RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers kick off a three-game series tonight at Busch Stadium for Fan Appreciation Weekend ... The Cardinals began their final homestand of the season by dropping two-of-three to the Cincinnati Reds.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters tonight in 4th place in the National League Central and 5.0 games back of the Mets (79-74) for the third and final Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals postseason elimination number stands at five (four vs. the Mets) ... With nine games remaining, St. Louis needs seven more wins to end at .500 and to go at least 8-1 for a winning record (82+ wins) ... The last time St. Louis posted two losing seasons over a three-year span was 1997 (73-89) and 1999 (75-86).

GAMES THAT MATTER: Since 2011 Opening Day, the Cardinals have played 2,295 out of a possible 2,317 regular season games (99.1%) during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated.

BETTER AT BUSCH: The Cardinals have clinched a winning record at Busch Stadium III (42-36, .538) for the 18th time in 20 seasons since the stadium was opened (2006-25), 3rd-most winning seasons at home behind only the Dodgers (20) and Yankees (20).

- Since 2006, their all-time .575 win pct (897-662) at Busch III also ranks 3rd to the Dodgers (.622, 974-593) & Yankees (.614, 960-604).
- Among teams in MLB history over their initial 20 seasons at primary home venues, the Cardinals .575 win pct. at Busch III ranks 11th-best and is 2nd in franchise history to the Gashouse Gang's first 20 years at Sportsman Park (.596, 901-611) from 1920-39. - *Elias Sports Bur.*
- The New York Yankees hold the MLB record by starting 1,027-501 (.672) at Original Yankee Stadium from 1923-42. - *Elias Sports Bur.*

IT'S ALWAY SONNY IN ST. LOUIS: St. Louis is 14-5 in **Sonny Gray's** starts at Busch Stadium this season, most home team wins for a starting pitcher in MLB (**Chris Bassitt** is 2nd; Toronto is 13-3 at Rogers Centre).

- With a Cardinals victory, Gray would match 2010 **Chris Carpenter** (15-4 at Busch III) for the most single-season team wins at Busch Stadium III while also tying 1942 **Mort Cooper** (15-6 at Sportsman's/ Busch I), 1964 **Bob Gibson** (15-5 at Busch I), 1985 **John Tudor** (15-4 at Busch II), and 2003 **Woody Williams** (15-3 at Busch II) for 2nd-most home team wins in single-season team history
- 2001 **Matt Morris** holds the franchise record, with St. Louis going 16-2 in his 18 starts at Busch II.

THE LEFTORIUM: Four of MLB's top nine leaders in batting average among left-handed hitters play in tonight's game: **Sal Frelick** (.296, 1st), **Brice Turang** (.289, 3rd), **Alec Burleson** (.285, 6th) and **Brendan Donovan** (.281, T-8th).

KINGS OF THE NORTH: The Springfield Cardinals (AA) are on to Texas League Championship Series for the first time since 2012 after sweeping the Tulsa Drillers (Dodgers) in the best-of-three semifinals ... Springfield clinched the series last night with a 3-0 shutout win at Hammons Field after waiting out a 3:13 rain delay to start the game ... The S-Cards advanced behind five shutout innings from left-handed starter **Brycen Mautz**, followed two perfect innings by reigning Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month, **Luis Gastelum** ... Springfield will look to capture its 2nd overall championship (also 2012) when it hosts Game 1 of the best-of-three series against the Midland RockHounds (Athletics) on Sunday ... Springfield set a franchise record in victories (88-50, .638), while winning both halves in the same season for the 2nd time in franchise history (2007).

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Erick Fedde made 30 starts for St. Louis over parts of two seasons (2024-25)...acquired at the 2024 MLB Trade Deadline from the White Sox as part of three-team trade with the Dodgers.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Stratton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Brewers Media Relations Intern **Owen Buescher** previously worked as a 2024 Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate...graduated from Belleville (Ill.) West High School and Univ. of Missouri.

Late Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** & **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Jacob Misiorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Willson Contreras's younger brother, **William**, is a catcher for the Brewers.

