ST. LOUIS CARDINALS (25-34) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (30-27)

JUNE 4, 2023 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #58/HOME #28

RHP MILES MIKOLAS (4-1, 3.75 ERA) vs. LHP RICH HILL (4-5, 4.76 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have won four straight games since falling under .500 (26-27) following their loss on 5/29 (the first time the team was under .500 since 4/2)...Have four separate winning streaks of at least four games this season, including a season-high seven-game winning streak from 4/17-23, their longest winning streak since 2018 (11 games)...Are 0.5 game behind the first place Brewers in the National League Central coming into today.

ROSTER MOVE: The Pirates selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Chase De Jong from Triple-A Indianapolis prior to today's game...Right-handed pitcher Yerry De Los Santos has been optioned to Indianapolis to make room on the 26-man active roster...There are currently 38 players on the 40-man roster.

CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET: Today the Pirates will look for their fourth sweep of the season and first against the Cardinals here at PNC Park since April 27-29, 2018, which was also a three-game series...Pittsburgh's last sweep came against the Reds in a four-game series from April 20-23 in Pittsburgh.

CENTRAL PERK: The Pirates have won six straight games against their own division, losing for the last time on April 16 when the team was walked off in 10 innings at St. Louis...The last time the Pirates won at least six straight games within their own division came in 2018 (nine straight from July 12-31).

RICH ON THE HILL: Rich Hill takes the mound for the 12th time this season and will pitch against St. Louis for the first time since 2021...Hill has won three of his last four matchups against the Cardinals coming into today... Hill will be looking for his first win since he went 6.0 innings and allowed just one hit in an 8-0 shutout at Detroit on May 17.

CUTCH THIS: Andrew McCutchen made his Major League debut on this day 14 years ago against the New York Mets batting leadoff while making the start in center field... McCutchen singled off Mike Pelfrey in his first at-bat and went on to have two hits while also recording an RBI and scoring three runs in an 11-6 win.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen is just one double shy of 400 in his career (his next double will also be his 300th as a Pirate)...McCutchen ranks seventh all-time in Pirates history in doubles (Hall-of-Famer Pie Traynor is sixth with 371).

CLOSING IN ON 2000 HITS: Andrew McCutchen also comes into today just three hits shy of 2000 in his career...McCutchen has recorded 1512 of his 1997 hits with the Pirates organization...McCutchen's 1512 hits with Pittsburgh ranks 12th in team history...Hall-of-Famer Roberto Clemente is first with 3000 while Tommy Leach is 11th (1603).

KE'S TO THE GAME: Ke'Bryan Hayes has gone deep in back-to-back games for the first time in the same season...Coming into today, Hayes ranks fourth among all National League third basemen with 21 extra base hits...The only National League players at that position with more extra base hits are Washington's Jeimer Candelario (26), Los Angeles' Max Muncy (22) and Atlanta's Austin Riley (22).

THE HOT CORNER: Ke'Bryan Hayes has recorded 14 RBI since May 19...That's tied for the fourth-most in the National League in that time behind J.D. Martinez (19), Ryan McMahon (16) and Fernando Tatis Jr. (15).

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar has picked up saves in each of his last three games after appearing in seven straight non-save situations from May 5-28...Bednar comes into today converting each of his last eight opportunities since being charged with his only blown save on April 11...He also ranks fourth in the National League with 12 saves, trailing San Francisco's Camilo Doval (14), Cincinnati's Alexis Diaz (13) and San Diego's Josh Hader (13).

GO JOE: Connor Joe has knocked in a run in three straight games for the first time in his career, including his two-run double in the sixth inning on Saturday that broke a 1-1 tie against the Cardinals...Joe is now 6-for-16 with three doubles, a home run and four RBI in his last four games.

June 4, 2022: Jack Suwinski became the first rookie in Pirates history to hit a walkoff home run to break up a shutout, blasting a two-run shot off former Pirate Mark Melancon in a dramatic 2-1 win over the Diamondbacks. Roansy Contreras allowed one unearned run and fanned eight Arizona batters in 5.2 innings of work, while Chris Stratton earned the win in his 200th career appearance.

JOHAN OVIEDO: The 25-year-old righthander will make his 12th start of the season tomorrow evening in the opener of a three-game series against the A's...Had a no-decision (4.1ip/1er) in his last start; a 2-1 win at San Francisco Tuesday night...Has held opposing hitters to a .196 average (21-for-107) against his slider according to Baseball Savant...Is in the 88th percentile in fastball velocity according to Baseball Savant...Has allowed one run apiece in three of his last four starts...Is 2-2 with a 4.40 ERA (28.2ip/14er) in five starts this season at PNC Park...Is averaging 6.83 runs of support this season...Had a scoreless streak of 15.1 innings from 4/3-14 (the third-longest scoreless streak by a Pirate this season).
