**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (0-3 at Cleveland, 2-1 at Washington), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a 2-1 series win vs. the Rangers over the weekend...Minnesota will continue the homestand today with the first of four against the Royals through Thursday.

☞ Minnesota has gone 21-11 in their last 32 games since April 22, tied with Kansas City (21-11) for the third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Philadelphia (24-8) and New York-AL (22-11).

☞ The Twins are 13-12 at home this season, including a record of 11-6 in their last 17 here.

**SUNDAY NOT-SO-FUN DAY:** The Twins lost to the Rangers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-2, failing to sweep the series and snapping their four-game winning streak...Pablo López (4-5) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded three hits, two coming from Carlos Correa...Correa and Max Kepler each had one RBI on the afternoon.

**WE'RE NOT SO DIFFERENT, YOU AND I:** Since April 22, the Twins and Royals have both gone 21-11, tied for third-best record in baseball...below are their offensive comparisons and MLB rankings since that date:

**ROYALTY CHECKS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the fourth of 13 meetings in 2024...these two opened the season at Kauffman Stadium from March 28-31 as the Twins took two of three...the last time the Twins hosted the Royals was for three games from July 3-5, 2023 as the Twins swept...Minnesota went 6-1 vs. KC at home last season.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 51-32 vs. Kansas City...51 wins are his most against any opponent.

☞ Minnesota has won four consecutive home games vs. the Royals, dating back to April 30, 2023...additionally, they have won 13 of their last 14 against KC in this ballpark.

☞ The Twins' 23 wins vs. KC since the start of '22 are their second-most wins vs. any opponent in that span, trailing Chicago-AL (26-13).

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .322 (55-for-171) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 25 walks, a .408 on-base percentage and a .905 OPS in 45 games against the Royals since '19.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .350 (43-for-123) with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI, 32 runs scored and a 1.074 OPS in his last 32 games against the Royals.

☞ In their last 12 home games against the Royals, Twins starters have gone 7-0, 1.80 ERA (70.0 IP, 14 ER) with 11 walks and 86 strikeouts.

**RYAN KING:** Joe Ryan enters today's start with a record of 5-0, 1.52 ERA (41.1 IP, 7 ER), with 11 walks, 46 strikeouts, a 0.87 WHIP and a .171 opponent batting average in seven career starts vs. the Royals...since the start of 2022, only Dylan Cease (47) has struck out more Royals and only Aaron Civale (42.1) has thrown more innings vs. KC.

☞ Ryan's wins and strikeouts vs. KC are his most against any opponent.

**KEPLER ON TARGET:** Max Kepler is one home run away from becoming Target Field's all-time leader in home runs...below is where Kepler ranks in a few categories in the ballpark's history:

**NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS:** Carlos Correa has reached safely in 16-straight games since May 8, tied for the sixth-longest streak of his career...the three longest of his career are 27 (2017), 20 (2022) and 19 (2023)...the streak is tied with Ryan Jeffers (May 8-26) for the longest by a Twin this season...it is tied for the seventh-longest active streak in baseball with Brenton Doyle, trailing Aaron Judge (23), Anthony Volpe (23), Corey Seager (20), Marcell Ozuna (19) J.T. Realmuto (19) and Salvador Perez (18)...during the current streak, Correa has posted a .359 on-base percentage, with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI, six walks and a .938 OPS.

**MAX PRODUCTION:** Max Kepler is hitting .355 (33-for-93) with 13 doubles, four home runs, 10 walks, 19 RBI, a .419 on-base percentage, a .624 slugging percentage and a 1.043 OPS in his last 29 games, dating back to April 22...since that date, he ranks third in baseball in batting average and OPS, fourth in slugging percentage, and seventh in on-base percentage.

**ROYCE ON REHAB:** Royce Lewis played in his second game on rehab assignment yesterday for Triple-A St. Paul in Buffalo, going 2-for-5 with a double, a run scored and a strikeout as the designated hitter...he is now 3-for-9 through two games on rehab assignment...St. Paul has the day off today but will resume play on Tuesday with a doubleheader at Rochester, starting at 3:05 pm (CT)...Lewis was injured with a right quad strain on Opening Day, March 28 at Kansas City, while running the bases.

**HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY:** The Twins are 25-32 all-time on Memorial Day...the Twins won on Memorial Day last season, a 7-5, 11-inning victory over the Astros at Minute Maid Park...in that game, Royce Lewis made his return from the Injured List, going 2-for-5 with a three-run homer and four RBI.

☞ Play of today's game will pause for a moment of silence at approximately 3:00 pm (CT), to mark the National Moment of Remembrance.

**FYI:** Right-handed pitcher Jay Jackson has cleared waivers and accepted his assignment to Triple-A St. Paul...Jackson was designated for release or assignment on May 19 after going 1-2, 6.85 ERA (22.1 IP, 17 ER) with eight walks and 23 strikeouts in 17 games for the Twins.

- Making 11th start of 2024 and 72nd of career.
Making his eighth career start against the Kansas City Royals...made his last start against Washington on May 21, a 10-0 Twins win...earned his third win of the season, allowing no runs with three hits, two walks and six strikeouts in 7.0 innings.
Ranks fifth among qualified AL pitchers with a 7.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 10th start of the season on May 21 against the Nationals; earned his third win of the season, allowing three hits, two walks and six strikeouts in 7.0 scoreless innings... matched his season high with 7.0 innings (also May 10 at Toronto)...collected his team-leading seventh quality start of the season...since May 5, Ryan is 2-2, 2.84 ERA (25.1 IP, 8 ER), 19 hits, four walks and 23 strikeouts.

