WE'RE TALKIN' BAAASEBALL: The Giants seek to bounce back this afternoon in a quick turnaround after last night's 17-1 defeat at the hands of the D-Backs.

- ▶ The Giants are 29-15 versus Arizona here at Oracle Park since 2019.
- ▶ This series has been pretty level since the start of last season, however, as the Giants are 7-8 in their last 15 games versus Arizona (regardless of venue)...they are 6-3 vs. Arizona here at home dating to last year and 1-5 in the desert.

THE GIANTS BY THE BAY: SF is in the midst of its longest homestand of the season with this 10-game stint...after the D-Backs depart following Sunday's game, the Giants will host the New York Mets for three Monday-Wednesday and the Pittsburgh Pirates for three Friday-Sunday.

- ▶ San Francisco is 4-4 through its first eight home games this year, averaging 2.9 runs/game (23 runs in those eight games) in the early going...last season, SF averaged 3.8 runs/game and went 45-36 by the bay.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Sean Hjelle was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day IL...RHP Kai-Wei Teng was optioned to Triple-A postgame yesterday.

BE A GOLDFISH: The -16 run differential in last night's loss was the Giants worst loss here at Oracle Park since also losing to the Diamondbacks by 16 runs on May 24, 2019 in an 18-2 defeat.

- ▶ The -16 run differential is tied for the second-worst run differential in a home loss in the SF-era (since 1958) behind a 17-run loss to the Dodgers on September 13, 2014 (17-0).
- ▶ SF was out-hit 22-4 yesterday...the -18 hit differential was the Giants largest in a game since that September 13, 2014 game vs. Los Angeles where they were out-hit 24-5 (-19).

WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. remains one of MLB's best on-base machines in 2024.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 17 of 20 games where he's had an at-bat this season, and is slashing .370/.474/.500 with eight runs, three doubles, a home run and six RBI.
- ▶ His .370 batting average is fourth-best in MLB while his .474 OBP is tops in the league (min. 50 PA).

CHART A COURSE: Below is a breakdown of how Giants hitters have fared against different pitches 21 games into the season...MLB rankings in parentheses.

- ▶ As you can see below, SF has been a better fastball-hitting team so far this season.
- ▶ SF has been fed 50% or less fastballs by opposing pitching in six of their last seven games according to Statcast data... in this series, Arizona pitching threw 55.2% fastballs on Thursday and 50% last night.
- ▶ In the previous series at Miami, the Marlins threw 32.9% fastballs Monday, 44.4% on Tuesday and 45.4% on Wednesday.

HARRY AND THE HENDERSONS: LHP Kyle Harrison takes the bump this afternoon in his first career start against the Diamondbacks.

- ▶ Three of Harrison's four outings to date in 2024 have been quality starts...that includes his last outing in Miami on Monday where he allowed three early runs but hung in to finish 6.0 innings in SF's 4-3 win over the Marlins.
- ▶ It's a small sample size, but Harrison has been better here at home (3.08 ERA in five starts) than he has in his six road starts to start his young career (5.46 ERA)...opponents have hit .202 off him here compared with a .281 clip in the road outings.
- ▶ So far in 2024 Harrison has been heavily reliant on his four-seam fastball, throwing it 67.4% of the time with opposing hitters batting .190 in at-bats that end with the pitch...15 of his 19 strikeouts this year have come on the pitch.
- ▶ Arizona has excelled against four seamers this year, posting an .892 OPS against the pitch, third-best in the Majors behind the Astros (.986) and Brewers (.964).

JHL DELIVERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee enters today's game with his 10-game hit streak still intact following his day off yesterday... he is slashing .349/.378/.395 with two doubles, an RBI, two walks, two steals and eight runs in that stretch (since April 7).

- ▶ The last Giants rookie to hit safely in 10 straight games was **C Patrick Bailey**, who did so in 11 straight games last year from June 17-30.
- ▶ Lee's 10-game hit streak is tied for the sixth-longest active streak in the Majors.
- ▶ Lee's 33 hard-hit balls for this season are tied for 13th-most in MLB entering play today.
- ▶ Lastly, his 89.6% contact rate is seventh-best in the Majors (fourth-best in the National League)...in the NL, only MIA's Luis Arraez (93.0%), NYM's Jeff McNeil (90.7%) and PHI's Alec Bohm (89.8%) have been better.

