SNAKEBITES

THE NL CHAMPS: The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-2 @ Cubs yesterday.

- ◆ Ryne Nelson earned his team-leading seventh win after tossing 5.2 innings of 3-hit, 1-run ball with a career-high 9 strikeouts.
- ◆ **Gabriel Moreno** went 3-for-5 with 1 double and 1 RBI, coming 1 hit shy of his career best in a game.
- ◆ Kevin Ginkel and Ryan Thompson combined for 2.1 scoreless innings while Paul Sewald collected his 14th save.

FOX TV BROADCAST TONIGHT: Tonight's game @ Cubs will be exclusively televised on FOX Baseball Night in America with Jason Benetti & A.J. Pierzynski.

GOING FOR 3 OVER: With a victory tonight, the D-backs would be 3 games above .500 for the first time in 2024.

- ♦ Arizona finished the first half over .500 after sitting 7 games under entering June 1.
- ♦ It marked the fifth time in the last 7 seasons, including last season (.571; 52-39), where the team finished the first half with a record above .500.

50 IN THE BOOKS: The D-backs marked their second straight season with 50 wins before team game No. 100 and have met the feat in 4 of their last 6 seasons (excl. 2020).

SERIES OPENERS: With their victory yesterday @ Cubs, the D-backs have won 9 of their last 13 series openers.

SECOND-HALF MOMENTUM: The D-backs have won 11 of their last 16 games, which are tied for the most wins in the span (also: Astros and Tigers).

♦ Since June 29, the D-backs lead the Majors with a .285 AVG, .367 OBP, .840 OPS, 101 runs scored and 69 walks, and are second with 6.31 runs per game.

STEADY .300: Since June 29, the D-backs feature 4 players hitting .300+ (min. 10 games):

- ◆ **Ketel Marte** .358 (19-for-53)/.469 OBP/.491 SLG/.959 OPS, 1 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 11 BB (4 K), 3 SB
- ◆ Christian Walker .355 (22-for-62)/.467 OBP/.661 SLG/1.128 OPS, 4 2B, 5 HR, 17 RBI, 13 BB
- ◆ **Gabriel Moreno** .341 (15-for-44)/.431 OBP/.500 SLG/.931 OPS, 4 2B, 1 HR, 6 RBI, 7 BB (7 K)
- **◆ Eugenio Suárez** .309 (17-for-55)/.406 OBP/.600 SLG/1.006 OPS, 4 2B, 4 HR, 16 RBI, 9 BB

CENTRAL SERIES: The D-backs will play 14 of their next 17 games (thru Aug. 7) against Central teams (@ Cubs, @ Royals, vs. Pirates, @ Pirates, @ Guardians).

♦ The 4 teams combine for a .533-win pct. this season, while the Guardians (.615), Royals (.541) and Pirates (.505) each sit with a .500+ record.

MULTI-HIT MASTERS: Lourdes Gurriel Jr.'s 16 multi-hit games since June 6 are tied for the most in the Majors with Jose Altuve/HOU and Heliot Ramos/SF while **Ketel Marte** ranks tied for second with 15 (also: 3 others).

REIGN OVER WRIGLEY: Since 2022, the D-backs .778 win pct. (7-2) @ Wrigley Field is the highest among the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (.700; 7-3) and Padres (.700, 7-3).

VS. CUBS: Since 2022, the D-backs are 12-6 vs. Cubs (5-4 @ home, 7-2 on road).

- ♦ In their first matchup from April 15-17 @ Chase Field, the D-backs took 1 of 3 games.
- ♦ 5 of the last 7 games vs. Cubs have been decided by 2 or fewer runs.
- ♦ In 2023, the D-backs faced off vs. Cubs in September with 7 games in 11 days (4 on road and 3 @ home) and took 6 of the 7 matchups, including a sweep @ Chase Field.

SERIES STRONG: The D-backs have won or split their last 5 series (4-0-1) and 11 of their last 13 series overall since May 30, going 8-2-3.

