WORK HARD, PLAY HARD: The Giants look to secure a series win in today's finale vs. the Pirates...SF is 2-3 this homestand after splitting the first two games of this series following a 1-2 showing vs. the Padres to open the week.

- ▶ SF has lost three straight series and nine of its last 11 games dating to the start of its last road trip on April 28.
- ▶ The Giants enter today nine games under the .500 mark for the second time this season (also on Friday)...prior to this week, the last time SF was nine games under .500 was July 5, 2019.
- ▶ SF's 15-24 (.385) record entering play today is tied for worst in the National League with the New York Mets...only the Angels have a worse record (15-25, .375).

WE DEM BOYZ: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to today's game.

- ▶ **LHP Sam Hentges** (#31) returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List.
- ▶ **RHP Dylan Smith** (#66) recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.
- ▶ **RHP Ryan Walker** and **RHP Gregory Santos** optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame.

PAYPHONE: RHP Tyler Mahle draws the start in today's homestand finale.

- ▶ Mahle is coming off a start at Tampa Bay on May 3 where he allowed just four hits and a walk while striking out five over 5.1 shutout innings.
- ▶ Thanks to his six seasons with the Reds (2017-2022), Mahle has 13 career starts vs. the Pirates, going 5-4 with a 3.84 ERA (30er, 70.1ip) with 70 strikeouts...Mahle has not faced the Pirates since leaving the Reds in 2022.
- ▶ Mahle's most-used pitch is his four-seam fastball (48.1% usage rate)...the Pirates' .740 OPS vs. four-seam fastballs is 22nd in MLB this season.

BLACK AND YELLOW: Since 2021 the Giants are 8-9 here at home against the Pirates and have lost three of the five completed series in that time.

- ▶ Since its opening in 2000, the Giants have a losing record to the Pirates here at Oracle Park (38-44, .463)...the only other NL team SF has a sub-.500 record against in Oracle Park history is the Dodgers (111-115).
- ▶ Pirates starter Bubba Chandler heavily relies on his four-seam fastball (54.4% usage rate)...it has a -5 run value this season per *Baseball Savant*...the Giants have a .692 OPS vs. four-seamers this season (26th in MLB).

YOUNG, WILD & FREE: IF Bryce Eldridge hit his first career home run in the 5th inning last night...at 21 years and 201 days old, he became the second-youngest Giants batter to homer in Oracle Park history, behind only **Luis Matos** (21 years and 147 days old on June 24, 2023 vs. AZ).

- ▶ Eldridge also became the youngest Giants left-handed batter to homer since **Tom O'Malley** (21 years, 135 days old) did so on May 9, 1982 at NYM.
- ▶ He also became the youngest Giants left-handed batter to homer at home in the San Francisco era, and youngest left-handed batter to homer at home overall since **Tookie Gilbert** on June 22, 1950 (21 years, 79 days old).
- ▶ With Eldridge's homer, the Giants have now homered in five straight games (six total in that span) after going six straight games on the previous road trip without a homer.

FR FR: Entering April 28, SF's bullpen had a 2.93 ERA (30er, 92.0ip), which was the third-best bullpen ERA in the Majors at that point...since April 28, the Giants' bullpen has a 5.89 ERA (24er, 36.2ip) and an .898 opposing OPS over the 11-game span (second-highest in the MLB in that span), raising the unit's season ERA to 3.78 (10th in MLB).

ROLL UP: The Giants will hit the road for a 10-day, 10-game road trip starting with a four-game series at the Dodgers Monday-Thursday...following the four-game set, SF will head back to Northern California for a three-game series in West Sacramento next weekend before again heading south to Arizona for a three-game series.

TODAY'S STARTER

TYLER MAHLE RHP #54

2026 RECORD: 1-4, 5.00 ERA

WELCOME TO SF: Is in the midst of his 10th season in the Majors and his first in a Giants uniform...the 31-year-old inked a one-year deal with SF on January 5.

