onight, the Rays look to avoid a season-high fourth straight loss...they have not dropped four consecutive games since a five-game skid last season from July 16 20...Tampa Bay has dropped four consecutive road games overall and looks to avoid its first five-game road losing streak since Oct. 1-5, 2022.
Tampa Bay is seeking its first win at American Family Field since June 22, 2011, nearly 13 years ago.
The Rays are three games under . 500 for the first time since April 16, 2021, when they entered play with a 5-8 record...they have not been four games under . 500 since opening the 2018 campaign 1-5.
Tampa Bay is 1-8 in series openers, tied with Arizona and Chicago-AL for the second-worst mark in the majors behind Miami (0-9)...the Rays last series-opening win on the road was a 9-7 victory at Fenway Park on Sept. 26, 2023.
Kevin Cash (752) remains three victories shy of surpassing Joe Maddon (754) as the Rays all-time managerial wins leader.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS-Earlier today, RHP Chris Devenski (right knee tendinitis) was placed on the 15-day IL and LHP Jacob Lopez was recalled from Triple-A Durham.
REHABBING RAYS-Yesterday, RHP Taj Bradley began his rehab assignment with Triple-A Durham and did not allow a hit over 5.0 scoreless innings, walking one and striking out seven.

CF Jonny DeLuca made his third rehab appearance with the Bulls yesterday and went 0-for-2 with two walks and two runs scored.
Making his second rehab appearance with Durham, 1B Jonathan Aranda went 0 -for-4 with one walk
(NOT SO) EXTRA, EXTRA!-Tampa Bay has recorded 67 extra-base hits, tied with St. Louis for the fifth fewest in the majors, ahead of only Miami (58XBH), Chicago-AL (59XBH), Seattle ( 62 XBH ) and Pittsburgh ( 67 XBH )...they have, however, tallied 14 XBH (9 2B, 5HR) over their last four games, accounting for 21.0 pct . of their season total.

Tampa Bay has recorded multiple doubles in each of its last four games, the third longest active streak in the majors behind Los Angeles-AL (12G) and Atlanta (5G). Despite the lack of extra-base hits, the Rays have the 12th-most total hits in the majors, as their 173 singles rank fourth in MLB behind Los Angeles-NL (183), San Diego (180) and Houston (176).
BETTER LATE THAN NEVER-Tampa Bay is batting . 269 from the 7th inning on, the third-best mark in the majors behind Atlanta (.303) and San Francisco (.276)...from innings $1-6$, the Ray are hitting .231 , ranking 20th in the majors.

Amed Rosario is batting 394 (13-for-33) with 8 RBI in the 7th inning or later, the second-highest average in the AL behind DET Gio Urshela...Isaac Paredes ranks third in the AL with a 387 (12-for-31) average in such situations.
RAYS ON THE POND-Since April 16, a stretch in which Tampa Bay is 4-8, Rays batters have left 88 players on base, the fourth-highest total in MLB during that time behind Los Angeles-NL (98) and Boston/Milwaukee (both 94)...the Rays are also batting .180 with runners in scoring position during that span, the fifth-lowest clip in MLB behind Pittsburgh (.122), Oakland/St. Louis (.161) and Toronto (.176).

Randy Arozarena has left 53 players on base this season, tied with NYY Aaron Judge for the most in the AL behind DET Spencer Torkelson (55).
GET UP. GET UP. GET OUTTA HERE, GONE!-Tampa Bay pitching has surrendered 39 HR, second most in MLB behind Chicago-AL (41)...the Rays bullpen has allowed an MLB-high 19 HR, but have limited opponents to 5 HR over the last 12 games since April 16.
(OBP)ALACIOS-Prior to his final two at-bats yesterday, Richie Palacios reached base safely in eight straight plate appearances, going 5 -for-5 with one home run and three walks (two intentional).

Per Elias, the last Ray to reach base safely in eight straight plate appearances was David Peralta (also 8PA) from Aug. 26-28, 2022 (5-for-5, 32B, 3BB).

HOT AND COLD-In 10 games since April 13, Ben Rortvedt is 10-for-24 (.417) with 3 RBI, four walks and four runs...he has reached base safely in each of his last five plate appearances, going 3 -for-3 with two walks.

RHP Jason Adam has allowed not allowed an ER in 9.2 innings over his last nine appearances since April 6, scattering two hits and three walks with six strikeouts. LHP Garrett Cleavinger has struck out 1+ batters in seven straight appearances since April 7 spanning 6.2 innings, allowing only one unearned run and fanning 12 batters during that stretch...he is one game shy of matching his career-best streak of eight straight appearances with a strikeout (April 12-Sept. 10, 2022).
Randy Arozarena has gone a career-long 25 straight games without a multi-hit performance dating to March 31...his . 121 (11-for-91) AVG in April is the lowest among all qualified players, with the next closest being SEA Mitch Garver (.137). Jose Siri has struck out in 18 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the majors...it marks the second-longest streak of his career behind a 24-game run from July 15-Aug. 15, 2023 that was the longest in Rays history

INTERLEAGUE INTEL-Since 2021, Tampa Bay is 58-34 (.630) in Interleague play, the third-best winning pct. in the majors over that timeframe behind Los Angeles-NL (61-31, 663) and Toronto (62-33, .653)

The Rays are 4-2 in Interleague play this season despite posting a 5.57 ERA (53.1IP, 33ER) across those contests...the only clubs with a worse Interleague ERA in 2024 are Milwaukee (6.03), Colorado (6.15) and Chicago-AL (7.41)

BRATS AND BREWS-Tampa Bay and Milwaukee kick off a three-game set tonight at American Family Field...the two clubs will be meeting in Milwaukee for only the third time...Tampa Bay took two of three from Milwaukee from June 20-22, 2011 and did not return until Aug. 9-10, 2022, when Milwaukee swept a two-game series.

