TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today activated from the 10-day injured list INF Noelvi Marte; activated from the 15-day injured list RHP Graham Ashcraft; optioned to AAA-Louisville RHP Sam Benschoter and OF/INF Ryan Vilade... placed on a rehab assignment at Louisville INF/OF Connor Joe.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Is the first game of a 3-game series vs Kevin Gregg's Phillies and Game 4 (1-2) of Cin's final road trip before the All-Star break, a 7-day/6-game excursion that includes a 1-2 series loss against the Red Sox (Mon-Wed).
 - Following Sun's series finale at Citizens Bank Park, the Reds return to Great American Ball Park for a 7-game homestand vs Mia (4g, 7/7-7/10) and Col (3g, 7/11-7/13).
- SERIES NOTES:** The Reds and Phillies kick off their season series with a 3-game set at Citizens Bank Park beginning this afternoon...these teams will meet again from 8/11-8/13 at Great American Ball Park.
- Cin went 4-3 against Phi in 2024, taking 2 of 3 at Citizens Bank Park from 4/1-4/3 before splitting a 4-game set from 4/22-4/25 at GABP... marked its first season series victory vs Phi since 2021 (4-2).
 - INF/OF Spencer Steer on 4/1/24 delivered a go-ahead grand slam in the 10th inning of that night's 6-3 win...marked the first grand slam by a Red in extras since Todd Frazier's walkoff slam on 6/17/15 vs Det.
 - The 7-0 Phillies win on 4/22/24 took 2 hours and 2 minutes...it was the quickest 9-inning game at Great American Ball Park since 9/5/06, when the Reds blanked the Giants, 3-0, also in 2 hours and 2 minutes.

FEELING GRAND: INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand on Wed at Bos delivered a go-ahead grand slam off Craig Weissert in the 7th inning...marked the first grand slam of his career and the sixth by a Reds batter this season.

- Cin's 6 grand slams in 2025 are tied with Sea for second-most among all Major League clubs, fewer than only AZ (8).
- Per Elias, Encarnacion-Strand became just the fourth player in Reds history to hit a grand slam with Cin trailing by exactly 3 runs in the 7th inning or later, joining Adam Dunn (6/30/06 vs Cle), Ken Griffey Jr. (5/20/06 at Det), and Samuel Byrd (5/23/1936 vs Pit).
- Encarnacion-Strand finished with a career-high-tying 4 RBI (3x, last: 4/14/24 at CWS)...marked his 10th career game with at least 3 RBI, second-most by a Red through his first 126 Major League apps since RBI became an official stat in 1920 (Jim Greengrass, 13g, 1952-53).

NATIONAL LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: INF/OF Spencer Steer on Mon was named National League Player of the Week for 6/23-6/29, marking his second career weekly honor (also: 4/1-4/7, 2024).

- During the week, slashed .444/.448/.815 (12-for-27) with 3 homers, 8 RBI, and 5 runs in 7 games...in that time, led qualified Major Leaguers in AVG (.522), SLG (.957), OPS (1.477), hits (12), and total bases (22).
- In the 8-1 win on 6/27 vs SD, he produced his first career 3-homer game, the first by a Red since OF Jesse Winker did it on 6/6/21 at StL...the second of his 3 HR on the night marked his 150th career XBH.

FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS: Terry Francona enters today's action 5 wins away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (Tex' Bruce Bochy 2,214).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for Bochy and Dusty Baker, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker (2,183) and Sparky Anderson (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000-win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining Bochy (SF), Bucky Harris (Det), and John McGraw (NYG).

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 27 times this season, most recently on Sat vs SD (1r, 3h, 1bb).

- Cin has plated 63 runs in the 1st inning this season, tied with Wsh for third-most in MLB, behind only LAD (65) and Bos (64)...this includes the 10 runs plated in the 1st inning on 5/10 at Hou.
- Cin has outscored opponents 63-38 in the first inning and are slashing .264/.347/.412 with 10 home runs.
- Have plated multiple runs in the opening frame of a game 18 times this season (last: 6/27 vs SD), tied with the Tigers for the most-such instances in MLB.

ELLECTRICITY: Over his last 39 games dating back to 5/19, SS Elly De La Cruz is slashing .311/.389/.601 (46-for-148, 10hr, 21xbh, 37r, 19bb, 27rbi).

- Has scored at least 1 run in 49 of Cin's 87 games this season.
- Is batting .293/.377/.538 this season vs RHP (66-for-225, 13hr, 43rbi).
- Against LHP in June, slashed .338/.442/.646 (3hr).
- Beginning 6/9, vs. relief pitchers is batting .421/.488/.816 (16-for-38, 4hr, 11rbi, 11r, 21 times on base, 31tb).
- Beginning 6/13, with 2 strikes, is batting .297/.333/.486 (11-for-37, 18g).
- Is 2 HR shy of joining Eric Davis (23hr/33sb, 1987) as the only players in Reds history with at least 20 HR and 20 SB before the All-Star break.
- Swiped his 20th base of 2025 in the 4th inning of the 1-0 win on 6/10 at Cle, making him the first player in Reds history with 20 or more steals in each of his first 3 seasons in the majors (courtesy Elias).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 28 series this season, including the recent 3-game set at Bos.

