## LOS ANGELES DODGERS (42-24) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (34-32) June 9, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - Game #67/Home #34 LHP Eric Lauer (2-5, 5.74 ERA) vs. RHP Paul Skenes (6-5, 2.83 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** had the day off on Monday and will begin a six-game homestand vs. Los Angeles-NL (Tuesday-Thursday) and Miami (June 12-14) with tonight's series opener vs. the Dodgers...Went 2-4 on their recent six-game, seven-day road trip to Houston (2-1, June 2-4) and Atlanta (0-3, Friday-Sunday)...Have the fifth-most runs scored (333) in Major League Baseball, behind Washington (356), Los Angeles-NL (345), Atlanta (344) and Milwaukee (344)...Have the third-most steals (65) in Major League Baseball, behind Miami (76) and Milwaukee (68)...Have the sixth-best run differential (+30) in Major League Baseball, behind Los Angeles-NL (+133), Atlanta (+116), Milwaukee (+106), New York-AL (+98) and Seattle (32).

**DODGER DOMINANCE:** Pittsburgh will host Los Angeles (NL) for three games at PNC Park this week (Tuesday-Thursday)...The Pirates swept the Dodgers in three games at PNC Park last season (September 2-4), marking their first sweep of the Dodgers in Pittsburgh since August 7-9, 2015 (three games)...Pittsburgh has won four straight home series against Los Angeles (they also took two of three games from May 9-11, 2022, two of three games from April 25-27, 2023 and two of three games from June 4-6, 2024)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the Pirates have won at least five straight home series against the Dodgers four times in series history...Those came from September 26, 1901-September 10, 1903 (eight straight series), July 21, 1910-July 27, 1911 (five straight series), June 17, 1925-July 24, 1926 (five straight series) & July 24, 1943-August 22, 1944 (five straight series).

**SOUTHPAW SIGHTING:** The Pirates are facing a left-handed starting pitcher for the 17th time this season...Pittsburgh's 86 RBI against left-handed pitchers this season are the eighth-most in Major League Baseball, behind only Atlanta (111), New York-AL (101), Washington (98), Arizona (93), Cleveland (92), the Athletics (89) and Philadelphia (88)...Marcell Ozuna is 6-for-11 with three home runs in his career against the Dodgers' Eric Lauer (took him deep on May 11, 2018, June 13, 2018 and May 14, 2021).

**PIRATING:** Pittsburgh has stolen at least one base in seven of its last nine games (since May 29 vs. Minnesota)...The Pirates' 16 stolen bases in that span lead Major League Baseball (New York-AL, 14, ranks second)...Jake Mangum's 91.7 stolen base success rate (11-for-12) is tied with Chicago (AL)'s Luisangel Acuña, Miami's Esteury Ruiz and Washington's James Wood for the third-best mark in Major League Baseball (minimum 12 stolen base attempts), behind only teammate Konnor Griffin (93.3, 14-for-15) and Cleveland's José Ramírez (92.0, 23-for-25)...Oneil Cruz' 21 stolen bases rank fourth in all of Major League Baseball...Pittsburgh's 86.7 stolen base success rate (65-for-75) is second in Major League Baseball, behind Philadelphia (86.9, 53-for-61).

**38 BUCS:** Davis Wendzel became the 38th different Pirate to appear in a game for Pittsburgh this season when he pinch ran during the eighth inning of his team debut on Sunday at Atlanta (the Pirates have used 19 different position players and 19 different pitchers)...Pittsburgh's 38 players used are tied with Cleveland, Colorado and Seattle for the seventh-fewest in Major League Baseball, behind only Philadelphia (36), San Diego (36), St. Louis (36), Kansas City (37), Texas (37) and Washington (37).

**INDISPENCEABLE:** Spencer Horwitz went 2-for-3 with a leadoff home run, a third-inning single and an eighth-inning walk on Sunday at Atlanta, extending his on-base streak to a career-high-tying 15 straight games (since May 23 at Toronto)...He also reached base safely in 15 straight games from June 9-8, 2025...Horwitz is batting .316 (18-for-57) with four home runs, five RBI, nine walks, a .956 OPS and nine runs scored during the streak...He has three leadoff home runs this year (also May 24 at Toronto and May 30 vs. Minnesota)...The only Pirates during the 21st century with at least four leadoff home runs in a single season were Andrew McCutchen (four) in 2009, Adam Frazier (five) in 2019 and Oneil Cruz (four) last season.

**JAKE RAKES:** Jake Mangum singled and stole a base in the ninth inning on Sunday at Atlanta, extending his hitting streak to a season-high six straight games (since May 30 vs. Minnesota)...He is 10-for-20 (.500) with a double, a home run, three RBI, five stolen bases, a 1.200 OPS and three runs scored during the streak...Mangum is 15-for-41 (.366) with six RBI, six stolen bases and an .849 OPS over his last 14 games, dating back to May 20 at St. Louis (he has raised his season batting average from .250 to .291 during that stretch).

