June 14, 2002: With two outs in the top of the ninth and the Mets leading 2-1, Derek Jeter singles in rookie Marcus Thames to tie the game and then, in the top of the 10th, Robin Ventura hits a two-run homer to help the Yankees to a 4-2 win over the Mets at Shea Stadium.

TOMORROW IN YANKEES HISTORY

June 15, 2005: Joining Mayor Michael Bloomberg, Governor George Pataki, and team officials, George Steinbrenner announces plans to build the new Yankee Stadium. That night, Jason Giambi hits a walk-off homer off Pittsburgh's Jose Mesa in the 10th inning to give the Yankees a 6-5 win over the Pirates.

June 15, 1923: Lou Gehrig makes his Major League debut at 19 years old during a 10-0 win over the St. Louis Browns, entering the game as a defensive replacement at first base.

ATA GLANCE: The Yankees continue their five-game road trip tonight with the second game of a two-game Subway Series vs. the Mets (1-0 thus far)...after an off-day on Thursday, will also play three games at Boston (Fri.-Sun.)...went 2-4 on their six-game homestand, losing two of three games against both Chicago-AL and Boston.

- At 39-29 (.574), have the fourth-best record in the AL and the sixth-best record in the Majors.
- Are 9-6 in their last 15 games, 14-9 in their last 23 games, 16-10 in their last 26 games, 18-11 in their last 29 games and 21-12 in their last 33 games.
- Are 24-14 (.632) in their last 38 games (since 5/2), tied for the best record in the AL and tied for the second-best record in the Majors in that span, trailing only Arizona (25-13, .658).
- Have won three of their last five completed series and five of their last eight completed series...have won or split seven of their last 10 completed series (since 5/8) and eight of their last 12 completed series (since 5/1).

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees defeated the Mets, 7-6, on Tuesday at Citi Field...**RHP Luis Severino** (4.2IP, 7H, 6R/5ER, 3BB, 4K, 1HR, 1HP, 2BK) started and did not record a decision...**DH Giancarlo Stanton** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1HP) hit a solo HR in the first inning...**3B DJ LeMahieu** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 2RBI) recorded a two-run HR in the fourth inning...**SS Anthony Volpe** (2-for-4, 1R, 2 doubles, 1RBI) hit a RBI double in the fourth inning...**RF Jake Bauers** (1-for-3, 2RBI) hit a go-ahead two-run single in the fourth inning...**PH Josh Donaldson** (0-for-0, 1RBI, 1SF) recorded a go-ahead sac fly in the sixth inning...**1B Anthony Rizzo** (1-for-4, 1R, 1HP) reached base twice...**RHP Ron Marinaccio** (1.0IP, 1H, 1BB) earned his third win of the season...**RHP Tommy Kahnle** (1.0IP) tossed a perfect seventh inning in relief...**RHP Clay Holmes** (0.2IP, 2K) entered the game with the bases loaded in the eighth inning and struck out both batters he faced...**RHP Michael King** (1.0IP, 1K) tossed a scoreless ninth inning and recorded his fourth save of the season.

STANTON ISLAND: **DH Giancarlo Stanton** hit a solo HR in the first inning on Tuesday...in 120 career games vs. the Mets, has batted .264/.349/.560 (115-for-436) with 72R, 15 doubles, 38HR, 88RBI, 56BB, 4HP and 5SF...**his 38HR vs. the Mets mark his most against a single opponent in his career** (next: Washington - 36HR).

- Has hit .257/.344/.619 (56-for-218) with 37R, 7 doubles, 24HR, 48RBI, 27BB/31BB, 3HP and 2SF in 58 career games at Citi Field...**his 24HR at Citi Field mark the most homers by an opposing player at the venue** (next: Bryce Harper, Anthony Rendon and Chase Utley - 14HR).

WHAT A RELIEF: **Yankees relievers** combined for 4.1 scoreless innings on Tuesday...**have posted a Major League-best 2.72 ERA (258.1IP, 78ER) and a .207 opponents' BA this season**...the Yankees are only one of two Major League bullpens that currently own an ERA below 3.00 (also Cleveland - 2.96).

