**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**MAY 25**  
**1975** - In the Dome, the Astros rally back from a 6-0 deficit to defeat the Expos, 8-7, in 12 innings. A clutch, solo HR in the bottom of the 9th by Cesar Cedeño ties the game at 6-6. With the Astros trailing, 7-6, in the bottom of the 12th, Enos Cabell's RBI-double ties it and then Milt May singles home the game-winner for the Astros walkoff win.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros and Rangers begin a 4-game series at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (1-2) will start for the Astros vs. Rangers **RHP Kumar Rocker** (2-4)...tonight will be Imai's 1st career app. vs. the Rangers.

**ROADIES:** Tonight is the 7th game (4-2 thus far) of a 10-game, 3-city road trip for HOU...HOU went 1-2 at MIN on the 1st stop of the trip and then went 3-0 over the weekend vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field...they'll wrap up the trip with this 4-game set at Globe Life Field.

**BACK INTO THE NIGHT:** Tonight will be the Astros first night game since Tues. night at MIN...since that game, they have played 4 consecutive day games, Wed. at MIN and all 3 games over the weekend vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field...prior to last week, the last time that the Astros had played 4 consecutive day games was April 2-6 of last season (source: Elias).

**ABOUT IMAI:** **RHP Tatsuya Imai** will make his sixth start tonight and the first of his career vs. the Rangers...Imai started the 1st game of this current road trip on May 18 at MIN, in which his outing was cut short due to a lengthy rain delay...prior to the delay, he had hurled 4.2 innings, allowing 3 earned runs with no walks and 5 strikeouts...earlier this season, Imai missed 26 games while on the Injured List (arm fatigue)...in January, the Astros signed Imai as a free agent to a three-year deal...in 2025, he was an All-Star for the Seibu Lions in the NPB in Japan, where he went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games.

**THE SILVER BOOT SERIES:** The Astros took 2 out of 3 from Rangers, May 15-17 at Daikin Park...**Even Series:** The two clubs have played each other 295 times in the regular season in their franchise histories, with the Astros holding a slight advantage, 148-147...recently, the Astros have had the upper hand, winning or splitting nine straight season series, going 95-52 against the Rangers since the start of the 2017 season...**Note:** The Silver Boot Trophy, which the Astros have held onto since 2017, is on display in the Centerfield Team Store at Daikin Park.

**YESTERDAY'S RECAP:** A 5-run outburst in the top of the 5th inning erased a 3-1 deficit and helped lead the Astros to a 7-5 win in yesterday's series finale at Wrigley Field...the win completed a 3-game sweep for the Astros...**RHP Peter Lambert** (3-4) earned the win (5 IP, 3 ER)...**Nick Allen** led the way on offense, going 3x3 with a HR, 2 RBI and 3 runs scored...**Jake Meyers** (solo HR) and **Christian Walker** (3-run HR) also contributed on offense...**RHP Nate Pearson** hurled a scoreless 9th inning to earn his 4th career save and 1st since 2024.

**SWEEPSTAKES:** The 3-game sweep of the Cubs over the weekend was the Astros 1st series sweep on the road in 2026 and their 2nd series sweep overall this season...their other sweep in 2026 came March 30-April 1 vs. BOS at Daikin Park...**At Wrigley:** Prior to over the weekend, the last time that the Astros swept the Cubs at Wrigley Field was in a 3-game series, May 30-June 1, 2011.

**FOR STARTERS:** Astros starters have a combined ERA of 2.84 (13ER/45.2IP) over the last 9 games... Saturday was the 3rd time in the last 5 games that an Astros starter did not allow a run in his start... additionally, Astros starters have allowed no runs 4 times in the last 9 games.

**WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: 1B Christian Walker** had a productive series over the weekend at Wrigley Field, going 5x12 (.417) with 3 HR and 6 RBI... for the season, he has been one of the top hitting 1st basemen in the AL...overall, he currently ranks T2nd in the AL in RBI (37) and 6th in TB (104), HR (14) and SLG (.531).

