RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and New York Mets wrap up their three-game weekend series this afternoon at Citi Field as the Redbirds continue their 11-day, eight-game international road trip through New York (1-1), the nation's capital to play the Nationals (June 19-21), and then across the pond in London, England to face the division-rival Cubs (June 24-25) ... The Cardinals ended a six-game losing streak yesterday and are looking for the first winning series since May 19-21 vs. the Dodgers at Busch Stadium (2-1).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in last place in the NL Central, 8.5 games behind 1st place Milwaukee and 5.5 games behind 4th place Chicago ... The Cardinals have spent 53 of 80 days in last place on this season's MLB schedule (April 26-May 19 and May 29-present) ... This season is the Cardinals slowest start since beginning 25-46 (.352) in 1978.

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY: The Cardinals are 21-29 all-time on Father's Day (8-15 on the road) since 1972 when President Richard M. Nixon recognized the third Sunday in June as an official holiday ... The Cardinals and Mets have faced off on Father's Day on six occasions (St. Louis is 3-3) ... The two teams have met in New York twice, first in 1992 in a 6-2 Cards defeat at Shea Stadium highlighted by a go-ahead, three-run homer by former Cardinal and Met **Vince Coleman** ... In 2019, **Paul DeJong** hit a game-winning home run off **Chris Flexen** in the 8th inning of a 4-3 St. Louis win at Citi Field.

START SPREADING THE NEWS: Despite a 23-26 all-time record at Citi Field, St. Louis enters today winners of nine of its last 14 games in Queens while outscoring the Mets 76-59 ... The Cards win yesterday was their 200th road victory in New York since the Mets joined the NL as an expansion team in 1962.

HEIR JORDAN: **Jordan Walker** has hit in 10 straight (.400/.462/.743, 14-35) since June 6, MLB's 3rd-longest active hitting streak behind **Shohei Ohtani** (14) and **Mookie Betts** (11).

- Walker opened the season by hitting in his first 12 games, establishing a Cardinals rookie record to begin a career and tying **Eddie Murphy** (1912 Philadelphia Athletics) for the MLB record for longest by a player age 20 or younger.
- Walker joins **Albert Pujols** (three in 2001) and **Rogers Hornsby** (two in 1916) as the third Cardinal age 21 or younger with multiple double-digit game hitting streaks in the same season.
- MLB Pipeline's top overall prospect in baseball has hit safely in 28-of-33 games with a PA this season, with his 36 career hits coming off 35 different pitchers from all 11 opponents he's played against.

YOUNG LEFTIES IN GOTHAM: **Matthew Liberatore's** start today will be the 23rd in franchise history made by a left-handed Cardinal age 23 or younger vs. the Mets in New York ... Prior to Liberatore, the last few to do so were **Allen Watson** (age 22-316) on Sept. 30, 1993, **Donovan Osborne** (age 22-307) on April 23, 1992, and **Joe Magrane** (age 23-289) on April 16, 1988.

- Vinegar Bend Mizell** was the most recent Cardinal to do so at both the New York Giants (age 23-012) on Aug. 25, 1953 (G1) at the Polo Grounds and at the Brooklyn Dodgers (age 22-338) on July 17, 1953 (G1) at Ebbets Field.
- Ray Sadecki** is the only left-handed Cardinal age 23 or younger to start in New York against the Yankees, doing so in Game 4 of the 1964 World Series (October 11).

UNIFORM COMBOS: The Cardinals packed five hats (red, navy, Sunday, Father's Day, & batting practice) and all four uniforms to create six different uniform combinations for their eight-game international road trip: Road Grays with Red hats, Victory Blues with Red hats (yesterday), Road Grays with Father's Day hats (today), Road Grays with Navy hats (Monday-Wednesday in Washington), Home Creams with Red hats (Saturday vs. Cubs in London), and Home Whites with Sunday hats (next Sunday vs. Cubs in London).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (June 18, 2018): **Yadier Molina** appears in his 1,757th career game behind the plate, passing Hall of Fame Cubs catcher **Gabby Harnett** (1922-40) to become the all-time leader in games caught with one Major League team.

NEW YORK CONNECTIONS

Steven Matz was originally selected by the Mets in the 2nd round of the 2009 MLB Draft out of Ward Melville High School in East Setauket, NY and pitched parts of his first six seasons (2015-20) in New York...was born in Stony Brook, NY.