- Lead the Majors with a .328 opponents' SLG, a .628 opponents' OPS and a 0.73 HR/9.0IP ratio...also rank third in WHIP (1.17) and fourth in opponents' OBP (.301).
- **Have posted a 1.30 ERA (27.2IP, 4ER) in their last eight games (since 6/4), a 1.41 ERA (51.0IP, 8ER) in their last 15 games (since 5/27) and a 1.81 ERA (84.2IP, 17ER) in their last 23 games (since 5/18)**...have held opponents to a .156 BA (45-for-289) over that 23-game stretch.

OH MY JOSH: **INF Josh Donaldson** recorded a go-ahead pinch-hit sac fly in the sixth inning on Tuesday...marked his second career RBI as a pinch hitter (also an RBI single on 9/26/10 vs. Texas with Oakland).

NATIONAL TREASURE: The Yankees are 12-4 in 16 Interleague games this season...matches the best record in Interleague games this season (also Miami: 15-5, .750)...have won each of their five completed series vs. NL opponents this season.

- At 293-205 (.588), the Yankees own the best winning percentage in Interleague history and have the second-most wins (Boston: 298-210, .587).
- Have posted a winning record in 20-of-26 completed seasons (20-3-3 overall) since Interleague play was established in 1997...have a *non-losing* Interleague record in 23-of-26 seasons (5-10 in 1997; 9-11 in 2013; and 8-12 in 2016).

COLE TRAIN: **RHP Gerrit Cole** will make his 15th start of the season tonight...**is 7-1 with a 2.84 ERA (85.2IP, 27ER) and 90K in 14 starts this season...has allowed 2R-or-fewer in 11 of his first 14 starts**...his 11 such starts are the third-most in the Majors, trailing only Chicago-NL's Marcus Stroman (12) and Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (12).

- His 7-1 record (.875) is tied with Houston's Cristian Javier (also 7-1, .875) for the second-highest in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (10-1, .909).
- **The Yankees are 11-3 in his starts this season...is one of three starting pitchers this season to have his team win at least 11 of his starts**...joins Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (club is 12-2 in 14GS) and Atlanta's Spencer Strider (club is 11-2 in 13GS).
- **Has left just one game this season with the Yankees trailing.**

BRONX BOMBERS: **Yankees batters** have hit 104HR this season, the second-most home runs in the AL and the fourth-most in the Majors...their 70HR since the beginning of May are the most in the Majors in that span.

- The Yankees have homered in nine of their last 10 games (since 6/2), hitting 17HR in that span...have homered in 13 of their last 15 games (since 5/27), hitting 26HR in that stretch.
- **Their 34 games with multiple home runs this season are the second-most in the Majors, trailing only Los Angeles-NL (35).**
- Since 5/1, rank fifth in SLG (.447) and runs scored per game (5.00), and sixth in runs scored (195).

LEMACHINE: **INF DJ LeMahieu** hit a two-run HR in the fourth inning on Tuesday...has hit .315/.393/.508 (93-for-295) with 59R, 13 doubles, 4 triples, 12HR, 33RBI, 36BB/11BB, 4SB, 3HP and 2SF in 77 Interleague games as a Yankee (since 2019)...**his .315 BA is the fourth-highest batting average (min. 100PA) by a Yankee in the history of Interleague play**, trailing only Carlos Beltrán (.326), Derek Jeter (.320) and Bernie Williams (.319).

- Has batted .306 (66-for-216) with 30R, 13 doubles, 2 triples, 2HR, 17RBI, 22BB/11BB and 3SF in 60 career games vs. the Mets.
- In 33 career games at Citi Field, has hit .299 (35-for-117) with 17R, 7 doubles, 2HR, 9RBI, 10BB/11BB, 2SF and 4SB...has hit safely in seven of his last eight games at Citi Field (since 7/3/19), batting .324 (11-for-34) with 7R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI, 4BB and 1SF in that span.

