## NEW YORK METS (30-33) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (32-29)

JUNE 9, 2023 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #62/HOME #32

RHP TYLOR MEGILL (5-3, 4.40 ERA) vs. LHP RICH HILL (5-5, 4.41 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** have lost back-to-back games following their six-game winning streak from 5/30 to 6/5...Have had four separate winning streaks of at least four games this season, including a season-high seven-game winning streak from 4/17-23, their longest winning streak since 2018 (11 games)...Are 1.0 game behind the first place Brewers in the National League Central coming into today.

**FROM 1 TO 1998:** Andrew McCutchen comes into today just two hits shy of 2000 in his career (his first career hit came in his big league debut against Mike Pelfrey of the Mets on June 4, 2009)...McCutchen has recorded 1513 of his 1998 hits with the Pirates organization...McCutchen's 1513 hits with Pittsburgh ranks 12th in team history...Hall-of-Famer Roberto Clemente is first with 3000 while Tommy Leach is 11th (1603).

**KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES:** Andrew McCutchen is just one double shy of 400 in his career (his next double will also be his 300th as a Pirate)...McCutchen ranks seventh all-time in Pirates history in doubles (Hall-of-Famer Pie Traynor is sixth with 371)...Each of the six Pirates with at least 300 doubles are in the Hall-of-Fame.

**A WALK IN THE PARK:** Andrew McCutchen walked seven times in Pittsburgh's last series against the A's...Prior to McCutchen, Pedro Alvarez was the last Pirate to draw seven free passes in a three-game series when he did so from May 1-3, 2015, against St. Louis...McCutchen leads all of MLB with eight walks this month while his 15.5 percent walk rate ranks 10th in all of MLB.

**ROSTER MOVE:** Prior to tonight's game the Pirates recalled outfielder Canaan Smith-Njigba from Triple-A Indianapolis...Chase De Jong was designated for assignment to make room for Smith-Njigba on the 26-man active roster...This is Smith-Njigba's second stint with the Pirates this season after making the team's Opening Day roster before being optioned to Triple-A on April 26.

**RICH ON THE HILL:** Rich Hill gets the start tonight in the opener of this weekend series against the Mets...Hill allowed one run in a season-high 6.2 innings while helping the Pirates complete a three-game sweep of St. Louis in his last start Sunday afternoon...Hill has thrown his curveball 39.7 percent of the time this season according to Baseball Savant, which ranks fourth in all of MLB behind Drew Smyly (50.6%), Charlie Morton (46.4%) and Domingo German (41.2%).

**THE BRIDGE TO BEDNAR:** Colin Holderman has been scored upon in just three of his 24 appearances this season with the Pirates...He has also recorded 20 strikeouts in the eighth inning this year, which are the third-most in the National League behind Colorado's Justin Lawrence (25) and Milwaukee's Peter Strzelecki (22)...The 27-year-old Holderman ranks 36th among 192 qualified relievers in MLB with a 6.1 percent walk rate according to FanGraphs and 21st among 192 qualified relievers with an xFIP of 2.96.

**CATCH THIS:** On Tuesday the Pirates promoted 2021 No. 1 overall pick Henry Davis to Indianapolis, joining Endy Rodriguez, who began the season in Triple-A...Pittsburgh's minor league system entered the 2023 campaign with two of MLB Pipeline's top 100 prospects behind the plate...Endy Rodriguez was rated 55th among Pipeline's top 100 prospects while Henry Davis was No. 57...The Pirates and Mets were one of two organizations with two catchers rated among Pipeline's top seven prospects at that position.

**THE HOT CORNER:** Ke'Bryan Hayes has hit safely in each of his last seven games, going 14-for-29 with a double, two triples, two home runs and seven RBI (it's his second seven-game hitting streak of the season)...Hayes ranks 18th in MLB in average exit velocity (92.7 miles per hour)...Hayes also ranks fifth among all National League third basemen in extra base hits (22).

**LEGGING IT OUT:** Ke'Bryan Hayes recorded his MLB-leading fifth triple of the season on Wednesday...Since the beginning of last year, Hayes' eight triples are tied for the second-most in the National League along with Charlie Blackmon, JT Realmuto and TJ Friedl...New York's Brandon Nimmo leads the way in that time with 11 triples...As a team, the Pirates are leading all of MLB with 15 triples this season.

**RUDY ROLLING:** Rodolfo Castro doubled and homered Wednesday and is now hitting .370 (10-for-27) in his last eight games...Castro has recorded a .712 slugging percentage against left-handed pitchers, which ranks fifth in all of MLB.

June 9, 1914: Bucco Hall-of-Fame shortstop Honus Wagner became the second member of the 3,000-hit club with a double off Philadelphia's Erskine Mayer. With the hit, Wagner joined Chicago's Cap Anson in the exclusive club.

<b>JOHAN OVIEDO:</b>	The 25-year-old righthander will make his 13th start of the season tomorrow afternoon in the middle game of this series against the Mets...Was in line for the win (7.0ip/3r) but had a no-decision in his last start in the team's last at-bat win vs. Oakland on Monday...Has held opposing hitters to a .192 average (23-for-120) against his slider according to Baseball Savant...Is 2-2 with a 4.04 ERA (35.2ip/16er) in six starts this season at PNC Park...His 2.57 ERA (28.0ip/8er) since 5/12 ranks ninth in the National League.
<b>vs. NEW YORK (NL):</b>	0-2 in three career starts...Went 0-2 in two starts in 2022, losing a 10-0 decision (1.2ip/4r) to Jacob deGrom in game two of a doubleheader at PNC Park on 9/7 and coming away with a no-decision (4.0ip/3r) on 9/18 at Citi Field...He also allowed four runs in 4.0 innings while losing a 7-2 decision on 5/5/21 as a member of the Cardinals.
