Series Wins

Despite yesterday's loss, Atlanta took three-of-four games from Washington over the weekend to win its 30th series of the season.

The Braves are 30-10-7 overall in series play this season, including 14-6-3 on the road.

Atlanta is one of just three teams in the majors to win 30 total series, joining the Houston Astros (30-9-7) and Los Angeles Dodgers (30-12-4).

FOLTY WINS: The Braves have won each of RHP Mike Foltyniewicz's last nine starts dating to June 11 vs. Pittsburgh, including each of his six turns since returning from his option to Gwinnett...Foltyniewicz is 4-0 with a 4.72 ERA (25 ER/47.2 IP) during the stretch.

After getting swept in a season-opening, three-game series here in Philadelphia, the Braves have won six of the last nine games with the Phillies, outscoring their division rival 78-43 over the stretch.

Two of the Braves' three losses in that stretch have been to tonight's starter, RHP Aaron Nola.

The Braves won the series in their last trip here, July 26-28, scoring a total of 28 runs and hitting seven home runs.

RHP Mike Foltyniewicz is set to face the Phillies for the 15th time in his career, for the 14th time as a starter and for the second time this season... Foltyniewicz is 7-3 with a 3.14 ERA (27 ER/77.1 IP) in his career against Philadelphia, and has won each of his last three starts against them, compiling a 1.96 ERA (4 ER/18.1 IP) and a .117 batting average against.

RHP Aaron Nola is 10-3 with a 2.46 ERA (28 ER/102.1 IP) in 16 career starts against the Braves, and has won each of his last four decisions against the Braves...His streak spans five games, all Phillies victories, and he owns a 2.81 ERA (10 ER/32.0 IP) in this stretch.

LOOKING FOR 90: Despite yesterday's loss, the Braves have won 20 of their last 25 games and 17 of 20 to move to 89-55...With one more win, the club will reach the 90-victory mark for the second consecutive season.

The Braves are looking to win at least 90 games in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2012 (94) and 2013 (96).

With a win tonight, this season would mark the quickest by games the franchise has reached 90 victories since 2003...Today is game No. 145.

That 2003 team reached win No. 90 in game No. 143...The 1998 team was the quickest in franchise history to 90 wins, earning it in game No. 136 that season.

HOME RUNS: The Braves hit two home runs yesterday, getting solo shots from OF Matt Joyce and UTIL Charlie Culberson...The Braves now have 227 home runs this season, the fifth most in baseball and second most in the National League.

The Braves are now eight home runs away from tying the single-season mark, set by the 2003 team.

MATT JOYCE: Starts tonight batting fifth and playing right field...In 28 starts this season, is batting .363/.463/.604 with five home runs and 15 RBI... Atlanta is 19-9 in his starts.

Joyce has made 20 of his 28 starts since July 27, the day Atlanta right fielder Nick Markakis was placed on the 10-day injured list...In Joyce's 20 starts since then, he is batting .359/.461/.594 and Atlanta is 14-6.

Has homered in each of the last two games, the first time he has homered in consecutive games since May 14 and May 16 of last season as a member of Oakland against Boston.

He has homered in three straight games just once in his career, from April 28 to May 1, 2013.

Jerry Blevins • LHP • 6-6 • 190 • 35 yrs • #50

Saves/Opp: 1/1 Holds: 8 1st Batter/Retired: 37/29 Inherited Runners/Scored: 20/6

- Is 1-0 with 3.90 ERA (12 ER/27.2 IP) in 37 games with Atlanta...Thirty of his 37 appearances have been scoreless, including 17 of his last 21.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 2.10 ERA (6 ER/25.2 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty of his 37 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .160 (8-for-50) average with 17 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-53 (.245).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignemnt by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

Shane Greene • RHP • 6-4 • 200 • 30 yrs • #19

Saves/Opp: 1/3 Holds: 8 1st Batter/Retired: 20/14 Inherited Runners/Scored: 4/4

- Is 0-1 with a 4.42 ERA (9 ER/18.1 IP) in 20 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.24 ERA (14 ER/56.1 IP) in 58 games on the season...He has converted 23 of 28 save opportunities.
- Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless appearances on 9/7 vs. Washington...Held opponents to just four hits while striking out 14 through 13.0 innings during the streak...Logged his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 vs. WSH.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...At the time ranked fourth in the AL with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 27 yrs • #77

Saves/Opp: 18/25 Holds: 8 1st Batter/Retired: 63/41 Inherited Runners/Scored: 23/11

- Is 8-2 with a 3.97 ERA (29 ER/65.2 IP) in 63 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since Oscar Villarreal also had eight in 2006.
- Per Statcast, has an expected batting average of just .209 and an average exit velocity of 87.9 mph...Opponents are officially batting .270 (70-for-259).
- Left-handers have just 16 hits in 97 at-bats (.165) against him...Righties are hitting .333 (54-for-162).
- Has fanned 90 batters in 65.1 innings for a career-best 12.40 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miami...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Recorded his second consecutive two-inning save, 5/15 vs. STL, to become the first Braves closer with back-to-back two-inning saves since Hall of Famer John Smoltz in 2002

Chris Martin • RHP • 6-8 • 225 • 33 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 4 1st Batter/Retired: 15/12 Inherited Runners/Scored: 1/1

- Is 1-3 with a 3.68 ERA (21 ER/51.1 IP) in 53 games on the season, including a 5.40 ERA (8 ER/13.1 IP) in 15 games with Atlanta...Has a 2.15 FIP with the Braves.
- Allowed one run on two hits, 8/26 at COL, to snap a five-appearance scoreless streak...Had retired 15 of 17 batters faced, striking out five...Earned his third hold with the Braves, 8/24 at NYM.
- Acquired from Texas on 7/30 in exchange for LHP Kolby Allard...Made his Braves debut on 8/2 vs. CIN with a perfect eighth inning.
- Went 0-2 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP) in 38 games out of the bullpen for Texas this season with 43 strikeouts and just four walks.
- Before joining Atlanta, had a rate of 0.95 BB/9 which ranked fifth best among qualifying relievers in the majors.
- Was in his second season with the Rangers, joining Texas as a free agent in December of 2017.

