**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles defeated the Diamondbacks, 4-2, to improve to 9-4 in series openers...Own a 6-9 record when wearing their City Connect uniforms (5-8 in all black, 1-1 in black jerseys/white pants)...**Cole Irvin** (5.2 IP, 5 H, 2 ER, BB, 6 K, HR) picked up the win in his fourth consecutive start, the first time he has done so in his career; is the first Oriole to win four consecutive starts since **Kyle Bradish** from August 20 to September 8, 2023...Extended his career-high scoreless streak to 22.2 innings before surrendering a solo home run to Ketel Marte in the third inning; the scoreless streak is the longest by an Orioles pitcher since **Dean Kremer** worked 22.2 scoreless frames from June 17 to July 4, 2022.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The Birds have won six of their last seven games, eight of 10, nine of 12, 13 of 18, and 17 of 23...At 25-12 (.676), the Orioles have the best record in the AL and second-best in MLB behind the Phillies (.692, 27-12)...The 25-12 record is tied for the best start through 37 games in O's history (1969, 1970, and 1997)...Since the start of 2022, Baltimore is 209-152 (.579), the second-best record in the AL behind the Astros (.580, 210-152).

**OPENING STATEMENTS:** O's starters have posted a 1.66 ERA (11 ER/59.2 IP) in 10 games since April 29, the best mark in the AL and second-best in MLB during that time...For the season, the rotation's 3.18 ERA (74 ER/209.2 IP) ranks third in the AL and fifth in MLB...The starting pitcher trio of **Cole Irvin** (6.1 IP), **John Means** (7.0), and **Dean Kremer** (6.0) did not surrender a run during last weekend's series in Cincinnati.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles lead MLB with 57 home runs, the third-most homers through the first 37 games of a season in O's history, trailing 1987 and 2012 (58)...The most long balls through Baltimore's first 38 games of a season is 60 by the 1987 and 2012 teams.

🍌 The Orioles have an MLB-best eight players with at least five homers: **Gunnar Henderson** (11), **Colton Cowser**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, **Cedric Mullins**, **Anthony Santander**, and **Jordan Westburg** (6), and **Ryan O'Hearn** and **Adley Rutschman** (5); the Yankees rank second with six players with at least five long balls.

🍌 Henderson's 11 home runs are tied with Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani for second in MLB, trailing Atlanta's Marcell Ozuna and Houston's Kyle Tucker (12).

**BIG TIME RUTSCH:** **Adley Rutschman** enters today ranked tied for fourth in the AL in hits (48) and sixth in batting average (.316)...He ranks fourth in the AL and tied for fifth in MLB in multi-hit games (15).

🍌 Rutschman has hit safely in seven straight games since May 2, 18 of 19 since April 19, and 23 of his last 25 since April 11; for the season, he has reached safely in 31 of his 36 games and has a hit in 30 of those.

🍌 Since April 19, he's slashing .349/.365/.542 (29-for-83) with four doubles, four homers, eight runs, 15 RBI, two walks, and a stolen base.

🍌 He had a career-long 11-game hitting streak from April 19-30, the longest by an O's batter this season.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles continue their season-long nine-game homestand today with the second of three games against the D-backs...The O's will then host the Blue Jays (3 G) from May 13-15, followed by a scheduled off day on Thursday, May 16, before hosting the Mariners (3 G) from May 17-19.

🍌 The O's are off to a 13-7 (.650) start at home, the fourth-best home winning percentage in the AL and eighth-best in MLB.

**AGAINST THE D-BACKS:** The O's and D-backs continue their only series of the season today with the second of three games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...The O's took two out of three against the Snakes last year from September 1-3 at Chase Field...Marks the first time the Birds have hosted the D-backs since sweeping a three-game set from September 23-25, 2016...Baltimore and Arizona have only squared off in the regular season 25 times in team history, with the O's owning a 10-15 record in those games.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** **Gunnar Henderson** and **Colton Cowser** were voted American League Player and Rookie of the Month, respectively, for March/April...It marks the first time in team history that the O's have claimed both awards in the same month...The last MLB team to do so was the Dodgers in August 2023: Mookie Betts (Player) and James Outman (Rookie)...The last occurrence among AL teammates was the Guardians in April 2022: José Ramirez (Player) and Steven Kwan (Rookie).

**SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE:** With today's game, the Orioles will have gone 104 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the *Sporting News* American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 340 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his second start of the season and first home start this afternoon against the Diamondbacks...Made his season debut on May 4 at Cincinnati...Began the year on the 15-day Injured List (left forearm strain)...Reinstated on May 1 after making six rehab starts for Triple-A Norfolk...Underwent UCL reconstruction (Tommy John) by Dr. Keith Meister on April 27, 2022, and missed the rest of that season...Threw the sixth no-hitter in team history on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Named to his first career All-Star team in 2019, the lone Orioles representative...Finished second in American League Rookie of the Year voting, the first Orioles runner-up in the Rookie of the Year voting since 2002 (RHP Rodrigo López)...Originally selected by the Orioles in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of West Virginia University.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Secured the win in his season debut on May 4 at Cincinnati after allowing three hits with eight strikeouts across 7.0 shutout innings...Generated 19 whiffs, the most since his no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle (26, career high)...Threw 85 pitches, 58 strikes.

**TREKKING THE DESERT:** Slated to make his second career start against the Diamondbacks...Dealt the loss in his sole start against Arizona on July 24, 2019 at Chase Field after allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR) and three walks with four strikeouts and one wild pitch.

**WILD WILD NL WEST:** Making his fourth career start against the NL West and first since 2019...Owns an 0-1 record with a 4.91 ERA (8 ER/14.2 IP) in his three previous starts against the division...Did not factor into the decision in his last time out against an NL West foe on September 11, 2019 vs. Los Angeles-NL; allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts across 6.1 innings.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Went 0-2 with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP) in two home starts in 2023...In his career, he has gone 10-15 with a 3.96 ERA (85 ER/193.1 IP) in 39 appearances (37 GS) at Oriole Park.

**STEP INTO THE DAYLIGHT:** Set to make his first day start since April 8, 2022...Owns a lifetime 8-11 record with a 4.31 ERA (63 ER/131.2 IP) in 27 career daytime appearances (24 GS).

**ON THE MEND:** Prior to his reinstatement on May 1, Means made six rehab starts for the Tides...In those games, he went 1-2 with an 8.68 ERA (18 ER/18.2 IP) and 22 strikeouts against seven walks...In his last rehab start on April 28 vs. Gwinnett, he earned the win after tossing 7.0 shutout, one-hit innings with a walk, a hit batter, and eight strikeouts...Threw 95 pitches, 61 strikes in that outing.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Went 1-2 with a 2.66 ERA (7 ER/23.2 IP) with 13 hits (4 HR), four walks, one hit batter, and 10 strikeouts in four starts for the O's...Began the season on the 60-day Injured List (left elbow UCL surgery)...Started a rehab assignment with Double-A Bowie on August 10 and made three starts for the Baysox before having his assignment transferred to Triple-A Norfolk for three starts on August 25...Made his first MLB appearance in 517 days on September 12 vs. St. Louis...Did not allow a hit in the first 20 outs on September 23 at Cleveland before Andrés Giménez hit a solo home run; became the first O's pitcher with 6.2 no-hit innings since he no-hit Seattle at T-Mobile Park on May 5, 2021, and the first Orioles hurler to take a no-hitter into the seventh inning since LHP Keegan Akin (6.0 IP) on September 11 (G2), 2021 vs. Toronto...Retired the first 13 batters faced on September 29 vs. Boston...Did not appear on the O's ALDS roster after experiencing left elbow soreness.

**HE MEANS BUSINESS:** Threw the sixth no-hitter in O's history on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Marked the first Orioles no-hitter since a combined effort by Bob Milacki, Mike Flanagan, Mark Williamson, and Gregg Olson on July 13, 1991 at Oakland, and the first individual no-hitter by an O's hurler since Jim Palmer on August 13, 1969 vs. Oakland...It was the first complete game of his career, while he became the first southpaw to throw a no-hitter in team history (since 1954)...Means' only baserunner reached on a dropped third strike, wild pitch, and was later caught stealing by Pedro Severino; according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Means was the first pitcher to throw a non-perfect no-hitter in which the opposing team did not record a walk, hit-by-pitch, or error...His 12 strikeouts were the most by an O's hurler in a no-hitter and tied a career high (also: 9/20/20 vs. TB)...Became the second pitcher in AL history to toss a no-hitter with 12+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining Félix Hernández, who worked a perfect game on August 15, 2012...Named the AL Player of the Week on May 10, the first Orioles pitcher to accomplish the feat since Arthur Rhodes in August 1994.
