TONIGHT'S STARTERS: RHP CORBIN BURNES (SEASON DEBUT) vs. RHP MICHAEL WACHA (9-8, 3.36)

A TALE OF 2 GAMES: The Royals suffered a bizarre, 5-4 loss in 10 innings yesterday to the Diamondbacks...the game was scoreless through 9 innings, but the D-backs scored 5 runs—including 4 with 2 outs in the 10th—before the Royals answered with a 4-run bottom half, but couldn't drive in the tying run, which stood at second base with 1 out.

- + [According to Sarah Langs](#), yesterday was the 3rd game in the Division Era (since 1969) that was scoreless through the 9th but ended with both teams scoring at least 4 runs.
- + **Salvador Perez** had 3 of the Royals 8 hits, including the bases-clearing double in the 10th to make it a 1-run game.
- + **Noah Cameron** scattered just 3 hits and 2 walks over 6.0 scoreless innings, with 7 strikeouts, and now owns a 1.66 ERA (11 ER in 59.2 IP) in his last 9 appearances (8 starts).

SEASON OF STREAKS: The Royals have lost 6 of their last 8 games on the heels of a Majors-best 13-2 stretch from Aug. 14-29...in their 15 games prior, they went 4-11 from July 28-Aug. 12, which followed a 7-3 run after the All-Star break.

- + Despite losing 6 of their last 8 games, the Royals are 15-8 (.652) in their last 23 games since Aug. 14, which is the 2nd-best record in the Majors to the Phillies (16-5), and they lead the American League during this stretch in on-base pct. (.343), slugging pct. (.441), OPS (.784) and runs per game (5.1) and rank 2nd in batting average (.266).

SERIES SPEAKING: The Royals have lost the 1st 2 series on this homestand on the heels of a 5-series win streak, during which they went 13-3...this marks the first time they've lost consecutive sets since Aug. 7-12, when they dropped 2 of 3 at home to the Cubs and were swept at Dodger Stadium.

- + To avoid losing a 3rd straight series, the Royals must win tonight and tomorrow night...the Royals have lost 26 series openers and have come back to win only 2 of those series, from May 22-24 vs. Seattle and July 4-6 vs. Philadelphia.

FIRST THING'S FIRST: The Royals have scored a 1st-inning run in 4 of the last 6 games, during which they have 11 runs on 11 hits (3 doubles, 4 HR) and are slashing .379/.455/.897.

- + In 86 games since June 1, the Royals lead Major League Baseball in the 1st inning in runs (63), batting average (.289) and on-base pct. (.352) and rank 2nd in slugging pct. (.513), OPS (.865) and HR (21), 1 shy of the Cubs (22).

- + On the flip side, the Royals have allowed a 1st-inning run in 4 of the last 6 and 10 of the last 20 games since Aug. 17...for the season, their 5.59 ERA (90 ER in 145.0 IP) in the 1st inning ranks 27th out of 30 Major League teams.

QUALITY TIME: The Royals have 59 quality starts this season, 2nd most in the American League and 4th most in the Majors, trailing only the Dodgers (74), Phillies (67) and Mariners (61).

- + The Royals have received a quality start in each of the last 2 games and 3 of the last 5 following a 4-game drought.
- + They're 35-24 (.593) in quality starts, which is the 3rd-worst mark in the Majors, and their 24 losses in quality starts are the most in MLB, 2 more than any other team.
- + Tonight's starter **Michael Wacha** has 19 quality starts this season, most in the American League and 2 more than any other pitcher...he's recorded a quality start in each of his last 3 outings and 7 of 9 since the All-Star break.

DAILY DOUBLE: The Royals 262 doubles rank 2nd in Major League Baseball, only 1 behind the Red Sox (263)...they are attempting to lead the Majors in doubles for just the sixth time in franchise history, following 1977 (299), 1978 (305), 1982 (295), 1990 (316) and 1992 (284).

- + They have recorded a double in 12 consecutive games since Aug. 26, which is tied for their longest streak of the season and is tied with St. Louis for the longest active run in the Majors...their last longer streak ran 15 games from June 13-29 last season.
- + The Royals boast a Majors-most seven players who have recorded at least 20 doubles this season, led by **Bobby Witt Jr.'s** 30 doubles, which rank tied for 4th in the AL.
- + Witt Jr.'s 181 doubles since his 2022 debut season are most in the American League, ahead of **José Ramírez** (177).
- + **Carter Jensen's** 29 doubles rank 2nd among all rookies, 1 shy of **Tristan Peters** (30)...the Royals rookie record is 36 doubles, set by **Alex Gordon** in 2007.

AMERICA'S SHORTSTOP: Since returning from the Injured List on Aug. 4, **Bobby Witt Jr.** is slashing .293/.389/.455 (36-for-123) with 32 runs in 32 games, most in the American League and 1 shy of **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (32) for the Majors lead.

- + Witt Jr. leads the AL at all positions in Outs Above Average (23) and ranks 2nd in the Majors to Crow-Armstrong (25).

