CINCINNATI REDS (8-24) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (13-18)

May 13, 2022 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #32/HOME #17 RHP TYLER MAHLE (1-4, 6.46 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (0-4, 6.11 ERA)

THE PIRATES.... have alternated between a win and a loss in each of their last nine games... Have gone 4-4 in their last eight games after dropping six-of-seven... Posted a 5-4 record in their first nine games; have gone 8-14 in 22 games since... Have won two games in a row on three occasions (last time coming on April 21-22)... Were 13-18 after 31 games last year (13-19 after 32).

ON THE BUMP: Mitch Keller gets the start tonight in the second game of this four-game series against the Reds...This is Keller's second straight start against Cincinnati after allowing five runs in 4.1 innings in Pittsburgh's 8-5 win in game two of last Saturday's doubleheader at Great American Ball Park...Keller's last big league win came against the Reds on 9/21 and his last victory at PNC Park came on 5/29/21 vs. Colorado.

NIGHT VISION: Ke'Bryan Hayes has produced a .370 (20-for-54) batting average in his 15 games played at night this season, the third-highest average among N.L. players under the lights this season behind Manny Machado (.432) and Eric Hosmer (.377)...Bucco rookie **Diego Castillo** is hitting .343 in his 10 night games, going 7-for-20 in his last five.

<u>SUITING UP:</u> Roldolfo Castro last night became the 39th different player to appear in a game for the Pirates this season and the 19th different position player...The Pirates had a club-record 64 different players appear in a game last season.

ON A SERIES NOTES: Dating back to Sepember of 2017, the Pirates have gone 8-2-1 in the last 11 series played against the Reds at PNC Park...The Bucs have posted a 25-11 record against the Reds in last 36 meetings at PNC Park.

LEADING THE WAY: As a group, Pittsburgh's leadoff batters have combined to hit .310 (40-for-129) this season - the highest average among all National League teams and the second-best mark in the Majors behind the White Sox (.333)... In his 10 games from the top spot, **Ben Gamel** has gone 14-for-37 (.378) with four extra-base hits and seven RBI.

A HOMETOWN HELLO: Cincinnati-area native Cam Alldred made his Major League debut last night and pitched a scoreless inning of relief...With Triple-A Indianapolis this season, he posted a 1-1 record and a 1.53 ERA (17.2ip/3er) in eight appearances (one start)...Alldred is a 2015 graduate of Country Day High School in Cincinnati and was Pittsburgh's 24th round selection in the 2018 Draft out of the University of Cincinnati...Alldred is one of four current former Bearcats in Major League Baseball, along with Ian Happ, Josh Harrison and Art Warren.

GET A WHIFF OF THIS: David Bednar has struck out at least one batter in each of his first 13 appearances, whiffing a total of 24 in 15.2 innings of work (13.79 K/per 9.0ip)...His 24 strikeouts this year are tied for the third-most among all big league relief pitchers and tied with Atlanta's Spencer Strider and New York's Edwin Diaz for the most among all National League relievers...Dating back to 8/3/21, Bednar has whiffed at least one batter in 29 consecutive games.

<u>DAN THE DH:</u> Daniel Vogelbach connected for his fifth home run of the season on Wednesday; a solo shot in the seventh inning that broke a 3-3 tie with the Dodgers...Vogelbach has hit five home runs this season as a designated hitter; a single-season high for a Pirates player...Among all Major League players this season, Vogelbach is tied with Pete Alonso for the second-most home runs hit as a DH...Shohei Ohtani, Bryce Harper and Yordan Alvarez lead all players with six.

SEEING RED: This series with the Reds is the first of three scheduled this season at PNC Park (also August 19-21 and September 26-28)...The Pirates went 5-4 at home against Cincinnati last season, including wins in each of the final two series from September 14-16 and October 1-3.

BIG BEN: Ben Gamel enters today's action tied with Philadelphia's Jean Segura for the most hits in the National League during the month of May (16)...Batimore's Cedric Mullins leads all players in 17 hits this month...Gamel is hitting .410 (16-for-39) with four doubles, a triple, homer and seven RBI in his first 10 games this month while lifting his season batting average from .224 to .299.

JACK IN THE BOX: Bucco rookie Jack Suwinski has reached base safely in six straight games and batting .292 (7-for-24) with two doubles, two home runs, four RBI and a 1.039 OPS in eight games this month...His 15 total bases this month are also the second-most among all rookies in the National League, trailing only St. Louis' Juan Yepez (21).

THIS AND THAT: Ke'Bryan Hayes has gone 26-for-72 (.361) with three doubles, a triple and two home runs in 19 career games against the Reds...Bryan Reynolds has gone 17-for-50 (.340) with five doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and a .492 on-base percentage in 17 career games against the Reds at PNC Park.

BOMBS AWAY: The Pirates homered three times Wednesday and have now gone deep 11 times in their last six games after hitting a total of three long balls in their previous 11 games...Pittsburgh's 13 home runs this month are tied for fifth among all National League teams and are tied for eighth in MLB (the Brewers lead all teams with 19).

FROM THE HOT CORNER: Ke'Bryan Hayes enters today's action ranked fourth in the National League in on-base percentage (.413) and fifth in batting average (.320)...Hayes has hit safely in six of his last seven home games (9-for-26, .346) and is hitting .364 (20-for-55) overall at PNC Park in 2022.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 13, 2009: Jack Wilson collected three hits, including a go-ahead double in the fourth inning, to lead the Pirates to a 5-2 win over the Cardinals at PNC Park. Ross Ohlendorf started and picked up the win after allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work. Matt Capps then preserved the win by recording the final two outs and picking up his sixth save of the season.
