TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 9-day, 8-game homestand with the final of 3 games vs. Minnesota (2-0)...will also face Tampa Bay (4 G, 6/17-6/20) and Colorado (2 G, 6/22-6/23) during the home stand...following the conclusion of the homestand, will embark on a 7-day, 6-game road trip vs. Chicago-AL (3 G) and Toronto (3 G)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners won last night by a score of 10-0, their largest winning margin of the season...have won 3 consecutive games and 13 of their last 22...are 14-9 in day games and 20-26 at night...are 19-14 at T-Mobile Park and 15-21 on the road...are 28-11 when scoring at least 4 runs and 6-24 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 25-3 when out-hitting their opponent.

- For Starters** - Mariners starting pitchers are 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (4 ER, 26.2 IP) with 6 walks and 25 strikeouts, while holding opponents to a .202 batting average against over the last 4 games.
- Brooms** - The Mariners look to secure their second series sweep of the season with a win tonight...previously swept the Rangers in a 4-game set at T-Mobile Park from May 27-30.
- Welcome** - **Jake Bauers** has hit safely in 5 of 6 games since joining the Mariners on June 10, batting .333 (8x24) with 3 runs scored, 1 double, 1 home run, 3 RBI and 2 walks during that span.
- Roll It** - The Mariners turned 2 double plays in last night's game...Seattle leads the Majors with 71 double plays turned this season, ranking ahead of Boston (68), Philadelphia (64) and Texas (64).
- No Runs for You** - The Mariners tossed their 5th shutout of the season in last night's 10-0 win.
- Can't Tell the Players Without a Scorecard** - The Mariners lead the Majors with 51 players used this season, ranking ahead of Milwaukee (46) and 5 teams with 45 players used...the Mariners also lead the Majors with 29 pitchers used, ranking ahead of the Cubs (27)...the 51 players used prior to the All-Star Break are currently the 2nd-most all-time, trailing only the 2019 Mariners (53)...rank ahead of the 2014 Rangers (50), the 2018 Angels (50), the 2015 Braves (49) and the 2018 Mets (49).
- Milestone Watch** - **Kyle Seager** (496) is 4 walks away from recording 500 in his career...he is also 10 games away from 1,400...Seager would become only the 5th player with at least 1,400 games in a Mariners uniform, joining Edgar Martinez (2,055), Ichiro (1,861), Ken Griffey Jr. (1,685) and Jay Buhner (1,440).

LEADING OFF...**J.P. Crawford** belted the third leadoff home run for the Mariners this season on the first pitch he saw in last night's game...Crawford became the 3rd player in franchise history to hit a leadoff home run on the first pitch, joining Ichiro (done 9x) and Dustin Ackley...the Mariners 3 leadoff home runs this season are tied for 13th-most in club history, and mark their most since 4 leadoff home runs in 2019...Seattle tallied a club-record 8 leadoff home runs in 2013.

- Is batting .348 (24x69) with 11 runs scored, 7 doubles, 1 home run and 8 walks in 17 games batting in the leadoff position this season...his .348 batting average in the leadoff position is the 2nd-highest in the Major Leagues this season (min. 70 PA)...he trails only Miguel Rojas-MIA (.350/28x80), while ranking ahead of Jesse Winker-CIN (.339/38x112), Adam Frazier-PIT (.331/82x248) and Brandon Nimmo-NYM (.328/20x61).

JUNE BLOOM...**J.P. Crawford** is batting .393 (22x56) in the month of June with 10 runs scored, 7 doubles, 2 home run, 8 RBI, 8 walks and 1 stolen base in 14 games...he's reached base safely in 12 of his 14 games this month, hitting safely in 11...in the month, he's gotten on-base at a .455 clip, slugging .625 with a 1.080 OPS, all of which lead the club in June...overall in his career during the month of June, Crawford is batting .333 (50x150) with 25 runs scored, 14 doubles, 3 triples, 4 home runs, 27 RBI, 25 walks 3 HBP and 4 stolen bases...among all active players in June (min. 150 PA), J.P.'s .431 on-base percentage is the 2nd-highest in the Major Leagues, trailing only Mike Trout-LAA (.442), while ranking ahead of Bryan Reynolds (.427), Corey Seager (.421), Joey Votto (.416) and Juan Soto (.416)...his .333 average is the 5th-highest in the Majors in June among active players.

FRENCH BATTERY...**Ty France** is batting .301 (25x83) with 7 runs scored, 7 doubles, 1 home run, 10 RBI and 4 walks since returning from the Injured List on May 24...excluding 20 games (April 20 - May 13) prior to going on the IL, is batting .306 (44x144) with 20 runs scored, 11 doubles, 4 home runs, 20 RBI, and 11 walks in 39 games this season...was HBP on right forearm by Dustin May on April 20 vs. LAD, and hit .157 (11x70) with 8 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 RBI and 9 walks in 20 games prior to being placed on the IL.

