THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, going 1-2 at Colorado over the weekend, followed by a loss in Los Angeles to the Dodgers last night...tonight, they will play the second of three at Dodger Stadium...after tomorrow afternoon's series/roadtrip finale, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off day on Thursday, then start a six-game homestand with three against the Nationals this weekend, then three against the Red Sox next Monday-Wednesday.

DODGER BLACK AND BLUE: The Twins lost to the Dodgers last night in Los Angeles by a score of 5-2...David Festa (3-4) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...three of the four hits were home runs by Will Smith (2) and Shohei Ohtani...the offense out-hit the Dodgers 9-7 but left 13 men on base and went 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position...Royce Lewis went 3-for-4 with a double and Matt Wallner reached four times on the night (2 hits, 2 walks).

DODGE BALL: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 26th, 27th and 28th times in their history this week...the Twins are 8-18 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 2-10 all-time at Dodger Stadium, 3-8 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome.
⌘ The Twins .308 winning percentage against LA is their second-lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961), trailing Atlanta (.286 — 8-20).
⌘ Byron Buxton has hit safely in eight-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he is hitting .364 (12-for-33) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, three walks and a 1.114 OPS...he has hit safely in all five career games at Dodger Stadium, hitting .429 (9-for-21) with two doubles, three home runs and a 1.452 OPS.

STADIUM ARCADIUUM: In the regular season, Minnesota is 2-10 all-time against the Dodgers at Dodger Stadium...including the Postseason, the Twins are 2-13 all-time vs. the Dodgers at Dodger Stadium, going 0-3 in this ballpark during the 1965 World Series.
⌘ The Twins first win vs. the Dodgers at Dodger Stadium came on June 11, 2005, a 5-3 victory as Carlos Silva beat Derek Lowe...Justin Morneau and Torii Hunter both homered for the Twins in that game as Morneau had four RBI.
⌘ Their other win was on May 16, 2023, a 5-1 victory as Bailey Ober beat Clayton Kershaw...Twins had 11 hits, including a home run from Kyle Farmer...Byron Buxton and Willi Castro each had two hits.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone 14-20 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 2-1 at Milwaukee (May 16-18), 1-2 at Cincinnati (June 17-19), 0-3 vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), 1-2 at Miami (July 1-3), 2-1 vs. Chicago (July 8-10), 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh (July 11-13), 1-2 at Colorado (July 18-20) and 0-1 at Los Angeles-NL.

ONE-NOTHING: Byron Buxton hit his 15th career leadoff home run last night off Shohei Ohtani...he has six leadoff home runs on the season, tied for third-most in baseball...last night's leadoff homer passed Chuck Knoblauch and tied Max Kepler for third-most in Twins history (since 1961)...below are Twins all-time leadoff homers (left) and MLB leadoff homers (right).

FOUR-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton hit his 23rd home run of the season last night, five short of his career-high of 28, done in 2022...Buck is on pace for 37 home runs on the season.
⌘ He has a 13.57 at-bat-per-home run ratio, third-best in the AL and sixth-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.58), Eugenio Suárez (10.06), Aaron Judge (10.19), Shohei Ohtani (11.03) and Kyle Schwarber (11.47).
⌘ Since June 17, Buck has 12 home runs (27 games), tied with Nick Kurtz, Cal Raleigh and Kyle Stowers for second-most in baseball, trailing Eugenio Suárez (15).
⌘ Over his last 32 games, Buxton is hitting .344 (42-for-122) with eight doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 20 RBI, 31 runs scored, 11 walks, a .407 on-base percentage, a .746 slugging percentage and a 1.153 OPS.
⌘ Over his last six games, he has 14 hits in 27 at-bats (.519).

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in eight-straight games with an at-bat, tied for the second-longest of his career...also ties his season-high, previously done April 26-May 6...his career-high is 14 (July 15-August 9, 2023)...in 14 games this month, Jeffers is hitting .421 (16-for-38) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, four walks, a .488 on-base percentage, a .605 slugging percentage and a 1.094 OPS.
⌘ Jeffers has reached base nine times in his last 14 plate appearances (.643 OBP)...he reached four times on four hits on Saturday in Colorado and four times last night on two hits and two walks.

MAJORITY RULES: Twins need a win tonight and tomorrow to secure their 15th series win of the season...a loss tonight and the Twins will drop their second-straight series, which would mark the first time since June 27-July 3 when they lost consecutive series' at Detroit and at Miami...Minnesota is 14-16-2 in series play, going 9-5-2 at home and 5-11-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play from March 27-April 13...after that stretch, they went 9-2-1 from April 14-May 25...but since have gone 4-10-1 since May 26.

HERE'S JHONNY: Earlier today, the Twins claimed catcher Johnny Pereda off waivers from the Athletics and optioned him to Triple-A St. Paul...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated catcher Jair Camargo for release or assignment.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2021, the Twins acquired Joe Ryan (along with Drew Strotman) from Tampa Bay, in exchange for Nelson Cruz...at the time, Ryan was in Tokyo, Japan, participating in the delayed 2020 Olympics as a member of Team USA's baseball squad.