EL PIKE: Ketel Marte has reached base in 18 of his last 19 games (since June 23), batting .366 (26-for-71)/.464 OBP/.577 SLG/1.042 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 15 RBI and 13 walks (6 K)...his .366 AVG in the span is the best in the NL, ahead of Jonathan India/CIN (.364), Trea Turner/PHI (.356) and Sal Frelick/MIL (.356).

- Has not struck out in 41 of his last 42 plate appearances since July 4.
- His 6 strikeouts since June 24 are tied for the NL's second fewest with Miguel Rojas/LAD and Sal Frelick/MIL, behind only Luis Arraez/SD (5).

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Over their last 11 games (since July 5), the D-backs are hitting .309 (30-for-97)/.949 OPS with runners in scoring position with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers and 20 walks.

ALL ABOUT SACRIFICE: The D-backs' 40 sacrifice flies are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Pirates (35), Royals (34), Yankees (33) and Giants (33), while their 18 sacrifice bunts are also the most, ahead of the Royals (15).

TAKING BASES: The D-backs' 127 bases taken [bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, balks, defensive indifference] are the most in the Majors, ahead of the Cardinals (116), Dodgers (103) and Giants (99).

◆ This season, **Corbin Carroll** has added 6 extra runs on the base paths, the most in the Majors, ahead of Jarren Duran/BOS (3) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (3).

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (4-6, 3.97)

- ♦ Will make his team-leading 20th start.
- ♦ Has allowed 1 run or fewer in 3 consecutive starts, combining to go 1-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts.
- ♦ Is 1-1 with a 2.95 ERA (6 ER in 18.1 IP) in 2 career starts vs. Cubs...made his lone start @ Cubs on Sept. 10, 2023 (ND; 4 ER in 6.0 IP).

• 2023 All-MLB First Team, NL Cy Young finalist, NL All-Star starting pitcher and D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona chapter of the BBWAA (third time: 2020, '22, '23)...set career highs with 34 starts, 17 wins, 210.0 innings and 220 strikeouts...in 34 starts, was 17-9 with a 3.47 ERA (81 ER in 210.0 IP) and 220 strikeouts.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Fifth start, second on the road, back from the injured list.

- Is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .125 AVG (5-for-40)/.397 OPS, 0.83 WHIP, 5 walks and 13 strikeouts in 2 starts against the NL Central this season.
- In his last 4 road starts, is 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP), opponent .175 AVG (10-for-57)/.540 OPS, 8 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- The D-backs are 3-1 in his last 4 road starts.

LAST START: Finished with a no-decision on July 14 vs. Blue Jays (6 ER in 3.2 IP)...the D-backs scored 7 runs in the bottom of the fifth inning to tie the game, but ultimately fell 8-7.

VS. CUBS: Third straight road start @ Cubs (2-0, 0.64 ERA) and fourth career start @ Wrigley Field (2-1, 4.00 ERA).

• Tossed his first career 9.0-inning shutout in his last start on Sept. 8, 2023 @ Cubs with 3 hits allowed and 9 strikeouts.

AMONG OTHER STARTERS: Since 2019, his 19 starts of 6.0+ shutout innings, 6+ strikeouts and 3-or-fewer hits allowed are tied with Blake Snell/SF for the most in the Majors, ahead of Corbin Burnes (17).

VS. LEFT AND RIGHT: In his last 4 road starts, is holding lefties to a .152 AVG (5-for-35)/.473 OPS with 2 walks and 10 strikeouts.

• Over his first 8 starts, through May 12, held righties to a .195 AVG (16-for-82)/.544 OPS with 7 walks and 27 strikeouts.

RUNNERS ON BASE: With runners on base over his last 10 starts, has held opponents to a .222 AVG (16-for-72)/.596 OPS with 4 walks and 20 strikeouts, which includes his last 5 road starts and a .154 AVG (4-for-26)/.407 OPS with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts.

RISPY BUSINESS: Over his last 4 road starts from May 7-July 4, is holding runners in scoring position to a .154 AVG (2-for-13) with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.