Tommy Edman doubled off **Steven Matz** for his first career MLB hit (June 14, 2019 at Citi Field).

Adam Wainwright (Sept. 11, 2005 at Busch II), **Jordan Hicks** (March 29, 2018 at Citi Field), and **Brendan Donovan** (April 25, 2022 at Busch III) made their MLB debuts against the Mets.

Cardinals Bench Coach **Joe McEwing** played five seasons with the Mets (2000-04)...appeared in 11 games with the Mets during the 2000 postseason as the club reached the World Series...originally traded by St. Louis to New York in exchange for **Jesse Orosco** (March 18, 2000)...played college baseball at the County College of Morris in Randolph Township, NJ, where his uniform is retired.

Tommy Pham played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2014-18)...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2006 MLB draft...traded by St. Louis to Tampa Bay with international bonus money for **Genesis Cabrera**, **Roel Ramirez**, and **Justin Williams** (July 31, 2018).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **José Oquendo** played the first two seasons of his 12 year MLB career with the Mets...traded by New York with **Mark Davis** to St. Louis in exchange for **John Young** and **Angel Salazar** (April 2, 1985).

Adam Ottavino was selected St. Louis in the 1st round (#30 overall) of the 2006 MLB Draft...pitched parts of six seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2006-11)...made his MLB debut with St. Louis in 2010.

Max Scherzer is a native of Chesterfield, Mo...graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by St. Louis in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign to pitch at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

Mets Clubhouse Operations Coordinator **Scott Keltner** previously worked in the Cardinals organization in the Busch Stadium (2016-21) and AutoZone Park (2014-15) visiting clubhouses.

Cardinals Hall of Famer & Mets broadcaster **Keith Hernandez** was selected by the Cardinals in the 42nd round of the 1971 MLB Draft...played 10 seasons in St. Louis (1974-83)...won the 1979 NL MVP Award...named to two National League All-Star teams and won six Gold Gloves.

Taylor Megill's older brother, **Trevor Megill**, was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to from Loyola Marymount (Calif.) University.

Mets Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Dominic Leone pitched parts of two seasons (2017-18) with the Cardinals.

Mets First Base Coach **Wayne Kirby** played in 98 games for Memphis (AAA) in 1998, where he was teammates with **Ron "Pop" Warner** and **Joe McEwing**...traded by St. Louis to the Mets for **Shawn Gilbert** (June 10, 1998).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** was born in nearby Poughkeepsie, N.Y....graduated from F.D. Roosevelt High School in Hyde Park.

Cardinals reporter **Jim Hayes** was born in New York City and raised in nearby Nyack, NY...graduated from State Univ. College at Geneseo, NY.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jason Isringhausen** was selected by the Mets in the 44th round of the 1991 MLB Draft...pitched parts of four seasons in New York (1995-97, 1999, 2011).

2023 SEASON

- Allowed his 1st HR of the 2023 season in his start at TEX (6/6). The 3rd inning solo HR by the Rangers' Nathaniel Lowe snapped his string of 13.0 homerless innings pitched to begin the season.
- Began the season with Memphis (AAA) and made eight starts before getting recalled to St. Louis for a May 17 start vs. Milwaukee.
- Made his 2023 debut and threw 5.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with three walks and six strikeouts. Posted the exact same line in each of his first two starts vs. the Brewers (5 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 6 SO).
- Named Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month and International League Pitcher of the Month for April with a 3-0 mark and 2.14 ERA over 33.2 innings pitched with 45 strikeouts covering six starts in March/April.
- Was leading all Minor League pitchers at any level with 46.0 innings pitched and all Triple-A pitchers with 56 strikeouts (3rd in MiLB) at the time of his recall.
- Posted a 10-strikeout game at Gwinnett (4/12).
- Named Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April and International League Pitcher of the Month for April with a 3-0 mark and 2.14 ERA over 33.2 innings pitched with 45 strikeouts covering six starts in March/April.

- Started for the National League in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field in Denver and worked a perfect 1st inning retiring a trio of then-top 10 prospects in Bobby Witt, Jr., Jarred Kelenic, and Julio Rodriguez on just 13 pitches.
- Acquired in trade with Tampa Bay Rays on January 9, 2020 in a deal that sent OF Jose Martinez and OF Randy Arozarena to Tampa.