ALL-STAR MITCH...**Mitch Haniger** is batting .259 (65x251) with 43 runs, 15 doubles, 1 triple, 16 home runs, 40 RBI and 19 walks in 64 games this season...Haniger has now surpassed the amount of games played (63) that he registered during 2019...among American League players with at least 60 percent of their games played in the outfield this season, Haniger ranks 1st in extra-base hits (32), T1st in HR (16), 3rd in runs (43), T4th in hits (65), 6th in doubles (15), 6th in slugging percentage (.518) and T7th in RBI (40).

HOME SWEET HOME...the Mariners are 19-14 at home this season, compared to 15-21 on the road...are 7-2 over their last 9 home games and 10-5 over their last 15 at T-Mobile Park...the Mariners pitching staff has posted a 3.76 ERA (125 ER, 299.0 IP) at home compared to a 5.22 ERA (175, 301.2 IP) on the road...dating back to May 2, Mariners starters are 12-8 with a 2.95 ERA (35 ER, 106.2 IP) with 31 walks and 97 strikeouts in 20 home starts, while holding opponents to a .201 batting average against...during that span, Mariners starters have held opponents to 3 runs or less in 18 of 20 starts, 2 runs or less in 14 starts and 1 run or less in 9 starts.

COMING BACK HOT...**Jake Fraley** is batting .311 (14x45) with 11 runs scored, 1 double, 4 home runs, 15 RBI, 14 walks and 3 stolen bases in 15 games since returning from the Injured List on May 31...during that span, holds a .475 on-base percentage and a .600 slugging percentage (1.075 OPS)...since May 31, ranks among Major League leaders in times on base (T5th, 27), on-base percentage (T6th, .475), OPS (12th, 1.075) and home runs (T13th, 4).

VOTE NOW, VOTE OFTEN...Mariners fans can cast their all-star ballots at <https://www.mlb.com/all-star/ballot> until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 4:00 pm ET/1:00 pm PT on Thursday, June 24...on Sunday, June 27, the top three vote-getters at each position (and the top nine outfielders) in each league will be revealed at 12:00 p.m. (ET) on the 2021 Google MLB All-Star Ballot Finalists Show exclusively on MLB Network, and they will advance to the second phase of voting to determine who makes the All-Star teams and starts for each league.

AS YOU KNOW...**J.P. Crawford** has reached base safely a Major League-best 30 times during the month of June, and...**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Ty France** and **Jake Fraley** have each reached base 24 times during the month, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Crawford, France and Fraley's 78 combined times on base this month are the most of any trio in the Majors, ranking ahead of Cincinnati's Jonathan India, Jesse Winker and Nick Castellanos (75) and Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr., Bo Bichette and Marcus Semien (73).

ABOUT SHEFFIELD...

- 25-year-old left-hander is making his 12th start of the season, his 33rd career Major League appearance (29th career start) and his first career appearance against the Minnesota Twins.
- Justus ("Justice") Kane Sheffield...resides in Tullahoma, TN.
- Acquired in trade from New York-AL along with Erik Swanson (rhp) and Dom Thompson-Williams (of) in exchange for James Paxton (lhp) on Nov. 19, 2018.
- His older brother Jordan, made his Major League debut with Colorado on April 2, 2021.
- Justus made his Major League debut with the Yankees on Sept. 19, 2018 vs. Boston.
- Native of Tullahoma, TN...selected by Cleveland in the 1st round (31st overall) of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Tullahoma (TN) High School...at Tullahoma HS, was the 2014 "Gatorade National Player of the Year" after going 10-0 with a 0.43 ERA (3 ER, 61.2 IP) and 131 strikeouts in his senior season...had his number "42" retired by THS on Jan. 21, 2020.
- Began his pro career with Cleveland after being selected by the Indians with the 31st overall pick in the 2014 MLB Draft...spent parts of 3 seasons with Cleveland before being acquired by the Yankees in a 4-player deal that sent Andrew Miller (lhp) to the Indians on July 31, 2016...joined the Mariners in a 4-player deal that sent James Paxton (lhp) to the Yankees on Nov. 19, 2018.

LAST START...L#5 on June 10 at Detroit...pitched 4.0 innings, allowing 5 runs (3 earned) on 6 hits and 2 home runs, walking 1 and striking out 3...Sheffield was on the mound for 3 Seattle errors.

UNEARNED...Sheffield's 8 unearned runs allowed this season are tied for the Major League lead with 5 other hurlers...the other pitchers to surrender 8 unearned runs this season are Alex Colome-MIN, Luis Castillo-CIN, Charlie Morton-ATL, Mitch White-LAD and Ryan Yarbrough-TB.

