PITTSBURGH PIRATES (26-27) vs. SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS (28-26)

MAY 30, 2023 at Oracle Park, San Francisco, CA -- GAME #54/ROAD #29

RHP JOHAN OVIEDO (3-4, 4.70 ERA) vs. RHP JOHN BREBBIA (2-0, 3.68 ERA)

THE PIRATES...lost 14-4 in the opener of their three-game series yesterday afternoon against the Giants...Have lost each of their last three games since beating Seattle in the opening game of their road trip Friday night...Are under .500 for the first time since 4/2...Won seven straight games from 4/17-23, their longest winning streak since 2018 (11 games)...Are 2.0 games behind the front-running Brewers in the National League Central coming into today.

JACK'S JACKS: Jack Suwinski went deep twice yesterday for the third time this season and second time on the current road trip after also doing so Friday night at Seattle...Suwinski now has four career multi home run games, highlighted by a single-game career-high three homers on June 19, 2022, against the Giants at PNC Park.

FEELING AT HOME ON THE ROAD: Last season 16 of Jack Suwinski's 19 home runs were hit at PNC Park...The 16 home runs were tied for the third-most home runs in a single season in PNC Park history (Brian Giles holds the record with 18 in 2001)...This year, eight of Suwinski's 11 home runs have been hit on the road (his eight home runs on the road are tied for the fourth-most in the National League).

SPLASH DOWN SAN FRANCISCO STYLE: Yesterday afternoon Jack Suwinski became just the second player in the 23-year history of Oracle Park history to have multiple splash hits in a game...The only other player to accomplish that was San Francisco's Barry Bonds on May 10, 2000, and May 18, 2002.

COMING INTO HIS OWN: Tucupita Marcano has recorded seven extra base hits since May 21, which are tied for the second-most in MLB (Atlanta's Austin Riley leads the way with eight)...Yesterday Marcano recorded the third three-hit game of his career along with his first career multi-double game...Marcano is now hitting at a .341 clip (14-for-41) with six doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and 1.079 OPS in his last 15 games.

NO JOSHING AROUND: Josh Palacios tripled for the first time in his career on Monday as part of a three-hit day (his career-high is four hits on April 10, 2021)...Since going hitless in his first nine at-bats after being promoted from Triple-A Indianapolis on May 9, a double, triple and three RBI in his last six games...The Pirates acquired Palacios from the Nationals organization during the Minor League Phase of this past offseason's Rule 5 Draft. Palacios has gone 7-for-14 with

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Johan Oviedo gets the start tonight in game two of this three-game series at Oracle Park...This is Oviedo's first start on the road since allowing one run in 5.0-plus innings on May 12 at Baltimore...Oviedo has allowed one earned run in three of his last four starts on the road...The exception came on April 30 at Washington when he allowed seven runs in 2.1 innings while losing a 7-2 decision.

CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen is two doubles shy of 400 in his career and two away from 300 as a Pirate...McCutchen ranks seventh all-time in team history in doubles...Paul Waner ranks first with 559, followed by Honus Wagner (556), Roberto Clemente (440), Willie Stargell (423), Max Carey (375) and Pie Traynor (371).

BAE, BAE, BAE: Ji Hwan Bae went 1-for-4 on Monday to extend his on-base streak to 11 games...Bae is hitting .359 (14-for-39) with four doubles, three RBI and a .405 on-base percentage during his current 11-game on-base streak...Bae ranks fourth among National League rookies in batting (.275), sixth in OBP (.327), tied for seventh in total bases (52) and first in stolen bases (15).

CALLING ON COLIN: Colin Holderman comes into today with a scoreless streak of 7.1 innings that began on April 29...Holderman has recorded a 2.76 ERA (16.1ip/5er) this season in 17 games while pitching in the eighth inning...That's the second-lowest ERA among all National League pitchers with at least 12.0 innings pitched in that inning behind San Francisco's Tyler Rogers (1.32).

LEGGING IT OUT: The Pirates have tripled in two straight and in three of their last four games...Pittsburgh is tied with Kansas City for the most triples (13) in all of MLB coming into today...Ke'Bryan Hayes, Connor Joe and Bryan Reynolds are tied for the team lead with three triples apiece.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 30, 1966: Roberto Clemente went deep in both games of Pittsburgh's doubleheader sweep of the Cubs at Forbes Field. Clemente tied the score with a solo shot in the first game in a 3-2 win in game one. He then keyed Pittsburgh's comeback win in the second game with a two-run blast in the seventh inning off Cubs reliever Bill Connors that put the Bucs ahead for good to complete the sweep.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

MITCH KELLER: The 27-year-old righthander will make his 12th start of the season tomorrow in the finale of this three-game series and six game road trip...Allowed a season-high six runs in 6.0 innings but won an 11-6 decision in his last start Friday night at Seattle...Lost for the only time this season on 5/3 at Tampa Bay, allowing five runs (1er) in 5.0 innings in Pittsburgh's 8-1 setback (has won each of his three decisions since that loss)...Has gone 3-1 with a 3.79 ERA (35.2ip/15er) in six starts this year on the road...Is four strikeouts shy of 400 in his career...Ranks 10th in MLB in OPS against (.599) and fourth among National Leaguers in batting average against (.209).

vs. SAN FRANCISCO: 0-2 with a 4.50 ERA (16.0ip/8er) in three career starts...Had a no-decision (6.0ip/2r/1er) in a 4-3 walkoff win on 6/19/22 at PNC Park...Went 0-1 in one start in 2021, losing a 4-1 decision (5.0ip+/2er) to Alex Wood on 5/16...Also lost a 5-4 decision at San Francisco on 9/10/19.
