## AROUND THE HORN

**MEXICAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME:** On Tuesday, the Mexican Baseball Hall of Fame (Salon de Fama del Beisbol Mexicano) announced its Mexican Baseball Immortals of Class 2026, featuring the D-backs' own **Erubiel Durazo** and **Rodrigo Lopez** in the "Mexicans in Major Leagues" category... **Durazo**, who was a member of the D-backs' 2001 World Championship team, played 4 seasons (1999-2002) with Arizona and has served as D-backs Special Advisor on Mexico to the President, CEO & General Partner since 2016... **Lopez** pitched for the D-backs in 2010, where he led the team in innings (200.0) and starts (33), and has served as an analyst for D-backs Spanish Radio broadcasts since 2014 as well as general manager of Mexico's 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classic teams.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** D-backs' starters have recorded 8 quality starts in their last 10 outings and allowed 1 or fewer runs in 7 of those.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' 2.11 ERA ranks third in the Majors, behind the Brewers (8 G, 1.74) and Braves (9 G, 1.80).
- In the span, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in quality starts (1st, 8), innings (1st, 68.1), innings/G (1st, 7.0), OBP (1st, .231), WHIP (1st, 0.85), opponent AVG (2nd, .168), OPS (3rd, .547) and strikeouts (4th, 55).
- D-backs' pitchers have starts of 6.0+ innings in 9 of their last 10 games.
- The D-backs are 16-5 (.762) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 7-4 (.636) on the road.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 9-1 @ Rockies last night, led by **Merrill Kelly's** first career complete game (W, 1 ER in 9.0, 4 H, 0 BB, 3 K) and paced by a season-high-tying 6-run first inning...set a road season high with 9 runs.

- **Kelly** is the first D-back to record a 9.0-inning complete game since Zac Gallen on Sept. 8, 2023 @ Cubs...is the fourth D-back ever to do so on the road @ Rockies (last: Patrick Corbin on May 20, 2013).
- **Nolan Arenado** (1-for-1, 2B, 4 BB) had a career-high 4 walks and reached base a career-high-tying 5 times.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** (4-for-5, 2B, 2 RBI) reached base a career-high-tying 5 times and recorded a season-high-tying 4 hits.
- **Gabriel Moreno** went 2-for-5 with 1 double and a game-high 3 RBI.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** and **Jose Fernandez** each knocked in 1 run.

**MORE MERRILL:** **Merrill Kelly** became the first D-back starter to record a 9.0-inning complete game with 100 or fewer pitches since Patrick Corbin on April 17, 2018 vs. Giants (100 P).

- Is 1 of 3 starters this season to accomplish the feat, with Sandy Alcantara/MIA (93 P) vs. White Six on April 1 and Bailey Ober/MIN (89 P) vs. Marlins on May 12.

**DIVISION SHOWDOWNS:** The D-backs have 13 straight NL West matchups (1-0, May 15-17 @ Rockies, May 18-20 vs. Giants, May 21-24 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

**BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT:** In their last 13 games since May 1, the D-backs lead MLB in ERA (1.99, 8 R-7 ER in 31.2 IP), opponent AVG (.173; 19-for-110), OPS (.489), OBP (.244), runs (8), hits (19), walks (9) and WHIP (0.88), and are tied for the fewest homers (0).

**GARCIA'S GAMES:** **Brandyn Garcia** has allowed only 1 single and 0 walks with 6 strikeouts in 5 games (5.2 IP) since being recalled from Triple-A Reno on May 1.

- Since May 1, ranks among MLB relievers in ERA (T-1st, 0.00), OBP (T-2nd, .059), OPS (2nd, .118) and WHIP (2nd, 0.18) [min. 5.0 IP].

**¡BRAVO MORILLO!** **Juan Morillo** has allowed 1 run over his last 11 games, going 1-0 with 1 save, a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), 0.56 WHIP, 1 walk and 14 strikeouts.

**A ROX LEGEND:** **Nolan Arenado**, who was drafted by Colorado in the second round of the 2009 Draft, played 12 professional seasons with the organization, including 5 in the Minors (2009-2013) and 8 in the Majors (2013-20), where he was a 5-time NL All-Star, 4-time Silver Slugger, 8-time Gold Glove and 4-time Platinum Glove.

**ROLLIN' NOLAN:** **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 19 of his last 20 starts, hitting .371 (23-for-62)/1.100 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 14 walks, including 10 games reaching 2+ times.

- Since April 21, ranks among MLB third basemen [min. 70 PA] in OPS (1st, 1.084), OBP (1st, .481), AVG (1st, .365), SLG (2nd, .603), runs (2nd, 17), times on base (3rd, 38) and hits (T-4th, 23).

**VS. ROCKIES:** The D-backs face the Rockies for the Rocky Mountain Showdown as part of MLB's second annual "Rivalry Weekend" presented by Booking.com.

- The D-backs have won 10 of their last 12 series vs. Rockies since 2023 and are 28-12.
- The D-backs have taken 4 of their last 6 road series @ Rockies since 2023 and are 11-9.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base 2+ times in 10 of his last 11 straight starts, hitting .435 (20-for-46)/1.270 OPS with 9 doubles, 2 homers, 14 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Corbin Carroll** has an 8-game hitting streak (.333, 11-for-33/1.088 OPS, 2 2B, 3 HR, 6 RBI, 5 BB) and hit safely in 19 of his last 20 games (.305, 25-for-82/1.022 OPS, 4 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR, 11 RBI, 12 BB).
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has an 8-game hitting streak, batting .313 (10-for-32)/.914 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 2 walks...reached base in 12 straight games (.313/.917 OPS, 15-for-48, 2 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 14 RBI, 7 BB).
- **Gabriel Moreno** has 2+ hits in 6 straight games, batting .577 (15-for-26)/1.400 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 RBI and 1 walk.

## NEXT STARTER: RHP MICHAEL SOROKA (5-2, 3.53)

- Had a quality start by tossing 6.1 scoreless innings in his last start on May 11 @ Rangers (W, 3 H, BB, 5 K)...marked the third time in his career tossing 6.0+ shutout innings with fewer than 90 pitches.
- Has allowed 1 run over his last 2 starts (2 quality), going 1-1 with a 0.71 ERA (1 ER in 12.2 IP), opponent .217 AVG, 3 walks and 11 strikeouts.
- Had a quality start in his lone career start vs. Rockies on June 17, 2025 (L, 3 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 BB, 9 K).
