RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 11-day homestand vs. Boston (0-1, 2 to play), Kansas City (3 to play) and Oakland (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...Tampa Bay is in the midst of a 13-game stretch featuring matchups exclusively vs. AL East opponents (6-5 thus far), which began with a three-game series vs. the Yankees from May 10-12 (1-2)...the 13-game stretch ends Wednesday, bookending seven matchups between the Rays and Red Sox over a span of 10 days...following this series vs. Boston, Tampa Bay will enjoy four off-days over the next 15 days.

Last night, Tampa Bay was shut out for the second time this year, joining a 2-0 defeat on May 10 vs. New York-AL...it marked the first time the Rays were shut out by the Red Sox since Oct. 4, 2022 (6-0) and the first at home since Sept. 2, 2021 (4-0).

The Rays totaled three hits, matching their fewest this season (also March 31 vs. TOR)...they have been held to four hits or fewer in back-to-back games for the first time since May 25-26, 2021...they last went three straight games with four hits or fewer from May 9-12, 2021.

Tampa Bay finished the game with one runner left on base, its fewest since June 8,

hits or fewer from May 9-12, 2021. Tampa Bay finished the game with one runner left on base, its fewest since June 8, 2023 vs. MIN (also 1)...the Rays, who did not advance a runner past first base in the loss, have scored two runs in their last 19 innings.

The Rays did not commit an error in last night's game, snapping a season-long four-game streak with at least one miscue.

Tonight, the Rays look to avoid a third straight loss, which would match their longest skid of the season (also: April 21-23, April 26-28).

**TALKIN' TAJ**—Last night, **Taj Bradley** recorded his second career 10+ strikeout game, becoming the third pitcher in franchise history to have multiple such performances before turning 24...**Scott Kazmir** had 14 such games from 2005-07 and **Matt Moore** had two from 2011-12.

SPRING(S) HAS SPRUNG—Yesterday, Jeffrey Springs made his first rehab start with the FCL Rays, allowing one run on three hits with no walks and two strikeouts...he allowed three consecutive singles to open the outing, but struck out the next two batters and recorded a line out to close the frame.

ROUNDING INTO FORM—Yandy Díaz has reached base safely in 15 of 17 games since May 3, slashing .343./410/.486 (24-for-70) with 4 2B, 2 HR, 12 RBI and 8 BB during that stretch...in 17 games prior, he went 15-for-67 (.224) with 3 2B and only 1 RBI.

His eight multi-hit games since May 3 are tied with LAD Shohei Ohtani for third most in the majors, trailing OAK Abraham Toro (10G) and OAK Brent Rooker (9G).

PEN PALS—The Rays bullpen has turned in an MLB-best 1.59 ERA (62.1IP, 11ER) since May 3...they entered that stretch with an MLB-worst 5.55 ERA through their first 32 games, dropping that mark to 4.22 entering tonight's game.

Riding an 11.0 scoreless inning streak, LHP Garrett Cleavinger has not allowed an earned run in 17 consecutive outings since April 6, tied for the fourth-longest active streak in MLB behind CLE Emmanuel Clase, WSH Dylan Floro and PHI Matt Strahm (all 18G).

RHP Jason Adam is 2-0 with a 0.51 ERA (17.2IP, 1ER) over his last 18 games.

RHP Pete Fairbanks has retired all 12 BF across four scoreless appearances since returning from the 15-day IL on May 11, recording 6 SO.

In 33 games through May 3, Tampa Bay relievers allowed an MLB-high 22 HR, with the next closest club being Toronto (21HR)...they have conceded only 5 HR

The Rays bullpen has posted a 1.58 ERA (51.1IP, 9ER) over the club's last 13 games

vs. the Red Sox since June 3, 2023.

BIT BY THE LONG BALL—Tampa Bay pitching has permitted 64 HR, second most in the majors behind Chicago-AL (65HR)...it marks the most long balls the Rays have allowed through 49 games since 2016 (66HR).

Tampa Bay has allowed 39 HR at Tropicana Field, most by any team in their home

hampa Bay has allowed 39 HR at Tropicana Fleid, most by any team in their nome ballpark, with the next closest being San Diego (35)...the Rays 1.42 HR/9.0 IP at home is the highest mark in MLB, also ahead of the Padres (1.35 HR/9.0IP)...the 39 HR are the third most Tampa Bay has allowed through its first 27 home games in club history, trailing the 2000 (48HR) and 2004 (43HR) Devil Rays. Rays batters have hit only 41 HR, fourth fewest in the AL, ahead of Chicago-AL (34HR) and Detroit/Toronto (both 39HR).