- Last start of 7.0-or-more scoreless innings was on June 22, 2023, when he threw a complete-game shutout vs. Boston.
Ranks fifth among qualified AL pitchers with a 7.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
Issued two walks for the first time since September 18, 2023 against the Reds.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his ninth start of the season on May 16 against New York-AL; took his third loss, allowing six runs on four runs (1 HR), one walk and five strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched... allowed a leadoff home run to Anthony Volpe...ended his season-high four game quality start streak dating back to April 24...three of the four runs he allowed came in the first inning...his four earned runs given up were a season high.

ROYAL SUCCESS: Facing Kansas City Royals for the eighth time in his career and second time this season...in the previous seven starts he is 5-0, 1.52 ERA (41.1 IP, 7 ER), 11 walks, 46 strikeouts, a 0.87 WHIP and a .171 (25-for-146) opponent batting average.

- His 1.52 ERA against the Royals is his lowest vs. any opponent in his career (min. 3 GS).
One start in 2024 against the Royals on March 30, tossed 5.1 innings, allowed one run on three hits, one walk and five strikeouts in a no-decision as Minnesota won 5-1 in its second game of the season.
In three career starts at Target Field vs. Kansas City, he is 2-0, 1.96 ERA (18.1 IP, 4 ER), five walks, 24 strikeouts a 0.93 WHIP and a .182 (12-for-66) opponent batting average.
His five wins against the Royals are the most vs. any opponent in his career.
His last win against the Royals came on April 2, 2023...allowed one run on three hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings.

BACK AT HOME: Through five starts at home in 2024, Ryan has gone 1-3 with a 5.02 ERA (28.2 IP, 16 ER), four walks, 31 strikeouts and five home runs compared to 2-0, 1.44 ERA (31.1 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 33 strikeouts and two home runs in five road starts.

- In 37 career home starts, he is 15-12, 3.84 ERA (208.2 IP, 89 ER), 167 hits, 52 walks and 247 strikeouts...Twins are 20-17 in Ryan's 37 home starts.
Since making his debut in 2021, he leads all Twins pitchers with 15 home wins...behind him are Griffin Jax (11) and Caleb Thielbar (10).
Has allowed seven home runs this year...five have come at Target Field.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .191/.225/.270 with six extra-base hits, including one home run, four walks and 36 strikeouts in 120 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters have slashed .250/.282/.491 with nine doubles, six home runs, five walks and 28 strikeouts in 117 plate appearances.

- Over his career, lefties are batting .205 (147-for-717) with 28 doubles, four triples and 21 home runs and a .613 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .243 (189-for-777) with 48 doubles, no triples and, 42 home runs with a .753 OPS.
In seven games vs. Ryan, Kansas City left-handed hitters have hit .154 (12-for-78) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, seven walks and 26 strikeouts with a .493 OPS...right-handed hitters have hit .191 (13-for-68) with four doubles, two home runs, four walks and 20 strikeouts with a .574 OPS.
In his last start against the Nationals, left-handed hitters hit went 0-for-16 with no walks and five strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has primarily used a four-pitch mix in 10 starts this season...has leaned on his 4-seam fastball and split finger the most, combining to throw the two pitches 89.4 percent of the time in his last start against the Nationals...here is Ryan's 2024 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

- In his last start three starts against Toronto, New York-AL and Washington, hitters have gone 1-for-27 vs. the split finger with seven strikeouts.
In his last start against the Nationals, hitters went 0-for-11 vs. the 4-Seam fastball with five strikeouts.
Right-handed hitters are hitting .229 (11-for-48) with three home runs and 13 strikeouts against the 4-seam fastball in 2024...left-handed hitters are hitting .184 (8-for-44) with two extra-base hits (2B, 3B) and 16 strikeouts.

RUNNERS ON: With runners in scoring position vs. Ryan, opponents are hitting .268 (11-for-41) with two home runs, one walk and 10 strikeouts...with the bases empty, opponents are hitting .192 (30-for-56) with four home runs, six walks and 48 strikeouts.

DAYTIME NUMBERS: Making his sixth daytime start of the year...has gone 0-3 with a 3.77 ERA (28.2 IP, 12 ER) in his five daytime starts this season, compared to 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (31.1 IP, 9 ER) at night.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Enters today with 442 career strikeouts, 29th in Twins history (1961-present)...next up is Tyler Duffey in 28th place with 466.

QUALITY STARTER: Recorded five-straight quality starts from April 24-May 21...leads the Twins with seven quality starts this season...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in nine of his 10 starts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 1-0, 2.57 ERA // CAREER: 1-1, 3.43 ERA)

Right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson is set to start the third of a four game set tomorrow night against the Kansas City Royals...last pitched on May 22 at Washington, allowing three hits, no runs, one walk and one strikeout in a 4.2-inning no-decision...set to make his first home start since May 6 against the Mariners after three consecutive road starts (Toronto, Cleveland and Washington); 0-0, 3.77 ERA (14.1 IP, 6 ER), two walks, five strikeouts a 1.19 WHIP and a .273 (15-for-55) opponent batting average in his last three starts...facing the Kansas City Royals for the first time in his career.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