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

**June 9, 1967:** The Pirates collected 23 hits in a 16-1 win over the Phillies at Forbes Field. Gene Alley, Jerry May, Bill Mazerowski and Willie Stargell all had multiple hits and at least three RBI, marking the second time in the Modern Era (since 1901) where Pittsburgh had four such players in a game and the first since August 2, 1928 at Philadelphia. Billy O'Dell improved to 5-2 after pitching a complete game.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the first round (No. 1) of the 2023 Draft.

**AS OF LATE:** Skenes had a no-decision after allowing three runs (one earned) in 4.2 innings in the 11-9 loss on June 3 at Houston...He threw a career-high 109 pitches, surpassing his previous high of 108 (April 25, 2025 at Dodger Stadium)...Skenes is 0-3 with a 4.95 ERA (20.0ip/11er) in his last four starts (since May 17 vs. Philadelphia)...The Pirates have scored five total runs while he has been in the game in the four starts.

**AGAINST THE DODGERS:** Skenes is 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA (23.1ip/7er) and 33 strikeouts in four career starts against Los Angeles (NL)...He has struck out at least eight batters in each of the four starts, including a nine-strikeout performance on April 25, 2025 at Dodger Stadium...Skenes has pitched a combined 12.1 scoreless innings over his last two starts against the Dodgers (6.1ip on April 25, 2025 and 6.0ip last year on Sept. 4).

**HOW THE WEST WAS WON:** Skenes is 9-1 with a 1.65 ERA (81.2ip/15er) and 94 strikeouts in 13 career starts against the National League West...He has won five straight starts against the division (since last year on August 24 vs. Colorado), posting a 0.25 ERA (35.1ip/1er) and 38 strikeouts in that stretch (the only run he allowed came on April 7 vs. San Diego)...His only loss against the division came on August 10, 2024 at Dodger Stadium, when he allowed four runs in his 6.0 innings of work in a 4-1 loss.

**IN THE BEGINNING:** Skenes has a 6.39 ERA (12.2ip/9er) and four home runs allowed in the first inning of games...He has a 2.04 ERA (57.1ip/13er) and two home runs allowed from the second inning onward (has not given up a run in the second inning).

**BEST OF THE BEST:** Skenes' 2.12 ERA (390.2ip/92er) through 68 Major League starts ranks second among all Major League pitchers through their first 68 starts during the Live Ball Era (since 1920), behind only New York (NL)'s Dwight Gooden (2.01, 1984-86).

**DON'T WALK HERE:** Skenes pitched 39.0 consecutive innings without issuing a walk (the streak began in the fourth inning on April 13 vs. Washington) before allowing a walk to Adolis García in the fifth inning on May 17 vs. Philadelphia...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, that was the second-longest streak without a walk by a Pirates pitcher during the Expansion Era (since 1961), behind only Bob Friend (46.1ip, May 28-June 22, 1963).

**CRAZY EIGHTS:** Skenes pitched 8.0 scoreless innings while allowing two or fewer hits and issuing zero walks in back-to-back starts on May 6 at Arizona and May 12 vs. Colorado...He joined Bob Veale (Sept. 16-22, 1963) and Steve Blass (Sept. 15-20, 1968) as the only Pirates during the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch 8.0 scoreless innings and allow two or fewer hits in back-to-back starts...He also became just the fourth Major League pitcher since 1901 to pitch 8.0 scoreless innings while giving up two or fewer hits and issuing zero walks in back-to-back starts, along with Boston (AL)'s Cy Young (1905), Chicago (AL)'s Billy Pierce (1958) and San Diego's Mat Latos (2010).

**NEAR PERFECTION:** Skenes pitched 6.2 perfect innings before allowing a single to Jake Bauers on April 24 at Milwaukee (he went on to strike out seven batters and surrender just the one hit over his 7.0 innings)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, he tied Nellie Briles (August 22, 1972 at San Francisco), Bert Blyleven (August 16, 1980 vs. Montréal) and Nick Kingham (April 29, 2018 vs. St. Louis) for the third-longest perfect game bid by a Pirates pitcher during the Expansion Era (since 1961), behind only Ken Brett (8.0ip, May 27, 1974 vs. San Diego) and Jeff Karstens (7.2ip, August 6, 2008 at Arizona)...Skenes was the sixth Pittsburgh pitcher in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have a start of at least 7.0 scoreless innings with one or zero hits allowed, zero walks issued and at least seven strikeouts...Skenes joined Bob Friend (September 7, 1955 at Chicago), Woodie Fryman (July 1, 1966 at New York), A.J. Burnett (April 17, 2013 vs. St. Louis), Kingham (April 29, 2018) & Jared Jones (May 4, 2024 vs. Colorado).
