- Making third start in 2024 and 64th career start...prior start was against the Cleveland Guardians on April 6, when he went 6.0 innings and allowed five hits, three earned runs, one walk and seven strikeouts, taking his first loss of the season.
Faced Detroit once in 2023...career 4-1, 3.57 ERA (35.1 IP, 14 ER) in six starts vs. Detroit.
Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

ONE BAD PITCH: First home start of the season came against the Cleveland Guardians on April 6, recorded his 27th career quality start after going 6.0 innings and allowing five hits, seven strikeouts and a three-run home run in the top of the second inning to David Fry...picked up his first loss of the season in a 3-1 final...it was the fourth loss of his career to the Guardians.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his first start the season in Twins' second game on March 30 at Kansas City in a Twins 5-1 win, opposite of Seth Lugo...shut out the Royals through the first 5.0 innings...was relieved by Steven Okert in the bottom of the sixth inning who inherited two runners by Ryan and allowed a two-out single by MJ Melendez...Ryan's final line was 5.1 innings pitched, one earned run, three hits, one walk and five strikeouts.

JOE VS. THE TIGERS: Facing the Tigers for the seventh time in his career...in the previous six starts, he owns a 4-1 record, 3.57 ERA (35.1 IP, 14 ER) five walks and 45 strikeouts...his last win against the Tigers came on September 30, 2022 at Detroit where he went 6.0 innings, five hits, no runs, one walk and eight strikeouts.

ROAD DEALING: Through one start in 2024 on the road at Kansas City, Ryan has logged 5.1 innings, one earned run three hits, one walk and five strikeouts factoring in a no-decision.

LEFT RIGHT SPLIT: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .200/.259/.240, one extra-base hit in 27 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .176/.175/.471, two doubles, one home run in 17 plate appearances.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a five-pitch mix in his first two regular season starts this year compared to his four-pitch repertoire in 2023...leaned on his four-seam fastball and split-finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 73.7 percent of the time throughout his two starts of the year...here is Joe Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- 2023 NOTES: Made Twins Opening Day roster, the second of career...posted career highs in innings (161.2), strikeouts (197) and starts (29).
Posted his best month in May 2-2, 2.73 ERA (33.0 IP, 11 ER) 30 hits, nine walks, 40 strikeouts and two home runs.
First career complete-game shutout vs. the Boston Red Sox on June 22, logging nine strikeouts and zero walks...season-high 122 pitches.
11 win tied Pablo Lopez for team lead, 197 strikeouts ranked second and 181.2 innings ranked third.
Made Postseason debut on October 11 in Game 4 of the ALDS vs. the Houston Astros, allowing one run (a second-inning home run to Michael Brantley) in 2.0 innings with one strikeout.
Placed on 15-day Injured list on August 3 with a left groin strain...made on rehab start assignment with Triple-A St. Paul and was reinstated on August 26.
Was supported with 97 runs of offense for a run support average of 5.40, 11th highest in the AL.
Went 8-6, 3.70 ERA (107.0 IP, 44 ER) with 18 walks and 124 strikeouts in 18 starts pre-All-Star break...ranked fifth in the AL in strikeouts and 14th in innings pitched.
Posted a 1.78 home runs-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio, the fourth highest in the AL.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.

LONG TIME WAITING AGAIN: After Thursday's postponed game, Ryan's last start was on April 6 vs. Cleveland Guardians, it'll be his second start in a row this season that he will go on six or more days of rest...in his career he has made 19 starts going 5-7, 4.27 ERA (99.0 IP, 47 ER), 76 hits, 33 walks and 105 strikeouts.

MASTER OF THE DAY: Went 6-5, 3.65 ERA (74.0 IP, 30 ER) with 16 walks, 88 strikeouts and a .223 opponent batting average in 13 daytime starts in 2023...is 12-9, 3.13 ERA (149.2 IP, 52 ER)...205 BAA in 27 career day starts, compared to 14-11, 4.71 ERA (197.0 IP, 103 ER), .239 BAA in 36 career night starts.

APRIL EXCELLENCE: Set to make his 11th career start in the month of April, going 8-2, 2.36 ERA (61.0 IP, 16 ER), 37 hits, 10 walks and 68 strikeouts...opponents are hitting .171 and OPS of .512...best month of his career with at least eight games started...since 2022, is tied with Clayton Kershaw for first (min. 50.0 IP) with eight April wins and also has the best April opponent batting average.

DOUBLE DAY AT THE PARK: Will be making his third career start in a doubleheader, second against Detroit...started Game 1 on September 14, 2021 at Cleveland (ND, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K)...also started Game 2 on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL (L, 4.0 IP, 3 H, 4 R/ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 3 K).