HOME SWEET HOME...Sheffield is 4-1 with a 3.58 ERA (11 ER, 27.2 IP) in 5 home starts this season...he has allowed 3 or fewer runs in each of his last 4 starts at T-Mobile Park since May 2.

CENTURY MARK...Sheffield recorded his 100th career strikeout on April 19 vs. Los Angeles-NL, striking out Sheldon Neuse to end the 4th inning.

2021 DEBUT...on April 5 in first start of the season as the Mariners were shut out by the White Sox 6-0...allowed 6 runs (4 ER) on 8 hits while walking 2 and striking out 5 over 5.0 innings...allowed a solo home run to Yasmani Grandal leading off the 2nd inning followed by 3 runs in the 4th inning and 2 more in the fifth innings...it marked the 3rd time in his career to allow 6 runs in a game.

BROTHERLY LOVE...Justus' older brother Jordan made his Major League debut with the Rockies on April 2 vs. the Dodgers tossing a shutout inning...Justus and Jordan are 1 of 8 sets of siblings currently in the Major Leagues (on active roster or Injured List...they join RHP Daniel Bard (COL) and RHP Luke Bard (LAA; 60-day IL), INF Yuli Gurriel (HOU) and OF Lourdes Gurriel Jr. (TOR), IF Nick Maton (PHI) and RHP Phil Maton (CLE), C Austin Nola (SD; 10-day IL) and RHP Aaron Nola (PHI), LHP Taylor Rogers (MIN) and RHP Tyler Rogers (SF), INF Kyle Seager (SEA) and INF Corey Seager (LAD) and INF Luis Urias (MIL) and INF Ramon Urias (BAL).

NO HOME RUNS ALLOWED...among pitcher who through at least 750 pitches or more during the 2020 season, Sheffield was 1 of 5 pitchers to allow 2 home runs or fewer...he joined Ian Anderson, Corbin Burnes, Brad Keller and Spencer Turnbull.

ROOKIE LEADER...in 2020, led American League rookies with 6 quality starts...among AL rookies, also ranked T2nd in starts (10), 3rd in innings pitched (55.1), 6th in strikeouts (48) and T7th in wins (4).

TRUE VALUE...posted a 1.6 fWAR, 2nd-best among all rookie pitchers in 2020, trailing only the Dodgers Tony Gonsolin (1.8)...Kyle Lewis (1.7) was the only American League rookie (position player or pitcher) to post a higher fWAR than Sheffield.

SEPTEMBER TO REMEMBER...went 2-0 with a 2.16 ERA (6 ER, 25.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts and 8 walks in 4 starts in the month of September...his 2.16 ERA was tied for 10th-best in the Major Leagues (also: Joe Musgrove-PIT) 4th-best in the AL in September...his 2.16 ERA was 2nd-best by a Mariners rookie in the month of September in club history, behind only Rich DeLucia in 1990 (2.00/8 ER, 36.0 IP).

PICKING UP THE PACE...from Aug. 9 through the end of the 2020 season, worked at least 6.0 innings while allowing 2 or fewer runs in 6 of 8 starts over this span...during this stretch, went 4-1 with a 2.64 ERA (14 ER, 47.2 IP).

TOUGH ON LEFTIES...in 2020 allowed only 1 extra-base hit to a left-handed batter (Charlie Blackmon, 2B, 8/9 vs. COL)...limited lefties to a .154 (8x52) BAA while striking out 14 and walking 4.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW...made his Major League debut with the Yankees on Sept. 19, 2018 vs. Boston, tossing a scoreless 9th inning...made his debut at 22 years, 129 days of age...selected from Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Sept. 18.

CAREER...in parts of 4 Major League seasons with New York-AL (2018) and Seattle (2019-c), is 9-9 with a 4.66 ERA (79 ER, 152.2 IP) with 130 strikeouts and 65 walks in 32 games (28 starts).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP JUSTIN DUNN (1-3, 3.91)

25-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 11th start of the season tomorrow in the series opener vs. Tampa Bay...**Last Outing:** 3.0 IP, 9 H, 5 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 1 HBP on June 11 at CLE...the outing snapped a 15-start streak that dated back to last season of allowing 3 or fewer runs, which led the Majors at that point...Dunn also surrendered a career-high 9 hits in the start...on May 29 vs. TEX, tossed 5.2 IP and allowed 1 run on 2 hits and 2 walks with 8 strikeouts...allowed 3 runs or fewer in all 9 of his 10 starts this season, including 1 run or fewer in 4 starts...struck out a career-high 9 batters on May 18 vs. DET (5.2,5,2,2,9,HR)...**2020:** Went 4-1 with a 4.34 ERA(22 ER, 45.2 IP) in 10 starts with Seattle...limited opponents to a .189 (31x164) with 31 walks and 38 strikeouts...Earned first Major League win on Aug. 10 at Texas, allowing 2 runs on 7 hits while walking 3 and striking out 2 in 6.0 innings.
