BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals continue an eight-game homestand into the All-Star Break against first place teams in the National League Central (Milwaukee) and East (Atlanta). The Cardinals conclude a five-game series with the Brewers tonight and trail 3-1 in the series. Tomorrow, the Cardinals and Pirates will trade opponents with the Atlanta Braves coming to town for a three-games series and the Brewers heading to Pittsburgh.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play in 3rd place in the National League Central, 9.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and 3.5 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The 'Birds are 5-5 into a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (2-1 at Braves; 2-1 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers 1-3; and 3 vs. Braves).

WALKER JOINS HR DERBY FIELD: All-Star OF **Jordan Walker** announced he will participate in the Home Run Derby at Citizens Bank Park on Monday. The last Cardinals player to participate in the event was **Albert Pujols** in Los Angeles in 2022. St. Louis is one of nine MLB teams who have yet to crown a champion with Pujols' 2nd place in 2003 as the highest finish. Walker is the 13th instance a Cardinal has participated joining a list that includes **Jack Clark** (1985), **Ray Lankford** (1997), **Mark McGwire** (1998-99), **Pujols** (2003, 07, 09, 22), **Jim Edmonds** (2003), **Matt Holliday** (2010, 11) and **Carlos Beltrán** (2012).

SKUNKY BEER: Tonight completes the Cardinals home slate with division rival Milwaukee. Milwaukee leads the series 7-2 overall and 4-2 in St. Louis. The two teams will conclude the regular season at American Family Field (Sept. 25-27). The Cardinals are 13-5 (.722) against all other National League Central opponents.

STEAK DINNERS: Last night, **Jordan Walker** drove in his 70th run of the season becoming the first player in MLB to hit the mark. Since 1954, only five Cardinals were the first to 70 RBI in MLB. The list includes **Albert Pujols** (2009), **Scott Rolen** (2004), **Jack Clark** (1987) and **Stan Musial** (1954). -*MLB Network*

ANDRE THE GIANT: Tonight's starting pitcher **Andre Pallante** has posted a career-high 10 wins before the All-Star Break. Since 2000, he's the 21st Cardinals pitcher with double-digit wins pre All-Star Break, and the first since **Miles Mikolas** with 10 in 2018. The last Cardinals pitcher with 11 wins was **Adam Wainwright** (12-4) in 2014. **Chris Carpenter** has the most Cardinals wins pre All-Star Break since 2000, when he was 13-4 at the 2005 break en route to his Cy Young Award.

MESS WITH THE BULL, YOU GET THE HORNS: Entering tonight's contest, the Cardinals have six pitchers with 37 appearances or more (Romero 42, Bruhl 40, Soriano 39, Stanek 39, Graceffo 37 & O'Brien 37). This is the most pitchers with 37 or more games in MLB with the Toronto Blue Jays next with five. The Cardinals rank 16th in MLB in relief innings with 338.1.

WHAT'S ON DRAFT?: Saturday afternoon, the Cardinals will participate in Day 1 of the Major League Baseball amateur draft. With seven picks, the Cardinals have the most selections of any team on the first day. The first pick will be at No. 13, followed by 32 (Competitive Balance Round-A), 50 (2nd Round), 68 & 72 (CB-B), 86 (3rd) and 114 (4th). The Competitive Balance picks came from market size (Round A) and from the **Brendan Donovan** trade (Round B from Seattle & Tampa Bay).

FOUR SCORES AND 25 GAMES AGO: With a 5-1 win last night, the Cardinals once again earned a win against Milwaukee when scoring four or more runs. During manager Oliver Marmol's tenure, the Cardinals are 20-5 against the Brewers when scoring four or more runs with a 11-2 mark at Busch Stadium. St. Louis is 8-34 when scoring three runs or less vs. Milwaukee since 2022.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Bryan Torres originally signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent in 2015 and played parts of five minor league seasons in the Brewers minor league system (2015-19)...played two seasons for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association (2022-23), where he was back-to-back Independent League Batting Champion (.374 and .370).

Matthew Liberatore earned his first MLB win on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Stadium.

Andre Pallante struck out **Christian Yelich** (April 15, 2022 at Milwaukee) for his first career strikeout, and **Matt Svanson** fanned **Isaac Collins** for his first strikeout (April 27, 2025 at St. Louis).

Jacob Misorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers Baseball Ops Special Asst. and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Cardinals Special Asst. to the President of Baseball Ops & 2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Yadier Molina** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 23, 2004 at Milwaukee off **Matt Wise**.