LAST TIME OUT: Tossed 5.1 scoreless innings last Sunday in SF's 2-1 loss in Tampa Bay...held the Rays to four hits with one walk and struck out five in the start...batters were 0-for-10 with four strikeouts off his four-seam fastball.

VS. PITTSBURGH: Will face the Pirates for the 14th time in his career and first since 2022...the right-hander is 5-4 with a 3.84 ERA (30er, 70.1ip) in the 13 starts, averaging nearly a strikeout per inning (70 K's, 70.1ip)...last faced them on May 13, 2022 at PNC Park, when he earned the win after striking out eight batters over 6.0 innings of work and giving up a pair of runs in the Reds' 8-2 win...overall, Mahle's 13 starts and 70.1 innings pitched against Pittsburgh are his third-most vs. any team, trailing only the Cubs (15 starts, 84.1ip) and Cardinals (14 starts, 73.0ip).

HOT AND COLD: Has alternated good and bad starts this season and hasn't found much consistency yet early in the year...in odd-numbered starts (#1, #3, #5 and #7) this season, he's combined to post a 0.82 ERA (2er, 22.0ip) with 21 strikeouts and a .185 opposing average against...in the other three outings (#2, #4, #6), he's gone 0-3 with a 11.57 ERA (18er, 14.0ip) and a .386 BAA.

HOMEBODY: Has been pitching much better here at home this season...in four starts at Oracle Park, the righty has a 2.91 ERA (7er, 21.2ip), .235 BAA and .657 opponents' OPS...in three starts away from home, he is 0-2 with a 8.16 ERA (13er, 14.1ip), .316 opposing average and .964 OPS...last season, Mahle had a 0.84 ERA in 10 starts at home and 4.36 ERA in six road starts.

PUT IT IN REVERSE: Has been putting some significant reverse splits this season, with right handers slashing .338/.434/.585 off him while lefties are just .205/.272/.301.

STAY GROUNDED: The 31-year-old is averaging a 50% ground ball rate this year, currently a career-best and a significant increase from last year's 38.6% mark...in 10 MLB seasons, Mahle has a 42.1% career ground ball rate.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Opponents are 7-for-11 (.636) with a triple and a home run against Mahle on the first pitch of an at-bat.

WORKING THE COUNT: When Mahle gets ahead of the count 0-1, opponents are hitting just .203 with a .527 OPS...after he falls behind 1-0, however, opponents are hitting .276 with a .898 OPS.

NOT SO FAST: Over his last three starts, opponents are just 3-for-27 (.111) with 10 strikeouts in at-bats ending with his four-seamer...overall, Mahle is throwing his four-seam fastball 48.1% of the time this year, averaging 92.5 mph (up 0.5mph from last season) with batters hitting .264 off the pitch...last year, he held batters to a .209 (27x147) clip with the pitch with 10 total XBH.

WALK THIS WAY: Mahle's rocky start to the season is due in part to a couple of odd outliers...the righty is walking batters at a rate of 11.4% this year, the highest of his career and well above his 8.6% career walk rate.

BANANA SPLIT: Batters are hitting .275 (14x51) with 12 strikeouts off his secondary pitch, his split finger, which Mahle throws 25.5% of the time...last year, Mahle's splitter was his most valuable pitch, accumulating a +5 run value...he used the pitch 27.7% of the time last year, with opponents hitting just .196 off his split-finger with 25 strikeouts (24.0% whiff rate).

TOMORROW'S STARTER

TREVOR McDONALD RHP #72

2026 RECORD: 1-0, 1.29 ERA

- ▶ Will face the Dodgers tomorrow after being recalled on Saturday when RHP Logan Webb went on the IL with right knee bursitis.
- ▶ McDonald was superb in his spot start last Tuesday against San Diego, limiting the Padres to one run on two hits in 7.0 innings in SF's 3-2 win.
- ▶ In his brief MLB career (five games, three starts) since 2024, McDonald has allowed four earned runs in 25.0 innings (1.44 ERA), struck out 23 and walked only three.

