THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record 3-6 (2-1 in Houston, 0-3 at New York-AL and 1-2 at Pittsburgh), the Twins began their 10-game, 11-day homestand by splitting the first two games with the Rockies...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale against Colorado...starting tomorrow, they will welcome the A's for four games from tomorrow night-Sunday, enjoy an off-day on Monday, then play the Rays for three games next Tuesday-Thursday.
The Twins are 17-14 at home this season...they have gone 15-8 in their last 23 at Target Field after starting the season 2-6 here.
The Twins are 3-1 in rubber games this season, their three wins coming May 12 at Toronto, May 22 at Washington and June 2 at Houston...their one loss coming April 21 vs. Detroit.

ROCKY NIGHT AT TARGET FIELD: The Twins lost to the Rockies last night at Target Field by a score of 5-4...Louie Varland was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...Caleb Thielbar was issued the loss, allowing four runs on three hits in the sixth inning, highlighted by a Ezequiel Tovar three-run homer...the offense recorded eight hits, highlighted by Byron Buxton, who went 2-for-4 with his fourth home run, a two-run shot in the seventh inning...Carlos Santana hit a two-run shot in the ninth inning to pull the game within one, his 10th homer of 2024.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Jay Jackson from Triple-A St. Paul...Jackson, 36, recently appeared in three games for the Saints, allowing one run on two hits in 3.0 innings of relief with no walks and two strikeouts...Jackson made the club's Opening Day roster and appeared in 17 games from March 31-May 18, going 1-2, 6.85 ERA (22.1 IP, 17 ER), one hold, eight walks and 23 strikeouts...he was designated for release or assignment on May 19 and accepted his assignment to Triple-A St. Paul...to make room for Jackson on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Louie Varland to St. Paul...to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Diego Castillo for release or assignment...Castillo appeared in five games for Minnesota, posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER) with seven walks and three strikeouts.

ROX ON THE RECORD: The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 24th time in their history today...the Twins have gone 13-10 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-4 at Coors Field (2008, '14 & '23) and 6-5 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22 & '24).
Dating back to June of 2022, the Twins have gone 5-2 against Colorado in their last seven.
The Twins have hit just 19 home runs against the Rockies in their history, Minnesota's second-fewest among any opponent (Atlanta - 17).
The Twins' 23 games against the Rockies are the fourth-fewest against any opponent (Miami - 19, San Francisco - 21 and Atlanta - 22).

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 6-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh and 1-1 vs. Colorado...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Diamondbacks at Chase Field from June 25-27.

C4 IGNITING: Carlos Correa is hitting .435 (10-for-23) with one double, one home run, five RBI, three walks, a .481 on-base percentage, a .609 slugging percentage and a 1.090 OPS in his last six games.

TWINS AND ROX, TAKE THREE: The Twins have gone 11-8-2 in series play this season, going 5-4-0 at home and 6-4-2 on the road...a win today would give them their 11th series win in their last 15 tries since April 25...full 2024 results to the right.
Twins are 1-2-1 against NL opponents in series play in 2024...their only win being a three-game victory (2-1) at Washington from May 20-22.
A win today would give the Twins three consecutive series victories over Colorado, dating back to May of 2017...they are 5-2-0 all-time in series play against the Rockies.