Caleb Durbin played college baseball at Washington University in St. Louis (2019-21).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Cardinals Dir. of Medical Ops/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay...graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his 31st start of the season (339th career appearance/329th start). It's his 59th career start for St. Louis.
- Boasts the highest strikeout percentage on the Sweeper (51.0) of those with 100 or more batters faced.**
- Marks his 5th season with 30 or more starts and first since 2023 with Minnesota.
- Ranks 7th among active pitchers with 328 starts.
- Ranks 108th in career strikeouts with 1,911. Passed Jerry Reuss (1969-90) in his last start and is seven behind Hideo Nomo (1995-2008) in 107th with 1,918.
- Is the first Cardinal with back-to-back 10-win seasons since **Adam Wainwright** (2021-22).
- Has a 9-5 record with a 4.04 ERA (13 HR) in 19 home starts, but 4-3 with a 5.11 ERA (10 HR) in 11 road starts.
- The Cardinals are 20-10 in Gray's 30 starts this season. Tied for 5th for most team wins for any pitcher.**
- St. Louis is 14-5 in his 19 home starts this season, most wins by a home team record for any starting pitcher in MLB this season.** Chris Bassitt (TOR) is 2nd with 13.
- Sonny's 18 wins at home since joining St. Louis (2024-25) tie **Carlos Rodon** for 2nd-most in MLB to **Tarik Skubal (19)**.
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (27.7%) - 9th-best in the NL.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks T-28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in MLB-leading 22-of-30 starts this season; St. Louis is 15-7 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 6th-most in MLB. Tigers LHP Tarik Skubal (12) leads the list.
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (261 K). **Kyle Lohse** ranks 9th with 297 strikeouts.
- 23 of his 169 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **38 of his 89 runs (42.7%) allowed this season have come via home run.**
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25), ranks among MLB leaders in strikeouts (390, 6th) and wins (26, T-7th).
- St. Louis is 37-21 (.638) in his 58 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 26-17 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, Sept. 13 at Milwaukee):

- Pitched a solid 5.0 innings allowing just two runs on four hits with eight strikeouts. Departed with a 6-2 lead that ended up as a 9-8 Cardinals loss in 10 innings for a no decision.

2025:

- Surpassed Josh Beckett for 109th all-time now with 1,903 strikeouts. Became the 9th-active pitcher with 1,900 career innings.
- Became 1-of-29 pitchers with 5 seasons with 30 or more starts since 2014 joining teammate Miles Mikolas and retired Cardinal Adam Wainwright.
- Has two starts holding the opposition to one hit this season (8/4 at LAD 7.0 IP & 6/27 at CLE 9.0 IP).
- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug. 22, 2022.*

- Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone's** perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw *shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer*.
- His 19 starts before the All-Star Break tied his single-season most (2014).

GRAY vs. MILWAUKEE

- Will be making back-to-back starts against Milwaukee last facing the Brewers on Saturday at American Family Field.
- Struck out eight in his last start vs. MIL, his most in a game since fanning eight at Los Angeles-NL on Aug. 4,
- **Of pitchers with 100 or more career innings vs. the Brewers, tops the list with an 11.42 strikeouts/9 IP/ Luis Castillo (11.21) and Randy Johnson (10.92) rank 2nd and 3rd.**
- Is 4-6 with a 3.63 ERA in 19 career starts vs. the Brewers since 2016. Has yet to earn a win as a member of the Cardinals (last: 8/26/21 w/CIN).
- In two starts at Busch Stadium with the Cardinals is 0-1 with a 3.65 ERA. Started on April 26 in a no decision the Cardinals won 6-5.
- Took the loss at Busch Stadium on 4/21/24, a 2-0 defeat to the Brewers, when he struck out a season-high 12; Allowed three straight two-out singles in the 7th inning accounting for the two runs.
- Has held N.L. Central opponents to one earned run or less in 5-of-9 starts this season; 3-of-other-4 starts vs. Milwaukee.
