**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to tonight's game, the Mets announced the following moves: RHP Stephen Nogosek has been selected from Triple-A Syracuse...He will wear #85...LHP Anthony Banda has been selected from Triple-A Syracuse...He will wear #77...RHP Corey Oswalt has been transferred to the 60-Day IL...INF Travis Blankenhorn has been optioned to Triple-A Syracuse...OF Johneshwy Fargas has been designated for assignment.

**METS IN THE MORNING:** The New York Mets today announced the launch of their new podcast, "Mets in the Morning" hosted by Josh Lewin...The podcast, which will air every weekday for the remainder of the regular season, can be found on Spotify, Apple and Google podcasts and [Mets.com/Podcasts](http://Mets.com/Podcasts)...Episodes will include highlights from the previous night's game, previews of each day's game, interviews and insight that will fully satisfy the appetite of fans everywhere...Lewin was a member of the Mets radio booth from 2012-2018.

**METSELLANEOUS:** The Mets defeated the Pirates, 7-6, in comeback fashion yesterday...The team snapped a three-game losing streak...The Mets continue a six-game road trip (1-2) featuring three games against the Pirates (1-2) and the Reds (three games)...The Mets are off on Thursday and then return to New York for a 10-day, 11-game homestand against the Blue Jays (three games), Braves (five games) and Reds (three games).

**DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK:** The Mets are the third team in the modern era to lose a game after having a six-run lead and then win a game after falling six runs behind the following day...They join the Rays on July 27-28, 2019 and the Braves on July 13-14, 1997...Courtesy of Stats, Inc...Yesterday, marked the second time in franchise history that the Mets won a game after falling behind by at least six runs in the first inning...The Mets also did this on July 13, 1997 at Atlanta...The team trailed 6-0 in first inning and went on to win 7-6 in 10 innings.

**PROUD TO BE GREAT AMERICAN:** The Mets own a 34-20 record with a 4.22 ERA (222 earned runs/473.2 innings) at Great American Ball Park...The team has hit .266/.333/.454 with 79 home runs at the yard...The Mets have outscored the Reds, 283-235 since the ballpark was opened in 2003...The team's .266 batting average is the fourth-highest opposing batting average in the ballpark...It's the second-highest in the NL...Only the Dodgers (.272) have a higher batting average at GABP.

**JULY! JULY! JULY!** The Mets collected 11 hits again yesterday...As a team, New York is batting .253/.347/.426 with a .772 OPS in 14 games this month...This is their highest batting average, OBP and SLG in any month this season...The Mets hit .222/.297/.379 in 30 games in June.

**1010 WINS:** The Mets collected their second consecutive game with at least 10 hits yesterday...The Mets have recorded 22 games this year with at least 10 hits and are 17-5 in those games.

**WE LIKE MIKE:** Michael Conforto is 3-11 (.273) with a run, two doubles, a home run, two RBI, two walks and a 1.112 OPS in three games since after the All-Star Break.

**MOVING ON UP:** Pete Alonso is now 21st on the Mets all-time home run list with 86 blasts...Gary Carter is 20th with 89 home runs...Michael Conforto has hit 122 home runs and is now tied with Kevin McReynolds for ninth on the team's all-time list...Todd Hundley is eighth with 124 blasts.

**I'M WALKING HERE:** Brandon Nimmo has drawn eight walks in his last three games, tied for his most in a three-game span in his career and tied for the most ever by a Met in a three-game stretch...He is 13-45 (.289) with 11 runs, four doubles, one home run, 11 walks and six RBI in 13 games since returning from the 10-Day IL...He is batting .306 (34-111) with 18 runs, nine doubles, two home runs, 14 RBI, 23 walks and an .871 OPS in 35 games this year.

**IN A PINCH:** The Mets pinch-hitters are batting .254/.336/.437 with eight doubles, five home runs, 27 RBI and 13 walks...Their .254 batting average is tied for the fourth-best in the majors and is the best in the NL...Their .772 pinch-hit OPS is also the best in the NL...The team's five pinch-hit home runs is tied for the third most in the NL.

**TOTAL DOMINATION:** Dominic Smith collected three hits yesterday, going 3-5 with a run a double, and an RBI...He is batting .300/.345/.560 with 12 runs, four doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, three walks and a .905 OPS in 14 games this month...He is batting .347/.395/.514 with eight extra-base hits against left-handed pitchers this year.

**ROAD SHOW:** Pete Alonso is batting .280/.346/.579 with 30 runs, seven doubles, 14 home runs, 36 RBI and 14 walks on the road this year...His 14 road home runs rank tied for third in the major leagues behind Shohei Ohtani and Jesus Aguilar who each have 15...This compares to a .218/.321/.336 slash line with three home runs at home...Dominic Smith is slashing .280/.343/.453 with 20 runs, 10 doubles, six homers, 17 RBI and 14 walks away from Citi Field...This compares to a .223/.295/.315 slash line with six extra-base hits at home.

**METS-REDS NOTES:** The Mets return to the Queen City for the first time since September 20-22, 2019...The team took two of three from the Reds.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** The Mets have been in first place since Saturday, May 8, a streak of 72 days...This is their longest run atop the East in the last 14 seasons...The 2007 Mets (135 days in a row) were the last iteration of the club to be in first longer than 72 days in a row, per Elias...The team has been in first place for 88 days overall this season, the most of any team in 2021.

**ACT II:** The Mets finished the first-half at 47-40...It is the first time the team was in first place at the All-Star break since 2007, when they were 48-39...The Mets' 47 wins were the most in the first-half since 2016, when they also had 47 wins...This is the sixth time in Mets history that they've are in first place coming out of the All-Star break...Also 1984, 1986, 1988, 2006 and 2007...Courtesy of Sports Radar.