THORN IN THE SIDE—Opposing nine-hole hitters are batting .273 vs. Rays pitching, the highest mark in the majors, with the next closest being Houston (.261)...Ceddanne Rafaela homered out of the ninth spot last night, marking the sixth homer Tampa Bay has conceded to nine-hole hitters...the 6 HR are tied with St. Louis for the most in MLB.

In comparison, opposing clean-up hitters are batting .203 against Tampa Bay, the third-lowest mark in MLB behind Los Angeles-NL (.183) and Philadelphia (.196).

MAY FLOWERS—Since taking over in 2015, Kevin Cash has guided Tampa Bay to a 139-105 (.570) record in the month of May, the fourth-best May winning, pct in MLB during that stretch behind Houston (155-90/.633), Los Angeles-NL (152-88/.633) and New York-NL (150-00/.635)

**UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY**—The Rays own a -34 run differential through 49 games, their worst mark since 2007 (-64)...Tampa has suffered 10 losses by 5+ runs, tied for the third-most such defeats in the AL and tied for fifth most in MLB...the Rays had 14 losses by 5+ runs all of last season.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays have played in 26 games decided by two runs or fewer, second most in the AL behind New York-AL (27G) and tied for fifth most in the majors... Tampa Bay is 18-8 (.692) in those contests, the second-best winning pct. in the majors behind Philadelphia (14-5/.737).

SOX IN ST. PETE—Tampa Bay and Boston continue a three-game set tonight at Tropicana Field...the two clubs met last week in Boston, with Tampa Bay taking three of four...the Red Sox return to Tropicana Field for a three-game series from Sept. 17-19 before the clubs close out the 2024 campaign with a three-game set in Boston from Sept. 27-29.

The Rays are 22-5 vs. the Red Sox at Tropicana Field since June 23, 2021, outscoring Boston, 130-83 (+47), during that stretch...Tampa Bay won a franchise-best 13 straight home games vs. Boston from April 23, 2022–April 13, 2023, tied for the fifth-longest home winning streak by any club vs. Boston since 1901: Minnesota Twins (17G, Aug. 4, 1964–May 7, 1966), Cleveland Indians (16G, June 21, 1920–July 13, 1921), Washington Senators (15G, April 26, 1926–May 30-G2, 1927) and St. Louis Browns (14G, Sept. 12, 1926-G2–June 11, 1928).

- Tampa Bay RHP Zack Littell was claimed off waivers by the Rays from the Red Sox on May 12, 2023...he became the first pitcher to be claimed off waivers mid-season and go on to make 10+ starts for a team that made the postseason since **Doug Fister** with the 2017 Red Sox (Elias).
- Red Sox RHP Cooper Criswell made 11 appearances (1GS) for the Rays across two seasons from 2022-23, going 1-1 with a 5.45 ERA (36.1 IP, 22ER)...he earned his first career win on May 26, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (4.0 IP, 4H, 1ER, 2BB, 350).
- Rays RHP Zach Eflin and Red Sox INF Vaughn Grissom attended Hagerty High School in Oviedo, FL...both players had their respective numbers retired by the school.
- Boston 1B Dom Smith was signed to a minor league contract by the Rays last month on April 1...he hit .263 with 3 2B, 2 HR and 11 RBI in 21 games for Triple-A Durham before joining the Red Sox.
- Rays LHP Jeffrey Springs was acquired from the Red Sox on Feb. 17, 2021...Springs, currently rehabbing from Tommy John surgery, gree up a Red Sox fan and enjoyed watching Pedro Martínez and Jason Varitek.
- Wade Boggs, who was inducted into Tampa Bay's inaugural Hall of Fame class in 2023, hit .338 with 422 2B, 47 3B and 85 HR in 11 seasons with Boston (1982-92).
- Boston RHP Kutter Crawford was born in Okeechobee, FL, roughly 140 miles from St. Petersburg... after graduating from Okeechobee High School, he spent two seasons at Indian River State College (2015-16) before transferring to Florida Gulf Coast University in 2017.

TONIGHT'S START—The right-hander will take the mound for his 10th start of the season, including his sixth at home...has recorded a 4.40 ERA (28.2IP, 14ER) in his last five starts compared to 2.14 (21.0IP, 5ER) in his first four...has a 2.31 ERA (11.2IP, 3ER) in his last two home starts...the Rays have won each of his last three starts overall, outscoring opponents, 17-8 (+9), in those games.