**SPENCER'S GIFTS:** Since making his season debut on April 15, **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has been one of the top starters in the Majors...with Friday's win at CHC, he is now 6-1 in just 7 starts with a 1.32 ERA (6ER/41IP) and a miniscule .169 batting avg. (24 H allowed in 41.0 IP)...since April 15, Arrighetti's 6 wins are tops in the AL in that span...**Model of Consistency:** Arrighetti has allowed 1 ER or less in 6 of his 7 starts and 2 ER or less in all 7 starts... in May, Arrighetti is 3-1 in 4 starts with an 0.78 ERA (2ER/23IP).

**RECENT STROS:** The Astros have won 3 straight, 4 of their last 5 and are 6-3 in their last 9 games and 7-4 in their last 11 games.

**CLOSE CALLS:** With yesterday's 4-2 win, the Astros are now 10-8 in 2-run games and 4-2 in 1-run games.

**THROWING SOME LEATHER:** The Astros 19 errors as a club are tied for the fewest in the AL, along with KC and ATH...the Astros had the fewest errors in the AL prior to committing 2 errors in Friday's 4-2 win.

**PEN PALS:** As a group, the Astros bullpen has had a decent run of success recently...since May 8, they have a combined ERA of 3.44 (20ER/52.1IP)...individually, several relievers are currently pitching well:

- RHP Bryan Abreu: 0.00 ERA in last 8 outings (7.2 IP, 0 R).**
- RHP AJ Blubaugh: 3.14 ERA in last 9 outings (14.1 IP, 5 ER).**
- LHP Bryan King: 1.42 ERA in last 10 outings (12.2 IP, 2 ER)**
- LHP Steven Okert: 8 K's in his last 4.2 IP (5 apps.)...3.24 ERA in his last 9 outings (8.1 IP, 3 ER).**

**TAPPING FOR SUCCESS:** Astros batters lead the Majors in successful ABS challenges with 36...they are 36-for-60 (60%) in their challenges...individually, **Jose Altuve** is tied for 2nd in the Majors with 9 successful challenges (9-for-13, 69%).

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Astros have been one of the AL's top hitting teams on the road in 2026... entering today's game, HOU leads the AL in road batting avg. (.264) and ranks 2nd in OBP (.334), SLG (.415) and OPS (.749).

**BRYAN'S SONG:** After a slow start to his season, **RHP Bryan Abreu** has not allowed a run in his last 8 outings, covering 7.2 IP (3 H, 0 R)...in his last 10 appearances, Abreu has posted an 0.93 ERA (1ER/9.2IP) with 9 K's.

**LAST START, MAY 18 at MIN:** Had a rain-shortened outing in his last start last Monday in Minnesota...worked 4.2 innings, allowing 3 runs on 5 hits with 5 strikeouts...did not issue a walk, marking the first walk-less game of his short MLB career...tossed 74 pitches (53 strikes) in the outing...allowed all three runs on a pair of homers by **Josh Bell**...had 2 outs in the 5th before the tarp was pulled and did not return to the mound following nearly a 2-hour rain delay...threw 35 four-seam fastballs, 34 sliders and 5 changeups in the outing...had a career-high 19 swings and misses, including 14 on his slider...topped out at 97.6 mph on his fastball, which tied as his hardest fastball thrown this regular season.

**ABOUT IMAI (pronounced ee-MY):** Rookie starter joined the Astros this offseason as an international signing out of Japan...has made 5 Major League starts this season around a month-long IL stint (April 13-May 10) due to right arm fatigue...tonight is his third start since returning from the IL.

**SAVANT SAYS:** Is in the 94th percentile of Major League pitchers in whiff % (34.6%) and in the 83rd percentile in groundball percentage (51.1%)...also ranks in the 69th percentile in strikeout percentage (25.3%).