BASH BROTHERS: Last season **Vinnie Pasquantino** led the Royals with 32 HR and 113 RBI, ahead of **Salvador Perez** (30, 100), who ranked 2nd on the team in both categories...they were the first Royals teammates to each record 30 HR and 100 RBI in a season, and they were one of three sets of teammates to turn the trick in 2025.

- + This season hasn't been as productive for the duo, as Salvy, now 36, has played through injuries and Pasquantino missed 40 games over two stints on the Injured List.
- + But the tide has recently turned for the duo, as in 19 games since returning from the Injured List, Vinnie is slashing .282/.386/.563 (20-for-71) with 10 XBH, 13 RBI (.949 OPS) with 11 walks and 5 strikeouts...Salvy hasn't started at catcher since Aug. 12 and in 22 games since, he's batting .302 (26-for-86) with 9 XBH (.810 OPS) and 19 RBI.
- + Vinnie and Salvy have combined to drive in 14 of the Royals 31 runs through 7 games on this stay (45.2%), and have accounted for 8 of the team's 9 RBI in the last 2 games.

ROOKIE RETURNS: **Carter Jensen** leads AL rookies with 53 extra-base hits and each of his last 8 hits have gone for extra bases, which is the longest streak by a rookie in Royals history, according to *Elias*, and is the 2nd-longest streak by a Royals catcher, trailing only **Fran Healy**, who had 10 straight hits go for extra bases while catching in 1974.

- + Among 60 American League players with at least 100 hits this season, Jensen's pct. of hits for extra bases (49.1%) is tied for 1st with **Colson Montgomery**.
- + Jensen has 6 leadoff home runs in only 66 games from the leadoff spot, which are tied for the 2nd-most leadoff HR in the American League, 1 shy of **Joc Pederson** (7).
- + Jensen's most recent leadoff homer last Wednesday night broke a tie with **Johnny Damon** (1998) and **Alex Gordon** (2011) for the single-season franchise record...Jensen's 6 leadoff HR (all as a catcher), are the most in a season by a player at the position since 1900, according to *Elias*.
- + Jensen's 22 HR are tied with **Carlos Beltrán** (1999) and **Bo Jackson** (1987) for the 2nd-most home runs in a season by Royals rookie, only 2 shy of **Bob Hamelin** (24) in 1994.
- + Jensen's 22 HR are the 2nd most by a rookie left-handed-hitting catcher, trailing Detroit's **Matt Nokes** (32) in 1987.

HOME: The Royals are 2-5 on this 9-game homestand vs. the Marlins (1-2), Blue Jays (1-2) and D-backs (0-1), already clinching their first homestand with a losing record since June 30-July 6 vs. the Rays (0-3) and Phillies (2-1)...they are now 5-4-3 on 12 stays this season, pending the final home stretch from Sept. 22-27 vs. the White Sox and Guardians.

- + The Royals are 2-5 on this homestand on the heels of a 17-4 stretch at home from July 5-Aug. 23, which included a 7-0 record on the last homestand vs. the A's and Tigers.
- + Despite this 2-5 homestand, the Royals are 38-35 (.521) at home this season, which ranks 7th in the American League.
- + The Royals rank among the American League leaders in many offensive categories at home, including 2nd in on-base pct. (.332), slugging pct. (.435) and OPS (.767) and 3rd in batting average (.264) and runs per game (4.86).

INTERLEAGUE INTRIGUE: The Royals are 18-25 (.419) vs. NL teams this season and they have lost 11 of their last 13 games, a stretch in which they've lost 4 straight completed series.

- + This marks the Royals final home series vs. an NL team...after this week, their last Interleague series will come on the next road trip in Pittsburgh from Sept. 18-20.
- + In Interleague play, the Royals lead AL teams in batting average (.261), on-base pct. (.333) and OPS (.768) and rank 2nd in slugging pct. (.436) and R/G (4.86).
- + **Salvador Perez** has 228 RBI in Interleague play, tied with **Miguel Cabrera** for 4th most all-time, trailing **Freddie Freeman** (241), **Nolan Arenado** (239) & **Albert Pujols** (238).
- + Perez's 351 Interleague hits rank 3rd among AL players, trailing only **Jose Altuve** (377) and **Derek Jeter** (364).
- + Salvy's 76 home runs in Interleague play are 2nd most among American League players to **Aaron Judge** (86).

SNAKE STORIES: The Royals are 18-23 all-time vs. Arizona, including 8-16 at Kauffman Stadium and 10-7 in Phoenix.

- + The Royals won 2 of 3 in Arizona when these teams met in July 2025 to mark their 1st series win since 2017, snapping a run of 4 winless series, in which they went 0-3-1.
- + The Royals are 1-6-2 in 9 completed series vs. the D-backs at Kauffman Stadium, with their only win series coming in the final set of 2017, from Sept. 29-Oct. 1, the series in which many players from the 2015 World Series Royals played here together for the last time.

