#### SNAKEBITES

**THE NL CHAMPS:** The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs reinstated RHP **Zac Gallen** from the 15-day injured list (strained right hamstring) and optioned LHP **Brandon Hughes** to Reno following last night's game.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 4-9 last night vs. Athletics.

- ◆ **Ketel Marte** reached base in his fifth consecutive game and has 3 multi-hit performances in his last 4 games.
- ♦ Lourdes Gurriel Jr. recorded his seventh multi-hit game in his last 9 and collected his 11th homer.
- ♦ D-backs pitchers combined for 15 strikeouts last night vs. Athletics, which tied a season high (also: April 28 @ Mariners)...in 2023, Arizona arms combined for 5 occurrences of 15+ strikeouts.

**#VOTE4KETEL - 2024 ALL-STAR GAME: Ketel Marte** is a finalist at second base for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game after leading all NL second basemen (1,853,424 votes), ahead of fellow finalist Luis Arraez/SD (1,760,593 votes) and Phase 2 of fan voting is live tomorrow at 9:00 a.m. through Wed., July 3 at 9:00 a.m. at **MLB.com/vote**.

- Marte was last an All-Star and fan-elected starter in 2019...he looks to join Paul Goldschmidt as the only players in franchise history with multiple fan elections.

- **IT'S MARTE'S PART-AY: Ketel** Marte leads all second basemen with a 4.2 bWAR, .519 SLG, .865 OPS, 17 homers, 37 XBH, 48 RBI and 161 total bases, is tied for first with 11 defensive runs saved, second with 18 doubles, tied for second with a 1.3 dWAR and third with 88 hits.
- ♦ His 4.2 bWAR is second in the NL (7th in MLB), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (4.7).

# SCHULTE TO RECEIVE 2023 AZ SPORTSCASTER OF THE YEAR AWARD:

On Monday, July 1, inaugural voice of the D-backs, **Greg "The Gub'nuh" Schulte**, will receive the 2023 Arizona Sportscaster of the Year award during the 64th National Sports Media Association (NSMA) Awards Banquet in Greensboro, N.C.

- ♦ Schulte retired in 2023 following the D-backs World Series run and 26 total seasons with the D-backs, calling nearly 4,000 Regular-Season and Postseason games on radio and TV.
- ♦ In Sept. 2023, the D-backs dedicated the longtime radio broadcaster and renamed the booth the "Greg Schulte Radio Booth".

**THE NL CHAMPS:** The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made letics, is hitting .421 (8-for-19) with 1 double and 2 RBI.

◆ Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has 3 homers in his last 4 games vs. Athletics...over his last 9 games, is batting .394 (13-for-33) with 6 extra-base hits and 8 RBI.

**FIRST-INNING FANS:** The D-backs are the only team in the Majors with a .300+ average in the first inning (.323; 109-for-337) while their 109 first-inning hits lead the Majors.

◆ Arizona's 18 occurrences with 2+ runs in the first inning are the second most in MLB, behind the Yankees (19).

**BASH BROS:** Over their last 5 games, both **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** and **Ketel Marte** boast a .389 AVG and have combined for 6 extra-base hits and 10 RBI.

- ◆ Gurriel Jr.: .389 (7-for-18)/1.067 OPS, 13B, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 1 BB (2 K)
- ◆ Marte: .389 (7-for-18)/1.283 OPS, 2 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, 2 BB (2 K)

**MULTI-HIT GURRIEL:** Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 26 occurrences with 2+ hits in a game this season are tied for fourth most in the NL (also: Bryan Reynolds/PIT), behind Luis Arraez/SD (33), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (31) and Ezequiel Tovar/COL (28).

AT A GLANCE: Sixth season with the D-backs.

 2023 All-MLB First Team, NL Cy Young finalist and D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona chapter of the BBWAA for the third time (2020, '22, '23) after going 17-9 with a 3.47 ERA (81 ER in 210.0 IP) and 220 strikeouts over 34 starts.

**GALLEN'S UNCORK FOR A CAUSE:** Zac Gallen hosted Uncork For A Cause benefitting the Zac Gallen Charitable Fund, his first charity event, on May 15...the 250 guests enjoyed an exclusive wine tasting soiree featuring limited-edition autographed bottles of Zac's very own Sonoma Reserve Red Wine...the event raised \$100,000 to be donated to St. Mary's Food Bank to ensure children will receive milk during the difficult summer months.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** Reinstated from the 15-day injured list (right hamstring strain) prior to today's game.

- · 12th start of the season, sixth @ home.
- First home start since May 24 vs. Miami (L; 3 ER in 7.0 IP, 8 H, 1 BB, 5
- Limiting opponents to a .149 average (10-for-67) with 31 strikeouts off his curveball.

MILESTONE TRACKER: Is 11 strikeouts shy of 800 career.

**LAST START:** Was removed in the first inning with a right hamstring strain after tossing just 6 pitches on May 30 @ Mets.

**VS. ATHLETICS**: Has faced the A's twice, both @ Chase Field, going 0-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER in 11.0 IP), .150 AVG (6-for-40)/.209 OBP/.300 SLG, 0.82 WHIP, 3 walks and 16 strikeouts.

