NATIONALS NEWS

HOT IN THE DESERT

The Washington Nationals and Arizona Diamondbacks kick off a three-game weekend series tonight at Chase Field.

- The Nationals are 19-12 (.613) on the road this season...Washington's 19 wins on the road are tied third-most in Major League Baseball behind only the Braves (23) and the Dodgers (20) and the .613 winning percentage is good for fourth.
- Overall, the Nationals are 20-16 (.555) since April 25...Washington has won eight of their 13 series over this stretch and has lost just two series since May 2.

VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS

All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams has reached base safely in nine of the last 10 games...He has two doubles, one home run, two RBI, 2 hit by pitches, four walks, two stolen bases and five runs scored during that span.
- Wood leads MLB with an average exit velo of 96.1 MPH with **O'Neil Cruz** (96.1)...His 38 barrels (at least 98 MPH exit velo/26 degree launch) are the most in MLB ahead of **Yordan Alvarez** (34) and **Mike Trout** (33)...He is one of five players in Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Junior Caminero** (3), **Yordan Alvarez** (2), **O'Neil Cruz** (2) and **Ketel Marte** (2).

BACKSTOP BATS

Drew Millas and **Keibert Ruiz** have been the most productive offense catching tandem in Major League Baseball since May 6...Combined, they rank among all MLB catching groups in slugging percentage (1st, .589), OPS (1st, .942), batting average (1st, .316), home runs (15th, 6), RBI (13rd, 23) and hits (7th, 30).

- Ruiz has hit safely in 12 of his last 16 games, going 21-for-55 (.382) with seven doubles, four homers, 17 RBI, two walks, one stolen base and 13 runs scored.
- On the season, Ruiz is tied for second among Major League catchers with 12 doubles and among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in slugging percentage (8th, .469).

VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE

Since May 6, Washington's offense ranks first in runs scored (148), tied for first in home runs (41), second in slugging percentage (.455) and third in OPS (.782).

- The Nationals recorded at least one extra-base hit in 32 straight games from April 29-June 2, the fourth-longest active streak in baseball behind San Francisco (36), Pittsburgh (34) and Chicago White Sox (33) at that time.

THUNDER FROM DOWN UNDER

Curtis Mead is hitting .287 (25-for-87) with six doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 15 walks (.404 OBP), a stolen base and 18 runs scored over his last 27 games since April 29.

- Mead has six RBI over his last six games and nine RBI over his last nine games...He is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with runners in scoring position since April 29.

THIS AND THAT

Some notable notes about other Nationals players:

- Dylan Crews** has reached safely in all 12 games since being recalled on May 19, the longest active on-base streak on the Nationals.
- Daylen Lile** is tied for second among National League outfielders and is tied for sixth in the National League with 15 doubles.
- Nasim Nuñez** is tied for most stolen bases (22) in Major League Baseball with **Jose Ramirez**.
- Jacob Young** ranks tied for 10th among National League outfielders in home runs with eight.

SAVES ON SAVES

The Washington Nationals have had eight separate pitchers record at least one save this season, the second-most in Major League Baseball (Minnesota, 11) and tied for the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with the 2009 Nationals and behind the 2017 Nationals.

- Gus Varland** (4), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **Clayton Beeter** (4), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1), **PJ Poulin** (2) and **Paxton Schultz** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

ACE OF BASES

The Nationals are one of the best baserunning teams in baseball according to the advanced metrics:

- Per Baseball Savant, the Nationals are tied for second in Major League Baseball with five baserunning runs (A Statcast metric designed to express the overall value of a baserunner, measured in runs created (or lost) via stealing bases and taking extra bases on the basepaths).

Harrisburg catcher **Max Romero Jr.** connected his ninth homer run of the season yesterday...He has now homered five times in his last five games and is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with two doubles, five homers, seven RBI, two walks and five runs scored...He's reached base safely in the five games.

Lefty starter returns to Major League Baseball after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball...Was a first-round pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 and their Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017.

- Made his Major League debut with Kansas City on July 27, 2020, his 25th birthday.
- Became the third pitcher since at least 1901 to earn the win in his MLB debut on his birthday, joining Edwin Jackson (9/9/03 at ARI) and Zach Day (6/15/02 at MON).

LAST START

Griffin tossed 5.0 innings, striking out five and allowing three runs on five hits against the San Diego Padres on May 30.

LEFT ON LEFT CRIME

Griffin has held opposing left-handed batters to a .178 batting average (13-for-73) with 21 strikeouts and just six walks...His four-seam fastball (.071), sweep (.182) and sinker (.167) have been particularly tough on left-handed hitters this year.

- In three starts from April 26 to May 8, lefties went 1-for-20 (.050) with six strikeouts and three walks against him.

TECHNICALLY, HE'S A ROOKIE

Although he spent three seasons in Japan, Griffin still qualifies as a rookie...Because of that, he ranks among qualified National League rookie pitchers in wins (1st, 6), starts (11st, 12), innings pitched (1st, 67.0), strikeouts (2nd, 65), opponents' average (4th, .223) and WHIP (4th, 1.15).

GRIFFIN'S GLOVE

Griffin has two defensive runs saved and two runs saved above average according to FanGraphs.com, tied for the most among National League pitchers.

BACK IN THE STATES, BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN

Griffin earned his first Major League win as a starter in his first career start on March 30 at Philadelphia...He threw 5.0 innings allowing just two earned runs on five hits with five strikeouts and no walks.

- It was his first Major League appearance since Sept. 22, 2022 at Tampa Bay and first Major League start after spending the last three seasons with the Yomiuri Giants of Nippon Professional Baseball

WINNING WAYS

Griffin won three of his first five starts without taking a loss, becoming just the third pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to win at least three of his first five starts with Washington without suffering a loss...He joins **Luis Atilano** (3-0 in 2010) and **Micah Bowie** (3-0 in 2007).

NPB Central League All-Star in 2025...Went 6-1 with a 1.52 ERA, 87 strikeouts, 22 walks and just one home run allowed in 89.0 innings across 17 starts.

- Recorded a 0.61 ERA (4 ER/59.0 IP) in nine starts from May 17 to July 12, 2025.
- Tossed 8.2 scoreless innings on June 15, 2024 at Nippon (5 H, 9 SO, 2 BB).
- Struck out 12 batters twice in 2024, both against Hiroshima: June 29 and Aug. 7.
