HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs' 24 wins are tied for the third most in the NL (also: Brewers), behind the Dodgers (27) and Braves (26).
- ♦ Arizona is second in the NL West and has spent 23 total days in or tied for first place (April 2-30).
- ♦ A win today will secure the D-backs' second straight series win and fifth in their last 7.

ROSTER MOVES

- ♦ The D-backs made the following roster moves:
- Recalled RHP Luis Frías from Triple-A Reno.
- Optioned OF Alek Thomas to Reno following last night's game.

OH, LOURDES!

- ◆ Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has a 10-game hit streak, tied for the fourth longest active streak in the Majors, and has an extra-base hit in 6 straight games (4 doubles, 2 homers)... is batting .436 (17-for-39) with 4 doubles (1 walk-off), 6 homers, 13 runs, 12 RBI and 8 walks.
- ♦ His current streak is the second longest by a D-back this season (behind Corbin Carroll, 12 games) and ties for the second longest in his career (also: June 4-15, 2022 with Toronto)...his career long is 12 games (July 11-Aug. 24, 2018 with Toronto).
- ♦ In his last 9 road games, is hitting .333 (11-for-33)/1.086 OPS

KETEL BEING KETEL

- ♦ Ketel Marte has a 17-game on-base streak (since April 26), the sixth longest active streak in MLB...has 1 double, 1 triple, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 9 walks and 2 HBP...he is 5 games shy of tying his career-long (22, Aug 2-29, 2019).
- ♦ He has reached base in 10 straight road games, since April 15, hitting .366 (15-for-41)/1.124 OPS with 1 triple, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 4 walks.

THE FLETCH SHOW

- ♦ Last night, **Dominic Fletcher** joined Gerardo Parra (2009), Mark Reynolds (2007), Chad Tracy (2004) and Matt Kata (2003) as the only D-backs with at least 20 hits in their first 15 career games.
- ♦ Fletcher is batting .377 (20-for-53)/1.004 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 7 runs, 13 RBI and 2 walks in his first 15 Major League games.

SEEING IT WELL

- ♦ Since April 23, the D-backs' .360 OBP leads the Majors, ahead of Red Sox (.355), Rays (.340) and Braves (.338).
- Since April 23, the D-backs' 11.0 walk pct. is second in the Majors, behind the Padres (11.7), compared to their 5.0 walk pct. (MLB low) from the start of season to April 22.

SNAKE BITES

- ◆ Christian Walker's 8 homers since April 21 are the most in the Majors...since 2022, Walker ranks among NL players in home runs (3rd, 46) [T-5th in MLB], RBI (6th, 124), extra-base hits (10th, 81) and total bases (10th, 356).
- ◆ Gabriel Moreno, in his last 10 games, is hitting .400 (14for-35)/.904 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 RBI and 2 stolen bases.
- ◆ Geraldo Perdomo is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with runners in scoring position and ranks third in the Majors [min. 35 PA], behind Marcus Semien/TEX (.525) and Yordan Alvarez/HOU (.500).

UNAVOIDED EXTRAS

♦ Last night, the D-backs entered their first extra-inning game of the season, marking the longest span of games in team history to start a season without going to extras (42 games)...the previous record was 38 games in 2020.

YOUNG 'BACKS

- ♦ The D-backs and Athletics are tied for the third-youngest team in the Majors at age 27.8, behind the Guardians (26.4) and Orioles (27.5) and ahead of Nationals (27.9) and Angels, Nationals, Phillies, Mariners, Pirates, Rays (28.0).
- Arizona has featured the most players aged 23 or younger (5) in the Majors this season (Corbin Carroll/22, Gabriel Moreno/23, Geraldo Perdomo/23, Alek Thomas/23 and Carlos Vargas/23), ahead of Los Angeles-AL (4).

ON DECK: PITTSBURGH PIRATES

- ♦ The D-backs went 4-3 vs. Pirates in 2022 and are 14-6 in the last 20 meetings (6-4 @ PNC Park).
- ♦ Ketel Marte has hit safely in 8 of his last 10 games @ PNC Park since 2019, batting .306 (11-for-36)/1.053 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers and 11 RBI.

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (6-1, 2.35)

- ♦ Made his last start on May 12 vs. Giants (W; 2 ER in 7.2 IP).
- ◆ Entering today, ranks among NL leaders in starts (T-1st, 9), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 8.75), innings (2nd, 57.1), wins (T-2nd, 6), strikeouts (4th, 70), WHIP (4th, 0.85), walks (T-5th, 8) and ERA (8th, 2.35).
- ♦ Is 1-1 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER in 13.0 IP) in 2 starts vs. Pirates.

AT A GLANCE: Selected by the D-backs in the second round (56th overall) of the 2019 draft.

- Attended the University of Oregon, where he was a 2019 First-Team All-Pac-12 selection...finished his junior year with a conference-high 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Making his fourth road start in 2023 and first against an AL West opponent.

- Has exited 5 of his 8 starts with a lead or tied.
- · Has walked 3 batters in his last 4 starts after walking 8 in his first 4

LAST START: Did not factor in the win on May 12 vs. Giants... allowed a game-tying single to J.D. Davis before exiting in the fifth inning.

VS. ATHLETICS: Making his first career start.

PITCH TRACKING: Opposing batters are 2-for-9 (.222) with 2 strikeouts off his changeup and 6-for-36 (.167) with 6 strikeouts off his cutter.

WHAT A DEBUT: In his Major League debut on Sept. 5, 2022 @ Padres, he set the D-backs record for most scoreless innings (7.0) in a Major League debut (later tied by Drey Jameson on Sept. 15) and tied for the most strikeouts (7) (also: Zack Godley on July 23, 2015 @ Brewers and Max Scherzer on April 29, 2008 vs. Astros).

Came 1.0 inning shy of tying Geraldo Guzmán's D-backs debut record (8.0 IP) set on July 6, 2000 @ Astros.

2022 REVIEW: Made 3 starts with Arizona in his first Major League stint and went 1-1 with a 1.47 ERA (3 ER in 18.1 IP), 0.82 WHIP and .145 opponent avg.
