**PERDOMO NAMED D-BACKS HEART & HUSTLE AWARD WINNER:** Today, **Geraldo Perdomo** was named the D-backs’ Heart & Hustle Award winner, announced by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA)...the annual award is given to active players who exemplify a true passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and traditions of the game.

- At the conclusion of the season, all alumni and fans will vote to select the final winner from the 30 team winners, which will be announced in mid-November on MLB Network...no D-back has ever won the overall award.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 6-2 vs. Padres last night for their third straight win.

- Brandon Pfaadt** earned his career-high-tying 11th win after tossing 5.2 innings with 2 runs allowed on 5 hits with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts.
- Alek Thomas** had his career-high fourth straight multi-hit game, has homered in 3 of his last 6 games and has reached base safely in 6 straight games.
- Tyler Locklear** slugged his first homer as a D-back (solo in third inning).
- Blaze Alexander** hit safely in his fourth straight game with an extra-base hit in consecutive games.
- Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 7 straight games (since July 28) and has hit safely in 6 of his last 7.
- Ketel Marte** has 4 multi-hit games in his last 6.
- Andrew Hoffmann** made his D-backs debut with 1.1 perfect innings with 2 strikeouts.
- Kyle Backhus** recorded his first career save (0 ER in 2.0 IP).

**FOR A SERIES:** With a win, the D-backs will claim their second consecutive series win and third since the All-Star break (also: @ Athletics and vs. Cardinals).

**VS. PADRES:** The D-backs are 5-3 vs. Padres this season and are 2 wins shy of clinching the season series...split their previous 4-game road series from July 7-10 and won the first series 2-1 @ Chase Field from June 13-15.

- Following this 3-game set, the D-backs will face off with the Padres one more time on the road in their final regular season series (Sept. 26-28).

**HEAD-TO-HEAD WITH NL WEST:** The D-backs are 16-12 (.571) vs. NL West opponents this season, the second-best interdivision win pct., behind the Dodgers (19-7, .731) and ahead of the Padres (14-13, .519).

- In head-to-head NL West play, the D-backs own the best OPS (.827), SLG (.494) with the most homers (51), hits (251), extra-base hits (105), runs (148) and stolen bases (20).
- Geraldo Perdomo has reached base safely in 23 of his 27 games vs. NL West, batting .327 (33-for-101)/.391 OBP/.525 SLG/.916 OPS with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 21 RBI, 12 walks and 2 stolen bases.
- Ketel Marte has reached base safely in 8 straight games vs. NL West (2 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI) and in 23 of his 27 games vs. NL West this season, slashing .303/.405/.677/1.082 with 7 doubles, 10 homers, 20 RBI, 15 walks, 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.
- Marte’s 47 times on base and Perdomo’s 45 rank second and fourth, respectively, in most times on base in head-to-head play, behind Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (1st, 50) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (3rd, 46).

**ALEK ON THE ATTACK:** **Alek Thomas**, in 11 games since the All-Star break, is hitting .371 (13-for-35)/.405 OBP/.657 SLG/.1.063 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 5 RBI and 2 walks.

- Since the All-Star break, his 1.063 OPS ranks fifth among the Majors, behind Warming Bernabel/COL (1.266), Kyle Schwarber/PHI (1.260), Bryce Harper/PHI (1.135) and Kyle Stowers/MIA (1.118).

**CARROLL’S RECENT HISTORICAL MARKS:** **Corbin Carroll** (80 2B, 40 3B, 73 HR) is the third MLB player in the live ball era (since 1920) to collect 80+ doubles, 40+ triples and 70+ homers within their first 440 career games, joining Joe DiMaggio (114 2B, 43 3B, 108 HR) and Lou Gehrig (125 2B, 47 3B, 82 HR) [h/t MLB Network].

- He is also the fifth MLB player since 1901 to have consecutive seasons with 14+ triples and 22+ homers, joining Jim Rice/BOS (1977-78), Johnny Mize/STL (1938-39), Joe DiMaggio/NYY (1936-37) and Lou Gehrig (1930-31).

**HITTIN’ AT HOME:** **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 13 straight home games (since July 1), batting .458 (22-for-48)/.544 OBP/.542 SLG/1.086 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 8 RBI, 7 walks (4 K), 2 hit-by-pitches and 2 stolen bases.

- Corbin Carroll**, has hit safely in 6 straight home games (since July 19), batting .400 (10-for-25)/.385 OBP/.800 SLG/1.185 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 5 RBI and 2 stolen bases.
- Alek Thomas**, in his last 5 home games, is hitting .333 (5-or-15) with 1 double, 1 homer and 2 RBI.

**ON-BASE MACHINE:** **Geraldo Perdomo**'s 55 times on base since July 1 are tied for the most in the Majors with Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR and Fernando Tatis Jr./SD.

- Has reached base in 26 of his 29 games since July 1, hitting .324 (34-for-105)/.433 OBP/.448 SLG/.881 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 17 RBI and 18 walks (10 K).

**RUNS VS. OPPOSING STARTERS:** In their last 3 games vs. opposing starters, the D-backs have scored 13 earned runs in 12.1 innings (9.49 ERA) while hitting .358 (19-for-53)/.446 OBP/.547 SLG/.993 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers, 9 walks and 10 strikeouts.

- The D-backs’ 325 runs vs. opposing starting pitchers are the most in the NL, ahead of the Brewers (319) and Dodgers (315), and third in the Majors, behind the Red Sox (340) and Yankees (337).

**RELIEVERS RECENTLY:** D-backs relievers, over their last 4 games, have allowed just 3 earned runs in 16.0 innings (1.69 ERA) with a 0.81 WHIP, 3 walks and 12 strikeouts.

- Since July 24, in their last 10 games, D-backs’ relievers have allowed a MLB-lowest 11.1 (1-of-9) inherited runs allowed pct., ahead of the Dodgers (15.0, 3-of-20), Cardinals (15.4, 2-of-13) and Padres (20.0, 3-of-15).

**DANGEROUS FROM 1-2 SPOTS:** From the 1-2 lineup spots since June 1, the D-backs lead the Majors in OPS (.889), SLG (.524), triples (9) and extra-base hits (52)...are second in homers (23), OBP (.365) and total bases (230).

- Corbin Carroll**’s 5 leadoff triples this season are the most in the Majors, ahead of Xavier Edwards/MIA (2) while his 5 leadoff homers are tied for fifth with C.J. Abrams/WSH.
- Since 1901, Carroll is the only MLB player to collect 5+ leadoff triples and 5+ leadoff homers within their first 100 games of a season.

NEXT STARTER: RHP ANTHONY DESCLAFANI (1-2, 4.91)

- Will make his third start for the D-backs.
- In 10 career starts vs. Padres, is 3-1 with a 2.68 ERA (17 ER in 57.0 IP), 11 walks and 42 strikeouts...made his last start with Giants on June 20, 2023 (ND; 3 ER in 5.0 IP).