BEST VS. THE METS: The Yankees are 79-60 (.568) all time vs. the Mets...marks the highest win total by any team over any single opponent in the history of Interleague play (next: Tampa Bay's 75 wins vs. Miami).

HOLMES SWEET HOLMES: **RHP Clay Holmes** struck out both batters faced on Tuesday...had entered the game with the bases loaded and one out.

- **Has not allowed a run in 18 of his last 19 appearances (since 5/6), going 4-0 with four saves, a 0.47 ERA (19.0IP, 1ER) and 24K in that span**...has stranded 10-of-14 inherited runners in that stretch...his 0.47 ERA since 5/6 is the second-lowest among Major League pitchers in that span (min. 15G), trailing only Miami's Andrew Nardi (0.00 ERA in 17G).

JAKE RAKES: **INF/OF Jake Bauers** recorded a go-ahead two-run single in the fourth inning on Tuesday...has reached base in nine of his last 13 games, batting .282/.356/.641 (11-for-39) with 5R, 5 doubles, 3HR, 9RBI, 5BB and 1SF over that span (since 5/29).

CLOSE CALLS: Each of the Yankees' last nine games and 10 of their last 11 games have been decided by 3R-or-fewer...the club's 46 games this season that have been decided by 3R-or-fewer are tied with Atlanta and Cincinnati for the second-most games in the Majors, trailing only Cleveland (51).

PITCH PERFECT: Despite allowing 6R on Tuesday, **Yankees pitchers have posted a 3.60 ERA this season, the fourth-lowest in the Majors.**

- Have held opponents to a .225 BA, the second-lowest opponents' BA in the Majors...also rank fifth in opponents' OBP (.305) and WHIP (1.21), and sixth in opponents' SLG (.381) and opponents' OPS (.686).

HOT START: **OF Billy McKinney** has hit safely in each of his six games this season, recording four extra-base hits (2 doubles, 1 triple, 1HR).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: RHP GERRIT COLE (7-1, 2.84 ERA)

RHP Gerrit Cole will make his 15th start of the season in tonight's series finale at Citi Field...the 32-year-old will pitch on regular four days' rest...last started on Friday vs. Boston and suffered his first loss of the season despite allowing just 2ER in 6.0IP (7H, 1BB, 6K, 1HR, 1HP)...reached 10 years of Major League service on 5/29...**recorded his 2,000th career strikeout on 5/23 vs. Baltimore (Jorge Mateo swinging), becoming the third-fastest pitcher in Major League history to reach the milestone** (in terms of games and innings pitched)...**is 7-1 with a 2.84 ERA (85.2IP, 27ER) and 90K in 14 starts this season...**has allowed 2R-or-fewer in 11 of his first 14 starts, the third-most such starts in the Majors...**the Yankees are 11-3 in his 14 starts this season...**in his third year with the Yankees in 2022, went 13-8 with a 3.50 ERA (200.2IP, 154H, 81R/78ER, 50BB, 257K, 33HR) in 33 regular season starts...his Major League-leading 257K last season were the most by a Yankees pitcher in a single season in franchise history, surpassing Ron Guidry's previous record of 248K in 1978...the five-time All-Star (2015, '18-19, '21-22) has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting five times (second in 2021, fourth in 2020, second in 2019, fifth in 2018, fourth in 2015)...his career 10.47 K/9.0IP ratio (2,020K/1,735.2IP) is the eighth-highest in Major League history (min. 1,000.0IP)...in 89 starts with the Yankees, is 43-20 with a 3.21 ERA (540.2IP, 193ER) and 684K...since 2018, leads the Majors in wins (78) and strikeouts (1,286), ranks second in K/9.0IP (12.14) and innings pitched (953.1), third in opponents' BA (.204), fourth in winning percentage (.722, 78-30, min. 60 decisions), WHIP (1.01) and WAR among pitchers (24.8 - FanGraphs), fifth in K/BB (5.16) and sixth in ERA (2.98)...was originally selected by the Yankees in the first round (28th overall) of the 2008 MLB First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play at UCLA for three seasons (2009-11)...was the first overall pick of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft, the 15th pitcher (and 11th right-hander) to be chosen first...is the fifth player selected first overall to play for the Yankees, joining Alex Rodriguez, Darryl Strawberry, Tim Lincecum and Ron Blomberg...signed a nine-year contract extending through the 2028 season with a player opt-out following the 2024 season on 12/18/19.

LAST START: Suffered his first loss of the season on Friday in the Yankees' 3-2 loss vs. the Red Sox despite allowing just 2ER in 6.0IP (7H, 1BB, 6K, 1HR, 1HP)...allowed an RBI single to Triston Casas in the fourth inning and a solo HR to Rafael Devers in the sixth inning.

2023: Is 7-1 with a 2.84 ERA (85.2IP, 27ER) and 90K in 14 starts this season...has allowed 2R-or-fewer in 11 of his first 14 starts...his 11 such starts are the third-most in the Majors, trailing only Chicago-NL's Marcus Stroman (12) and Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (12).

- Is tied for seventh in the Majors in innings pitched (85.2) and tied for eighth in wins (seven)...ranks fourth in the AL in innings pitched, is tied for fifth in wins, ranks sixth in strikeouts (90) and eighth in ERA (2.84).
- Has allowed 1R-or-fewer in six of his 14 starts...four of his 14 starts this season have been scoreless.
- 17 of his 29R allowed have come in three starts: 6R on 5/7 at Tampa Bay, 5R on 5/23 vs. Baltimore and 6R on 5/28 vs. San Diego.
- Was just the second Yankees pitcher in franchise history to toss at least 5.0IP and allow 2R-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts of a season, joining Hideki Irabu (first seven in 1998).
- Has allowed 9HR in his last seven starts after not allowing a HR in his first seven starts of the season...seven of his 9HR allowed this season have been solo home runs...his seven-start homerless streak to start the season (3/30-5/2) was the third-longest homerless streak of his career (10G from 5/26-8/13/16 and 8G from 7/9-8/20/18).
- Has received 3R-or-fewer of support in nine of his 14 starts...has received 2R-or-fewer of support in seven of his starts.
- Has started after a Yankees' loss six times this season...the Yankees are 6-0 in those games with Cole going 3-0 with a 2.00 ERA (36.0IP, 8ER).
- Has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 10 of his 14 starts...his 10 such starts are tied for the second-most in the AL.
- Tossed his fourth career shutout on 4/16 vs. Minnesota (9.0IP, 2H, 1BB, 10K)...marked his seventh career complete game (first since 7/17/21 vs. Boston-6.0IP) and his fourth career nine-inning complete game.
- Posted a career-high 25.2 scoreless inning streak from 4/11-27...was the second-longest scoreless streak by a Yankees starting pitcher in the last 63 years (since 1961), trailing only Catfish Hunter's 26.0 scoreless inning streak from 8/30-9/11/75...also posted a season-opening 12.0 scoreless inning streak (3/30-4/5).

WINNING WAYS: His 7-1 record (.875) is tied with Houston's Cristian Javier (also 7-1, .875) for the second-highest in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (10-1, .909)...his seven wins are tied for the eighth-most in the Majors.

- The Yankees are 11-3 in his starts this season...is one of three starting pitchers this season to have his team win at least 11 of his starts...**joins Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (club is 12-2 in 14GS) and Atlanta's Spencer Strider (club is 11-2 in 13GS).
- Has left just one game this season with the Yankees trailing.**
- Went undefeated in his first 13 starts of the season...his 13-start season-opening undefeated streak was tied for the third-longest by a Yankees starter in franchise history,** trailing only Ron Guidry's 17-start streak to begin the 1978 season and Allie Reynolds' 15-start streak to begin the 1954 season...Orlando Hernández (2004), Bob Wickman (1993), Jim Coates (1960) and Monte Pearson (1937) also recorded 13-start streaks...his 13-start undefeated streak was also the second-longest undefeated streak of his career, trailing only a 28-start streak from 5/27/19-8/19/20.
- His season-opening seven-game winning streak from 3/20-6/3 was the longest winning streak by a Yankees pitcher to start a season since Aaron Small's season-opening 10-game winning streak in 2005...was also tied for the third-longest winning streak of his career, trailing a 20-game streak from 5/27/19-8/14/20 and an eight-game streak from 9/7/14-4/29/15 (also had a seven-game streak from 5/4-6/24/18).

DECADE OF DOMINANCE: Reached 10 years of Major League service on 5/29...since making his Major League debut on 6/11/13, ranks second in the Majors in strikeouts (2,020) and third in wins (137), starts (281) and innings pitched (1,735.2), and fifth in ERA (3.21, min. 1,400IP).

MILESTONE MAN: Recorded his 2,000th career strikeout on 5/23 vs. Baltimore (Jorge Mateo swinging)...became the **third-fastest pitcher (in terms of games) in Major League history to reach the milestone (278th career game),** trailing only Randy Johnson (262G) and Clayton Kershaw (277G)...**recorded his 2,000th career strikeout in 1,714.2IP, becoming the third-fastest pitcher in Major League history to record 2,000 career strikeouts in terms of innings pitched,** trailing only Chris Sale (1,626.0IP) and Pedro Martínez (1,711.1IP).

TROPHY CASE: Was named the AL "Pitcher of the Month" for March/April after going 5-0 with a 1.11 ERA (40.2IP, 23H, 5ER, 11BB, 44K, 0HR) in six starts...was also named the AL "Player of the Week" for 4/10-16.

IN PINSTRIPE: In 89 starts with the Yankees (since 2020), is 43-20 with a 3.21 ERA (540.2IP, 193ER) and 684K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 68-of-89 starts...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 59 starts as a Yankee, the second-most such starts in the AL and the fourth-most such starts in the Majors in that stretch...has recorded 18 scoreless starts as a Yankee, the most scoreless starts by any AL pitcher and tied for the sixth-most by any pitcher in the Majors in that span.

- His 43 wins since 2020 are the most in the AL and the second-most in the Majors over that stretch, trailing only Julio Urias (45-14).
- His 540.2IP since 2020 are the third-most by a Major League pitcher...his .214 opponents' BA ranks sixth (min. 400.0IP).
- His 3.21 ERA since 2020 is the third-lowest in the AL (min. 400.0IP).
- His 684K since 2020 are the most in the Majors...his 11.39 K/9.0IP ratio in that span is the best in the Majors (min. 400.0IP)...has finished in the top-five of Cy Young Award voting in two of his first three seasons in pinstripes (second in 2021, fourth in 2020).
- His 23 double-digit strikeout games as a Yankee are tied with Ron Guidry for the most in franchise history.

KING OF THE HILL: Since 2018, leads the Majors in wins (78) and strikeouts (1,286), ranks second in K/9.0IP (12.14) and innings pitched (953.1), third in opponents' BA (.204), fourth in winning percentage (.722, 78-30, min. 60 decisions), WHIP (1.01) and WAR among pitchers (24.8 - FanGraphs), fifth in K/BB (5.16) and sixth in ERA (2.98).

VS. NEW YORK-NL: Is 2-2 with a 6.75 ERA (30.2IP, 23ER) in six career starts vs. the Mets...has made just one start vs. the Mets as a Yankee, recording a no-decision in Game 1 of a doubleheader on 7/4/21 at Yankee Stadium (3.1IP, 6H, 4ER, 3BB, 6K, 1HR).

- Has made just one career start at Citi Field on 6/2/17 with Pittsburgh (W, 5.0IP, 8H, 7ER, 2BB, 6K, 3HR).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: In 39 career Interleague starts, is 23-7 with a 2.94 ERA (245.0IP, 80ER) and 290K...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 32 of those starts and 2R-or-fewer in 26 of his Interleague starts.