**HOME COOKIN:** In 5 home starts (4 quality), is 3-2 with a 2.05 ERA (7 ER in 30.2 IP), .225 AVG (25-for-111), 8 walks, 31 strikeouts and 1 home run allowed.

- Has allowed 1 run or fewer runs in 3 of his 5 home starts this season, including 2 starts with 0 runs.
- Has issued walks to 2 or fewer batters in 4 of his 5 contests.

**FRANCHISE RANKINGS**: Ranks among D-backs starters in franchise history in ERA (4th, 3.23), WHIP (4th, 1.11), strikeouts (6th, 746), wins (9th, 43) and quality starts (9th, 65).

**AMONG OTHER STARTERS:** Since 2022, his 13 starts of 6.0+ shutout innings, 6+ strikeouts and 3-or-fewer hits allowed are the most in the Majors ahead of Corbin Burnes/BAL (12), Blake Snell/SF (11), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (10) and Luis Castillo/SEA (10).

**RUN SUPPORT:** Is 4-0 with a 1.17 ERA (3 ER in 23.0 IP) when the D-backs score 6+ runs in his starts.

**VS. LEFT AND RIGHT:** Holding left-handed hitters to a .231 AVG (24-for-104) with 8 walks and 25 strikeouts, while righties are batting .241 (27-for-112) with 7 walks and 35 strikeouts.

• In his last 5 starts, is holding lefties to a .184 AVG (9-for-49) with 2 walks and 13 strikeouts.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** Holding runners in scoring position to a .200 AVG (6-for-30) with 1 walk and 12 strikeouts @ home.

 Runners in scoring position with 2 outs are batting .150 (3-for-20) with 1 walk and 8 strikeouts.

**INNINGS 5-6:** In innings 5-6, is 5-4 with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP), .200 AVG (11-for-55)/.267 OBP/.364 SLG, 1.00 WHIP, 5 walks and 14 strikeouts.

 At home, is holding hitters in innings 5-6 to a .111 AVG (3-for-27)/.200 OBP/.128 SLG.

**1, 4, 7 AND 9 HITTERS:** Opponents batting first are hitting .185 (5-for-27) with 6 strikeouts, batting fourth are hitting .148 (4-for-27) with 7 strikeouts, batting seventh are hitting .174 (4-for-23) with 10 strikeouts and batting ninth are hitting .095 (2-for-21) with 10 strikeouts.

**2 STRIKES:** Limiting hitters to a .167 AVG (19-for-114), 7 walks and 60 strikeouts with 2 strikes.

**EARLY RISER:** In his last 5 day starts dating back to Sept. 8, 2023 vs. Cubs, is 4-1 with a 1.97 ERA (7 ER in 32.0 IP), .202 AVG (23-for-114), 0.97 WHIP, 8 walks and 34 strikeouts.

**CYYOUNG HOPEFUL:** Finished third (68 votes) in 2023 NL Cy Young Award voting behind Blake Snell/SD (204) and Logan Webb/SF (86).

- In 2022 voting, finished fifth (45 votes).
- In 2020 voting, finished tied for ninth (2 votes)

**ALL-STAR STARTER:** Named to his first All-Star Game in 2023 at T-Mobile Park and earned the starting nod...tossed 1.0 scoreless inning with 1 strikeout.

- At 27 years old, became the youngest D-backs pitcher, third overall (fourth time) and first since Curt Schilling (35 in 2002) to start an All-Star Game (also: Randy Johnson; 36 in 2000 and 37 in 2001.
- Was the youngest NL starting pitcher since Matt Harvey/NYM in 2013 (24).

**2023 POSTSEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Won the series-clincher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card @ Brewers (2 ER in 6.0 IP) on Oct. 4, 2023.

- Won Game 2 of the NLDS @ Dodgers (2 ER in 5.1 IP) on Oct. 9, 2023.
- In 6 postseason starts, went 2-3 with a 4.54 ERA (17 ER in 33.2 IP), .248 opponent average, 14 walks and 24 strikeouts.
- Game 1 starter for NLCS @ Phillies and World Series @ Rangers.

**2023 RECAP:** Set career highs in virtually all categories, including wins, innings and strikeouts in 2023.

- His combined 243.2 innings in the regular season and postseason combined were 24.0 more innings than any other pitcher.
- Along with Gerrit Cole (209.0 IP, 222 K), were the only pitchers in the Majors in 2023 with 200.0+ innings and 200+ strikeouts.
- In 2023, ranked among qualifying National League leaders in innings pitched (2nd, 210.0), starts (2nd, 34), wins (2nd, 17), strikeouts (3rd, 220), WHIP (6th, 1.12), win percentage (6th, .654), ERA (7th, 3.47) and opponent average (T-9th, .238).

**HOW HE STARTED:** Cardinals' third-round pick in the 2016 draft out of the University of North Carolina.

- Made his Major League debut on June 20, 2019 for the Marlins @ Cardinals (7-6 win, ND, 5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 6 K).
- Acquired by D-backs on July 31, 2019 from the Marlins.
- Made his D-backs debut on August 7, 2019 vs. Phillies (6-1 win, W, 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 6 K).

- ♦In his last 12 games with runners on, is limiting hitters to a .154 AVG (2-for-13)/.214 OBP with 3 strikeouts, 1 walk and 0 extra-base hits.