**C IS FOR COOKIE:** Carlos Carrasco is currently on a rehab assignment with the Brooklyn Cyclones...He tossed 2.0 scoreless innings and allowed only a hit, while striking out two on Thursday...Carrasco is on the 60-Day IL with a right hamstring injury.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Mets are 20-28 with a 4.52 ERA (199 earned runs/396.1 innings) with 137 walks and 423 strikeouts on the road this year...This compares to a 28-14 record with a 2.43 ERA (97 earned runs/359.0 innings) with 128 walks and 399 strikeouts at home...The team's 2.43 ERA at home is the best in the majors and their .667 winning percentage is fourth-best.

**OUCH!** The Mets have been plunked 51 times this season...That places them sixth in the majors and fifth in the NL...Since the start of 2019, the team has been plunked 191 times, which is tied for the second-most in the majors in that span...Only the Reds (192) have been hit more.

**JEFF McHITS:** Jeff McNeil has safely reached base in each of his last nine games, putting up a .469 OBP in that span...He is batting .333 (14-42) with seven runs, a double, five RBI and six walks in 14 games this month.

**CONNECT FOUR:** The Mets are 39-8 when scoring four or more runs this season...The team is 9-34 when scoring three or fewer runs...The Mets are 36-12 when scoring first this season...The team's .750 winning percentage is the third-best record in the major leagues when scoring first this season.

**REPLACE-METS:** Entering today, the Mets have used 51 players through 90 games this season...The franchise record for most players used in a season is 56 by the 2018 Mets...The Mets have had 15 different pitchers start a game this season...That is the most in the majors...The Mets used 10 starters in 2020...The last time the Mets used 15 or more starters in a season was in 1979 when they also used 15...The franchise record is 20 starters used in 1967.

**THREW ME FOR A LOUP:** Aaron Loup has allowed one run in his last 18 appearances...He is 2-0 with a 0.47 ERA (one earned run/19.0 innings) in that span with four walks and 24 strikeouts...Overall, he is 3-0 with a 1.48 ERA (five earned runs/30.1 innings) with 25 hits, six walks and 37 strikeouts...He has held left-handed hitters to a .186 (8-43) batting average this season.

**QUALITY EATS:** The Mets have made 34 quality starts this season...The Mets rotation owns a 3.05 ERA (149 earned runs/439.2 innings) this season, the second-best mark in the major leagues...deGrom leads the major leagues with a 1.08 ERA, while Marcus Stroman is 13th in the majors with a 2.78 mark.

**THIS DAY IN METS HISTORY:** On this day in 1980, Roy Lee Jackson earned his first win of the season as he tossed a complete game in a 13-3 win over the Reds in Cincinnati...He allowed three runs on three hits with three walks and struck out 12... Jackson went 1-5 at the plate with a triple...All together, the Mets collected 20 hits in the win including four from Bill Almon who went 4-6 with four runs, a walk and a tripe...For cool photos and interactive history information on the Mets, please visit the Mets Virtual Vault at [metsheritage.com](http://metsheritage.com).

### EICKHOFF NEWS & NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** Eickhoff made his third appearance of the season, his first in relief against the Pirates on July 11...The righty allowed two runs on six hits in 2.2 innings of work...Both runs came on solo home runs...Six of the seven earned runs Eickhoff has allowed this season have come via home run...It was Eickhoff's fifth career relief appearance and his first since June 16, 2019.

**MAKING A GOOD FIRST IMPRESSION:** In his first career major league game, August 21, 2015, Eickhoff pitched 6.0 scoreless innings en route to his first career major league victory...In his first career game with the Mets, Eickhoff pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in game two of June 21's doubleheader against the Braves...Eickhoff is one of 72 pitchers in major league history to not allow a run in their first start with multiple teams since 1900 per Elias Sports Bureau.

**VS. CINCINNATI:** In two career starts against the Reds, Eickhoff is 0-1 with a 3.75 ERA (five earned runs/12.0 innings)...Both starts came in 2017...In his lone outing at Great American Ballpark, Eickhoff suffered the loss after allowing two earned runs in 6.2 innings on April 5, 2017.

**MAJOR LEAGUE REVIEW:** Eickhoff spent the first five years of his big league career with the Phillies, going 21-30 with a 4.15 ERA (203 earned runs/440.0 innings) in 80 games (76 starts)...He put up a 2.65 ERA in eight starts as a rookie in 2015 and made a career-high 33 starts the next year as he went 11-14 with a 3.65 ERA for the 2016 Phils...He appeared in a total of 39 games (35 starts) from 2017-2019, going 7-13 with a 5.07 ERA

**MINOR LEAGUE REVIEW:** Eickhoff has made nine starts with Syracuse (AAA) this season, going 5-1 with a 5.09 ERA (26 earned runs/46.0 innings)...He is second in the organization in wins...He won each of his first five decisions before suffering his first loss of the season on June 12...In his last start with Syracuse, Eickhoff pitched 2.0 scoreless innings on July 7 against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

**RECENT EICKHOFF:** Since his last major league season, Eickhoff has seen time in three organizations...After the 2019 season, he signed a minor league contract with San Diego...Spent the majority of 2020 at the Padres' Alternate Site...Had his contract purchased on August 2, then was outrighted the next day...He signed with Texas on August 29, 2020 and spent the remainder of the 2020 season at the Rangers' Alternate Site...Eickhoff signed a minor league contract with the Mets on December 21, 2020.
