vs. Cleveland and 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with
a loss in Detroit last nighttoday they will play the second and third games of this series,
then wrap the series tomorrow afternoonafter tomorrow afternoon's game. Minnesota will
travel to Baltimore for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

TWINS SMACKED DOWN IN MOTOWN: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 8-2...Pablo López (1-2) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with three walks and seven strikeouts...Michael Tonkin made his return to the Twins, pitching 2.0 innings of relief with five strikeouts...Twins pitchers combined for 15 strikeouts, setting a season high...the offense recorded six hits, walked four times and struck out 11...Carlos Correa went 0-for-2 and exited the game in the third inning with a right oblique strain...Kyle Farmer reached safely three times, going 1-for-2 with two walks, one run scorred and one RBI one run scored and one RBI.

CORREA TO THE IL: The Twins announced that they have placed shortstop Carlos Correa on the 10-day Injured List with a right oblique strain...Correa, who sustained the injury during last night's game in Detroit, has hit .306 (11-for-36) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, eight walks, a .432 on-base percentage and a .876 OPS in 11 games.

◆ To replace Correa on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled catcher Jair Camargo from Triple-A St. Paul...the 24-year-old has hit .268 (11-for-41), with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, five walks, seven runs scored, a .362 on-base percentage and an .825 OPS in 11 games for the Saints this season...a native of Barranquilla, Colombia, Camargo was aquired by the Twins from the Los Angeles Dodgers in the Kenta Maeda trade in February 2020...Camargo will wear jersey number 85 and is looking to make his major league debut.

◆ The Twins have also selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Matt Bowman from the Saints...Bowman has not permitted an earned run across five relief appearances for St. Paul this season, working 6.0 innings with one unearned run allowed, three hits, two walks and seven strikeouts...the 32-year-old has gone 7-13, 4.13 ERA (185.1 IP, 85 ER), 64 walks and 152 strikeouts across parts of five major league seasons with St. Louis (2016-18), Cincinnati (2019) and New York-AL (2023).

◆ To make room for Bowman on the 26-man and 40-man rosters, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Michael Tonkin for release or assignment...Tonkin, who was acquired in a trade with the New York Mets on April 9, pitched 2.0 innings against the Tigers last night, allowing two runs on two hits, with two walks and five strikeouts.

BUY A VOWEL: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson to start Game 2 tonight at Comerica Park...Simeon made his major league debut at Comerica Park in a start on October 2, 2022, allowing three runs (2 earned) on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts and was dealt the loss in a Twins 5-2 defeat... allowed two unearned runs in the bottom of the first...struck out first career batter in the second inning, fanning Victor Reyes...at 22 years and five days old, he became the youngest pitcher to debut in 2022 in all of baseball.

**Woods Richardson was acquired by the Twins, along with utility player Austin Martin, in the José Berríos trade at the 2021 trade deadline from Toronto...today marks the first time both Woods Richardson and Martin have been on a major league roster at the same time.

DAY 'N' NITE: The Twins are playing their first doubleheader of the season today after playing none in 2023...they have another DH scheduled for August 9 vs. Cleveland at Target Field from an April 7 rainout...below are the results from the last four doubleheaders, all in 2022: DATE GAME 1 GAME 2 NOTES

♣ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 47-34 against the Tigers — since 2019...only
Terry Francona (51-29) has beaten Detroit more in that span.

♣ The Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 116, 19

ahead of Chicago-AL (97)...49 of those have come at Comerica Park, also most among opponents. **♣** Christian Vázquez is hitting .311 (33-for-106) with nine doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI

and an .826 OPS in 31 career games vs. the Tigers.

KON'NICHIWA: Kenta Maeda will face the Twins in the regular season for the first time since he elected free agency at the end of 2023 season...Kenta started against the Twins in Lakeland, FL, on March 12, pitching 4.0 shutout innings in a spring training start; an Alex Kirilloff single to open the game was the Twins' only hit that day in a 1-0 defeat...Maeda was acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on February 10, 2020 (along with Jair Camargo and others)...finished second to Cleveland's Shane Bieber (unanimous in 2020 AL Cy Young Award voting with 92 total voting points (18 second place)...missed the entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...as a Twin, Maeda went 18-14, 4.02 ERA (124 ER, 227.1 IP) with 70 walks, 310 strikeouts and a 1.12 WHIP in 53 regular season games (52 starts) since 2020.

RUN THE JULS: Edouard Julien has five hits (2 home runs, 3 RBI) in his last two games (8 at-bats)...in his last five games, he is hitting .313 (5-for-16) with two home runs, three RBI, two walks and a 1.076 OPS after starting the season by hitting .150 (3-for-20) with one walk and a .540 OPS in his first six games.

ONE BAD PITCH: First home start of the season came against the Cleveland Guardians on April 6, recorded his 27th career quality start after going 6.0 innings and allowing five hits, seven strikeouts and a three-run home run in the top of the second inning to David Fry...picked up his first loss of the season in a 3-1 final...it was the fourth loss of his career to the Guardians.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his first start the season in Twins' second game on March 30 at Kansas City in a Twins 5-1 win, opposite of Seth Lugo...shut out the Royals through the first 5.0 innings...was relieved by Steven Okert in the bottom of the sixth inning who inherited two runners by Ryan and allowed a two-out single by MJ Melendez...Ryan's final line was 5.1 innings pitched, one earned run, three hits, one walk and five strikeouts.

DOE VS. THE TIGERS: Facing the Tigers for the seventh time in his career...in the previous six starts, he owns a 4-1 record, 3.57 ERA (35.1 IP, 14 ER) five walks and 45 strikeouts...his last win against the Tigers came on September 30, 2022 at Detroit where he went 6.0 innings, five hits, no runs, one walk and eight strikeouts.

This 35.1 innings pitched against the Tigers are his third most vs. any team in his career.

Last start against the Tigers came on June 16, 2023 at Target Field going 7.0 innings, six runs, no walks, seven strikeouts earning his first career loss against the Detroit Tigers.

In his last two starts at Comerica Park, he's gone 2-0, 0.77 ERA (11.2 IP, 1 ER), nine hits, two walks and 15 strikeouts

walks and 15 strikeouts.

ROAD DEALING: Through one start in 2024 on the road at Kansas City, Ryan has logged 5.1 innings, one earned run three hits, one walk and five strikeouts factoring in a no-decision.

◆ In 30 career road starts, he is 12-10, 4.43 ERA (160.2 IP, 79 ER), 148 hits, 39 walks and 167 strikeouts...Twins are 17-13 in Ryan's 30 road starts.

◆ Tied with Pablo López for most on the Twins with four road wins in 2023.

◆ Allowed 32 home runs in 2023...20 of them came on the road, has allowed zero through one road start this year.

LEFT RIGHT SPLIT: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .200/.259/.240, one extra-base hit in 27 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .176/.175/.471, two doubles, one home run in 17 plate appearances.

© Over his career, lefties are batting .207 (130-for-627) with a .630 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .240 (164-for-682) with a .747 OPS.

© Through 2022-2023, Ryan, has made five starts against the Tigers...right-handed hitters hit (8-for-54) one double, two home runs, two walks, 26 strikeout and a BABIP of .231

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a five-pitch mix in his first two regular season starts this year compared to his four-pitch repertoire in 2023. leaned on his four-seam fastball and split-finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 73.7 percent of the time throughout his two starts of the year. here is Joe Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:
