HE'LL BE IN THE SQUAAAAAT: The Giants open up their season-long nine-game homestand today with the first of three vs. Detroit.

- ▶ SF is coming off a tough road trip in which the Giants went 2-5 through San Diego (1-3) and Texas (1-2)...the trip dropped SF to a season-low 19 games under .500 for the first time since ending the 2017 season 34 games under .500.
- ▶ With Wednesday's loss, the Giants fell to 48-67 (.417), which is the fifth-worst winning percentage in MLB.
- ▶ SF's 67 losses through its first 115 games this season are the franchise's most since losing 70 of 115 to start the 2017 season...the Giants have had 67+ losses through the first 115 games just two other times in the SF era (1984 and 1985).

SEABISCUIT LIKES BEER: The Giants made the following moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **RHP Trent Harris** (#68) selected from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP Tristan Beck** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento.

ON THE HILL TONIGHT FOR THE GIANTS: **RHP JT Brubaker** will open for the Giants tonight in what is his first start of the season...Brubaker is 0-0 with a 3.17 ERA (19er, 54.0ip), 36 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in 34 relief appearances this season.

- ▶ Prior to his elbow injury in 2023, Brubaker had predominantly been used as a starter...in 114 career MLB games, 62 have come as a starter, including one start in 2025 with SF.

JUST ANOTHER HA HA HA HA LAUGHER: The Giants have won 13 of their last 20 games at Oracle Park and outscored opponents 96-69 (+27)...SF's 13-7 record since June 14 ranks as the sixth-best home record in MLB in that span and fourth-best in the NL.

- ▶ The Giants will play 16 of their next 22 games at Oracle Park through August 29, with three of the five opponents at home being sub-.500 like the Giants in Detroit (56-59), Colorado (45-70) and Cincinnati (56-58)...the other two teams SF plays at home in this stretch are Houston (59-57) and Arizona (61-55).

GRAB SOME PINE, MEAT: The Tigers have given the Giants trouble, with SF going 2-7 vs. Detroit since the start of the 2023 season...in that span, SF's 2-7 (.222) record vs. the Tigers is its worst against any opponent.

- ▶ The one series at Oracle Park in that time featured a 2-1 series win for the Giants in August of 2024...since taking a 2-0 series lead on August 10, 2024, the Giants have lost four-straight to the Tigers, including getting swept in three games at Detroit in May, 2025.
- ▶ SF is 12-21 (.364) in Interleague play this season, the lowest winning percentage in the NL and tied for the second-worst in MLB with Minnesota...only the Angels have a lower Interleague mark (13-23, .361)...four of SF's next five series are vs. AL teams (vs. Detroit, vs. Houston, at Cleveland and Boston).

BIG-LEAGUE HANG-WITH 'EM : Two Giants recorded their first career extra-base hit on Wednesday with doubles by both **IF/OF Eddys Leonard** and **C Drew Cavanaugh**...SF's .744 OPS by rookies is seventh-best in MLB this season.

- ▶ Leonard and Cavanaugh are two of eight Giants to debut this season, joining **OF Victor Bericoto**, **OF Jonah Cox**, **IF Nate Furman**, **RHP Wilkin Ramos**, **C/IF/OF Jesús Rodríguez** and **C Daniel Susac**...the eight debuts are tied with St. Louis, Pittsburgh and Arizona for second-most in the NL behind Colorado's nine MLB debuts this season.

WE ARE GIANTS : Longtime Giants broadcaster **Mike Krukow** announced yesterday that he would be retiring at the end of the season...Krukow is in his 36th season in the television booth, and his 32nd full season on the radio side.

- ▶ The 13-time Emmy award winner was inducted into the Bay Area Radio Hall of Fame in 2025... he was a finalists Ford C. Frick finalist in 2025, 2024 and 2017.

WE ARE SAN FRANCISCO: The Giants will induct **Brandon Belt**, **Brandon Crawford**, **Joe Panik**, **Buster Posey** and **Pablo Sandoval** onto the Giants Wall of Fame tomorrow in a pregame ceremony...fans are advised to be in their seats by 3:00 p.m. to enjoy the festivities.