LAST TIME OUT—Littell did not factor into the decision of the Rays 7-5 win at Fenway Park on May 16, allowing his second-most runs in any outing this season (5.0IP, 7H, 4ER, BB, 3 SO, HR)...yielded a **Rafael Devers** solo homer to lead off the 2nd inning...ran into trouble in the 5th, loading the bases with one out before permitting an RBI-groundout followed by a two-run double off the bat of Garrett Cooper...has recorded a HBP in back-to-back starts after not plunking a batter in his first seven outings.

WE MEET AGAIN—Littell will make his second consecutive start against WE MEET AGAIN—Littell Will make his second consecutive start against the Red Sox after facing them as a starter for the first time in his career on May 16...prior to this stretch, he had made one relief appearance against them, earning the win after holding Boston scoreless over the final two frames of a 17-inning win in Minnesota on June 18, 2019 during his stint with the Twins (W, 2.0IP, 2H, 0R, 2SO)...it was the longest contest in Target Field history until the record was broken just nine days later, when the Revised for the Twins 5.2 in an 18 inning magnitude at 10. Rays defeated the Twins, 5-2, in an 18-inning marathon to conclude a 10-

Littell was traded from Texas to Boston on May 5, 2023 and had his contract selected the following day...he yielded 3 ER over two relief appearances spanning 3.0 IP before being designated for assignment on May 10 and subsequently claimed by the Rays on May 12. Since joining the Rays, Littell has gone 3-0 with a 3.00 ERA (33.0IP,

7ER) in his six starts against AL East opponents.

**HOMEWARD BOUND**—Since transitioning to a full-time starting role last July, Littell is 3-3 with a 3.43 ERA (60.1IP, 23ER) in 10 home starts, four of which were quality...has tossed 5.0+ IP in each of those outings and allowed three runs or fewer in seven of them...he has posted a 2.51 ERA (43.0IP, 12ER) in his last seven home starts dating to Sept. 7, 2023.

PINPOINT PRECISION—Littell holds the AL's sixth-fewest walks per 9.0 IP PINPOINT PRECISION—Littell holds the AL's sixth-fewest walks per 9.0 IP (1.45) and fifth-lowest walk rate (3.8%)...according to Elias, his free pass to NYY Anthony Rizzo on May 11 snapped a 123 BF streak without a walk, third longest in Rays history behind Corey Kluber (150, 2022) and David Price (124, 2013)...five of his eight walks have come in a total of two frames: the 1st inning on April 10 at LAA (3BB) and the 2nd on May 11 vs. NYY (2BB)...excluding his statistics in those two frames, he has produced a 1.5 pct. walk rate (3BB/200BF) in all other innings.

From April 17-May 4, he recorded 6+ SO without issuing a walk in a club-record four straight starts...the four such starts are tied for second most in the majors behind PIT Tared Jones (5)

BEND, DON'T BREAK—Littell has allowed opponents to bat .298 (48-for-161) over his last seven starts dating to April 10 at LAA...min. 35.0 IP, it signals the fourth-highest mark among AL hurlers in that timeframe...his success has stemmed from his lack of walks coupled with a career-best 33.1 pct. hard-hit rate, the fifth-lowest mark in the AL behind NYY Luis Gil (30.6%), DET Tarik Skubal (30.6%), BOS Kutter Crawford (31.5%) and KC Michael Wacha (32.4%) and 13th lowest in the majors...it has dropped 8.8 pct. compared to his 41.9 pct. hard-hit rate last season.

Opponents have swung at 54.2 pct. of Littell's total pitches, the fourth-highest mark in the majors behind PIT Jared Jones (57.7%), CHC Shota Imanaga (56.3%) and SEA George Kirby (54.5%).

3RD-FRAME FEATS-Littell has not allowed a run in the 3rd inning, holding opponents to a 2-for-28 (.071) clip while permitting only three baserunners (2 2B, BB), one of which was erased on a double play...on the season, opposing hitters are batting .301 (22-for-73) against him the first time through the order vs. .238 (19-for-80) the second time through.

SLIDE TO THE LEFT—Opponents are batting .186 (13-for-70) with 16 SO against his slider...this includes a 4-for-34 (.118) clip against left-handed hitters...opposing batters have hit a combined .328 (44-for-134) against his
