WORK FROM HOME

- **Daylen Life** homered, doubled and knocked in a career high five runs to lead the offense...**Cade Cavalli** turned in his 26th start this season allowing three runs or less, the most in Major League Baseball, to earn his 12th win of the season.
- The Nationals are 8-4 over their last 12 home games and 16-15 at Nationals Park since June 13.
- The Nationals are on a stretch of 16 games in 16 days...Tonight is game eight of the 16 with their next off day coming on Sept. 3.

The Washington Nationals activated **Matt Waldron** and designated **Trevor Williams** for assignment on Tuesday.

- Waldron, 29, has pitched in 14 games (three starts) between San Diego and Toronto this season...He is 1-2 with a 7.54 ERA between the two stops.

Jacob Young is 17-for-52 (.327) with three doubles, one triple, one homer, five RBI, three hit by pitch, four walks, just eight strikeouts and eight runs scored in his last 16 games...He's hit safely in 11 of the 16 and has multi-hit efforts in six.

- Following his latest defensive gem on Sunday, in which he climbed the wall in center field at loanDepot Park, Young has now converted seven five-star plays (catch probability below 25%) this season according to *Baseball Savant*, tied for third-most in Major League Baseball behind **Pete Crow-Armstrong** and **Cedanne Rafaela's** eight.
- Since the beginning of the 2024 season, Young has converted 41 four or five-star catches (catch probability below 50%), the second most in Major League Baseball behind only Crow-Armstrong.

Keibert Ruiz has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 games, going 18-for-47 (.383) with a double, one home run, seven RBI, seven walks, just four strikeouts and seven runs scored.

- Ruiz is on pace to set career marks in doubles (21; 24 in 2023), average (.283), slugging percentage (.444) and OPS (.768) this season...His .283/.323/.444 slash line tops his career numbers of .253/.297/.382.

Dustin Giant's bullpen has pitched to a 3.12 ERA (24 ER/69.1 IP) over the last 18 games...The 'pen has recorded a 2.94 ERA (11 ER/33.2 IP) and a .232 opponents' average (21-for-94) in the last eight games...Notable recent performances include:

- **Will Dion** has tossed 12.0 scoreless innings with 13 strikeouts and four walks since joining the Nationals on Aug. 5...He's allowed just two hits in 37 at bats (.054 opp. AVG)...He leads all rookie relievers with a 5.43 strikeout-to-walk ratio this season (38 SO/7 BB).
- **Orlando Ribalta** has pitched to a 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and a .171 opponents' average (7-for-41) over his last 11 games...He has not allowed any of the seven inherited runners to score.
- **Erik Tolman** made his Major League debut on Aug. 22 at Miami and worked a scoreless inning with a strikeout...He followed it with a scoreless inning on Aug. 24.

The combination of **Andrés Chaparro** and **Abimelec Ortiz** have put up impressive numbers as of late:

- **Andrés Chaparro** leads Major League Baseball in slugging percentage (.690) and ranks second in OPS (1.088) and since the All-Star break...He's hitting .296 (21-for-71) with a .398 on-base percentage (8 BB), seven doubles, seven homers, 25 RBI and 17 runs scored in the 28 games since the break.
- **Abimelec Ortiz** has a .471 slugging percentage (2B, 4 HR) with nine RBI, three walks and nine runs scored in his last 15 games...He's hit safely in nine of the 15.

Washington leads Major League Baseball with 184 home runs, five ahead of the New York Yankees (179)...See box to the right for additional rankings.

- The Nationals have clubbed 147 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and 14 more than the New York Mets (133)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB.
- Washington has seven players (Abrams, Crews, Garcia Jr., Lile, Mead, Wood, Young) with at least 10 home runs, the most by a Nationals team (2005-pres.) since the 2019 Nationals had 10 players with at least 10 homers.

CJ Abrams - the National League Player of the Month in July - is at the top of the Major League and National League leaderboards in several offensive categories...See chart to the right for the list.

- With 92 RBI this season, Abrams has passed **Ian Desmond** (91 in 2014) for the most RBI by a shortstop in a single season in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...With eight more RBI, he will become the 12th player in Nationals history to record 100 RBI in a season and first since **Anthony Rendon** (126) and **Juan Soto** (110) in 2019.
- With four more stolen bases and one more home run, Abrams will become the second player in Nationals history to record a 30 homer/30 stolen base season joining **Alfonso Soriano** (40 HR/41 SB) in 2006.

LAST START

Alvarez struck out five in 5.0 innings of one-run ball on four hits in the 2-0 loss to the Texas Rangers on August 20...It was his fifth straight start allowing two runs or less.

vs. COLORADO

Alvarez is set to make his second career start against the Colorado Rockies...He worked 4.1 innings, allowed three runs with two strikeouts in his first start against the Rockies on July 20 at Coors Field.

REGENCY BIAS

Alvarez has not allowed more than two runs across any his last five starts, pitching to a 2.36 ERA (7 ER/26.2 IP) with a .172 opponents' average (16-for-93)...He ranks in the National League in opponents' average (3rd, .172), opponents' slugging (4th, .269), WHIP (8th, 1.01), ERA (10th, 2.36) and home runs allowed per nine innings (10th, 0.68) over this stretch since July 27.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Opposing batters are hitting .178 (19-for-107) with six extra-base hits off Alvarez's curveball...He's fanned 47 batters with the curve this season, the most of any of his pitches.

2025

Tall left-hander ranked second in Washington's system (4th in all of Triple-A) with 123.0 innings and third in the organizaton (10th in Triple-A) with 114 strikeouts at the time of his Major League debut.

- Pitched to a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) in his first three career starts...Only Tanner Roark (0.95) produced a lower ERA in his first three career starts in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
- Matched the Major League record for a starting pitcher in his first five career games by not allowing a run in three of his first five games (22nd overall)...He was the first National (2005-pres.) to do so.
- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 1 vs. Miami (5.0 IP, H, 4 SO, 2 BB)...Struck out Joey Weimer in the third inning for his first Major League strikeout...Earned the win, becoming the sixth pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to do so in his Major League debut.
- Became the first pitcher in Nationals' history (2005-pres.) to throw 5.0 shutout innings in his Major League debut.
- In six starts prior to his callup, he went 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (8 ER/30.1 IP) with 39 strikeouts and a .170 opponents' average.