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since 1989, when they went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs Phi.
- The Reds are the only Major League team that has yet to be swept this season.

THE FUTURE IS HERE: C Alfredo Duno and INF Sal Stewart on Mon were selected to represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the All-Star Futures Game, which will take place on 7/12 at Truist Park in Atlanta, GA.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in the 6-4 loss on Sat (6/28) vs SD (5.0ip, 7h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 102TP).

- Was in line for the victory until the Padres plated 5 unanswered runs in innings 6-7.
- Was his 11th start this season in which he allowed fewer than 2 runs.
- Threw 52 pitches in his final 2 innings of work.
- Issued a free pass to Jose Iglesias in the 4th inning...had not walked any of his previous 73 consecutive right-handed batters dating back to 6/4 vs Mil.

JUNE 22: Earned the 4-1 win on 6/22 at StL (7.0ip, 3h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 3k, 100TP).

- Was his third app of the season in which he pitched at least 7.0 innings while allowing fewer than 2 runs.
- Marked his second consecutive start in which he didn't walk a batter.
- Was the third time this season he reached 100 pitches.
- Retired his final 18 batters.
- Became the first Reds starter to allow 1 run or fewer to StL in at least 3 straight starts since Luis Castillo did it in 4 consecutive starts against the Cards from 7/23/18-7/20/19.

JUNE 17: Did not factor in the decision in the 6-5 win vs Min on 6/17 (5.2ip, 8h, 5r/1er, 0bb, 5k, 2hr, 90TP).

- Was reached for 5 runs for the second time in 3 starts, but only 1 was earned.
- In the 4th inning induced groundouts to the first 2 batters he faced before Ty France reached on a throwing error by 3b Christian Encarnacion-Strand...the next 2 batters singled in 2 runs before Harrison Bader hit a 2-run homer...all 4 runs that inning were unearned.
- His 3rd inning strikeout of Bader was the 300th of his career... became the fifth-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (58) to reach the 300K mark since 1893 (*courtesy Elias*).

JUNE 10 (COMPLETE GAME SHUTOUT): Threw his first career complete-game shutout in the 1-0 win at Cle on 6/10 (9ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k, 110TP).

- Was the first CG SHO by a Reds pitcher since Hunter Greene's on 6/6/22 vs AZ (7ip)...was the first 9-inning CG SHO by a Reds pitcher since Wade Miley's no-hitter at Progressive Field on 5/7/21.
- Had a runner in scoring position just twice, once in the 2nd inning and once in the 8th...4 of his 31 batters reached base.
- Was ahead in the count to just 38.7% of his batters (12 of 31), the fourth-lowest such percentage of his 11 starts.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 20 of his 31 batters (64.5%).
- His 110 pitches were the second-most he's ever thrown in a game (113TP on 7/25/23 at Mil, 6.0ip).

JUNE 4: Suffered his first loss of 2025 on 6/4 vs Mil (6.0ip, 7h, 5r/5er, 1bb, 6k, 2hr, 100TP)...allowed 5 runs in an outing for the first time this season and for the first time since 8/7/24 at Mia (5ip, 6r/6er)...that 8/7/24 game also marked the last time before this outing in which he gave up 2 or more homers in a game (3).

- Eclipsed the 300.0-inning milestone to become the fourth player on the current roster to pitch 300 innings as a Red (Greene, Ashcraft, Lodolo).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in the 3-2 win vs SD on Sun, 6/29 (5.1ip, 7h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 1hb, 95TP).

- The only run he allowed came off Xander Bogaerts 4th inning solo homer.
- Threw 49 pitches combined in innings 3 & 4.
- Was ahead in the count to just 38% of his 26 batters (10-of-26)...his average this year is 48.8%.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 57.7% of his 26 batters (15-of-26)...his average this year is 66.5%.
- It marked just the second time in his career in which he allowed at least 7 hits and fewer than 2 runs in a game... he also did it on 4/19/24 vs LAA (7-1 win, 6.1ip, 7h, 1r/1er).

1.79 ERA OVER 14 STARTS: His 1.79 ERA over 14 starts is the lowest by a Reds' starter through his first 14 starts of a season since Edinson Volquez' 1.67 ERA in 2008...is the lowest by a Reds left-handed starting pitcher in any 14-start span since Danny Jackson pitched to a 1.56 mark over 14 starts in 1988.

HE EARNED IT: His 3.30 ERA (327.2ip, 128r/120er) through his first 60 career starts is the lowest by a Reds starting pitcher in that span since RHP Mario Soto (3.30, 1977-82).

LIMITING HARD CONTACT: Among all pitchers with at least 75.0 innings, his hard-hit percentage of .329 is sixth-best in the majors...*hard-hit percentage measures the percentage of pitches put in play at an exit velocity over 95 mph*.

EASY AS 1-2-3: Is holding top of the order batters (1, 2, 3) to a .202/.254/.325 slash line (23-for-114, 4hr, 20 hard-hit pitches).