TOMORROW NIGHT'S STARTER: LHP DANIEL LYNCH IV (4-5, 3.51)

- + **Daniel Lynch IV** will make his 7th start of the season and the 63rd of his career (177th appearance) in tomorrow night's series finale vs. the Diamondbacks.

+ In his most recent start last Friday vs. the Blue Jays, Lynch IV was charged with the loss as the Royals fell 9-2 after he allowed 5 runs on 7 hits and 1 walk in 5.0 innings...he struggled in the 1st, allowing a HBP to the leadoff hitter and 3 consecutive hits to **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.**, **Alejandro Kirk** and **Kazuma Okamoto**, with Kirk and Okamoto driving in runs...**Ernie Clement** tacked on 2 more runs later in the frame to put the Royals in an early 4-0 hole...he ran into traffic again in the 2nd, as he allowed another RBI to Kirk...following that, he retired 10 of his final 11 batters before he was pulled in favor of **Nolan Hoffman** in the 6th inning.

+ His 24 batters faced in the start vs. Toronto were his most in a game since June 12, 2024 vs. the Yankees (29), though that was in a relief appearance...his last start to reach that number came 5 days earlier on June 7 vs. the Mariners (24).
- + Daniel is still finding his footing since joining the rotation on Aug. 7, as he has a 6.97 ERA (16 ER in 20.2 IP) across 6 starts, however his pitch count has increased or stayed the same from each start to the next (35, 39, 45, 59, 70, 70).

+ In 2 appearances vs. Arizona in his career, Lynch IV has pitched 2.0 scoreless relief innings with 3 walks and 1 strikeout...the outings came on back-to-back days on July 4 and 5, 2025 at Chase Field, with him working around a 2-on, no out jam in the 1st game and striking out **Geraldo Perdomo** with 2 on in the 2nd.

+ Across 19 games (7 starts) vs. the National League West in his career, he is 3-4 with a 3.61 ERA (17 ER in 42.1 IP) and 37 strikeouts...his last game vs. an NL West foe came against the Dodgers on Aug. 12, when he was charged with the loss after he allowed 3 runs on 3 hits in 2.1 innings with 3 strikeouts as the Royals lost 4-2.

+ In 28 games (4 starts) at The K this season, Daniel is 1-2 with a 3.18 ERA (14 ER in 39.2 IP) and 23 strikeouts...his ERA at Kauffman Stadium this year ranks 2nd on the Royals (min. 30.0 IP), trailing only **Michael Wacha** (3.14), while his 1.03 WHIP is 1st.

MANAGER MATT QUATRARO (kwuh-TRAIR-roe)

- + **Matt Quatraro** is in his fourth season as Royals Manager...in January, he agreed to an extension that runs through 2029 and includes a club option for 2030...the option would represent his eighth season, which would mark the 2nd-longest tenure in franchise history, trailing only **Ned Yost's** 10 seasons as Manager.

+ His 288 wins are 5th most in club history, 12 shy of 300 wins and trailing only Yost 746, **Whitey Herzog** 410, **Dick Howser** 404, **Tony Muser** 317 in Royals history.

+ Quatraro led the Royals to back-to-back winning seasons in 2024-25 for the first time since 2013-15...the Royals under Q are the eighth team in the Wild Card Era, according to *Elias*, to have back-to-back winning seasons after a 100-loss campaign.
- + Quatraro led the 2024 Royals to an 86-76 record in his second season as Manager.

+ Q finished runner-up in the 2024 American League Manager of the Year voting.

+ The 2024 Royals were the sixth team in the 162-game Era (since 1961), according to Elias, to have a 30-win improvement from one season to the next (excluding shortened seasons)...they were the third team to make the postseason following a 100-loss season, following the 2017 Minnesota Twins and 2020 Miami Marlins.

+ Before joining the Royals, he spent five years on **Kevin Cash's** staff in Tampa Bay and four seasons on **Terry Francona's** staff in Cleveland...during his 12 full seasons on a big league staff, his teams have reached the postseason seven times.

REPLAY SPECIALIST BILL DUPLISSEA

- + **Bill Duplissea** is in his 21st season with the Royals and has served as the Replay Coordinator since Instant Replay was instituted in 2014...during that time, the Royals 65.4% success rate is 1st in the Majors, ahead of the 2nd-place Yankees (64.0%).

+ Duplissea has overturned 22 of 30 challenges this season (73.3%), which is the best rate in the Majors according to the latest update sent from MLB last Friday.

+ In 12 full seasons of Instant Replay, the Royals have finished in the top 5 in success rate eight times and have finished in the top 10 in all 12 seasons.
- + Duper started with the Royals as a Bullpen Catcher in 2006, then added advance scouting duties in 2012...in his current role, he works closely with the coaching staff in scouting upcoming opponents, in addition to his in-game replay role.

+ Prior to joining the Royals, he spent 2004-05 as an Assistant Coach at the College of San Mateo, helping lead the Bulldogs to conference titles in both seasons.

+ Duplissea was a catcher for five seasons in the Los Angeles Dodgers organization, reaching Triple-A Albuquerque in 2000.
