TODAY'S GAME:

- Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Michael Vassallo's Brewers** and the first game of a 7-day, 6-game homestand that includes an upcoming 3-game series vs the **Diamondbacks**.
- Following Sun's game vs **AZ**, the Reds will embark on a 7-day, 6-game road trip at **Cle** (6/9-6/11) and **Det** (6/13-6/15).
- The Redlegs are coming off a 3-3 road trip at **KC** (2-1) and **Chc** (1-2).

SERIES NOTES: The **Brewers** have won each of the last 11 series, 12 of the last 13 series, and 15 of the last 17 series vs Cin dating back to 2021.

- The Reds on 8/30/24 were swept in a doubleheader vs **Mil** for the first time since 9/5/15 at **Great American Ball Park**...the 14-0 loss to the **Brewers** in 8/30/24 nightcap was Cin's largest margin of defeat since its 18-4 loss at **American Family Field** on 5/4/22.
- Since 7/16/21, **Mil** has won 40 of 55 meetings against Cin, including 22 of 30 contests against the Reds since the beginning of the 2023 season.
- The Reds have lost 44 of 78 games at **American Family Field** since 2016 and 17 of 25 there since 2022.
- The Reds have lost 29 of 39 games vs **Mil** at **GABP** since 9/24/19.

TJ MAX: OF TJ Friedl went 0-for-4 in yesterday's 7-3 loss at **Chc** to snap his 8-game hitting streak...has hit safely in 10 of his last 12g (.412/.464/.569).

- Had multiple hits in 7 straight games from 5/23-5/30 (15-for-30) and in 9 of 10 games from 5/19-5/30 (20-for-43, .465, 1hr, 3 2B, 1 3B, 10r).
- His 7-game multi-hit streak was the longest by a Red since **Jonathan India's** 8-game run in 2024 (6/22-6/29).
- Began the season with 6 hits over his first 29 at-bats (.207/.258/.207)...since then is slashing .314/.399/.452.

OPEN FOR BUSINESS: Cin is 12-7 in series openers this season and 45-27 (.625) dating back to last year...only **NYM** (47-26, .644) has a better record in the first game of series since the beginning of 2024.

- Cin is outscoring opponents in series openers this year, 93-71 and holding opponents to a .209/.275/.373 slash line.
- The Reds own a 24-6 record (.800) when scoring first this season (T3rd in the majors with **Chc**, behind **NYM's** 23-5 and **Det's** 26-6).

- 8 of his 12 HR this season have either tied the game or put Cin ahead.
- Is on pace for 32 HR and 45 SB...would become the fourth player in franchise history to join the 30 HR / 30 SB club.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 7-2 win at KC on Tue (7.0ip, 7h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 3k, 99TP).

- Was his first career appearance vs the Royals...was drafted by KC in the first round in 2018 and made 127 apps there from 2020-2024...has now faced all 30 teams.
- Matched a season-high with 7.0 innings.
- Retired 10 straight batters before allowing a 2-out single in the 6th inning (Drew Waters).
- Did not allow a home run for the second straight outing after giving up at least 1 HR in all 7 of his previous starts.
- Hasn't given up an XBH in any of his last 12.0ip (50 BF, last: Pit's Kiner-Falefa double in 1st inning on 5/21).

MAY 21 at PIT: Suffered the 5-3 loss at Pit on 5/21 (5.0ip, 5h, 2r/2er, 4bb, 3k, 102TP).

- After opening the season 5-0, this was his third loss in 5 outings and 4 decisions.
- Allowed a season-high 4 walks for the 10th time in his career.
- Did not allow a home run for the first time in 7 apps.

MAY 16 vs CLE: Earned the 5-4 victory on Fri vs Cle (5.0ip, 3h, 3r/3er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr, 90TP).

- Was his fifth win in 9 starts.

MAY 10 at HOU: Didn't factor in the 13-9 victory at Hou on 5/10 (2.1ip, 9h, 7r/7er, 1bb, 1k, 1hr, 51TP)...was staked to 10-0 and 12-1 leads but couldn't get out of the 3rd inning.

- Was his shortest start since pitching 0.2 inning on 9/28/21 vs Cle (3h, 3r/3er, 1bb, 14TP).
- Was the first time allowing 7 or more runs in a game since 6/11/24 vs NYY (5.2ip, 7h, 7r/6er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 1hb).

APRIL 11 vs PIT: Earned the victory in the 5-3 win vs Pit on 4/11 (5.0ip, 2h, 3r/3er, 3bb, 3k, 88TP).

- Carried no-hit bid into the 5th inning before allowing a 1-out double to Tommy Pham...marked the fourth-longest no-hit bid of his Major League career.
- Became the 11th Reds pitcher since 1900 to win each of his first 3 pitching appearances with the club, the first since teammate Andrew Abbott in 2023 (*courtesy Elias*).
- Got off to a 3-0 start for the first time in his career.

LEAD SINGER: Made his Reds debut in the 14-3 win vs Tex, on 3/31 and allowed just 1 hit and 2 walks over 7.0 scoreless innings (8k).

- Became the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to post a start of at least 7.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit or fewer in his team debut (*courtesy Elias*).
- Became the first Cin pitcher with a scoreless start of at

ANSWERS THE CALL: Since his 2020 debut his 135 starts rank 16th in the majors while his 744.0 innings rank 18th.

PERSONAL: Played collegiately at the University of Florida where he was named 2018 SEC Pitcher of the Year and winner of the Dick Howser Trophy...was named *Baseball America* College Player of the Year in 2018 and a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award...helped lead the Gators to the school's first NCAA College World Series championship in 2017...struck out 12 vs LSU in Game One of the CWS finals, the most strikeouts in the championship round since at least 2003...was teammates at Florida with another 2018 first-round pick, Jonathan India, for whom he was traded in 2024...Graduated from Eustis High School (FL), the same school attended by 1972 Nobel Prize winner John Robert Schrieffer, former NASA astronaut David Walker, and former Reds catcher Chris Okey.
