AN ARTIST AT WORK—Pepiot's 33.2 pct. whiff rate leads the AL and ranks fifth in the majors, trailing PIT Jared Jones (37.5%), DET Jack Flaherty (35.0%), MIL Freddy Peralta (33.8%) and NYM José Butto (33.3%)...27 of his 31 SO have been swinging strikeouts...the 31 SO are tied for sixth most through a pitcher's first five games with the Rays...Jake Faria holds the record through five games (35SO) while Taj Bradley (42SO) set the mark through six outings last season.