Mark Melancon • RHP • 6-2 • 230 • 34 yrs • #36

Saves/Opp: 9/9 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 17/14 Inherited Runners/Scored: 2/0

- Is 5-2 with a 3.98 ERA (27 ER/61.0 IP) in 60 games this season between Atlanta and San Francisco...In 17 games with the Braves, has a 5.52 ERA (9 ER/14.2 IP) and a 1.76 FIP.
- Has converted each of his nine save chances with Atlanta, last on 9/7 vs. WSH...Was his 192nd career save.
- Allowed four runs in 0.1 inning, 8/10 at MIA...The outing stopped an 11-game scoreless streak that dated to 7/14.
- Acquired from San Francisco in exchange for RHP's Dan Winkler and Tristan Beck on 7/31...Was 4-2 with a 3.50 ERA (18 ER/46.1 IP) in 43 appearances out of the San Francisco pen.
- Is a three-time All-Star, appearing for the National League club in 2013, 2015 and 2016 while with Pittsburgh.
- Prior to joining Atlanta, owned a 27-26 career record with a 2.82 ERA (176 ER/562.1 IP) and 183 saves in 560 games, all in relief...His 183 saves ranked seventh most among all active pitchers...Among qualified active relievers, his 85.1 (183-for-215) career save percentage was fifth best in the majors.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 25 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 5/7 Holds: 5 1st Batter/Retired: 35/20 Inherited Runners/Scored: 10/5

- Was recalled, 9/3, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his third stint with Atlanta this season...Is 3-4 with a 6.91 ERA (22 ER/28.2 IP) in 35 games for the Braves, with five saves.
- Has converted five of his seven saves chances with Atlanta, and is 20-of-24 in save opportunites for his career (83%)... Recorded his first career multi-inning save 6/26 at CHI.
- Right-handers are batting .333 (23-for-69) with eight extra-base hits against him...Lefties are .245 (12-for-49).
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 6/11 to 8/1, for his second stint with Atlanta...Was also with the Braves from Opening Day until he was optioned on 5/9.
- Walked just one batter with Gwinnett over his last 12.0 innings (51 batters faced) since his option...Walked 23 batters over his first 27.1 innings with Atlanta.
- Appeared in 20 games with the Stripers, going 2-2 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER/22.2 IP)...Had a 4.50 ERA over 11 games following his most recent option on 8/1.

Saves/Opp: 1/3 Holds: 16 1st Batter/Retired: 44/30 Inherited Runners/Scored: 18/7

- Is 6-3 with a 3.19 ERA (22 ER/62.0 IP) in 48 games this year, including four starts...Has 16 holds and just two blown saves.
- Has a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) over his last nine appearances, which comes after going 1-2 with a 13.50 ERA (10 ER/6.2 IP) in his previous eight games from 7/28-8/16.
- Went a career-high 11 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run, 5/29-6/29...Has nine relief appearances of more than 1.1 inning, including five of more than 2.0 frames.
- Opened the year in the starting rotation, before moving to the bullpen on 5/4...Has a 3.11 ERA (16 ER/46.1 IP) in 43 games in relief...Has issued just 15 walks and struck out 49 hitters since joining the bullpen.
- Fanned a season-high six over 4.2 scoreless innings, 6/10 vs. PIT...Threw 40 strikes in 55 total pitches.
- Recorded his first career save, 5/20 at SE...Became the first Braves pitcher to start multiple games and earn a save in the same season since Matt Wisler in 2016.

Darren O'Day • RHP • 6-4 • 220 • 36 yrs • #56

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 0/1 Inherited Runners/Scored: 0/0

- Made his Braves debut and his first major league game on 9/7 vs. Washington, his first appearance since 6/26 of last season while with Baltimore...He walked the only batter he faced...Was returned from his rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 60-day injured list, 9/5 after recovering from a right forearm strain.
- Has pitched in four rehabilitation games between the GCL Braves, High-A Florida and Triple-A Gwinnett, tossing 4.0 scoreless innings with two hits and six strikeouts.
- Was acquired by the Braves along with RHP Kevin Gausman from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for four minor leaguers on 7/31/18.
- Entered 2019 with 577 games over an 11-year major league career, going 36-19 with a 2.56 ERA (158 ER/555.0 IP) and 21 saves...Has struck out 572 batters.
- Was a 2015 AL All-Star while with Baltimore, when he went 6-2 with a 1.52 ERA (11 ER/65.1 IP) in 68 games.

- Was recalled, 9/1, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Has a 6.84 ERA (20 ER/26.1 IP) in 27 appearances for the Braves...Is a perfect 6-for-6 in hold chances.
- In 18 appearances with the Braves since 4/20, has a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) and is allowing opponents to bat just .212...Had a 12.38 ERA (11 ER/8.0 IP) over his first nine games.
- Twelve of the 16 earned runs he has allowed have scored at SunTrust Park...Has an 8.76 ERA at home, and a 2.63 (4 ER/13.2 IP) mark on the road.
- Made the Opening Day roster before going on the 10-day IL with a left abdomen strain on 4/29...Was reinstated from the IL and optioned to Gwinnett on 5/25...Was also up from 6/30-8/1.