**IMAI'S ARSENAL:** Has thrown 42% sliders in his MLB career, while throwing four-seamers (37%) and sinkers (13%) as his fastballs...among fastballs, threw only four-seamers in his first 3 starts, only sinkers in his start on May 12, and only four-seamers again in his last start...has also worked in select changeups (3%), split fingers (1%) and curveballs (1%)...has raised eyebrows by featuring his unique wrong-way slider, which was well known during his time pitching in the NPB...Imai's slider is averaging 5.2 inches of arm-side run...for context, the average MLB slider breaks 4 inches to the glove side.

**VS. TEX:** Is facing the Rangers for the first time in his career tonight...this start will give him 5 starts against AL West opponents, in 6 career starts.

**FIRST MAJOR LEAGUE WIN:** Flashed brilliance and earned his 1st career Major League win on April 4 at ATH in what was his second Major League start...in that outing, he allowed 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in 5.2 innings...threw a season-high 94 pitches in the outing.

**MLB DEBUT:** Made his MLB debut on March 29 vs. LAA, working 2.2 innings while allowing 4 runs on 3 hits...picked up his first MLB strikeout vs. **Mike Trout**, the second batter he faced in his debut...the Angels really worked Imai in the outing, swinging just 6 times on 37 fastballs thrown, taking 12 fastballs for strikes.

**SCORELESS SPRING TRAINING:** Made 3 official Spring Training starts and an exhibition game start, combining to toss 9.2 innings of scoreless baseball...in his 3 official starts, he allowed 2 hits and 1 walk with 7 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...his exhibition start came on March 23 vs. the Astros Triple A affiliate, the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, in which he tossed 3.2 scoreless innings.

**2025 RECAP:** Went 10-5 with a 1.92 ERA (35ER/163.2IP) in 24 games with Seibu in the NPB in 2025...recorded 178 strikeouts and a 0.89 WHIP...in the NPB, he ranked T-1st in WHIP, 2nd in strikeouts, 6th in ERA and 10th in starts (24)...was selected as an All-Star for the 2nd consecutive season...struck out a club record 17 hitters on June 17, 2025 vs. the Yokohama DeNa Baystars...also tossed 8.0 innings of a combined no-hitter on April 18, 2025 vs. the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks.

**JAPANESE CAREER:** Prior to signing with the Astros, Imai starred in the Nippon Professional Baseball Organization (NPB) for the last 8 seasons (2018-25)...he went 58-45 overall with a 3.15 ERA (337ER/963.2IP) and 907 strikeouts in 159 career games in the NPB...was a 3-time All-Star in the NPB (2021, 2024 and 2025).

**JAPAN CONNECTION:** Became the 33rd Japanese-born pitcher to make a start in the Majors...is the fourth Japanese-born player to play for the Astros, joining **IF Kazuo Matsui** (2008-10), **OF Norichika Aoki** (2017) and **LHP Yusei Kikuchi** (2024)...Imai knows Matsui well, having played for him from 2023-24, while he was managing in the NPB with the Seibu Lions.

**LAST APPEARANCE (5/24 at CHC):** Allowed 1 hit and 1 walk in 1.0 scoreless inning yesterday at CHC to record his 4th hold of the season.

**TIDES TURNING:** Has gone 2-0-2 through 8 consecutive scoreless appearances (7.2 IP), dating back to May 3, also posting a .167 opponent average (4x24) and 1.17 WHIP over that span...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season...his 8-appearance scoreless streak is the longest active streak (in terms of games) among Astros pitchers.

**ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS:** With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (336) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).

**DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS:** Reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on May 16 vs TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history...his 244 career strikeouts at Daikin Park are also 3 away from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in the venue's history.

**VS. THE CUBS:** Has posted a 1.42 ERA (1ER/6.1IP) with 9 strikeouts and a .182 opponent average (4x22) in 5 career appearances vs. the Cubs.

**CAREER:** In 336 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.86 ERA (110ER/346.2P) with 469 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.18 K/9 and a 0.75 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