(bohr-RUCK-ee)

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Split Finger, Sweeper

Last Game: 5/9 vs. PIT; 0.2ip, 2h, r, er (16 pitches)

- ▶ Last four games: 3.1ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, bb, k (.429 BAA, 8.10 ERA).
- ▶ Lefties are 5-for-26 (.192) with three walks and seven strikeouts vs. him...has held lefties to a .182 clip (72-for-395) in his MLB career.
- ▶ Righties, however, are 12-for-24 with five XBH (two HRs) this year.
- ▶ Played for Pittsburgh from 2023-2025, pitching in 87 games.
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with Chicago-AL as an NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.

#34 JT BRUBAKER ▶ RHP

(BROO-baker)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Cutter, Changeup

Last Game: 5/9 vs. PIT; 0.2ip, 4h, 4r, 3er, k (30 pitches)

- ▶ In his last four outings, he has a 7.11 ERA (5er, 6.1ip) and .370 BAA (10x27)...in nine games prior, he had a 2.38 ERA (3er, 11.1ip) and .250 BAA (10x48).
- ▶ Has thrown 8.1 scoreless innings in six appearances on the road...has a 7.71 ERA (8er, 9.1ip) in seven games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in eight of 13 contests (5.60 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Right-handers are 13-for-40 (.325) with four XBHs off him while lefties are 7-for-27 (.259).
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Pirates in the 6th round in 2015 out of University of Akron...made his debut with Pittsburgh in 2020 and spent three seasons with PIT from 2020-22, appearing in 63g (61 starts).

#93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

Last Game: 5/9 vs. PIT; 0.2ip, h, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has surrendered three runs (two ER) in 16.0ip this year (1.13 ERA).
- ▶ Has not allowed an earned run in his last 10g (7.2ip, 4h, 1r, 6bb, 3k).
- ▶ Lefties are just 2-for-18 (.111) against him this season, and 19-for-101 in his career (.188).
- ▶ His 26.7% hard hit rate ranks in the top 5% of MLB.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.

#31 SAM HENTGES ▶ LHP

(HENT-chiss)

Pitch Arsenal: Curveball, 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker

Last Game: 5/8 vs. RNO; 0.1ip, 2bb, k (21 pitches) (w/AAA)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day IL earlier today...will make his first appearance in a Giants uniform.
- ▶ In 10 rehab games between Single-A San Jose and Triple-A Sacramento, the lefty had a 1.93 ERA (2er, 9.1ip) with six walks and eight strikeouts.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness uring his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ His next outing will mark his first MLB action since July 10, 2024.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/8 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, h, r, er, 2bb (35 pitches)

- ▶ Earned his first career save Monday night despite allowing a homer in SF's 3-2 win...has allowed a run in each of his last two outings after allowing just one run in his first 14 games.
- ▶ Has a 9.53 K/9ip ratio.
- ▶ Owns a 25.7% strikeout rate but also has a 14.3% walk rate...owns a .208 xBA.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are just 5-for-34 (.147) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 4-for-24 (.167) with two homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#63 JOEL PEGUERO ▶ RHP

(jo-EL peh-GAIR-oh)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/6 vs. SD; 1.0ip, k (8 pitches)

- ▶ Activated on Tuesday after 10 rehab games with Triple-A Sacramento...missed SF's first 35 games while recovering from a left hamstring strain that also held him out of most of Spring Training.
- ▶ Has tossed 2.0 scoreless frames since returning from the IL, allowing just one hit so far.
- ▶ Had a 4.82 ERA (5er, 9.1ip) with 11 strikeouts and a 0.86 WHIP in the 10 rehab outings.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2025 with SF after signing with the org. prior to the season on an MiLB contract...posted a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA (6er, 22.1ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP over 17 games.
- ▶ His sinker averaged 99.8 mph and his four-seamer 99.9 mph last season...his slider averaged 91.6 mph and accounted for 12 of his 15 strikeouts.

#66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP