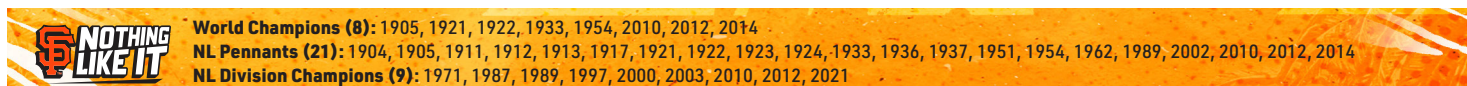
MAKE A NOTE: Even with Arizona's outburst yesterday, Oracle Park has still very much played like a pitcher's park in 2024... the facility's .616 OPS is the lowest of any MLB ballpark this year (*Sports Info Solutions*).

- ▶ For comparison, the park had a .686 OPS last season amongst all clubs.

TODAY'S START: Harrison is scheduled to make his fifth start of the season today in the third game of this four-game series against the Diamondbacks...Harrison is 2-1 with a 4.70 ERA (12er, 23.0ip) in his four starts so far this season.

ABOUT KYLE: Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect entering the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the season on Monday at Miami in SF's 4-3 victory...allowed all three of his runs in the 2nd inning then shutdown Marlins rest of the way...used his fastball and changeup on all but five of his 85 pitches...after almost entirely abandoning his once-signature slider, Harrison has said the change-up is his second-most comfortable pitch after his fastball.

FROM SIS: According to *Sports Info Solutions*, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff causes some issues...opposing hitters are 14-for-31 (.452) with three homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fastball...they're 11-for-58 (.190) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

THE FASTBALL: Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 67.4% of the time, second-highest among starting pitchers to throw at least 200 pitches (James Paxton, 68%).

THE LONGBALL: Has served up at least one home run in all four of his starts this season, giving up five total in his 23.0 innings.

NO FREE PASSES: Has limited the walks through his first four starts, allowing just four free passes in 23.0 innings...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.

MORE FROM SIS: According to Sports Info Solutions, one career stat for Harrison that stands out is that his first time through the order, he has 32 strikeouts vs. 99 batters faced...other times through the order, he has just 21 strikeouts out of 138 batters faced.

2023 SEASON: Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A...Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia...tossed 3.1 innings and held opponents to two runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the outing...at 22 years and 10 days old, the southpaw became the youngest Giant to make his first career start since **Madison Bumgarner** in 2009 (20 years, 38 days).

#58 NICKAVILA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinkers, Cutter, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 4/19 vs. ARI; 0.2ip, h, r, er, k, hr (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in five of SF's 17 games since having contract selected on April 1...has allowed a run in four of his five outings w/SF.
- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action...went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker
Last Game: 4/17 at MIA; SV, 1.0ip, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made four appearances and gone 1-0-3 with three hits allowed, one walk, eight strikeouts and no runs allowed (4.1ip).
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: 4/17 at OKC (w/AAA); 1.0ip, h, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment with Triple-A Sacramento and reinstated from the 15-day IL today...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made five rehab appearances between San Jose (A) and Sacramento (AAA)...threw 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits with seven strikeouts...threw 4.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts while on his rehab stint with Sacramento (three games).
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF at the Major League level last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: 4/17 at MIA; 1.0ip, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last six outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed one run on just one hit in 6.1 innings (1.42 ERA) with 10 strikeouts and one walk.
- ▶ LHBs are 1-for-12 off him early on...RHBs are 2-for-18.
- ▶ Has appeared in nine games for SF, allowing six runs in 9.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter
Last Game: 4/16 at MIA; 0.1ip, h (5 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in seven games for SF so far, allowing two runs over 5.1 innings of work with five strikeouts.
- ▶ In 14 career games vs. Arizona, Taylor has allowed one earned run in 14.2 innings pitched (0.61 ERA) with 18 strikeouts and two walks.
- ▶ Appeared in 60 games for SF last season, posting a 6-4 record with a 3.83 ERA and averaging 11.15 SO/9 (64k, 51.2ip).
- ▶ Allowed just six of his 23 inherited runners to score (26.1%), his best mark since 2018 with Minnesota (25.6).
- ▶ His .211 opposing average in 2023 was the second-lowest in his career (had a .206 opponent's average in 2018 with MIN).
- ▶ Allowed just four earned runs in 27 road games (23.1ip) last season...his 1.54 road ERA was seventh-lowest in the NL (min. 20.0ip).

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 4/18 vs. ARI; 1.0ip, h (10 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in nine of SF's first 21 games, allowing three runs (two on HRs) in 8.1ip.
- ▶ Appeared in 68 games in 2023, his third consecutive season appearing in 68+ games.
- ▶ His 84.4 mph average exit velocity in 2023 was second-best in MLB.
- ▶ Rogers' 27.6% opposing hard hit rate was eighth-best in the Majors.