AND WHY IS THE CARPET ALL WET TODD? I DON'T KNOW MARGOT!: Today marks the sixth time in the club's last 21 games that Manny Margot has led off — typically leads off against lefties...in his last 20 games overall, Margot is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with three doubles, one triple, three RBI, four walks, a .422 on-base percentage, a .475 slugging percentage, an .897 OPS and just four strikeouts.
Margot is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with an .826 OPS in his last nine games vs. lefties.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Twins hitters are slashing .251/.300/.408 with a .708 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .223/.305/.390 with a .695 OPS vs. right-handed pitching.
Willi Castro is hitting .345 (19-for-55) with an .881 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...in his last 23 games vs. lefties, he is 19-for-45 (.422) with a 1.047 OPS.
Royce Lewis is 3-for-6 (.500) off left-handed pitching this season...in 42 career games vs. lefties, Royce Lewis is hitting .338 (22-for-65) with an .897 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2017, the Twins selected Royce Lewis with the first overall pick in the MLB Draft out of JSerra High School...in the following days, in the 12th round, the Twins drafted Bailey Ober out of College of Charleston.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched June 6 at New York-AL, opposite Marcus Stroman, and took the loss in Minnesota's 8-5 defeat...allowed seven runs on four hits (1 HR) in 4.0 innings, with a career-high six walks, a hit-by-pitch and four strikeouts...hit Austin Wells and allowed second-inning two-run home run to Trent Grisham...walked three-in-a-row to begin the third and all three came around to score...allowed two more runs in the fourth.

- ⌘ Seven runs tied a season high (5/20 at WSH) and 4.0 innings tied a season low (4/23 vs. CWS).
- ⌘ Four of the six walks and the hit batter came around to score.
- ⌘ Eight of 23 batters faced reached a three-ball count.
- ⌘ Induced 13 whiffs on 41 swings (31.7%)...ranks in MLB's 72nd percentile with a 28.3 percent whiff rate.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started May 31 in Houston, opposite Ronel Blanco, and earned the win in Minnesota's 6-1 victory...allowed one run on six hits (1 HR) in a season-high-tying 7.0 innings with one walk and six strikeouts...only run came on Alex Bregman's fourth-inning home run...retired nine-straight batters to end the outing.

- ⌘ Induced 17 whiffs on 53 swings (32.1%).
- ⌘ Allowed just three hard-hit balls; Houston went 3-for-3 on those swings.
- ⌘ Owns a 1.47 ERA (18.1 IP, 3 ER) in three career starts (regular + Postseason) vs. Houston.

RECORD VS. ROCKIES: Has made four career starts vs. Colorado, going 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (26.1 IP, 5 ER), seven walks and 26 strikeouts...last matchup came June 22, 2022 in Miami; López earned the win, allowing one unearned run on four hits in 7.0 innings with three walks and six strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: On June 6, New York-AL's left-handed hitters went 1-for-8 with a home run, two walks and two strikeouts vs. López, while its righties went 3-for-7 with a double, four walks and two strikeouts...through 13 games vs. López, lefties have hit .255 (38-for-149) with a .748 OPS, 25.2 percent strikeout rate and 5.0 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .252 (32-for-127) with a .760 OPS, 27.7 percent strikeout rate and 3.5 percent home run rate.

- ⌘ Has induced a 26.3 percent whiff rate vs. lefties, 30.7 percent vs. righties.
- ⌘ Colorado ranks 22nd in baseball with a .670 OPS vs. right-handed pitching this season.

KEEP IT DOWN: López's 31.0 percent fly ball rate and 4.3 percent home run rate are both career highs...has allowed one-or-more home run in five-straight starts and 10 of 13 overall...average launch angle of 15.9 degrees is also a career high; compares to 12.6 degrees in 2023...his 4-seam fastball has allowed a career-high average launch angle of 27 degrees; compares to 19 degrees in 2023.

- ⌘ Among qualified pitchers, López's 1.65 home-runs-per-9.0 innings ranks third highest, trailing Triston McKenzie (1.85) and Aaron Civale (1.75).
- ⌘ His 31.0 percent fly ball rate is eighth highest in baseball (min. 300 batters faced).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2024: 4-5, 3.30 ERA // CAREER: 30-24, 3.91 ERA)

Joe Ryan is scheduled to start tomorrow night's series opener vs. Oakland...last pitched June 7 in Pittsburgh and took the loss in Minnesota's 3-0 defeat...allowing two runs on two hits (1 HR) in 7.0 innings, with two walks and eight strikeouts...was his ninth quality start of the season; has a 4-3 record in those starts...only career start vs. Oakland came July 16, 2023, when he allowed three runs on five hits in 5.1-inning no-decision, with three walks and seven strikeouts...Minnesota won that game 5-4.
