for-78) with 6 2B, 7 HR, and 23 RBI at Tropicana Field during that stretch.

★ **Kevin Kelly** has recorded 17 scoreless outings (18.OIP) at Tropicana Field, the third-longest season-opening streak at home by a Rays reliever behind **Jake McGee** (19G) in 2012 and **Trevor Miller** (17G) in 2008...per Stats Perform, the 18.0-IP streak at home is the third longest to begin the season in MLB this year, trailing **NY Yankees Brent Headrick** (19.2, active) **MIA Tyler Phillips** (18.1), and is the longest to open a campaign in Rays history (see table on the right).

BAG BANDITS—Rays baserunners have swiped six bases over their last four games, including a season-high-tying 4 SB on June 20 vs. WSH, matching April 4 at MIN...they rank second in the AL with 16 SB in their last 15 games (June 7–pres.) after recording 1 SB in their previous 13 games (May 22–June 6).

★ **Chandler Simpson** broke a career-long 26-game drought without a stolen base after swiping second in the 3rd inning on Saturday vs. WSH...prior to the skid, his 14 SB through his first 40 games (May 11) ranked second in the AL, trailing only **CLE José Ramírez** (16).

★ Simpson's stolen base last night tied him with **Jason Bartlett** for 13th most in franchise history and moved him 17 SB behind **Taylor Walls** (78) for most by an active Ray.

★ Rays pinch runners have combined for 4 SB, tied for second in the majors behind the Royals (7).

REAL ROYALTY—The Rays and Royals will complete a seven-game season series over the course of 11 days from June 22–July 2...this marks the Rays first four-game series this season—they were scheduled to play four at Fenway Park from May 7-10, but the third contest of the series was postponed due to inclement weather...the Rays and Royals have split their last two season sets (3-3 in 2024-25), but the Rays have not lost a season series to Kansas City since 2017 (4-3), going undefeated in the previous series (5-0-2; clubs did not meet in 2020).

★ Dating back to July 4, 2024, the road team has won nine straight games between the Rays and Royals, the longest such streak in franchise history...per Stats Perform, it surpasses eight-game streaks with the White Sox (Aug. 3, 2018–July 20, 2019) and Mariners (June 7, 2014–July 5, 2015).

★ In 47 career games against the Royals, **Yandy Díaz** has slashed .301/.414/.497 (43-for-143) with 11 2B, 1 3B, and 5 HR...Díaz has walked in eight of his last nine games (July 3, 2024–pres.) against the club over that span.

TONIGHT'S START—Griffin Jax will toe the rubber tonight for his 11th start and 22nd appearance of the year, including his sixth start and ninth outing at Tropicana Field...marks his 11th straight start after pitching out of the bullpen in each of his first 11 appearances...is the 27th start of his major league career...acquired from the Twins for RHP Taj Bradley on July 31, 2025.

- ✦ Jax has not allowed an extra-base hit in six starts this year, tied with rotation-mate Shane McClanahan and LAA José Soriano for the most such starts in the AL...in all of MLB, only MIL Jacob Misiorowski (9) has more.
- ✦ Has fashioned a 1.20 ERA (15.0IP, 2ER) across his last three starts since June 7, tied for the fifth-lowest mark in the majors (min. 15.0IP) and second lowest in the AL during that span behind NYY Cam Schlichter (0.96ERA).
- ✦ Jax has struck out four batters or more in four straight outings (June 1-pres.), the longest streak of his career.
- ✦ Five of his seven earned runs allowed in June have come off of homers...his 5 HR this month are tied for sixth most in the AL and tied for eighth most in the majors.
- ✦ Boasts a 2.70 ERA (40.0IP, 12ER) with 36 strikeouts in 10 starts compared to an 8.00 ERA (9.0IP, 8ER) with 10 strikeouts in 11 relief appearances this year.

LAST TIME OUT—Spun a season-high-tying 5.0 innings on June 19 vs. WSH with two hits, two runs, and five strikeouts while earning the win...yielded a pair of homers to CJ Abrams in the 2nd inning and Luis García Jr. in the 3rd frame...retired his final seven batters faced following the García Jr. long ball...he has given up two runs or fewer in six of the seven starts in which he worked 4.0 IP or more.

- ✦ Earned his first win since April 18 at PIT and his first as a starter since Oct. 2, 2021 at KC.
- ✦ Generated 10 whiffs, his fourth most this season...his seven whiffs on the changeup tied a season high (also: May 19 vs. BAL).
- ✦ Jax has walked three batters across his last five starts since May 26, tied for the third fewest (w/ KC Noah Cameron) during that span among AL starters (min. 15.0IP) behind BOS Jake Bennett (1BB) and SEA Bryan Woo (2BB).

