One-Run Games

Every game in Atlanta's previous series at New York-AL was decided by one run. The Yankees won the first two games, 3-2 and 5-4, before the Braves won the finale, 2-1.

The Braves own a .514 winning percentage (19-18) in one-run games this year. Since July 12, though, their .643 mark (9-5) ranks third in the National League behind Cincinnati (.833) and Milwaukee (.800).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets will today commence their final scheduled series of the 2026 campaign, beginning a three-game midweek series... Atlanta must sweep this series to earn a victory in the season set...With a single loss, the Braves will lose the season series to the Mets for the first time since 2017 (7-12, .368).

 The Braves lost a series to the Yankees over the weekend in the Bronx, two games-to-one...Each of the three games was decided by a single run.

 The Braves and Mets are slated to play all 13 of their regular season games during the summer months for the second consecutive season...Each of the contests between these two clubs will be played between June 12 and August 12...In that span, 24% of Atlanta's total games will be against New York.

 Atlanta played to an 8-5 record against New York last season, including a 4-2 mark here at Truist Park...The Braves have taken the season series from the Mets for nine consecutive seasons dating to 2018, and are 80-55 (.593) against New York in that span.

 RH Christian Scott is scheduled to make his fourth career start against the Braves...The 6-foot-4, 215-pound right-hander has shouldered the loss every time he's faced Atlanta (0-3) while posting a 3.94 ERA (7 ER/16.0 IP)...The Coconut Creek, FL, native has struck out at least seven Braves in each start...Since 2007, Scott is one of two pitchers to take three straight losses against Atlanta while striking out at least seven every time (JT Brubaker).

 RH Bryce Elder will face the Mets for the eighth time in his career (seventh start)...The Braves are 4-2 in his six previous starts...Overall, Elder is 3-1 with a 5.00 ERA (20 ER/36.0 IP) in his career against New York...On June 14, Elder faced the Mets at Citi Field and surrendered six earned runs across 4.0 innings...The Mets tallied 10 hits off him...Since July 20, Elder's 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) ranks sixth in the National League.

PITCHING: Braves starting pitchers have allowed three runs or fewer in 18 consecutive games, tied for the second-longest streak in Major League Baseball this season behind Tampa Bay (22 games) and even with Milwaukee.

 Today's starting pitcher, Bryce Elder, has accounted for three of those starts...Within that span, the right-hander has pitched to a 1.50 ERA (3 ER/18.0 IP).

 Atlanta's streak is the longest active in the majors...The club hasn't posted such a streak since August 11-September 6, 2024, when it did so across 25 games.

 Atlanta's starting pitchers own a 1.20 ERA (6 ER/45.0 IP) in the month of August, the lowest in MLB.

IN THE DIVISION: The Braves are riding an active eight-game winning streak against National League East teams...They won Game 2 of July 29's doubleheader against these New York Mets, then proceeded to sweep the Washington Nationals and Miami Marlins in four games and three games, respectively.

 Atlanta last won at least eight straight games against the NL East from June 20-August 12, 2023, when it also won eight in a row against the division...It hasn't exceeded that mark since 2022, when it won nine in a row from August 18-September 20.

 The Braves' intradivision win streak stands as the third-longest by any club this season, behind an 11-game streak by Milwaukee and a 10-game streak by Boston.

 Atlanta's .676 winning percentage against its own division is the best in MLB this year...Since 2020, the Braves' .610 intradivision winning percentage is second-best in MLB...The Los Angeles Dodgers (.657) are the only other club above the .600 mark.

AT HOME: The Braves today return home to Truist Park, where their .661 winning percentage (39-20) paces the National League...The Tampa Bay Rays (.695) are the only team with a better record in their home confines.

 The Braves have won nine straight games at Truist Park, dating to July 22 versus San Diego...The stretch is tied for the third-longest home winning streak in baseball this year, behind runs by the Cubs (15 games) and Rays (11 games).

 It's the longest home winning streak by Atlanta since it won 11 straight at Truist Park from June 11-July 24, 2023.

 Atlanta is 16-3 (.842) in series openers at home, easily the best record in MLB...The Rays rank second at 13-6 (.684)...Houston was the last club to finish a season with a better winning percentage in such games, posting an .885 mark (23-3) in 2019.

MATT OLSON: Belted his 34th home run of the season in last night's seventh inning...He's tied for third in baseball in that regard, only trailing Yordan Alvarez (HOU, 35) and Kyle Schwarber (PHI, 35)...Olson's 63 extra-base hits pace Major League Baseball.

 Olson's homer was hit off a 100.0-mph fastball from the Yankees' Cam Schlichter...Only seven other batters have homered off pitches 100+ mph this year.

 It marked the fourth occurrence in the Statcast era (since 2015) that a Brave homered off a pitch thrown 100 mph-or-harder...Olson accounts for two of those instances, having homered on a 101.0-mph Hunter Greene fastball on April 10, 2022 – his first home run in a Braves uniform.