William Contreras's older brother, **Willson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2005-08).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and post-game shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Brewers Sr. Special Asst to the GM **Carlos Villanueva** pitched in 35 games for St. Louis in 2015.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Drew Rom was acquired by the Cardinals from the Orioles in the four-player Jack Flaherty trade in 2023. He earned his first MLB win with St. Louis at Baltimore on Sept. 13, 2023.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Making his 18th start of the 2026 season tonight and his 79th career start (187th career appearance).
- Is seeking his 11th win of the season. The last Cardinal with 11+ wins prior to the All-Star break was **Adam Wainwright** (11-4) in 2014.
- Pallante's 10 wins are most by a Cardinal through their first 17 starts in a season since **Carlos Martinez** (10 in 2025). Martinez is also the last Cardinal with 11 wins through. 18 starts.
- The Cardinals had won seven of his his last eight starts while Andre has collected six winning decisions.
- Owns an 11.17 Run Support Average on the road (highest in MLB) but just a **3.04 at home** ... He's received 3 runs or fewer in 9 of his 10 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 6 of his 7 Road starts.
- Making his his 187th career appearance tonight, tying **Fernando Salas** and **Jordan Hicks** for 64th all-time among Cardinals pitchers. He has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204), **Chris Carpenter** (198), and **Matt Morris** (187) since 2000 to reach both 187 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 75 or more starts.
- **Is 6-0 in six Road starts (St. Louis is 6-1)** and he's 4-5 in Home games with the Cardinals going 5-5 in his Home starts after starting out 1-4 in his 1st five Home starts.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (78), wins (34), and innings pitched (555.0).**
- Began the season with 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP (March 31-May 23), first Cadinal to do so since RHP **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Alternated Home & Road starts in first 11 starts to begin the season, but that trend ended on May 29-June 7 homestand after consecutive Home starts. Now is alternating again through his last three.
- Allowed 2 runs or fewer in five of six starts from May 17 to June 22 (2.88 ERA) and led the Cardinals starting staff with his 3.16 ERA in June.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, July 3 at Chicago's Wrigley Field): W, 17-1; 5.2 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 2 SO, 0 HR, 102 pitches.

- Hurled 5.2 scoreless innings in the Cardinals' 17-1 beatdown of the division-rival Cubs in last Friday's series opener at Wrigley Field.
- Exited with two outs in the bottom of the 6th inning after yielding a Nick Hoerner double as St. Louis was leaing 16-0.
- Pallante's 16 runs of support were the 2nd-most given to any MLB starting pitcher this season ... and most to a Cardinals starter since 16 to **Kent Bottenfeld** on Aug. 7, 1998 in 16-3 win over the Cubs at Busch II

2026 NOTES:

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .189 BA (21-111) with his slider, and 35 of his 70 strikeouts this season have come via the slider ... Boasts a 9 Run Value on his slider, T-6th best slider in MLB according to *Baseball Savant* this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 16 of his 17 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in 10 of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .867 OPS, 14 runs and 4 HRs in 1st inning ... Batters are hitting .313 (15-48) when contacting the 1st pitch of an 0-0 at-bat.

SIX & THIRTY: Snapped a 4-game losing skid in games pitched at Busch Stadium as he matched his season total from 2025 with his 6th win of the season on 6/3 vs. TEX; It also marked his 30th career win.

THE STATE OF WINNING: With a win in Sacramento (May 12), earned his first MLB in his home state of California.

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched then season-best 6.0 IP while allowing 1 run in Cards 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in G3 of a 4-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- **Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (62.2%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.** As a starting pitcher (423.1 IP), Pallante's 59.0 career groundball pct. currently is the 10th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 400.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. MILWAUKEE

- Is making his 5th career start against the Brewers and his 17th career appearance.
- Owns a career mark of 0-3, 5.45 ERA against Milwaukee. Sports a 4.24 ERA (17.0 IP) at Busch Stadium, but is 0-2, 6.43 at American Family Field in 8 games (21.0 IP)
- His first three starts against the Brewers were at American Family Field: 0-2 with a 6.28 ERA (14.1 IP).
- Received a no-decision in his June 14, 2025 start in an 8-5 Cardinals win. Exited leading 6-4 after 4.1 innings not qualifying for the win.
- The Cardinals posted wins in 4 of his first 5 career appearances against MIL, but they are just 2-9 in his last 11 games pitched.

LAST START vs. BREWERS: May 6, 2026 at Busch Stadium: L, 6-2; 6.0 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 104 pitches

- Was toched for four runs in the first inning, highlighted by an Andrew Vaughn three-run homer.
- Hurlled a season-high 104 pitches and limited Milwaukee to one run over the next five innings.