FOUNTAIN OF LEARNING—Jax has appeared in 26 games opposite the Royals in his career, making three starts...he holds a 2-2 record with a 3.08 ERA (38.0IP, 13ER), .215 (29-for-135) opp. average, and 29 strikeouts in those outings...his team has gone 18-8 and provided 4.97 runs of support per 9.0 innings in those appearances.

- ✦ Jax has a 12-13 record with a 3.59 ERA (150.1IP, 60ER) across 109 career outings (11 starts) against AL Central foes...his club has gone 66-43 in his appearances, giving him 5.87 runs of support per 9.0 innings...is 0-1 with a 6.00 ERA (9.0IP, 6ER) with eight strikeouts across four appearances (two starts) against AL Central clubs this season.
- ✦ Will mark his first start against the club since Oct. 2, 2021 at KC, when he earned the win after 5.0 innings of one-run ball in a 4-0 victory.
- ✦ KC Salvador Perez's 17 career AB against Jax are the most among active AL hitters...Perez is batting .118 (2-for-17) lifetime with 1 2B, 2 RBI, 1 BB, 4 SO, and 1 HBP, the second-lowest average among active AL hitters against Jax (min. 10PA).

WITH HEAVEN ON TROP—At Tropicana Field this season, Jax holds a 4.57 ERA (21.1IP, 11ER) in eight games (five starts) with 26 strikeouts to six walks and a .218 (17-for-78) opp. average...eight of his 11 earned runs at home came in his last two outings on June 1 vs. DET (6ER) and June 19 vs. WSH (2ER)...in his career, he holds a 4.49 ERA (204.1IP, 102ER) in home games compared to a 3.49 ERA (201.1IP, 78ER) on the road.

- ✦ Has surrendered a home run in three straight appearances at home (May 19-pres.), the second-longest streak of his career behind an eight-game run (June 25, 2021-April 13, 2022)...the last Ray to allow home runs in four straight starts or more at Tropicana Field was Taj Bradley (4G, July 31-Sept. 5, 2024).

GET JAX UP AND MOVING—This marks the first time Jax has been a regular starter since his 2021 rookie season with the Twins, when he made his final 14 appearances as a member of the Twins rotation after his first four came in relief...he started two games for the Rays last season, working as an opener for Ian Seymour on Sept. 5 vs. CLE before starting a bullpen game on Sept. 10, 2025 at CWS...both starts lasted 1.0 scoreless frame...for his career, he is 4-8 with a 4.77 ERA (111.1IP, 59ER) in 26 starts compared to 21-28 with a 3.70 ERA (294.1IP, 121ER) in 294 relief appearances.

- ✦ Jax spent his first five professional seasons (2016-19, 2021) as a starter...he first transitioned to a full-time relief role in 2022...from 2016-21, 50 of his 55 minor league appearances were starts.

CAPTAIN JAX—Jax is currently a Captain in the U.S. Air Force Reserve, earning the promotion in June 2021, and remains the only Air Force Academy graduate to play in the majors...after his graduation from the Academy in 2017, he made five starts with Class-A Cedar Rapids and Rookie-level Elizabethton during his 60-day leave ahead of his first active duty assignment, departing on July 22 to begin his role as an acquisitions officer working with civilian contractors such as SpaceX and Boeing...the following year, he was accepted into the Air Force World Class Athlete Program, which allows soldiers to train for the upcoming Olympic Games as their active duty job responsibility for a two-year period, allowing him to continue his baseball career while completing his active duty requirement...became eligible for the program when baseball was readmitted for the scheduled 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

- ✦ He completed his active duty requirement and was admitted to the Air Force Reserve in November 2019...was notified of his promotion to Captain on June 5, 2021, the same day he was selected to the Twins major league roster ahead of his MLB debut three days later.

2025 RECAP—Last season, made a career-high 73 appearances (2 starts), tied for sixth most in the AL, between the Twins (50G) and Rays (23G), going a combined 1-7 with a 4.23 ERA (66.0IP, 31ER)...also set career bests in strikeouts (99) and holds (28)...acquired at the July 31 trade deadline for RHP Taj Bradley...of his 99 strikeouts, 97 came as a reliever, fourth most in the AL behind HOU Bryan Abreu (105), CLE Cade Smith (104), and teammate Edwin Uceta (103)...min. 250 BF, ranked second in the majors in chase rate (38.1%) behind CIN Graham Ashcraft (38.3%) and was fifth in whiff rate (37.3%)...joined Abreu as the only pitchers in the majors to make 70 appearances or more each season from 2023-25...his 216 appearances in that timeframe ranked third to SF/NYM Tyler Rogers (226G) and Abreu (220G).