Milwaukee Associate Manager Rickie Weeks Jr., finished his playing career in Tampa Bay, appearing in 37 games for the Rays in 2017.

TONIGHT'S START-Pepiot will make his sixth start of the year and second on the road...has gone 1-0 with a 1.50 ERA (12.0IP, 2ER) in his last two starts...he is 2-0 with a 1.23 ERA (22.0IP, 3ER), 0.59 WHIP and .145 (11-for-76) opponent average over his last four outings (2GS) on the road dating back to Sept. 7, 2023...min. 25.0 IP, his 0.98 WHIP ranks sixth among AL hurlers.

LAST TIME OUT-He did not factor into the decision of the Rays 4-2 loss to the Tigers on April 23 at Tropicana Field despite tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball (6.0IP, 3H, ER, 2BB, 4SO)...did not allow a hit the first time through the order, but Riley Greene tagged him for a solo homer in the 3rd frame...permitted a Mark Canha two-out double in the 6th, but fanned Kerry Carpenter to conclude the outing...his 4 SO were his second fewest in an outing of 6.0+ IP (3SO on Sept. 7, 2023 at MIA).

THE BREW CREW-Pepiot will make his second career start opposite the Brewers this evening, both of which have come at American Family Field...on Aug. 16, 2022 in Milwaukee, he worked into the 4th inning in his sixth career start, but tied career highs with five walks and 2 HR allowed (4.2IP, 3H, 3ER, 5BB, 6SO, 2HR)...along with his MLB debut on May 11, 2022 at Pittsburgh, Pepiot owns a 3.52 ERA (7.2IP, 3ER) with 10 BB and 9 SO in two career starts against NL Central opponents.
LOCKED IN-Pepiot has allowed one run or fewer over 6.0+ frames in back-to-back outings for the second time in his career, joining Sept. 19-26 2023, when he did so while working behind an opener...with another such effort tonight, Pepiot would become the first Rays pitcher to accomplish the feat in three straight outings since Tyler Glasnow's three-start run from July 25-Aug. 14, 2023...it would also mark the first time he has thrown three straight quality starts in his career.

ANARTIST AT WORK-Pepiot's 33.2 pct. whiff rate leads the AL and ranks fifth in the majors, trailing PIT Jared Jones (37.5\%), DET Jack Flaherty (35.0\%), MIL Freddy Peralta (33.8\%) and NYM José Butto (33.3\%)... 27 o his 31 SO have been swinging strikeouts...the 31 SO are tied for sixth most through a pitcher's first five games with the Rays...Jake Faria holds the record through five games (35SO) while Taj Bradley (42SO) set the mark through six outings last season.
HEAT CHECK-Pepiot's four-seam fastball has been one of the most effective pitches in the majors...opponents are just 4-for-45 (.089) with 18 SO against the offering...min. 40 AB , the only individual pitch in the majors with a lower mark is PIT Bailey Falter's four-seam fastball (.069). Pepiot has produced a 39.0 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the second highest mark on any MLB pitcher's fastball (min. 50 pitches swung at) trailing only OAK Mason Miller's four-seamer (50.0\%).

While opponents have gone a combined 10-for-73 (.137) in at-bats that end with Pepiot's fastball and slider, they are 8 -for- 25 (.320) against his changeup.
HUNG OUT TO DRY-The Rays have been outscored, 27-12 (-15), in Pepiot's starts...they have provided him with only 2.51 runs of suppor per 9.0 IP, eighth lowest among AL pitchers (min. 25.0IP)...in his career as a starter, Pepiot is 6-0 with a 2.15 ERA (54.1IP, 13ER) when receiving just two or more runs of support (10GS) and 0-3 with a 6.46 ERA (23.2IP, 17ER) with one or zero runs ( 5 GS )...in the three starts in which he received multiple runs of support this season, Pepiot is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (18.0IP, 2ER)...this compared to 0-2 with an 8.44 ERA (10.2IP, 10ER) in his other two starts.

The Rays have not scored more than three runs in any of Pepiot's starts...they are averaging just 2.4 runs per start in his five outings compared to 4.3 runs in their other 24 contests.

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE-He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.20 ERA (15.0IP, 2ER) and 0.73 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to a 6.59 ERA (13.2IP, 10ER) and 1.24 WHIP in all other frames...four of the 10 runs he's allowed have come in the 1st inning.
THAT'S RIGHT-Min. 40 AB , his .143 (6-for-42) opp. average against righthanded batters is the lowest in the AL and fourth lowest in MLB behind SD Dylan Cease (.090), PIT Bailey Falter (.123) and PHI Zack Wheeler (.129)...righties are 5-for-46 (.109) with 15 SO vs. his four-seam fastball/ slider combination.