 Eddie Rosario (September 1, 2021 vs. LAD) and Dansby Swanson (August 28, 2022 vs. STL) are the only other Braves to do it in that timeframe.

Today's Game

- Makes his 23rd start of the season and the 101st of his career, in the opener of a three-game series against New York (NL)...Atlanta is 13-9 in his 22 turns.
- Will make his seventh career start against the Mets and is 3-1 with a 5.00 ERA (20 ER/36.0 IP) in seven career appearances (six starts)...Faced New York once this season, June 14 at Citi Field, allowing six runs on 10 hits over 4.0 innings in an 8-1 loss.
- Owens a 3.69 ERA this season, compared to 6.52 mark in 2024 and 5.30 in 2025...It is his lowest single-season ERA since he pitched to a 3.81 mark as a 2023 National League All-Star.
- Since the All-Star break, is 3-0 with a 1.88 ERA (5 ER/24.0 IP) and three quality starts in four outings, the lowest post-break ERA of his career...Atlanta's starting staff owns a 2.52 ERA (34 ER/121.2 IP) over that span, the lowest in the majors.
- Has received 2.5 runs of support per start this season.
- Has recorded 13 quality starts in 22 outings this season...Ten of them have come at Truist Park, where he is 6-2 with a 3.00 ERA (27 ER/81.0 IP) in 13 turns.
- Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 18 of his 22 starts this season, including each of his last five (eight total).
- Has pitched to a 3.27 ERA (32 ER/88.0 IP) and held opponents to a .215 average in 15 night starts this season, compared to a 4.66 ERA (20 ER/38.2 IP) and a .261 mark in seven day starts.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .198 average (58-for-293) this season, while right-handers have hit .280 (52-for-186).
- Has incorporated a cutter into his arsenal this year after not throwing the pitch across his first four major league seasons from 2022-25, delivering 246 of his 292 cutters to lefties.
- In 10 starts with a four-seam fastball averaging 92.0 mph or higher, owns a 2.78 ERA (17 ER/55.0 IP), holding opponents to a .227 average (46-for-203) and a .345 slugging percentage.
- In his other 12 starts, with the heater at 91.9 mph or below, has a 4.40 ERA (35 ER/71.2 IP), with opponents batting .232 (64-for-276) and slugging .417.
- Opponents have hit 12 home runs against him in the sub-92 starts, compared to seven in his harder-throwing turns.
- Over his last 29 starts, dating to August 24 of last season, Elder is 11-8 with a 3.47 ERA (66 ER/171.1 IP) and a 1.14 WHIP...His 19 quality starts over the span are tied for the fourth-most in the majors.
- Since the start of the 2023 season, Atlanta is 51-40 in Elder's starts...His 91 starts for the Braves over the span lead the staff.

2026

- Earned the win August 5 against Miami, allowing one run on one hit over 7.0 innings with three strikeouts in a 4-1 victory at Truist Park, making his 100th career start... Did not allow a hit through the first 4.1 innings, the longest no-hit bid of his career.
- It was his second career start allowing one hit over 7.0 innings, last doing so August 15, 2023, against New York (AL).
- Has allowed one earned run or fewer in each of his last three starts for the first time since August 29-September 8, 2025...Owns a 1.50 ERA (3 ER/18.0 IP) and a .143 opponent average (9-for-63) over the span.
- Snapped a streak of nine consecutive starts with a home run allowed August 5, a run that was tied for the second-longest by a Brave in modern baseball history and the first since Julio Teheran (nine games) in 2017.
- Reached 100 strikeouts on the season July 31 against Washington, earning the win after allowing one run on four hits over 6.0 innings in a 6-2 victory at Truist Park.
- Is one of just five pitchers in Atlanta history to make at least six starts in March/ April and compile an ERA under 2.00, joining Tom Glavine (1997, 2000, 2002), Greg Maddux (1994), Tim Hudson (2007) and Julio Teheran (2014)...Finished March/April with a 1.88 ERA (9 ER/43.0 IP) over seven starts.

Career

- Awards:** 2023 National League All-Star.
- Joined Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz and Michael Soroka as the only starters in Atlanta-franchise history to make the All-Star team in their second year playing.
- Atlanta won 21 games started by Elder in his first full season with the Braves, the second most team victories on the season...Trailed only teammate Spencer Strider's 26 team wins that year.
- Made six starts in his career of at least 6.0 innings without allowing a run, the most such games in Braves franchise history (since 1900) in a player's first 25 starts...Irv Young (1905), Clif Curtis (1909-'10) and Ian Anderson (*20-21) each had five such starts.
- Was originally drafted by Atlanta in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Texas...Was the fifth member of the 2020 draft class to debut, and the lowest-selected pick to do so.
- Of the first five members to play in the majors from the 2020 draft class, three were selected with the first 11 picks in the draft - Detroit's Spencer Torkelson (No. 1 overall), the Angels' Reid Detmers (No. 10) and the White Sox's Garrett Crochet (No. 11).
